## R3 CAEN [R-H]

**C1 - PRIX DE MONTGAROULT - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Mounted  
- EUR € 21,000**

- 1. L'OURS** - Anthony Perrin-trained Amiral Sacha gelding/newcomer to be ridden on debut by Marius Durville. For another day
- 2. LUCKY CHUCKY** - Panache de l'Iton newcomer from the stable of Nils Pacha, who also rides this gelding on debut. Watch for now
- 3. L'AMOUR DU PONT** - Disqualified on debut in a 2950m mounted race at Saint-Malo on 14 April. Can improve but is best watched for now
- 4. LABEL DE TILLARD** - Was disqualified in a mounted race at Enghien on debut before finishing a well-beaten 8th in a 2800m harness race at Chartres on 31 March. Hard to recommend
- 5. LAIOS DU GOUTIER** - Didn't go unnoticed on debut, despite his disqualification over 2200m at Vincennes on 9 April. Worthy another chance
- 6. LATINO BEJI** - Disqualified in a course-and-distance mounted race on debut and made little impression (7th) in a 2350m harness race at Angers on 3 April
- 7. LUCIFER D'ORPHEE** - Acquitted himself well (6th) on debut in a harness race but switches to the mounted code now after a recent disqualification in that category at Pontchateau on 8 April
- 8. LOOK DES ECUS** - Disqualified in all 3 outings in the harness code (including his latest at Royan-Atlantique on 7 April) but finished 6th over course and distance in his only start under the saddle - dark horse
- 9. LOOK DE LA COTE** - Improved from his debut disqualification in a harness race over this track and trip to finish 5th over 2350m at Angers on 3 April. Warrants in his first start under the saddle
- 10. L'AS DES VENTES** - Disqualified once and unplaced twice in 3 harness races - the latest (6th) over 2400m at Amiens on 13 April - but finished a creditable 5th over track and trip in his only outing in this code
- 11. LOUXOR DE JOUB** - Has maintained a consistent/competitive level of form in 3 three appearances under the saddle. Improved in this shoeing configuration to finish 3rd on his reappearance over 2950m at Saint-Malo on 14 April
- 12. LOVE CHASER** - Improved under the saddle to finish 4th then 3rd in consecutive course-and-distance outings (in this shoeing configuration) last month. Can redeem himself after a recent disqualification (shod) at Ecommoy on 31 March
- 13. LE CADOR DE SIMM** - Delicate but is undeniably capable of playing a leading role in a race of this nature, if avoiding disqualification. Finished an encouraging 4th in a 2200m mounted race at Vincennes last time (9 April)

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**14. LAUREL LA RAVELLE** - A tricky customer but has performed well in the harness category when applied/remaining wise, although was disqualified in a 2575m harness race at Saint-Brieuc on 26 March. Could have more to offer under the saddle

**Summary:** LAIOS DU GOUTIER (5) didn't go unnoticed on debut, despite his disqualification, and ought to have improved with the benefit of that experience. On that evidence, he could be worth siding with in a race of this nature. LAUREL LA RAVELLE (14) showed enough in the harness category to suggest that he, too, could fight for victory in his first start under the saddle. LUCIFER D'ORPHEE (7) also has the means to play a leading role but remains delicate. LOUXOR DE JOUB (11) and LOVE CHASER (12) complete the shortlist.

