R4 AGEN LA GARENNE [R-H]

**C1 - PRIX DE FOULAYRONNES - 2575m (a1m1/2) - Class G Amateur
Drivers - Harness - EUR € 6,000**

- 1. HELTER SKELTER** - Only modest this year and finished 9th in Class G at Auch over 2800m on 21 February. Capable of doing better but others make more appeal
- 2. INGLORIOUS** - Finished 8th in Class G at Cordemais over 2825m on 14 December. Returns from a break and could make the frame
- 3. HADRIEN MERITE** - Has major disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 18 March. Probably best watched for now
- 4. INVECTUS JELOCA** - Did not show his best when unplaced in Class F at Laval over 2850m on 18 February. Capable of better and has claims in this line-up
- 5. IPANO STAR** - Showed some improvement when fourth in Class F at Bagnoles-de-l'Orne over 2850m on 31 August. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 6. JUNTA DES THIRONS** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in Class G over this course and distance on 1 March. Can go one better this time
- 7. ICARE DE BANVILLE** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in Class G at Auch over 2800m on 21 February. Could earn some minor money
- 8. HAMBRIN D'ARANAU** - Battling to find best form and finished 6th in Class G at this track over 2625m on 1 March. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 9. JADIS PRIOR** - Consistent and was runner-up in a Class F mounted race at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 2 September. Could need this run returning from a break
- 10. JOYEUSE SMART** - Has disqualification issues and finished 8th in Class G at Auch over 2800m on 8 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 11. JOURNEE A LA GRAVE** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class G over this track and trip on 1 March. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 12. JEU ROYAL** - In good form and was successful again in Class G over this course and distance on 1 March. Quite capable of following up in this line-up
- 13. HAVANO DU THAY** - On a long losing run but was not disgraced when 5th in Class G over this course and distance on 1 February. Might play a minor role
- 14. JAGUAR D'AIMTE** - Unreliable and finished 6th in Class F at Castelsarrasin over 2375m on 19 October. Returns from a break but might play a minor role at best

Summary: JEU ROYAL (12) was an easy winner over this track and trip at the beginning of the month and has a big chance of doubling up. JUNTA DES THIRONS (6) was a fast-finishing runner-up behind that rival that day. She is not as reliable as the selection but should be a threat. INVECTUS JELOCA (4) is better than what he showed last month at Laval and can contest the finish. INGLORIOUS (2) returns from a break but is not out of it on best form.

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**C2 - PRIX D'ASTAFFORT - 2625m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Mounted - EUR €
27,000**

- 1. JASMINE DE LYONS** - Not reliable but was fourth in a Class F mounted race at Bihorel-lès-Rouen over 2500m on 15 March. Might play a minor role at best
- 2. JAMAICA SPORT** - Just needed the last run when 5th in a Class G harness race at Toulouse over 2950m on 13 March. Barefoot this time and is not out of it
- 3. IMPEC DE BERTRANGE** - Usually competitive and was not disgraced when 5th in a Class G harness race at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 18 March. Can make the frame
- 4. KOUROUKA BLUE** - Not reliable but was not disgraced when 5th in a Class F mounted race at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 9 March. Can be a threat to these rivals
- 5. KIKO DU VIGNAC** - Did not show his best when 11th in a Class F harness race at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 7 March. Barefoot and can bounce back to score in a mounted race
- 6. JEAN DES GLENAN** - Disqualified last time out in a harness race at Castillonès over 2450m on 8 March. Barefoot this time and could be a threa
- 7. CLICK STARLIGHT** - Returned from a break and was successful in a Class D mounted race at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 8 March. Quite capable of following up
- 8. GO FOR BELLAY** - Finished 8th last time out in a Class F mounted race at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 22 October. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 9. JIRI PACHA** - Broke a long losing run when scoring in a Class F mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 2 March. Can make the frame

Summary: A very competitive-looking race. CLICK STARLIGHT (7) returned from a break and was a solid winner at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat earlier this month, and that sets the standard for the race. JIRI PACHA (9) was successful at Caen in a confidence-boosting win, but this does look a bit tougher. KIKO DU VIGNAC (5) is unbeaten under the saddle, and his last run is best ignored. KOUROUKA BLUE (4) is not reliable but is another to consider.

