

# R4 LE CROISE-LAROCHE [L-H]

**C1 - PRIX DES VACANCES - 1900m (a1m1/4) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 27,000**

- 1. JERRY DU LOISIR** - Disqualified in three of last five starts, including last time out in Class C at Cherbourg over 2625m on 14 June. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 2. LOVELY DU VALLON** - Unreliable and finished 13th in Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 29 May. Might play a minor role at very best
- 3. LOVEBIRD** - In good form and finished third in Class C at Enghien over 2150m on 23 May. Big chance in this line-up
- 4. KID PARKER** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 6 June. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 5. LAURELINA** - Did not show her best when 7th in Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 29 May. In good form before that and is not out of it
- 6. JACKPOT D'ORGUEIL** - Victorious last time out in Class F at la Capelle over 1800m on 8 May. Liked this distance and could follow up
- 7. LARIFLETTE** - Consistent of late and finished fourth in a claimer at Enghien over 2875m on 16 April. Capable of making the frame
- 8. KACEY BELL** - Not reliable and finished 8th in Class F at Vincennes over 2100m on 12 June. Capable of an upset on best form
- 9. LOTUS DE BEYLEV** - Has only been modest of late and finished 8th in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 5 June. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 10. LUNGA DES BROUSSES** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Vincennes over 2700m on 6 June. Capable of earning some minor money when smart
- 11. LETIKALIN** - In good shape and finished third in Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 6 June. Should like this distance and has claims
- 12. LEDZEP** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 8 March. Could need this run returning from a break

**Summary:** Lovebird (3) should be well suited by this trip and is partnered by an in-form driver, makes plenty of appeal. Despite a tricky second-row draw, Letikaline (11) has the required speed figures to mount a serious challenge. Lariflette (7), fitted with all four shoes off for her first start for Dries Kumpen, warrants consideration. Laurelina (5), returning to a shorter trip, also looks to hold some claims.

## C2 - PRIX DE LA PROMENADE - 2825m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 18,000

- 1. MAD MAX BOND** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in Class F at this course over 2700m on 1 June. Can earn some more money
- 2. MORRIS DE REUX** - Not reliable and finished 6th in Class F at Caen over 2200m on 30 May. Ran much better than the result showed that day and could be a threat
- 3. MONOGAME** - In good form and finished third in Class F at Reims over 2500m on 23 April. Capable of making the frame
- 4. MAMBO FIVE OKINA** - Not reliable and finished 6th in Class F at Orleans over 3400m on 7 June. Has already won twice this year and is capable of an upset
- 5. MY SIMON** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out in Class E at Vincennes over 2200m on 14 November. Could need this run returning from a break
- 6. MOONSHINER JOLY** - Not disgraced when fifth in Class F at Amiens over 2900m on 11 June. Should be a threat to these rivals
- 7. MARVIN D'ALGOT** - Showed some improvement when third in Class F at Graignes over 2700m on 30 May. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 8. MANGO DU POMMEREUX** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2650m on 2 June. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 9. MAWENZI** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class F at Le Neubourg over 3000m on 25 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 10. MERALTO** - Usually competitive and was runner-up in Class F at Reims over 2550m on 25 May. Can go one place better
- 11. MIGHTY RUN** - Returned to form with a victory in Class F at Reims over 2550m on 6 June. Hard to trust but is capable of following up
- 12. MIRADOR** - Successful twice in last three starts, including last time out in Class F at Gournay-en-Bray over 2550m on 24 May. Can follow up

**Summary:** A tricky race. There is little to choose between Mirador (12), is narrowly selected following his success at Gournay-en-Bray on 24 May, and Meralto (10), who brings some strong form lines into the contest. Morris de Reux (2), if keeping his action together, has the ability to play a leading role at this level. Mighty Run (11) is held in some regard by Cédric Parys and is another to consider closely.