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## C2 - PRIX DE BENOUILLE - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. LYNDA CASTEL** - Showed little in 4 Vincennes appearances (disqualified and unplaced twice each) but capitalised on the drop in class to open her account at Ecommoy over 2750m on 1 April. Confirmation awaited
- 2. LANKA** - Failed to confirm the improvement of her previous outing (4th) in this shoeing configuration when disqualified over 2550m at Reims on 17 April. Shouldn't be hastily condemned with Eric Raffin engaged from the front row
- 3. LYRA POTERIE** - Consistent for the most part and seldom finishes far off the mark when applied/remaining wise, although was disqualified last time over 2850m at Vincennes on 22 March. Needs to reaffirm
- 4. LUBIE D'URZY** - Debut winner at Le Mont-Saint-Michel on 10 March but failed to confirm that promise when disqualified over 2200m at Pontchateau three weeks later (31 March). Can't be written off, especially back on a right-hand track
- 5. LUNABELLA D'OMAHA** - Justified favoritism when winning on debut over 2725m at Lisieux on 14 April. Should have more to offer, with the benefit of that experience, and is ideally positioned behind the autostart - her progress is worth following
- 6. LOUISIANE** - Showed promise by finishing 4th in consecutive 2850m outings at Mauquenchy and Laval before an improved last-start 2nd at Pontchateau over 2200m on 31 March. Ought to make her presence felt here
- 7. LOYALE DAIRPET** - Consistent filly with sound references/form credentials, which include an encouraging 4th on her reappearance over 2800m at Argentan on 15 April. Dark horse
- 8. LAGUNE** - Failed to justify favouritism when disqualified on debut (Le Mont-Saint-Michel) but made amends/redeemed herself by winning subsequently at Amiens over 2400m on 6 April. Warrants respect
- 9. LADY DU POMMEREUX** - Finished 3rd in consecutive starts but fluffed her lines in back-to-back subsequent outings before getting back on track with a reassuring 2nd over 2600m at Nancy on 30 March. Confirmation required
- 10. LORENE LA RAVELLE** - Won over 2700m at Graignes in her third start but finished unplaced in her other 4 outings, although seldom far off the mark. Was 5th over 2200m at Pontchateau on 31 March, improvement needed
- 11. LORCANTA** - Disqualified in both outings, the latest over 2650m at Bordeaux on 15 April, so is hard to make a case for. Others preferred
- 12. LUTTE DU LOGIS** - Winner on debut over 2625m at Cherbourg but at fault (disqualified) shortly after the start in both subsequent outings - the latest at Laval over 2850m. This will be a question of wisdom
- 13. LAGUNE PIYA** - Confirmed the promise she showed during qualification by winning on debut over 2100m at Cholet on 1 April and would've gained from that experience. Candidate for success
- 14. L'ETOILE DE GINAI** - Didn't go unnoticed when finishing 6th on debut at Cabourg last year but was disqualified on her reappearance at Lisieux on 14 April. Open to improvement

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**Summary:** There are several sorts in the lineup, though it could pay to follow the progress of easy debut winner LUNABELLA D'OMAHA (5) who is ideally positioned behind the autostart, whereas LAGUNE PIYA (13), herself a winner on debut, starts on the second row together with LAGUNE (8), another last-start winner with an awkward starting berth. LUBIE D'URZY (4) and LYNDA CASTEL (1) appeal most of the remainder.

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## C3 - PRIX D'ARROMANCHES - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Mounted - EUR € 18,500

- 1. KIF DES PLANS** - Disqualified in both outings in the harness category so is hard to recommend in his first start under the saddle. Watch for now
- 2. KILLER POINT** - Sanctioned in both appearances in the harness category and was disqualified again on his debut in the mounted code. Others preferred
- 3. KING CROWN** - Sanctioned on debut in a 2400m harness race at Amiens on 13 April. Can improve under the saddle but is best watched for now
- 4. KRUNCH DE L'ITON** - Showed little in two starts in the harness category and has done likewise in four outings under the saddle. Was soundly beaten at Dozulé on 9 August
- 5. KASH DE LA COTE** - Disqualified in seven of his eight appearances, including his latest in a mounted race over 2700m at Machecoul on 24 March. Keep an eye
- 6. KAPORAL CARISAIE** - Finished 2nd on debut in a harness race but failed to confirm that promise when disqualified over 2600m at Blain-Bouvron-Le Gâvre 13 April. One to note in his first start under the saddle
- 7. KHEOPS LA VALLEE** - Runner-up under the saddle on debut over 2950m at Saint-Malo on 14 April. Ought to make his presence felt
- 8. KHALIF DEL PHEDO** - Delicate but has performed well under the saddle when avoiding disqualification, though is seldom far from a fault - was sanctioned on his reappearance at Durtal on 24 March
- 9. KENNETH DU CLOS** - Delicate but is not devoid of ability - usually acquits himself competitively when avoiding disqualification. Was sanctioned in his most recent outing at Pontchâteau on 31 March. Keep safe
- 10. KABOTIN CHENEVIERE** - Consistent for most part and seldom far off the mark in the harness category - didn't go unnoticed when 5th at Chartres over 2800m on 14 April. Not taken lightly on his debut in the mounted code
- 11. KATHEO WINDER** - Versatile sort with references in both trotting disciplines. Has regained momentum after two comeback outings which include a last-start 8th over 2950m at Saint-Malo on 14 April
- 12. KENOBI D'HERFRAIE** - Delicate but has performed well when avoiding disqualification - finished 3rd under the saddle at Vincennes in May last year. Sanctioned in his last start over track and trip on 21 March
- 13. KANOIS DE LATOUR** - Progressive trotter who has made giant strides under the saddle in this shoeing configuration (barefoot). Won his second successive start at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 14 April
- 14. KAPORAL GAME** - Improving last-start winner who opened his account over 2750m at Cabourg on 18 December. Respected on his reappearance
- 15. KARACHO** - Delicate and seldom far from a fault in the harness category. Hard to make a case for after finishing a modest 9th over 2625m at Cherbourg on 1 April

