**R4 CAGNES-SUR-MER [L-H]**

**C1 - PRIX DE LA PROVENCE - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class F - Harness - EUR  
€ 20,000**

- 1. LUTIN D'HERMES** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 January. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 2. LIVE ON** - In good shape and finished third in class E over this course and distance on 8 January. Remains barefoot and can score
- 3. LESLEY ARCTIC** - Consistent of late and was third in class F at this track over 2925m on 30 December. Can get involved with the finish
- 4. LASKA DU LIVIER** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in class E over this track and trip on 5 January. Remains barefoot.but others are preferred
- 5. LIZY DU VIVIER** - Showed some improvement when fifth in class F at this track over 2925m on 30 December. Might need to do more to beat these rivals
- 6. LADY DE BEYLEV** - Disqualified in class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 29 November. Not easy to trust but is capable of making the frame
- 7. LILLY DE GOUYE** - Disqualified twice in a row,the latest in class E at this track over 2150m on 5 January. Needs to do more to score
- 8. LADY BLACK ROCHEL** - Very consistent and was third in class E at Lyon La Soie over 2700m on 10 January. Should contest the finish
- 9. LIPSTICK QUICK** - Disqualified in class E at this track over 2925m on 18 December. In very good form before that and is capable of winning
- 10. LOUMIODO** - Unreliable and finished 7th in class F at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 17 October. Tries barefoot and is capable of an upset
- 11. LEPTON** - Faulted in class E at this track over 2150m on 8 January. Has major disqualification issues and others make more appeal
- 12. LYNX DES LOYAUX** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 January. Might play a minor role

**Summary:** LIVE ON (2) remains in good shape. He ran well over this course and distance earlier this month and can win in this grade. LIPSTICK QUICK (9) is clearly talented. He faulted last time out but can bounce back to be a real threat to these rivals. LADY BLACK ROCHEL (8) has been very competitive of late and should be involved in the finish yet again. LADY DE BEYLEV (6) is unreliable but can also make the frame when in the right mood.

## C2 - PRIX DE LA CAMARGUE - 2925m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. JADA MOKO** - Disqualified in class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 January. Unreliable but is capable of earning money when smart
- 2. IBANA DE MONTI** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class F at this track over 2150m on 30 December. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 3. JACOVIA MADRIK** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class E over this track and trip on 8 January. Others make more appeal
- 4. JOLIE MOME CHIC** - Not reliable and finished 8th in class E over this course and distance on 30 December. Did win before that and is not out of it
- 5. JAIKA DES FANES** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in class E over this course and distance on 8 January. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 6. JOYCE D'AVEZE** - Not disgraced when fifth in class F at Nantes over 3000m on 12 January. Quite capable of making the frame
- 7. JAKARTA DU LEVANT** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in class G at this track over 2700m on 18 December. Can go one place better
- 8. JONGLEUSE DE BRY** - Returned to form and was barefoot and runner-up in class F over this course and distance on 5 January. Remains without shoes and can go one better
- 9. JOY FOR EVER** - Very consistent and finished third in class E over this track and trip on 8 January. Remains barefoot and should fight out the finish
- 10. JAZZIE DE BERLES** - Showed improvement and was barefoot and third in class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 January. Remains barefoot and could earn some more money

**Summary:** A very competitive-looking race. JONGLEUSE DE BRY (8) hinted at a winning turn when finishing a good runner-up over this course and distance earlier this month and gets a narrow vote to score. JOY FOR EVER (9) has been very consistent of late and will not go down easily again, so must be respected. JAKARTA DU LEVANT (7) has hit the crossbar three times in her last five starts and is clearly not out of it. JOYCE D'AVEZE (6) is capable of a strong finish and can also shine brightly.

**C3 - PRIX DE LA LORRAINE - 2925m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR €  
38,000**

**1. JOUVENCE SECRETE** - Unreliable and was fifth in class E over this track and trip on 8 January. Tries barefoot and can get involved with the finish but does have disqualification issues

**2. HIGH TECH ROC** - Not reliable but was fifth in class F over this course and distance on 5 January. Remains barefoot and could earn some money

**3. IBIZA EVENING** - Unreliable and finished 6th in class F over this course and distance on 5 January. Needs to find a few lengths to win

**4. JITANE VALLEE** - Did not show her best when 6th in class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 18 January. Remains barefoot and is clearly not out of it

**5. HAYASTAN DE ROSAN** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in class D at this track over 2150m on 5 January. Needs to do a bit more to score

**6. HARENA DE MARZY** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class D at this track over 2150m on 5 January. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal

**7. INFINITY JET** - Not disgraced when fifth in class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 18 January. Remains barefoot and should contest the finish

**8. JESTA BUISSONAY** - Disqualified in class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 18 January. Has ability and is quite capable of bouncing back to score

**9. HAPPY D'AIMTE** - Unreliable but finished third in class E over this track and trip on 13 December. Remains barefoot and has a place chance

**Summary:** A very open race. JESTA BUISSONAY (8) is clearly better than what she has been showing of late and can win a race of this nature. INFINITY JET (7) did not run badly at Vincennes a few days ago and should be right there at the finish this time around. JITANE VALLÉE (4) is better than her last run would suggest and is a threat on her best form. JOUVENCE SECRÈTE (1) races without shoes and is one of a few others capable of winning.

