**C1 - PRIX DES CHENES - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR €
21,000**

- 1. LETS GO HAPPY** - Has struggled of late and finished 10th in class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 20 January. Remains barefoot but others are preferred
- 2. L'AMIRAL CHATAULT** - Did not show his best whe 10th in a class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 2 December. Capable of doig better and has a place chance
- 3. LINO DU POMMEREUX** - Unreliable and was disqualified in a class E at Graignes over 2725m on 2 February. Not easy to trust but could earn some minr money
- 4. LOOKING BOY** - Not disgraced when fifth in class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 16 February. Tries barefoot and could be ready to score
- 5. LOVAK DE HOUELLE** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 10 February. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish
- 6. LISANDRO DE LOU** - Not reliable but was runner-up in a class F mounted race at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 12 February. Remains barefoot and is clearly not out of it
- 7. LYS PETTEVINIERE** - Showed some improvement and was runner-up in class F at Angers over 2425m on 21 January. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 8. LOVE ME HAUFOR** - Battling to find best form and finished 8th in a claimer at Vincennes over 2100m on 3 January. Needs major improvement to win
- 9. LINDIR** - Unreliable and finished 6th in class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 21 January. Remains barefoot but more is needed to score
- 10. LOUP D'ERPION** - Showed some iprovement when fourth at Mons over 2840m on 27 January. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 11. L'OURAGAN** - Battlin to regain best form and was unplaced in class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 4 February. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 12. LEONARD** - Unplaced in class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 12 February. In good form before that and might play a minor role

Summary: LOOKING BOY (4) hinted that a winning turn is not far away with a good last run at Vincennes. He is barefoot and ready to strike. LOVAK DE HOUELLE (5) has some fair form of late and could get involved in the finish. LISANDRO DE LOU (6) is unreliable but only found one better on the day at Rouen-Mauquenchy earlier this month and should be a threat again. LYS PETTEVINIERE (7) also showed improvement last time out and must be respected for that.

21,000**

1. **KATANA** - Not disgraced when fifth in class F at Graignes over 2725m on 9 February. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish
2. **KARMINA DU BREUCQ** - Not reliable and finished 6th in class F at Vincennes over 2700m on 11 February. Reverts to barefoot and can score
3. **KILIANA DU VAUTOUR** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 27 November. Needs to fo more to scpre
4. **KORONA DU CHIFFRES** - Disqualified at Mons over 2300m on 10 February. Reverts to barefoot and is capable of earning money when smart
5. **KARA DU VAUTOUR** - Disqualified in a class F at Montier-en-Der over 3025m on 24 August. Hard to trust and is likely to need this run returning from a break
6. **KARA DES BROUSSES** - Disqualified in class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 9 November. Returns from a break and others make more appeal
7. **KARLA DES THUYAS** - Has struggled of late and finished 10th in class F at Reims over 2500m on 10 November. Reverts to barefoot but could need this run returning from a break
8. **KADOLINE WEST** - Unreliable and was unplaced in class F at Reims over 2550m on 19 October. Returns from a break and could need this run
9. **KAABA RINGEAT** - Disqualified in a class F at Vincennes over 2700m on 24 December. In good form before that and could contest the finish
10. **KOQUETTE LIRE** - Unreliable but was fourth at Mons over 2840m on 3 February.. Probably needs to do a lot more than that to beat these rivals
11. **KATYUSHA** - Knocking very hard at the door and was runner-up at Mons over 2300m on 17 February. Should contest the finish
12. **KATHLEEN DU NORD** - Has only been modest of late and finished 8th in a class G at Machecoul over 2700m on 2 November.. Needs to find a few lengths beat these rivals
13. **KLARISSA** - In good shape and was third in class G at this track over 2700m on 8 December. Could earn some more money
14. **KALAMATA BEACH** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in class F at Amiens over 2400m on 9 December. Quite capable of making the frame

Summary: KILIANA DU VAUTOUR (3) was not disgraced at Vincennes last time out and that was over this distance. She is barefoot this time and could pop up with a victory. KATANA (1) has some fair form of late and could be even more competitive this time. KAABA RINGEAT (9) had some good form before faulting in her latest start and could be a lively danger if she stays in stride. KALAMATA BEACH (14) has only been modest of late but can be competitive for Eric Raffin.

