- 1. **DOOSTY** Started well in commission last start but could only manage ninth over 2400m at Montauban. Finds the right race this time.
- 2. **FANTASIA DE LIGNY** Was not a factor when resuming last start finishing sixth at Montauban over 2400m and beaten 30 metres. Winning prospect with that run under the belt.
- 3. **FRESNEAUX** Failed to raise backers' hopes when resuming last start finishing fifth at Vichy over 3525m and beaten 30 metres. Open to plenty of improvement.
- 4. **GENTLY DE MUZE** Has been in good recent form including a win by 5.5 metres over 3525m at Vichy last time. Expected to go very well.
- 5. **FAST DOMINO** Won three starts back at this track but hasn't repeated that form since the latest offering a fifth at Vincennes over 2700m beaten 20 metres. Must be included in the main chances.
