## R1 VINCENNES [L-H]

**C1 - PRIX RMC (PRIX JACQUES MOREAU) - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E -  
Harness - EUR € 35,000**

- 1. SAMMY BOY (BEL)** - Knocking loudly at the door and was runner-up at Wolvega over 2700m on 7 February. Might play a minor role at very best
- 2. FAITH DI POGGIO** - Consistent and finished 5th at Villanova d'Albenga over 1600m on 29 July. Returns from a break and tackles stronger this time
- 3. SECRET OF LAW** - Did not show his best when 7th in Class E over this course and distance on 10 February. Consistent before that but others make more appeal
- 4. SAM PIERJI (BEL)** - A winner of three of his last five starts, including last time out in Class E over this course and distance on 10 February. Can be successful again
- 5. DUKE OF NEW YORK** - In good shape and was runner-up in Class E over this course and distance on 10 February. Can get into the mix of things once again
- 6. TAURUS CROWN** - In good form and was runner-up in Class E over this course and distance on 27 January. Remains barefoot and should fight out the finish
- 7. SEVEN SEAS S** - Not reliable but did finish fourth at Gelsenkirchen over 2000m on 4 February. Has claims at scoring on French debut
- 8. OMARI BOKO** - Unreliable but did finish third in Class E over this track and trip on 27 January. Capable of making the frame
- 9. LATINUS AVIS** - Bounced back to form with a win in Class E at Nantes over 3000m on 13 February. Not easy to trust but could double up
- 10. FRENCHCONNECTION** - Disqualified in his last two starts, the latest in Class E over this track and trip on 27 January. Lost third through an enquiry that day and is capable of contesting the finish
- 11. LIVE YOUR DREAMS** - Has struggled of late and finished 11th in Class D at this track over 2100m on 5 February. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 12. OVERDRIVE STEEL** - Did not show his best when 7th in Class E over this course and distance on 27 January. Place chance on best form
- 13. LUCHADOR** - Much improved last run when fourth in Class D at this track over 2850m on 15 February. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 14. L'AS DE SMARVES** - Has struggled of late and was tenth in Class E at Nantes over 3000m on 13 February. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 15. LUCKY BOY VERTRAC** - Not reliable and finished fourth at Mons over 2300m on 20 February. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals

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**Summary:** A very tricky opening event. SEVEN SEAS S (7) has some good form from Germany and some othat included beating French runners like rival in this DUKE OF NEW YORK (5). He could score on French debut. TAURUS CROWN (6) remains in good shape and should contest the finish. FRENCHCONNECTION (10) has a couple of diqualifications of late but was unlucky last time and could be a threat. SAM PIERJI (BEL) (4) has struck a priple patch of form and is clearly not out of it.

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## C2 - PRIX NEW TOUR (PRIX D'AIGUEPERSE) - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class A - Harness - EUR € 51,000

- 1. NAKALOUN** - Victorious in Class D at this track over 2100m on 11 February. Tougher task this time but could earn some money
- 2. NATURALE MAG** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest over this course and distance on 8 February. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 3. NEW APPROACH** - Unreliable and finished 8th in Class A over this track and trip on 7 February. Capable of earning some money
- 4. NICE SPEED** - Has disqualification issues but is in good shape and finished fourth in Class A over this track and trip on 8 February. Big chance if staying in stride
- 5. NOTTINGEN** - Has done little wrong so far and finished runner-up in Class A over this course and distance on 8 February. Can go one place better
- 6. NIKO DE TIMBOEUF** - Consistent and was third in Class A over this course and distance on 18 January. Could earn some more money
- 7. NOUS QUATRE** - Has shown promise in two starts and was fourth in Class C at this track over 2100m on 19 December. Can be a threat to these rivals
- 8. NOE DES BAUX** - Returned to form and was third in Class A over this track and trip on 8 February. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 9. NOVECENTO** - Not disgraced when 6th in a Group 2 over this course and distance on 24 January. Clearly is not out of it
- 10. NO WORRY** - Consistent and was runner-up in Class A over this course and distance on 7 February. Can make the frame

**Summary:** A very open-looking race. NICE SPEED (4) was very unlucky last time out over this course and distance and can make amends for that if staying on the trot all the way through. NOTTINGEN (5) has only been beaten once in his three starts and should be right there at the finish once again. NOE DES BAUX (8) was not far behind them last time out and can be competitive once again. NOUS QUATRE (7) shows promise and is capable of getting involved with the finish.