- 1. KING TURGOT** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest a class D at Nantes over 3000m on 13 February. Can make the frame when smart
- 2. KOLOSSE RHODES** - Unreliable and finished 9th in a class E mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 24 October. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 3. KEFIR COHIAIS** - Has improved of late and was runner-up at Mons over 2300m on 10 February. Quite capable of earning some more money
- 4. KINDER DE LA NAVE** - Successful in his last two starts, the latest in class G at Amiens over 2400m on 13 November. Remains barefoot and could score if fit enough after a break
- 5. KAOLIN MOUROTAIS** - Much improved last run when third in class F at Graignes over 2725m on 9 February. Can be competitive once again
- 6. KILLER DE BEAULIEU** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class F at Vincennes over 2700m on 21 December. Capable of an upset on best form
- 7. KADOR DU RABUTIN** - Has struggled of late and was 10th in class F at Argentan over 2800m on 24 January. Remains barefoot and could run well for Eric Raffin
- 8. KRAPO LILA** - Did not show his best when 9th in class F at Reims over 2550m on 10 November. Remains barefoot but has a place chance returning from a break
- 9. KOLCANI JEEP** - Unreliable but did run third in class G at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 30 November. Might play a minor role at very best
- 10. KASHMIR PRESTANCE** - Unreliable and finished 9th in class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 26 January. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 11. KYROC D'ERPION** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a class G at Amiens over 2400m on 13 November. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 12. KAISER DE SIENNE** - Did not show his best when 9th in class G at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 13 December. Capable of doing better and others are preferred
- 13. KAPITO CLUB** - Unreliable and finished 9th in class a class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 4 February. Needs major improvement to win
- 14. KINGSLEY ROBSEN** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class F mounted race at Reims over 2550m on 10 November. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 15. KITALIANO ALGREF** - Disqualified at Mons over 2840m on 3 February. In good form before that and could earn some minor money
- 16. KRACDARCHE** - Has improved of late and was fourth in a class E mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 4 February. Capable of earning some money

Summary: KINDER DE LA NAVE (4) won some nice races at the end of last year. He returns from a break but may well complete his hat-trick. KAOLIN MOUROTAIS (5) showed some improvement last time out and can be a threat to these rivals. KADOR DU RABUTIN (7) will have Eric Raffin driving and can get into the mix of things. KING TURGOT (1) has a string of recent faults but is capable of scoring when staying on the trot.

21,000**

- 1. INSERT DU BAS BOSQ** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a Claimer at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 3 November. Could need this run returning from a break
- 2. JACKSON HILL** - Consistent and finished fourth in class G at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 12 February. can earn some minor money
- 3. IN AMERICA** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class E at Vincennes over 2850m on 20 December. Remains barefoot but others are preferred
- 4. JASMIN DANOVER** - In good form and finished third in a class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 15 February. Should be competitive once again
- 5. JACKPOT DES BORDES** - Unreliable and finishe fourth in a claimer at Vincennes over 2700m on 16 February. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 6. JACARTO DE HOUELLE** - Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up in a class G at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 31 January. Can go one better
- 7. JOURNAIO DU ROI** - Not reliable and finished 7th in class G at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 26 January. Remains barefoot and others are preferred
- 8. JET DE CANVILLE** - Disqualified in a class H mounted race at Bernay over 2800m on 21 September. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 9. JAZZ JENILOU** - Unreliable and finished 8th in a class F at this track over 2825m on 15 December. Tries barefoot and has claims at scoring
- 10. JOY EASTER** - Unreliable and was a winner of a class G at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 21 January. Might well follow up
- 11. JAMES RULES** - Unreliable and finished 10th in class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 15 February. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 12. JOHN ANGOT** - Not disgraced when fifth in class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 15 February. In good form before that and can contest the finish
- 13. JAGUAR'S EYES** - Disqualified in class F at Vincennes over 2850m on 30 January. Capable of doing better and has a place chance
- 14. JURASSIC** - Only modest of late and finished fifth in class G at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 23 November. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 15. JAG DE ROZEVIC** - Unreloable and finished 6th in a class F at Laval over 2850m 4 February. Might play a minor role at very best
- 16. ITEM BUISSONAY** - Consistent and finished third in class F at Vincennes over 2850m on 30 January. Cn earn some more money