1. **LITTEE MAMS** - Finished 7th last time out in Class F at laon over 2850m on 28 September. Could need this run returning from a break
2. **LISETTE DE WATOU** - Battling to find best form and was 8th in Class F at Nancy over 2600m on 19 April. Needs to do a bit more to score
3. **LEONA STARRO** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at Waragem over 2960m on 9 June. Hard to trust and others are preferred
4. **LADY DU MIREL** - Showed some improvement when third in Class G at Strasbourg over 2800m on 7 June. Can earn some minor money
5. **L'ELITE DU CHOQUEL** - Has some fair form of late and finished 5th at Waragem over 2960m on 9 June. Capable of making the frame
6. **LUTECE RINGEAT** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in Class H at Châlons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 14 June. Can go one place better
7. **LADY NANIE** - Has major disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Châlons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 14 June. Hard to trust and others are preferred
8. **LIZY DU VIVIER** - Not reliable and finished 9th in Class F at Bernay over 2800m on 31 May. Might need to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
9. **LEGENDE CHENEVIERE** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in Class E at Cherbourg over 2625m on 14 June. Others make more appeal
10. **LADY D'ELFE** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class H at Châlons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 14 June. Has disqualification issues but might play a minor role
11. **LINAYA DU CHATELET** - In good shape and finished third in Class F at this course over 2700m on 1 June. Should fight out the finish
12. **LALOU D'AMOUR** - Not reliable but did finish fourth in Class F at Elbeuf over 2750m on 14 June. Can be a threat to these rivals
13. **LYRA DU METZ** - Unreliable and was disqualified last time out in Class E at Reims over 25f0m on 31 May. Capable of an upset on best form
14. **LUPINE DIESCHOOT** - Finished 9th in a Class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2175m on 3 January. Returns from a break and could need this run
15. **LUCIA DU CHATELET** - Off form and finished 8th in Class E at la Capelle over 1800m on 24 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score

**Summary:** It's a tight call between the tough Lutece Ringeat (6), who is versatile tactically, and Linaya du Châtelet (11), who was only denied in the closing stages on her reappearance here and is sure to go close again. L'Elite du Choquel (5) and Lalou d'Amour (12), both of whom make the trip with serious ambitions. L'ELITE DU CHOQUEL (5) has some fair form but this is a tougher task. LALOU D'AMOUR (12) is unreliable but can shine when in the right mood.

## C4 - PRIX DU TOURISME - 2825m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. **LAZARRO DE LOU** - Finished fourth last time out at Tongres over 2650m on 17 June. Tougher task this time and others make more appeal
2. **LOVER DREAM** - Has struggled of late and was 12th in Class E at Reims over 2550m on 6 June. Needs rto do a bit more to score
3. **LOKI DU CARMA** - Disqualified in five of last six starts, including last time out at Châlons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 8 May. Very hard to trust but could earn some money when smart
4. **LARGO DU PONT** - Disqualified last time out at this course over 2700m on 1 June. Not easy to trust but is capable of making the frame
5. **LOCKDOWN POWER** - Disqualified three times in a row. the latest in a mounted race over this course and distance on 27 April. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
6. **LONE RANGER** - Not disgraced when fourth at Wolvega over 2100m on 6 June. Quite capable of making the frame once again
7. **LOVER DE TAGOR** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Vincennes over 2700m on 23 January 2025. Should need this run after a lengthy break
8. **LOVERMAN D'HERTALS** - Disqualified last time out at Strasbourg over 2800m on 7 June. Very unreliable but might play a minor role
9. **LUCIFER MELOC** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Bernay over 2800m on 31 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
10. **LUTIN DU VAUTOUR** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in Class H at Châlons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 14 June. Needs to do more to beat these riva;s
11. **LEAD ME ON** - Unreliable and finished 11th in Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 11 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score
12. **LOUP SOLITAIRE** - Off form and finished 9th at Savigny-sur-Braye over 3500m on 7 June. Needs major improvement to beat these rivals
13. **LUTIN DE LA BESVRE** - Successful twice in a row, the latest in Class F at this course over 2700m on 1 June. Can complete the hat-trick
14. **LE CHEF** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in Class E at La Capelle over 1800m on 24 may. Better this distance and could be competitive
15. **LAROUS** - Faulted last time out in Class E at Vincennes over 2850m on 12 June. Capable of bouncing back to score

**Summary:** Lutin de la Besvre (13), scored in a notably good time on this track on 1 June, will be looking to follow up and is a confident pick to score. Larous (15), although not fully backing up his winning reappearance on 3 May, still appeals as a player. Lone Ranger (6), faultless this season, tackles this track with solid claims. Le Chef (14), likely primed for this assignment, is also capable of returning to the podium.