## C3 - PRIX CHINESE NEW YEAR (PRIX DE LARRE) - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 46,000

- 1. KALISCO PLANCHETTE** - Disqualified last time out over this course and distance on 1 February. In good form before that and could play a minor role
- 2. MAN OF STEEL (GER)** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Berlin-Mariendorf on 18 October. Returns from a break and others are preferred
- 3. EVANDRO DEGLI DEI** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class E over this course and distance on 13 January. Can be competitive once again
- 4. RED D'OVER** - A winner of his last three starts, the latest at Mons over 2840m on 27 January. Can add another win to tally
- 5. KANEM** - Battling to find best form and was 7th in Class E over this track and trip on 1 February. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 6. KEPI DEL** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Rouen-Mauquenchy on 26 January. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 7. KARAT DEFF** - Not reliable but is in good shape and finished fourth in Class D over this track and trip on 6 January. Capable of scoring
- 8. PURE STEEL** - Faulted last time out at this track over 2850m on 19 January. Not easy to trust but is capable of earning some money
- 9. ELAND** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in D at this track over 2850m on 19 January. Remains barefoot and could make the frame
- 10. NOAH NEWPORT** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Wolvega over 2600m on 24 January. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 11. KESSERO** - Holding form well and was fourth in Class E over this track and trip on 1 February. Can contest the finish once again
- 12. ERES DORIAL MAIL** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in Class D at this track over 2850m on 19 January. Capable of an upset on best form
- 13. KAIROS DE BOMO** - Has shown improvement of late and was runner-up in Class E over this track and trip on 1 February. Can go one place better
- 14. EL DORADO BAR** - Not reliable and finished 14th in Class C at this track over 2850m on 29 January. Can be a threat with this shoeing
- 15. KOCKTAIL WOOD** - Has really struggled of late and was 11th in Class D at this course over 2100m on 7 February. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

**Summary:** A very competitive-looking race. KARAT DEFF (7) was a bit of a disappointment last time out over this track and trip and is likely to do a lot better this time, so gets the vote to score. EL DORADO BAR (14) seems to have targeted this race and must be respected for that. KAIROS DE BOMO (13) is in good shape and could have a winning turn. ELAND (9) has only been modest of late but is likely to improve and could make the frame.

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## C4 - PRIX DE PARIS EQWIN - AMERIQUE RACES - 4150m (a2m1/2) - Gr1 - Harness - EUR € 400,000