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C3 - PRIX MOLINIE BOISSONS - 2575m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. NORTON DU GOSIER** - Improving and was victorious in Class F at Toulouse over 2325m on 27 February. Can double up
- 2. NOBLE AVENUE** - Improved with each run and was runner-up in Class D over 2625m on 21 September. Returns from a break but is not out of it
- 3. NARRETEPAS GIO** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 7 March. Capable of earning money when staying in stride
- 4. NINO DE LARRE** - Disqualified twice in four starts, including last time out at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 12 March. Can earn some money when smart
- 5. NEZHA DU PATURAL** - In good shape and was runner-up in Class E over this course and distance on 3 March. Can be competitive again
- 6. NOBEL SPEED** - Did all that was asked of him when scoring on debut in Class F at Chartres over 2300m on 1 March. Capable of doubling up
- 7. NASON** - Showed some improvement and was runner-up in Class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 13 March. Can contest the finish
- 8. NUCERA BELLA** - Consistent and finished third in Class E over this track and trip on 3 March. Can make the frame again
- 9. NICOS DE JANEIRO** - Has run well in both starts, the latest when runner-up in Class D at Auch over 2800m on 8 March. Can be competitive once more
- 10. NIGHT DE BANVILLE** - Unreliable but did finish fourth in Class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 13 March. Has disqualification issues but can earn some money when smart
- 11. NEO KNIGHT** - Disqualified last time out over this track and trip on 3 March. Did win on debut and is a threat if staying in stride
- 12. NEW LOOK SENOVILLE** - Showed promise on debut when runner-up in Class F at Reims over 2550m on 1 March. Can go one better this time

Summary: An open-looking race. NOBEL SPEED (6) looked good when winning on debut but will need to show he is as effective going right-handed this time. NEW LOOK SENOVILLE (12) was narrowly beaten on debut and should fight out the finish once again. NEO KNIGHT (11) had more to give when faulting last time out and was a debut winner before that, so must be respected. NINO DE LARRE (4) has disqualification issues but is capable of making the frame.

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C4 - PRIX DE SERIGNAC-SUR-GARONNE - 2575m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 18,000

- 1. MARQUIS DE NUIT** - Not disgraced when barefoot and 5th in Class E at Toulouse over 2150m on 30 January. Can get involved in the finish
- 2. MOZART TURGOT** - Finished third in Class E at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 19 December. Barefoot for the first time and can score
- 3. MARIUS DES TOURS** - Consistent and finished fourth in a Class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2175m on 14 May. Returns from a lengthy break but is not out of it
- 4. MENTHE A L'EAU** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 7 February. Could earn some minor money
- 5. MAC VENESI** - Yet to win a race and was disqualified last time out at this track over 2625m on 3 March. Capable of doing better and can make the frme
- 6. MALICE D'ATOUT** - Unbeaten in two starts this year, the latest in Class F at Castillonnès over 2450m on 8 March. Remains barefppt and can complete a hat-trick
- 7. MACH DELALANDE** - Yet to win a race but did show improvement when barefoot and third in Class E over this track and trip on 14 February. Might play a minor role
- 8. MENTEUSE PAN** - In good shape and finished third in Class E at Toulouse over 2150m on 30 January. Has claims in this line-up
- 9. MICKEY DE VIVOIN** - Finished 9th in Class E at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 19 December. Needs major improvement to win
- 10. MAVERICK DE VIETTE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Auch over 2800m on 8 March. Others are much preferred
- 11. MOON DE LA COTE** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class E at this course over 2625m on 3 March. Needs to do a bit more this time
- 12. MUDGE CREEK** - Did not show his best when 7th in Class E at this course over 2625m on 3 March. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 13. MANHATTAN DUEM** - Has improved of late and was victorious in Class G at Auch over 2250m on 21 February. Tougher task this time but is not out of it
- 14. MONTSECRET** - Unreliable and finished 6th in Class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 27 February. Might play a minor role at best

Summary: A very open race, and only a few can safely be ruled out from winning. MOZART TURGOT (2) will be racing barefoot for the very first time, so could be ready for a winning turn. MARIUS DES TOURS (3) is barefoot returning from a lengthy break, so must be respected for that, and he is talented. MALICE D'ATOUT (6) is unbeaten this year, and both wins were achieved when barefoot, so is clearly not out of it. MAC VENESI (5) has yet to win a race but can earn some money

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**C5 - PRIX DE CAUZAC - 2575m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR €
24,000**