1. **KIARA DU SAPTEL** - Off form and was unplaced in class F at Cherbourg over 2550m on 14 June. Needs to find a few lengths to win
2. **KATITZI** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in class F at Vichy over 2950m on 10 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
3. **KAPELLA DRY** - Showed some improvement when 4th in class F at Challons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 14 June. Has claims in this line-up
4. **KALINE D'ERPION** - Disqualified in class F at Elbeuf over 2750m on 7 June. In good form before that and could contest the finish if smart
5. **KLOE D'ARRY** - Finished 7th in class F at Nancy over 2600m on 29 May. Capable of doing better and is not out of it
6. **KISS ME JAMINI** - Finished 7th in class F at Nantes over 3000m on 1 June. Victorious in February and has a chance in a race of this nature
7. **KININE DE MONTCEAU** - Battling to find best form and finished 11th in class F at Nancy over 2600m on 29 May. Makes little appeal
8. **KIARA BLUE** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in Class F at Cherbourg over 2550m on 14 June. Needs to do a lot more to beat these rivals
9. **KESA DES THIRONS** - Disqualified in class F at Elbeuf over 2750m on 14 June. Battling to find best form and others make more appeal
10. **KEROZIA DE REM** - Disqualified in class F at Elbeuf over 2750m on 14 June. Has needed both runs this year and could be the surprise package of the race
11. **KERIA FLEURY** - Has struggled of late and finished 13th in class E at Vichy over 2800m on 4 May. Capable of being a threat at this course
12. **KEEP THE FAITH** - Victorious at Mons over 2300m on 26 May. Has shown improvement of late and can contest the finish once again
13. **KAVALE DU CHATELET** - Disqualified in class G at Chartres over 2825m on 17 June. Battling to find best form and others make more appeal
14. **KLARISSA** - Unreliable and finished 9th in class E at La Capelle over 2750m on 14 June. Others are much preferred
15. **KOQUETTE LIRE** - Has really struggled of late and was unplaced in Class E at La Capelle over 2750m on 14 June. Has major disqualification issues and is best watched for now
16. **KETTINA DU CYGNE** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in Class F at Cherbourg over 2550m on 14 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score

**Summary:** Kapella Dry (3), after two runs to sharpen her fitness and now facing mares only, could win a very open race. Kaline d'Erpion (4) was likely below par last time at Saint-Aubin-lès-Elbeuf but is expected to bounce back quickly and be a threat. Well placed on the front line, Kiss Me Jamini (6) and Kloe d'Arry (5) also make plenty of appeal but there are many more in this race capable of scoring so caution is advised.

## C6 - PRIX SEA HORSE RANCH - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class F Amateur Riders - Harness - EUR € 19,000

1. **KRACDANCHE** - Returned to form and finished 4th in class F at Cherbourg over 2550m on 14 June. Should fight out the finish once again
2. **KALISTO DU BOURDON** - Has only been modest of late and finished 8th in class F at Cherbourg over 2550m on 14 June. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
3. **KILLY D'IRATY** - Disqualified in class F at Challons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 14 June. In good form before that and can contest the finish if smart
4. **KADOR DELO** - Consistent and finished 4th in class F at Amiens over 2900m on 11 June. Could earn some minor money at very best
5. **KISS ME POLE** - Disqualified in class F at Cherbourg over 2550m on 14 June. Victorious earlier in June and is clearly not out of it
6. **KEVERT** - Showed some improvement when 3rd in class F at Elbeuf over 2750m on 14 June. can be competitive in this line-up
7. **KING DE FOURCHES** - Off form and finished 9th in class E at Chartres over 2825m on 31 May. On a long losing streak and is best watched for now
8. **KASIMODO DREAM** - Victorious in class E at Reims over 2550m on 6 June. Clearly not reliable but is also not out of it in this line-up
9. **KYROC D'ERPION** - Not reliable but was 5th in class F at Laon over 2650m on 7 June. might play a minor role at very best
10. **KERYVON FARM** - Unreliable and finished 5th in class F at Cherbourg over 2550m on 14 June. Needs to do a bit more to score

**Summary:** Partnered by one of the leading apprentices in the current ranks, Kracdarche (1) could be ready to strike again and return to winning ways. The main dangers look to be Kirikou Street (15), who was only denied in the final strides at Laon on 7 June, and Kevert (6), who appears to be back to his best. Guilty of mistakes last time out Kiss Me Pole (5) is capable of being competitive if staying on the trot.