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**Summary:** KANOIS DE LATOUR (13) is at the top of his game and can take this jump in class in his stride to complete the hat-trick, although he will be tested by returning KAPORAL GAME (14), who looks destined for bigger and better things later this campaign. KENNETH DU CLOS (9), especially with Benjamin Rochard aboard, is delicate but has the means to pose a threat if avoiding disqualification. KHALIF DEL PHEDO (8) could also get into the picture if remaining wise throughout.

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## C4 - PRIX DE CANTELOUP - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. **KAIPIRINHA** - Showed promise early in her career with this shoe fitting (shod). Reappears with her irons after a creditable 6th (barefoot) at Saumur over 3250m on 6 April
2. **KAMILLA FRANCE** - Inconsistent but certainly not incapable of getting into the picture in a race of this nature after 2 much-needed comeback outings, the latest (9th) over 2800m at Rambouillet on 7 April. Dark horse
3. **KAMA D'EM** - Showed early promise but has lost her form this year, finishing unplaced in both comeback outings - the latest (9th) over 2675m at Le Mont-Saint Michel on 7 April. The booking of Benjamin Rochard is encouraging, though
4. **KETTY KATE** - Delicate and seldom far from a fault - disqualified in both starts last month, the latest at La Capelle over 2750m on 24 March. Question of wisdom
5. **KRISTALE** - Consistent, improving filly who has upped her game and maintained her form/competitiveness in 3 starts with this configuration (barefoot). Finished 5th over 3125m at Angers on 23 March
6. **KALIAH DES LANDES** - Consistent filly with sound references at a lower level, albeit without success (after 11 starts). Finished 3rd over 2825m at Vire on 31 March
7. **KYUSHU** - Unreliable but has the means to stake a claim, if judged on her best references - finished 2nd in this shoe fitting (unshod behind) two starts back. Not disgraced when 6th (shod) over 2675m at Le Mont-Saint Michel on 7 April
8. **KELLY D'ERABLE** - Undefeated in two starts but hasn't been seen since the last of those victories at Saint-Malo on 14 August over 2950m. Smart prospect
9. **KEADYE CASH DU DAN** - Inconsistent but not incapable of getting into the picture in a race of this nature, especially if improving in this configuration (barefoot), which she tries for the first time. Finished 4th over 2700m at Graignes on 14 April
10. **KLEM DU HANOY** - Complicated but is certainly not incapable of staking a claim in a race of this nature - usually competitive when avoiding disqualification and confirmed as much with an encouraging 5th over 2500m at Reims on 8 April
11. **KYRA GIO** - Delicate but not devoid of ability and usually acquits herself well when avoiding disqualification. Sanctioned in her last start on 7 March over 2200m on this course but is capable of redeeming herself with Eric Raffin engaged
12. **KIARA D'ECOTAY** - Delicate and seldom far from a fault but has better references under the saddle, which her last-start success at Reims in a 2550m mounted race on 21 March attests to. Dark horse
13. **KELLY MARY** - Promising filly whose limits are unknown, having revealed potential by winning consecutive outings at Hyeres last year. Absent since her disqualification at Beaumont-de-Lomagne on 11 September - best watched for now
14. **KLASSIKA DIDALO** - Consistent filly with sound references/form credentials, including an encouraging last-start 2nd in this barefoot configuration at Cherbourg on 1 April. Will be a factor