- 1. LELLAMIKA** - In good shape and was runner-up in class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 7 March. Can be competitive once again
- 2. LA MOME BEAUFOUR** - Undefeated in two starts this year, the latest when barefoot in Class E at this course over 2625m on 9 February. Not barefoot this time but is not out of it
- 3. LANCELOT ELLIS** - Not reliable and was 6th in class E at Castillones over 2450m on 8 March. Victorious back in January but others are preferred this time
- 4. LEKEVIN DESBOIS** - Holding form and was 4th at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 7 March. Should contest the finish once again
- 5. LIBERTINE ECAJEUL** - Has some fair form and finished 4th in class E at Castillones over 2450m on 8 March. Might play a minor role at very best
- 6. LOOK DES ECUS** - Victorious in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 3 March when barefoot. Not fully barefoot this time but is capable of scoring
- 7. LE CARAT D'AS** - Disqualified in class E at Castillones over 2450m on 8 March. On a long losing run and others make more appeal
- 8. LINGUIST D'HERIPRE** - Battling to find best form and finished 6th in class E at Caen over 2450m on 9 March. On a long losing streak and needs to improve to score
- 9. LIBERTANGO** - Successful in Class F at this track over 2625m on 1 March. Keeps that shoeing and has claims once again
- 10. LE PRINCE** - Needed the last run when 10th in class F Caen over 2200m on 12 March. Has disqualification issues and is best watched for now
- 11. LOUXOR BOCAIN** - Returned from a break and was 3rd in Class F at Auch over 2800m on 8 March. Fitter this time and has a place chance in this line-up
- 12. LUZ DES CHARENTES** - Not disgraced when 5th in class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 30 January. Might earn some minor money once again

Summary: A very open-looking race. LOOK DES ECUS (6) was a good winner at Cagnes-sur-Mer early this month but is not fully barefoot this time around. LEKEVIN DESBOIS (4) is consistent and is likely to fight out the finish yet again. LIBERTANGO (9) has a very good record at this course and can follow up on a solid last win. LA MOME BEAUFOUR (2) has won both her starts this year but is not racing barefoot this time.

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C6 - PRIX DE SAINT NICOLAS DE LA BALERME - 2625m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. KIWI D'AUVRECY** - Disqualified in class F at Agon-Coutainville over 2200m on 31 August. Has major disqualification issues and is best watched for now
- 2. KANSAS LEMAN** - Unreliable and finished 5th in class F at Villeneuve-sur-lot over 2650m on 31 August when barefoot. Not this time and is likely to need this run returning from a break
- 3. KILLY D'IRATY** - Not reliable but was 4th in a claimer at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2875m on 14 March. On a long losing streak and others are preferred
- 4. KILL BILL MARGOT** - Only modest of late and was 7th in class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 1 March when barefoot. Not this time and others make more appeal
- 5. KING GATE** - Needed the last run when 8th in class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 7 March. Fitter this time but others make more appeal
- 6. KENZO DE LA CRIERE** - Has shown improvement this year and was 3rd in class F at this course over 2625m on 1 March. Can earn some more money
- 7. KALITA DU PADOUENG** - Unreliable and finished 8th in class G at this course over 2625m on 1 March. Might play a minor role at very best
- 8. KALINE D'ARDENNES** - Has shown improvement this year and was 3rd in a claimer at Montauban over 2400m on 23 February. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 9. KILLER DE MILLAC** - Knocking at the door and was runner-up in class G at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 16 November. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 10. KINAYA DU CHATELET** - Victorious in Class F at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 25 January when barefoot. Has won three of her last five starts but is not barefoot this time. Others are preferred
- 11. KRISTOBAL** - Disqualified in class E at this track over 2050m on 9 February. Victorious back in January and is better this distance. Has a place chance
- 12. KEYS** - In good shape and was 3rd in class E at this course over 2050m on 9 February. Can be competitive once again
- 13. KAPTA JELOCA** - A winner of four of last five starts, the latest in Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 7 March. Can strike another victory
- 14. KEOPS TILLAYE** - Not reliable and was 9th in class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 26 February. On a long losing run but can contest the finish
- 15. KSAR BLUE BOCAIN** - Needed the last run when 10th in class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 7 March. Fitter this time but others are preferred
- 16. KEONA DELALANDE** - Faulted last time out in class E at Marseille-Vivieux over 2650m on 13 February. In good form before that and has claims when smart

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Summary: KAPTA JELOCA (13) has struck form for Charles Bouview. Her wins have been impressive of late, and she sets a decent standard for the race. KEOPS TILLAYE (14) chased that rival home a few starts ago and is clearly better than his last run would suggest. KEONA DELALANDE (16) had more to give when faulting last time out, so could be a threat if smart this time. KEYS (12) was third behind KAPTA JELOCA (13) and can be a danger to these rivals.

