- **1. KEONA DELALANDE -** Has some fair form of late and as 5th in Class E at Nimes over 2750m on 27 April. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 2. KOUROUKA BLUE Disqualified in her latest start, at Marseille-Borely on 18 April. Much better under the saddle and can bounce back to score
- **3. KAMILLA -** Disqualified in her last four starts, with the latest being at Castillonnès on 27 April. Probably best watched for now
- **4. JEANNETTE LOUISE -** In good form and was barefoot and third in a Class F harness race at Oraison over 2650m on 8 May. Better under the saddle and is not out of it
- **5. JOYAU DE SOYORA -** Disqualified in his last three starts, with the latest being at Graignes on 29 April.Capable of playing a minor role when wise

- **2. MADAME CLAUDE -** Has run well in both starts and was runner-up last time out in Class E at Marseille-Borely over 2400m on 25 April. Should be very competitive once again
- **3. MILOU DE CAZOULENE -** Finished 5th in Class D at Hyeres over 2650m on 1 May. Tougher task this time but could play a minor role
- **4. MELLA DE NESLE -** Unreliable and was fourth in Class D at Hyeres over 2650m on 1 May. Can get involved with the finish again

- **4. GAVROCHE DE L'ITON -** Probably needed his seasonal reappearance when eighth in a Class D at Laval over 2850m on 30 April. Needs major improvement to feature
