PREVIEW: SECRET DEPTHS sets a good standard. She remains consistent at this level and is likely to give another competitive account of herself. Maturing 3yo fillies DUPLICITY and BRAVE NEW WORLD, however, are progressive and unexposed. They receive chunks of weight from that rival so may have her measure with further improvement expected of both. Last-start maiden winner SOVEREIGN ROSE has scope too and is another who could raise her game going the trip for the first time. Honest QUICKSTEP LADY is seldom far off in this grade but continues to slide down the ratings, so warrants respect - riding arrangements, though, suggest unexposed stablemate FRENCH DECLARATION is preferred. LARENTINA and HAMMIE'S FAN are also capable of taking home a cheque. Good race!

Last-start maiden winners PERFECT PRINCESS and OPERA SWING are likely improvers, capable of making their presence felt too - include. MISS MILLSTREAM is holding form and has caught the eye in recent sprints. She is unexposed over this distance and could pose a threat if as effective stepped up in trip - joker in the pack. QUEEN'S CLUB has not been disgraced in stronger races over track and trip recently, yet continues to slide down the ratings. She is distance suited, well drawn and likely to fare better dropped to this class. ORFERD'S FLASH and GREY PRINCESS have earning potential too. Trick!

PREVIEW: Fascinating race for a field of this size. THE SECOND WAVE has returned from a break in winning form. He got the better of ADIOS AMIGOS (subsequent winner) and consistent DOUBLE CHARGE on his comeback, then defied a 2-point penalty to beat improving SALVATOR MUNDI (1kg better off) over track and trip last time. The unexposed latter has raised his game after gelding and is likely to improve in his peak run to contest the outcome. Progressive ADIOS AMIGOS won a good race last time and should be a factor on that evidence. However, it is worth noting jockey Grant van Niekerk has opted to stick with DOUBLE CHARGE. NORTHERN SONG and SAVANNAH BUDDY add further intrigue and are capable of making their presence felt too.

A return to this trip off a 3-point higher rating will hold no fears and another bold bid can be expected. CELTIC NIGHT built on the promise of her debut 3rd by winning well at her next start. She is open to any amount of improvement and could well prove better than the handicapper's assessment - follow. VIRIDIAN LIGHT and WINDSOR BEAT are capable performers at this level of the handicap and could pose a threat reverting to this trip. TWO PENNIES could be anything over a sprint trip and isn't easily discounted.

PREVIEW: FIGHTER confirmed the improvement he made with blinkers fitted 2 starts back by winning a similar contest (easier than the margin suggests) over track and trip last time, and the minimum 2-point penalty may not be enough to prevent him from following up with jockey Grant van Niekerk and the headgear retained. Runner-up BALTIMORE JACK is weighted to turn the tables and should give him most to fear again. Recent maiden scorer DE BULL opened his account at his first attempt over this trip. He has more scope than most so could improve to pose a threat. BARNEY MCGREW, WHAT A MAN and LINE OF POWER can get into the picture too.