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C7 - PRIX DE LAFOX - 2575m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 30,000

- 1. IMHOTEP BUROIS** - Unreliable and was 4th in class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 7 March. Capable of an upset on best form
- 2. HEPICETOU** - Off form and finished 9th in class F over this track and trip on 1 March. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 3. JANTARA DESBOIS** - In good shape and was runner-up in class E mounted race at this track over 2625m on 14 February when barefoot. Better under the saddle and others are preferred
- 4. KING DRY** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 8 March. Remains barefoot and can earn some money
- 5. HO MEDOCAIN** - Not reliable but was 5th in class F at Castelsarrasin over 2375m on 9 November. Remains barefoot but could need this run returning from a break
- 6. ILOU FIRST RICHER** - Has disqualification issues but was 3rd in class E at Toulouse over 2950m on 27 February. Has shown improvement and has a place chance
- 7. ITONO DE MILLAC** - In good form and was runner-up in class F at Reims over 2550m on 14 March. Should fight out the finish
- 8. JOGGER KILY** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class E at Toulouse over 2950m on 27 February. Remains barefoot and was unlucky last time. Has a chance
- 9. DUNA DI GIRIFALCO** - Not reliable but was 5th in class A at this track over 2625m on 3 March. Can be a threat in this line-up
- 10. HARCOURT DE PADD** - Battling to find best form and was 6th in class F over this course and distance on 1 March. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 11. ECLIPSE GAR** - Unreliable but was runner-up in class D at Enghien over 2150m on 6 March when barefoot. Can go one better
- 12. JEU INTERDIT** - Not reliable but was runner-up in class D at Toulouse over 2950m on 30 January. Can go one place better

Summary: ECLIPSE GAR (11) raced three wide last time out and only found one better on the day. He can certainly go one better this time around if in the same mood. JOGGER KILY (8) was unlucky last time out, and that disqualification is easily ignored. He can be a serious challenger if smart. ITONO DE MILLAC (7) remains in good shape and would not be a surprise winner. DUNA DI GIRIFALCO (9) is unreliable but could also contest the finish.

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C8 - GRAND PRIX BARON D'ARDEUIL AOC BUZET - 2625m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 30,000

- 1. JULIEN SENSEI** - Not reliable and was 8th in class E at Enghien over 2875m on 6 March. Victorious back in February and can bounce back to score
- 2. DUBLIN FI** - Finished 5th in class E at Enghien over 2875m on 8 October. Victorious in September when barefoot but could need this run returning from a break
- 3. ENJOY (HUN)** - A trotter from Hungary. Makes his French debut barefoot and could get involved with the finish for Matthieu Abrivard
- 4. JALISCO DE NEUVY** - Unreliable but was runner-up in class G at Castillonnes over 2450m on 8 March when barefoot. Can earn some more money
- 5. KIKI** - Disqualified in class D at Toulouse over 2150m on 19 February. Fitter this time and is capable of making the frame
- 6. INFATIGABLE** - Only modest of late and finished 6th at Toulouse over 2950m on 27 February. On a long losing streak and more is needed to beat these rivals
- 7. ISPAHAN TEAM** - Needed the last run when 8th at Toulouse over 2950m on 7 February. Fitter this time but others make more appeal
- 8. KAPORAL CARISAIE** - Victorious three times in a row, the latest in Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 7 March. Can add another win to the tally
- 9. IMPERIAL RYLD** - In good form and finished 3rd at Toulouse over 2950m on 27 February. Could play a minor role at very best
- 10. ILLYTRASS** - Finished 3rd in class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 19 October. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 11. INDIGO PLANCHETTE** - Did not show his best when 9th in class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2050m on 9 March. Capable of doing better and has a place chance
- 12. ITALO DUEM** - Finished 10th in class E at Toulouse over 2950m on 7 February. Off form and needs major improvement to score
- 13. KOTKIE** - Did not show her best when 7th in class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 18 January. Capable of doing better and is not out of it
- 14. VALLATONIAN** - Successful twice in a row, the latest in Class D at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 6 March. Capable of completing the treble

Summary: A very interesting lucky last race. JULIEN SENSEI (1) is best judged on his win at Vincennes in his penultimate start and gets a very narrow vote to score. VALLATONIAN (14) is looking for a hat-trick and will not go down easily. ENJOY (HUN) (3) has impressive form in Hungary and could be a real threat for Matthieu Abrivard. KAPORAL CARISAIE (8) has won his last three starts and is another that could shine brightly.
