ALTA CAPITANA showed improvement with blinkers fitted last time and she's another with scope to improve over this distance with the headgear retained. LITTLEMISSPLENDID warrants respect too.

PREVIEW: OPERA FAN capitalised on her drop in the ratings to win a similar contest last time and the resultant 4-point penalty is somewhat negated by her rider's 1.5kg allowance, so another bold bid is expected. Class-dropper BRIGHT AND BRAZEN should fare better back against same-sex opposition with the aid of her rider's 1.5kg claim. PLAY WITH THE WIND and GOLDEN ASPEN have the means to get involved, as does FAIR PROPOSAL after an encouraging return to form recently at a higher level.
