- **4. LOVE ME AGAIN -** Disqualified last time out at this course on 4 April. Ignore her last run and she is capable of contesting the finish
- **5. LOTTA ROSIE -** Holding form and was third last time out in Class E at Enghien over 2875m on 25 March. Can make the frame