## C7 - PRIX DES KERMESSSES - 2825m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 18,000

- 1. MANTA BUISSONAY** - Has some fair form and was 5th in class F at this course over 2700m on 1 June. Might earn some minor money
- 2. MY FRIEND AND ME** - Disqualified in class F at Cherbourg over 2625m on 14 June. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 3. MAFIA** - in good form and finished third in class F at Laon over 2850m on 7 June. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 4. MAEVA DES PRES** - Victorious in class G at Strassbourg over 2750m on 7 May. Clearly unreliable but also cannot be ruled out
- 5. MY LADY DE CAHOT** - Disqualified five times in a row, the latest in class F at Bernay over 2800m on 31 May. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 6. MILADY DE REUX** - Off form and finished 8th in class F at Laon over 2850m on 7 June. On a long losing streak and others make more appeal
- 7. MADOVA DU RILER** - Not disgraced when 5th in class F at Amiens over 2900m on 11 June. Probably needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 8. MONA LE LOUP** - Not disgraced when 5th in class F at Laon over 2850m on 7 June. Victorious in April and can make the frame
- 9. MILAMONDINA** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in class F at Laval over 2850m on 22 May. Capable of going one place better
- 10. MON ALTESSE** - Very consistent of late and finished 3rd in class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 30 April. Can contest the finish once again
- 11. MAYUMI** - Victorious twice in a row, the latest in class F at Montlucon 3025m on 14 May. Capable of completing the hat-trick
- 12. MA VIE DE HOUELLE** - Unreliable and finished 6th in class F at Rambouillet over 2800m on 14 May. Not easy to trust but can beat these rivals if smart

**Summary:** If able to quickly take the lead and remain sound in her action, Ma Vie de Houelle (12) looks more than capable of going all the way. Mayumi (11), has been in relentless form since being unshod and will be looking to take another step forward in her progression. Mon Altesse (10), already tuned up on her return to action and warrants close attention. Milamondina (9), recently lowered her personal best over 2,850m at Laval and could be a threat.

## C8 - PRIX DE LA DECOUVERTE - 2825m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. NELLY CROWN** - Disqualified on debut, in class F at Saint-Omer over 2625m on 31 May. Capable of improvement but makes little appeal
- 2. NORLANDO** - Threatening to win a race and was runner-up in class F at Reims over 2550m on 6 June. Can go one place better this time
- 3. NOTUS DU COGLAIS** - Disqualified twice in just four starts, including last time out in class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2100m on 9 June. Victorious in May and is not out of it
- 4. NENESSE PECE** - In good form and finished 3rd in class E at Laval over 2850m on 11 June. Should be right there at the finish once again
- 5. NEVER EVER** - Victorious in class F at Alencon over 2650m on 31 May. Improving and must be given some respect in this line-up
- 6. NAPOLITANO D'AWA** - Has some fair form and finished 3rd in class E over this course and distance on 30 May. Yet to win but might earn some more money
- 7. NOTELLA D'OR** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in class D at Vincennes over 2200m on 9 June. Might need to do more to score
- 8. NANS DE FLEUR** - Victorious in class F at Reims over 2550m on 31 May. Has done little wrong so far and can get involved with the finish
- 9. NORTH LIFE** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in class D at Vincennes over 2200m on 9 June. can contest the finish when staying in stride

**Summary:** A very interesting lucky last race. The verdict could well be between Norlando (2), who made an excellent debut here when finishing second, and Nenesse Pece (4), who recently clocked a promising 1'16"2 over a similar trip at Laval. The only runner representing the Lelièvre stable on the card, Never Ever (5) returns to the sand with a solid chance and is preferred to North Life (9), for whom it will once again be a question of staying on the trot.