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**15. KALINKA DU GREMAT** - Inconsistent but not incapable of getting into the picture in a race of this nature, even in this shoe fitting (shod). Didn't go unnoticed when finishing 6th in a stronger race/field at Enghien on 26 March

**16. KALEA DREAM** - Delicate filly who won her first two starts but has lost her way since (in 11 subsequent outings). Disqualified in her latest appearance at Enghien over 2875m on 26 March

**17. KATANA** - Inconsistent but seldom finishes far off the mark and is open to improvement trying this shoeing configuration (barefoot) for the first time in her career, Finished 9th over 2100m at Vincennes on 5 April

**18. KIFILE DANICA** - Versatile filly with references in both trotting disciplines, including two victories in the harness category. Hasn't been seen since finishing 9th at Vincennes in a harness race over 2200m on 6 December

**Summary:** Undefeated KELLY D'ERABLE (8) looked a smart prospect in winning both starts last year so is worth siding with to make a winning reappearance and preserve her 100% record. KLASSIKA DIDALO (14) finished a reassuring 2nd in this configuration (barefoot) in her last start time and needs only to confirm that progress to pose a threat. KYRA GIO (11) is better than her recent form suggests and, along with KLEM DU HANOY (10), could also have a role to play. KRISTALE (5) is in good form and physical condition so cannot be underestimated either.

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## C5 - PRIX DE CAUDEBEC - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. JULIANA BREIL** - Has regained momentum after three comeback appearances and confirmed as much with a last-start success over 2875m at Argentan on 28 March. Ought to remain competitive
- 2. JUSTICE D'ORGUEIL** - Delicate but talented mare who usually acquits herself well when avoiding disqualification - 2nd in consecutive starts over 2700m before her recent failure (disqualification) at Reims on 4 April. Candidate for success
- 3. JONQUILLE D'AIMTE** - Unreliable but confirmed in this shoeing configuration (barefoot) with sound references at this level. Regained freshness after finishing 9th over 3125m at Angers on 10 January
- 4. JERSEY BLEUE** - Disqualified over 2500m at Reims on 8 April but is confirmed in this shoe fitting and remarkably placed behind the car with Yoann Lebourgeois engaged. Keep safe
- 5. JABALLA** - Disqualified in a mounted race at Vincennes when last seen on 1 December but is more effective in the harness category. The booking of Franck Nivard, with whom she gets along well, bodes well for her chances
- 6. JANE CASH** - Consistent mare with sound references/form credentials, including an encouraging 4th on her reappearance on this track over 2450m on 21 March. Winning chance
- 7. JOLANA JADOR** - Delicate but certainly not devoid of ability and usually acquits herself competitively when not disqualified. Confirmed as much with a reassuring 4th at Vire over 2825m on 31 March
- 8. JEUNE IMPERATRICE** - Unreliable but is confirmed/effective in this configuration (barefoot). Didn't go unnoticed when finishing 7th in her last start over course and distance on 18 March
- 9. JUSTE PARFAITE** - Complicated but is certainly not incapable of staking a claim in a race of this nature - usually competitive when avoiding disqualification, which she confirmed with a reassuring 2nd over 2725m at Lisieux on 14 April. Beware
- 10. JUNE LATAL** - Inconsistent but certainly not incapable of getting into the picture in a race of this nature after two encouraging comeback outings, the latest (6th) over 2725m at Lisieux on 14 April. Place chance
- 11. JAVA DU PLESSIS** - Honest hard-knocker who seldom finishes far off the mark but rarely wins her races (has 1 win from 34 starts). Didn't go unnoticed last time (6th) at Laval over 2850m on 30 March
- 12. JUST ME BABY** - A tricky customer, seldom far from a fault but is confirmed/effective in this configuration (barefoot). Sanctioned in her last start over 2700m at Graignes on 18 April - needs to reaffirm
- 13. JUDIRA DE HOUELLE** - Consistent, lightly raced mare with sound references/form credentials at this level. Showed signs of a return to form when finishing an encouraging 5th over 2500m at Reims on 8 April
- 14. JABOROSA BLUE** - Last-start winner over 2400m at Amiens on 13 April but is most effective when racing unshod, so best watched for now with her irons refitted

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**15. JOUEUSE MAJYC** - Unreliable and was a well-beaten 13th (shod) over 2950m at Saint-Malo on 14 April. Races barefoot for just the second time in her career

