# C1 - PRIX DES GLAIEULS - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 29,000

- **1. JOLANA JADOR -** Showed some improvement and was fourth in Class F at Bernay over 2800m on 13 July. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **2. JOSIE DE MIENNAIS -** Unreliable again this year and was tenth in Class F at Genets over 2600m on 13 July. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **3. JOCASTE DAIRPET -** Fluffed her lines with a disqualification last time out at Bernay on 13 July. Unlucky that day and could be a threat if wise
- **4. JOLLY CHIC -** Showed some improvement and was 5th in Class D at Le Mans over 2200m on 15 July. More is needed to win
- **5. IRYSKA LESMELCHEN -** Very unreliable of late and was disqualified last time out at this track on 15 July. Probably best watched for now
- **6. JAZERANE -** Showed some improvement and was barefoot and runner-up in Class F at Châteaubriant over 2300m on 7 July. Remains barefoot and can go one better
- **7. JUSTE PARFAITE -** Did not show her best when 11th in Class F at Châteaubriant over 2300m on 7 July. Best when barefoot but could surprise
- **8. JEEP DE DALINE -** Has struggled this year and was 11th in Class F at Sablé-sur-Sarthe over 2825m on 29 June. Likes this track and could contest the finish
- **9. JUSTICE PROUVEE -** Has some fair form of late and was 5th in Class F at Les Andelys over 2525m on 6 July. Capable of making the frame
- **10. JOYCE D'AVEZE -** Has struggled this year and finished 12th in Class F at Châteaubriant over 2300m on 7 July. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- **11. JOSY DES LANDES -** On a very long losing run but did show improvement when fourth in Class F at Les Andelys over 2525m on 6 July. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **12. JITANE VALLEE -** Remains in good shape and was third in Class D at Argentan over 2875m on 25 May. Can earn some more money
- **13. JOYEUSE ENTREE** Unreliable of late and finished 12th in Class D at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 16 July. Capable of better and has a winning chance
- **14. IDYLLE COPAISE -** Did not show her best when 6th in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 6 February. Returning from a break and could need this run

**Summary:** JAZERANE (6) found only one better on the day when racing barefoot at Châteaubriant and can go one better in this competitive opening event. JOCASTE DAIRPET (3) was unlucky last time out and could be competitive if more focused this time. JEEP DE DALINE (8) is best judged on the form she showed at this track last year and could pose a threat. JUSTICE PROUVEE (9) has been in fair form and is another to consider.

- **2. LAURA SISSI -** Hard to trust and was disqualified last time out at this track on 11 July. Did win twice last year and is capable of an upset when wise
- **3. LAGUNA SECA** Disqualified in her last two starts, with the latest being at this track on 15 July. Won some nice races last year and is not out of it
- **4. LOLLIPOP TIVO -** Has some fair form of late and finished 5th in Class E at Châteaubriant over 2300m on 7 July. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish
- **5. LUNE DU DOUET -** Has struggled of late and was 9th in Class E at Clairefontaine-Deauville over 2900m on 14 July. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **6. LYSANDRA -** Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class E at Vichy over 2950m on 25 June. Did better before that and could play a minor role
- **7. LITTLE DU RIB -** Has some fair form of late and finished 5th in Class E at this track over 2725m on 4 July. Has a place chance in this line-up
- **8. LICORNVERASPERANZA -** Disappointing last run when 8th in Class E at this course over 2725m on 4 July. Capable of better and has a place chance
- **9. LAETITIA MONTVASON -** In good form and was runner-up in Class E at Châteaubriant over 2300m on 7 July. Should be right there at the finish once again
- **10. LOVELY GODIVA -** Showed some improvement and was 7th in Class E at this track over 2725m on 4 July. Barefoot and capable of winning on best form
- **11. LADY DE JANEIRO** Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class E at Vichy over 2950m on 25 June. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **12. LA GUARDIA -** Unreliable but did run well when third in Class D at La Capelle over 2750m on 20 June. Could play a minor role
- **13. LILAS D'ECHAL -** Disappointing last run when 15th in Class D at Laval over 2850m on 26 June. Barefoot this time and is capable of being a threat
- **14. LARA MAKS -** Disappointing last run when 13th in Class D at Laval over 2850m on 26 June. Has won twice this year and can bounce back to score

**Summary:** LARA MAKS (14) has been in good form this year, so her disappointing last run can be forgiven. She gets a narrow vote to score. LAETITIA MONTVASON (9) has been in fine form again this year and won't go down without a fight. LOVELY GODIVA (10) hinted at a return to form last time out, did well last year, and is not without a chance. LOLLIPOP TIVO (4) has been consistent since going barefoot and also holds winning claims.

- **4. LADY DE VANDEL -** Remains in very good form and was victorious last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 3 June. Be right there at the finish
- **5. LINOTTE DU MOUCHEL** Disappointing last run when 8th in Class C at Vincennes over 2850m on 27 June. Capable of better and could play a minor role

- **3. KIRIKOU STREET -** Showed vast improvement and was third in Class H at Francheville over 2475m on 14 July. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **4. KADOR SPIRIT -** Yet to win a race but has been fair of late and was 5th in Class F at Les Andelys over 2525m on 6 July. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **5. KOOL DU VALVIC -** Has struggled in all three runs this year and was 9th in Class F at Reims over 2500m on 21 June. Needs major improvement to win
- **6. KOWEIT -** Unreliable and finished 6th in Class E over this track and trip on 8 July. Place chance on best form

- **3. LIGHT UP ONE** Disqualified in a class E at Angers over 2425m on 10 June. Unlikely to be involved in the finish and needs to improve
- **4. LUARIA -** Fourth in a class E at this track over 2750m on 1 July. Improved in the latest effort and can play a role in the finish