## C4 - PRIX DU PERIGORD - 2925m (a2m) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 29,000

- 1. LEADER DU POMMEAU** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class C over this course and distance on 27 December. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 2. LAPS GEDE** - In good shape and finished third in class B over this course and distance on 5 January. Reverts to barefoot and has a place chance
- 3. LOGAN JIEL** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class B over this track and trip on 5 January. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 4. LIVANTO KALOUMA** - Not reliable but was runner-up in class C over this track and trip on 27 December. Reverts to barefoot and can go one better
- 5. LYNRYD SKYNYRD** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in class C at Vincennes over 2100m on 24 October. Remains barefoot and others are preferred
- 6. LE CASHMAKER** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in class C at Vincennes over 2175m on 19 December. Might play a minor role at best
- 7. LOTUS GRIFF** - Unreliable and was fifth in class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 4 January. Capable of being competitive when in the right mood
- 8. LOVER MAUZUN** - Disqualified in class B at this track over 2925m on 5 January. Ultra-consistent before that and should contest the finish
- 9. LUPIN D'OLMEN** - Disqualified in class C at this track over 2925m on 20 December. Not easy to trust but can contest the finish when smart
- 10. LEVER DU JOAMAX** - A winner of three of his last four starts, including in class B over this track and trip on 5 January. Reverts to barefoot and can win again
- 11. LEWIS RIVER** - Did not show his best when 8th in class B at Vincennes over 2850m on 31 December. Capable of doing better and is not out of it

**Summary:** LEVER DU JOAMAX (10) has struck a purple patch of form and is seeking a hat-trick. He beat a few of these last time out and can do it all again. LOVER MAUZUN (8) put in a rare disqualification last time out but was very consistent before that and must be respected. LIVANTO KALOUMA (4) is barefoot this time and ran well when runner-up to LEVER DU JOAMAX (10), so is clearly in the mix. LUPIN D'OLMEN (9) is not easy to trust but can also get involved with the finish.

## C5 - PRIX DU LIMOUSIN - 2925m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 26,000

1. **JEWEL SMILE** - Battling to regain best form and was unplaced in class E at Lyon La Soie over 2700m on 10 January. More is needed to score
2. **JAYZI DU BOURG** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in class E over this track and trip on 11 January. More is needed to beat these rivals
3. **IVY METAL** - Disqualified in class F at Amiens over 2900m on 20 September. Returns from a break and could need this run
4. **JIRENZO** - Has struggled of late and was 10th in class F at this track over 2150m on 11 January. Reverts to barefoot but others make more appeal
5. **IQUEM MARVIC** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, the latest in class G at this track over 2700m on 30 December. Hard to trust and others are preferred
6. **IMPACTDARCHE** - Victorious in class G at this track over 2700m on 30 December. Unreliable but might just follow up in this line-up
7. **ILLUMINATI** - Not disgraced when fourth in class F at this track over 2700m on 2 January. Might play a minor role at very best
8. **JALNY DE CASTELLE** - Successful in class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 4 January. Remains barefoot and can follow up
9. **JAGUAR ATOUT** - Finished fourth in class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 January. Has a place chance on best form
10. **JERRY QUICK** - In good form and was fourth in class F at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 7 December. Reverts to barefoot and should be competitive
11. **JAKADI DE VAUVILLE** - Disqualified in class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 January. Had some fair form before that and could make the frame
12. **IRUN DU BOCAGE** - Not reliable but was runner-up in class F at this track over 2700m on 2 January. Can go one place better this time

**Summary:** An interesting race. JALNY DE CASTELLE (8) just beat a good field at Vincennes and is clearly the one to be with. IRUN DU BOCAGE (12) is best when racing without shoes and should be very competitive once again. JERRY QUICK (10) is barefoot and can be competitive over this course and distance. IMPACT DARCHE (6) is unreliable but did win at this course last month and is capable of doubling up if in the same mood.