**16. JONCTION HAUFOR** - Delicate mare not devoid of ability and usually acquits herself well when avoiding disqualification. Sanctioned in her last three starts, the latest over 2350m at Angers on 11 April - this is again a question of wisdom with her

**17. JOYEUSE ENTREE** - Inconsistent but seldom finishes far off the mark on a going day and is confirmed/effective in this configuration (unshod behind). Didn't go unnoticed when 8th over 2800m at Carhaix on 7 April

**18. JASMINA DES PRES** - Inconsistent but has references at this level and is seldom far off the mark on a going day - confirmed/effective in this configuration (shod). Failed to confirm the improvement of her previous starts (3rd) when only 11th over 2350m at Angers on 11 April

**Summary:** With a much-needed and encouraging (4th) comeback outing under her belt, JANE CASH (6) appeals most with Eric Raffin engaged from a favourable starting position on the front row. This track profile/layout will, however, suit JUSTICE D'ORGUEIL (2) who can't be judged on her recent faux pas and retains the means to fight for victory. JABALLA (5) gets on well with Franck Nivard and should make her presence felt too. JERSEY BLEUE (4), with Yoann Lebourgeois at the helm, and JULIANA BREIL (1) have legitimate claims of finishing on the podium.

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**C6 - PRIX D'ANGOVILLE - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR  
€ 21,000**

- 1. IGNACE DE BAUBRIE** - Second in a class E at Pontchateau over 2800m on the 31 of March. Improved in the latest effort and can confirm
- 2. INNOCENT ARCTIC** - Unplaced in a class E Mounted event at Argentan over 2875m on the 15 of April. Poor form and unlikely to win
- 3. IROISE DES BAULTS** - Unplaced in a class G at Graignes over 2700m on the 18 of April. Reverts to barefoot and might improve
- 4. IMPEC D'ECOUVES** - Unplaced in a class E at this track over 2200m on the 7 of March. Others are preferred
- 5. IGGY PERRINE** - Fourth last time out in a class E at Chatellaillon-La Rochelle over 2625m on the 24 of March. Remains barefoot and on best form can get involved
- 6. IDEALE D'ARCEY** - Disqualified in a class E at Chartres over 2825m on the 31 of March. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 7. IRMA BABEL** - Disqualified in a class F at La Capelle over 2700m on the 7 of April. Others are preferred in this line-up
- 8. IBILI DE SALTA** - Disqualified in a class F at Amiens over 2400mm on the 6 of April. Trained by Gilles Curens and on his day can be in the shake-up
- 9. INSTIGATEUR** - A runner-up last time out in a class G at Rambouillet over 2800m on the 7 of April. In form and will a chance to claim victory
- 10. ISIS DU LEARD** - Winner in a class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on the 15 of April. Won well recently and deserves to be respected. Remains barefoot
- 11. ITHENA DE GAJUEL** - Disqualified in a class F at La Capelle over 2700m on the 7 of April. Surprise runner-up three runs back
- 12. IBANA DE MONTI** - Finished 6th in a class F at Graignes last time out over 2700m on the 14 of April. Has disqualification issues but on the best efforts can be involved
- 13. IDEO JOSSELYN** - Winner in a class E at this track over 2450m on the 27 of March. Will be looking to make it two in a row. Remains barefoot
- 14. IMPACTS LUDOIS** - Fourth in a class F at Lignieres over 2825m on the 14 of April. Seldom far off them and can play a role
- 15. ILLAM DE MONGOCHY** - Was 9th in a class F Loudeac over 2850m on the 17 of March. Remains barefoot and should be thereabouts
- 16. ITALICA** - Winner in a class F at Amiens over 2900m on the 30 of September 2023. Long break and will probably need the run back

**Summary:** IDEO JOSSELYN (13) is unreliable but he did win well at this track last time out and is quite capable of following up. ISIS DU LEARD (10) is not easy to trust but she did win last time out and is capable of winning again if in the mood. INSTIGATEUR (9) remains in good form and can contest the finish yet again. IGGY PERRINE (5) is unreliable but could also get involved with the finish.

