- 2. **PARTENIT** Second at Deauville over 1500m in a Class Two beaten 1.25L. Lightly raced but more required.
- 3. **FIRE OF THE SUN** Won a Group Three at Dresden (Germany) over 1400m by 1.5L. More than capable.

- 2. SYROS Passed the post in second but was subsequently DQ at Saint-Cloud in a G3. This is tougher.
- 3. **PROUD AND REGAL** Second beaten 1.25L in the G1 National Stakes at the Curragh over 1400m. Trainer is bidding for a sixth win in this contest.
- 4. **SALT BAY** Won by 2L at Haydock Park by 2L over 1600m in a maiden. Trainer won this contest last season. Completely unexposed.
- 5. **ESPIONAGE** Stepping up in class after a 1.75L in a Curragh maiden over 1400m. Interesting.
- 6. **KUBRICK** Is bidding for a hat-trick after winning by a long-neck in the G3 Prix des Chenes over 1600m. Well worth a try at this level.