- 1. IDYLLE EXPRESS** - A winner of her last four starts, the latest in a Group 3 at this track over 2100m on 25 January. Tougher task this time but she cannot be ruled out of the equation
- 2. HE AND ME** - At his best when barefoot and was third in a Class B at this track over 2850m on 29 January. On the upgrade and can be closely involved
- 3. WORKING CLASS HERO** - Holding form and finished 5th in a Class A at this course over 2100m on 7 February. Probably at very best over shorter distances but a place prospect nonetheless
- 4. HARMONY DU RABUTIN** - Let her supporters down with a rare disqualification last time out in the Group 1 Prix d'Amérique at this track over 2700m on 25 January. Can bounce back to score over this longer distance
- 5. KING OPERA** - Won this race in 2023. Unreliable and was barefoot and tenth in the Group 1 Prix d'Amérique at this course over 2700m on 25 January. Others are preferred
- 6. HAPPY DANICA** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class A at this course over 2100m on 7 February. Needs to do plenty more to beat these rivals and is easily overlooked
- 7. JAZZMAN DEBAILLEUL** - Has struggled of late and was 16th in a Group 2 at this track over 2850m on 28 December. Has been struggling all winter and is not worth any consideration
- 8. J'AIME LE FOOT** - Has lost his way and was disqualified last time out at this course over 2700m on 25 January. Should enjoy the rise in trip. Battling to find best form and others are preferred
- 9. IMMORTAL DOC** - Never too far behind and finished 6th in the Group 1 Prix d'Amérique at this track over 2700m on 25 January, Capable of making the frame
- 10. IBIKI DE HOUELLE** - Disqualified last time out at this course over 2700m on 18 January. better under the saddle and not easy to trust. Others are preferred
- 11. FRANK GIO** - Very game and consistent. Finished fourth in the Group 1 Prix d'Amérique at this course over 2700m on 25 January. Tries a lot further this time but is the one to beat
- 12. JUST LOVE YOU** - Put in an improved performance when 5th in the Group 1 Prix d'Amérique at this track over 2700m on 25 January. Can be competitive once again
- 13. HOOKER BERRY** - Disappointing form of late and was 9th in the Group 1 Prix d'Amérique at this course over 2700m on 25 January. Needs to raise his game and others make more appeal
- 14. FRANCESCO ZET** - Usually competitive and was third in the Group 1 Prix de France at this track over 2100m on 8 February. Tries a lot further this time but would not be a surprise winner

**Summary:** FRANK GIO (11) was a good 4th in the Prix d'Amérique and did not enjoy the best of run that day. He is a pure class act and finds here a great opportunity to resume winning ways at the highest level. HARMONY DU RABUTIN (4) was possibly the most unlucky runner in the big race at the end of January and is seeking redemption too. FRANCESCO ZET (14) is a very smart trotter and can make a big splash on his first run over such a long distance. JUST LOVE YOU (12) gave every signs of a return to form in her last run and must be hugely respected too. HE AND ME (2) comes fresh into the race. He is on the upgrade and can be the surprise package at the finish.

1. **COSMEA** - Returned to form and was third in a Group 3 at this track over 2100m on 25 January. Could be the surprise package of the race
2. **OMERTA BOKO** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Group 3 over this course and distance on 18 January. More is needed to beat these rivals
3. **LUDIVINE** - Threatening to win, with three runner-up performances in a row, the latest in Class A over this track and trip on 31 January. Should be right there at the finish again
4. **KEY OF LOVE** - Has shown improvement of late and was runner-up in Class E over this course and distance on 3 February. Tougher task this time around
5. **FELLOW WISE AS** - Has been a bit disappointing of late and was 9th in a Group 1 over this track and trip on 24 January. Capable of being a threat to these rivals
6. **BOSCHA DIABLO** - Did not show his best when 9th in a Group 3 at this track over 2850m on 8 February. Capable of better and could make the frame
7. **BROTHERS IN ARMS** - In good form and was third in a Group 3 at this track over 2850m on 8 February. Has a place chance in this line-up
8. **CAVIAR FROM MINE** - Victorious in Class A at this track over 2850m on 3 January. Very consistent and could contest the finish
9. **KIKA JOSSELYN** - A winner of two of her last three starts, the latest in a Group 3 at this track over 2850m on 8 February. Can win again
10. **LEMON TREE** - Unreliable and was 9th in a Group 2 over this track and trip on 8 February. Others make more appeal in this line-up
11. **KUIPER** - Disqualified last time out at this track over 2850m on 8 February. Capable of earning some money when smart
12. **LITTLE BROWN** - Unreliable but was barefoot and third in a Group 3 over this course and distance on 18 January. Might play a minor role
13. **LORD DU GERS** - Not reliable and finished 8th in a Group 1 over this course and distance on 24 January. Quite capable of contesting the finish
14. **KELLE BEAUTE** - In good shape and was runner-up in a Group 3 at this course over 2850m on 8 February. Can be competitive once again
15. **KAYA DREAM** - Off form and finished 9th in a Group 1 over this course and distance on 24 January. Needs to find a few lengths to win