## C6 - PRIX DU BERRI - 2925m (a2m) - Class E - Mounted - EUR € 26,000

**1. KOURANE LA CHENAIE** - Disappointing form of late and finished 6th in a Class F mounted race at Toulouse over 2325m on 15 January. More is needed to score

**2. KALISTA TILOU** - Not reliable and finished 5th in a Class G harness race at Lyon-Parilly over 2875m on 13 December. Did win a mounted race before that and can strike again

**3. JAWENN DE KERYANN** - Unreliable but was fourth in a Class F harness race at Lyo-La Soie over 2700m on 17 January. Might play a minor role

**4. JEOFFREY** - Holding form and finished fourth in a Class F mounted race over this track and trip on 20 December. Capable of making the frame

**5. KISMIE DE MONTFORT** - Disqualified last time out in Class E over this track and trip on 18 January. Can contest the finish back in a mounted race

**6. DESDEMONA SAGE** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Turin over 1600m on 24 December. Others are preferred

**7. KRUNCH DE L'ITON** - Consistent of late and finished third in a Class F mounted race at Meslay-du-Maine 2900m on 18 December. Be right there at the finish

**8. LUTECIA ELLIS** - Showed some improvement when third in a Class F mounted race at Toulouse over 2325m on 15 January. Can be a threat once again

**Summary:** KALISTA TILOU (2) is unbeaten in two starts in the mounted category and should make a bold bid to maintain that record. KRUNCH DE L'ITON (7) has been very competitive of late and can once again feature prominently at the finish. LUTECIA ELLIS (8) showed improvement under the saddle last time and is capable of being in the mix again. KISMIE DE MONTFORT (5) made a mistake last time but has shown ability in this discipline and cannot be ruled out.

## C7 - PRIX DE LA DORDOGNE - 2925m (a2m) - Class G Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 8,000

**1. JAGUAR GEDE** - Unreliable but did run well when third in Class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 11 December. Can be competitive once again

**2. ILTON BEAUREGARD** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in Class Class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 January. Fitter this time and could play a minor role at very best

**3. JOKER BODENSEE** - Not reliable and finished 5th in Class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 January. Can make the frame

**4. JURDIG LESMELCHEN** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class D at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 30 November. Fitter this time and could be the surprise package of the race

**5. HEAVEN JIEL** - Has major disqualification issues and faulted last time out in Class G at this track over 2950m on 8 January. Others are preferred

**6. INO DE BREVOL** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in Class G at this track over 2150m on 20 December. Capable of an upset on best form

**7. GAETAN** - May have just needed the run when 5th in Class F at this course over 2150m on 11 January. Better this distance and can go close to winning

**8. GO CHICAGO** - Battling to find best form and finished 6th in F at this course over 2150m on 11 January. Needs to do more to score

**9. HAMYOT DE BOMO** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class E at this track over 2925m on 11 January. Can earn some minor money

**10. ISBA BESNOT** - Showed some improvement when barefoot and fourth in Class F at this track over 2150m on 11 January. Remains without shoes and can win a race of this nature

**11. FIFTY WINNER** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in Class F at this course over 2950m on 2 January. Battling to find best form and others

**Summary:** A very open contest. ISBA BESNOT (10) showed improvement when racing barefoot last time and can take another step forward here. GAETAN (7) should be fitter for his recent outing and looks a serious contender for the finish. JAGUAR GEDE (1) is not the most reliable but ran well at Marseille-Vivaux and can pose a threat again. JOKER BODENSEE (3) is another unreliable type, yet has the ability to make the frame when at his best.

26,000**

**1. MAGGY JENILOU** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 26 December. Barefoot this time and could be a threat

**2. MELODIE D'HOULBEC** - In good shape and finished third in Class D at this track over 2925m on 13 December. Could earn some more money

**3. MOLLY DU VALLON** - Returned from a break and was runner-up in Class C at this track over 2700m on 27 December. Races without shoes and can go one better

**4. MAMICASH D'HERIPRE** - In good form and was barefoot and successful in Class E over this track and trip on 2 January. Remains barefoot and can double up

**5. MAMBA DES DURIEZ** - Unreliable and finished 5th in Class E at this course over 2700m on 16 January. More is needed to beat these rivals

**6. MADE IN ATALANTE** - Disqualified in Class D at this track over 2925m on 5 January. Not reliable but can earn some minor money at very best

**7. MY WAY LEAGABIN** - Holding form and finished fourth in Class D at this course over 2925m on 5 January. Can earn some more money

**8. MACARENA D'HOULBEC** - Has improved of late and was third in Class D at this course over 2925m on 5 January. Remains without shoes and can be competitive once again

**Summary:** An intriguing lucky last. MOLLY DU VALLON (3) is a model of consistency and was only beaten by one rival when resuming from a break. She races barefoot for the first time and gets the nod to go one better. MAMICASH D'HERIPRE (4) is in good form and can back up a recent barefoot success. MACARENA D'HOULBEC (8) has shown improvement and also goes without shoes this time, so must be respected. MAGGY JENILOU (1) is another capable of improvement and shouldn't be overlooked.