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## C7 - PRIX DE ROTS - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class E Amateur Riders Race - Mounted - EUR € 21,000

**1. INTEL D'OSTAL** - Versatile trotter on his day with sound references under the saddle, especially in this shoeing configuration. For lovers of outsiders

**2. HANNAH DU BERYL** - Disqualified when last seen under the saddle at Nantes in November and was sanctioned on her reappearance in a harness race at Elbeuf on 7 April. Best watched for now

**3. HOLD UP D'ERI** - Delicate individual disqualified in eight of his last nine appearances, including his last start in a 2400m harness race at Amiens on 13 April. Others preferred

**4. IF DU RIB** - Consistent for the most part and is confirmed in this shoeing configuration (shod). Disqualified in consecutive outings last season - the latest over 2700m at Graignes on 30 December. One to note on his reappearance

**5. HORS CADRE** - Inconsistent veteran trotter whose best references have been achieved in the harness category and without his irons - confirmed as much with an encouraging 5th over 2900m at Amiens on 24 February. For another day

**6. HORCHATA** - Unreliable veteran mare, confirmed in this shoeing configuration (barefoot) but has been off the boil for some time now. Finished 7th under the saddle over 3125m at Angers on 11 April - others preferred

**7. IAROSLAVA** - Delicate but talented mare who usually performs well when avoiding disqualification but sanctioned in 3 of 4 starts this year, including consecutive recent outings (the latest at Angers on 3 April). Ought to redeem herself

**8. HANA DES MONTS** - Disqualified in a mounted race over 2800m at Rambouillet on her reappearance on 7 April. Just watch for now

**9. HARIBO DU SURF** - Consistent performer in the mounted category and has sound references/form credentials in this configuration (unshod behind). Didn't go unnoticed when finishing 6th over 2875m at Argentan on 15 April

**10. IVOIRE DU CEDRE** - Reliable type whose effectiveness/competitiveness under the saddle at this level is beyond doubt. Finished an encouraging 4th on his reappearance over 2875m at Argentan on 28 March - high on the shortlist

**11. IPSIE DE LA LUNE** - Hard-knocking, honest mare with references at a higher level in the harness category - finished 9th over 2150m at Mauquenchy on 4 April. Debuting under the saddle but cannot be underestimated

**12. HIPPO DE POMMERAYE** - Consistent and has sound references/form credentials in the harness category, which include two encouraging comeback outings this year - won on his reappearance and finished 3rd at Ecommoy over 2750m on 31 March. Lacks references in the mounted category

**Summary:** Delicate IAROSLAVA (7), with an established apprentice engaged, is undeniably capable of winning a race of this nature if avoiding disqualification. IVOIRE DU CEDRE (10) has proven his competitiveness under the saddle and is likely to fight for victory, along with HARIBO DU SURF (9) after an encouraging reappearance. IPSIE DE LA LUNE (11) and HIPPO DE POMMERAYE (12) are ideally entered at the ceiling of earnings, so are not without a chance either.

- 3. HERNANDO BELLO** - Third in a class F at Saint-Brieuc over 3150m on the 26 of March. Track suited and will have supporters
- 4. GALGA D'ESCRIT** - Was 7th in a class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on the 4 of April. Remains barefoot and probably needed the last start. Can improve
- 5. HORACIO DE CERISY** - Was 6th in a class F at Argentan over 2875m on the 15 of April. Remains barefoot and at best a place chance
- 6. HAVE DREAM BEYLEV** - Finished 5th in a class G at Vincennes over 2100m on the 9 of April. Seldom far off them and can play a role. Reverts to barefoot
- 7. HORTENSIA DE LARRE** - Disqualified in a class E at Strasbourg over 2800m on the 1 of April. Remains barefoot
- 8. HARTEFAX** - Third in a class G at Argentan over 2150m on the 15 of April. Eric Raffin does the assisting and can be involved
- 9. HENRY DE L'ECLAIR** - Winner in a class F at Saint-Brieuc over 3150m on the 26 of March. In form and is fit. Remains barefoot and has sufficient means to fight for the victory
- 10. HELIOS DJEMA** - Winner in a class E at this track over 2450m on the 27 of March. A recent winner that can have success
- 11. GAIA DU CHERISAY** - Finished 6th in a class G at Saint-Malo ov2950m on the 14 of April. Remains barefoot and did place third at this track in the penultimate start