- 1. JACARANDA** - Fluffed his lines with a disqualification last time out at this track over 2850m on 7 February. A winner of his previous 7 starts and can bounce back to score
- 2. GADGET DU GADE** - Off form and finished 12th in a Class B mounted race at this course over 2850m on 17 December. Others are much preferred
- 3. JASON GINYU** - Holding form and was not disgraced when 5th in a Class B harness race over this course and distance on 13 February. Just as good under the saddle and is not out of it
- 4. IVANOF** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a Class B mounted race at this course over 2850m on 7 February. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 5. ILTON ROYAL** - Only fair of late and finished 5th in a Class B mounted race at this course over 2850m on 7 February. Can earn some minor money
- 6. HANNAH** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in a Class B mounted race at this track over 2850m on 7 February. Capable of making the frame

JASON GINYU (3) is usually competitive and will be back in a mounted race. He is clearly not out of it over this course and distance.

- 1. NINEPOINTS LASSE** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a Group 3 over this course and distance on 25 January. Quite capable of being competitive in this line-up
- 2. ICARE DU BERYL** - In good shape and was runner-up in class C at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 26 January. Might need to do more to beat these rivals
- 3. COMBAT FIGHTER** - Not disgraced when 6th in class B at this course over 2700m on 13 February. Better this shorter distance and could contest the finish
- 4. CHITCHAT** - Victorious in class B at this track over 2700m on 13 February. Continues to win his races and can add another win to the tally
- 5. JESON BOY** - Unreliable but was 4th in class C at this course over 2700m on 17 January. Has a place chance if in the right mood
- 6. HIGH PROPULSION** - Has some fair form and finished 4th in class B at this track over 2700m on 6 February when barefoot. Not this time but might play a minor role

**Summary:** CHITCHAT (4) has built up an impressive three wins in a row with this driver. He has every chance of extending his winning streak. COMBAT FIGHTER (3) is better than his last run would suggest and can contest the finish dropped in distance this time around. NINEPOINTS LASSE (1) was not disgraced in a Group 3 last time out and is a lively threat. CHESTNUT (SWE) (10) is another that is quite capable of being successful when in the right frame of mind.

- 1. MAYA D'AVRIL** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class D over this track and trip on 16 February. Capable of making the frame when staying on the trot
- 2. MANOU DU CHENE** - Off form and was 10th in class C at this track over 2175m on 10 February. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 3. MANHATTAN FRANCE** - Consistent and was 3rd in class D at this track over 2850m on 29 January. Capable of earning some minor money at very best
- 4. MYSTIC DES FORGES** - Successful in class D over this course and distance on 1 February. Has shown improvement and is capable of making the frame
- 5. MESSINA** - Finished 14th in class C at this course over 2175m on 10 October. Returns from a break and is likely to need this run
- 6. MYRTILLE MARBOULA** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in class B over this track and trip on 12 December. Does need to find a few lengths to score

- 1. MILLE MERCIS** - Holding form and finished 4th in class D over this track and trip on 30 October. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 2. MARABOU DODVILLE** - Finished 5th in class D over this track and trip on 26 December. Probably need to do more to beat these rivals
- 3. MAESTRO D'AVEL** - Barefoot and successful in class E at this course over 2200m on 13 February. Continues to improve and can follow up
- 4. MERCURE D'ELLE** - Disqualified in class D at this track over 2100m on 6 February. Unlucky that day and can bounce back to score
- 5. MYTHIQUE JOSSELYN** - Disqualified in class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 15 February. Has major disqualification issues and others make more appeal
- 6. MAGIC FRIENDS** - In good shape and was 4th in class D over this course and distance on 31 January. Can get involved with the finish