Summary: JACARTO DE HOUELLE (6) is threatening to win and was unlucky not to score in either of his last two starts. He does have disqualification issues but gets a confident vote to score. JAZZ JENILOU (9) is unreliable but will be barefoot this time and can be a lively danger. JOHN ANGOT (12) has been in good shape of late and would not be a surprise winner. JACKSON HILL (2) is consistent and should be right there at the finish once again.

18,000**

- 1. MAGIC LOVE ELEVEN** - Has struggled of late and finished 9th in class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 11 November. Tries barefoot but needs major improvement to score
- 2. MANHATTAN SYGA** - Unreliable and was 10th in class G at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 30 November. Returns from a break but has a place chance
- 3. MAN OF WOOD** - In good shape and was runner-up at Straubing over 1925m on 9 November. Returns from a break but can be atleast if fit enough
- 4. MY TOP GIFT** - Disqualified in a class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 16 February. Battlin to regain form and others are preferred
- 5. MINIMUM** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class F at Angers over 2425m on 7 February. Can bounce back and beat these rivals
- 6. MONT LIGNERIES** - Disqualified in class F at La Capelle over 2700m on 2 November. Returns from a break but can earn some money when smart
- 7. MOJITO CENE** - Finished fifth in class F over this track and trip on 29 September. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 8. MAJOR DU COUDOU** - Unreliable and was fifth in class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 12 January. Capable of making the frame
- 9. MARIO DE LOU** - In good shape and was third in a class F at Angers over 2425m on 7 February. Should be right there at the finish
- 10. MASTER KING** - Not reliable but was fifth in class F at La Capelle over 2700m on 2 November. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 11. MAGNUM DE RATILLY** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 30 January. Remains barefoot and needs to do a bit more to score
- 12. MAXIM D'HERTALS** - Has improved of late and was fourth at Wolvega over 2600m on 31 January. Might ply a minor role

Summary: A very open-looking race. MINIMUM (5) has a couple of faults in a row but is also quite capable of winning this particular race. MARIO DE LOU (9) is in good shape and looks very likely to contest the finish once again. MAN OF WOOD (3) makes his French debut returning from a break but could score. MAJOR DU COUDOU (8) is not reliable but has done enough of late to hold a winning chance in this line-up.

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C6 - PRIX DES ORMES - 2825m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 18,000

- 1. MAMBACITA** - Disqualified on debut in class F at Angers over 2425m on 7 February. Capable of improvement but others make more appeal
- 2. MAGENTA** - Disqualified in class F at Vire over 2800m on 8 February. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 3. MAFIA** - Has not show much and finished 6th in class F at this track over 2825m on 12 May. Tries barefoot and has a place chance
- 4. MISSION DU CHOQUEL** - Not disgraced when 6th in class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 4 February. Likely to improve and is not out of it
- 5. MALICE DES CHAMPS** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class E at this track over 2700m on 10 December. Needs to do more to score
- 6. MUSE DU GOUTIER** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 4 February. Capable of an upset on best form
- 7. MISS DE REUX** - A winner on debut in a class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 5 September. Returns from a break but can score if fit enough
- 8. MADY DU POMMEREUX** - Disqualified in class F at Mont-de-Marsan over 2875m on 18 December. Not easy to trust but might play a minor role
- 9. MISS DU RABUTIN** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in class G at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 1 February. Can go on place better
- 10. MIDNIGHT DU VICLAU** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 5 September. Returns from a break and could be the surprise package of the race
- 11. MISSIONDARCHE** - Did not show her best when fifth in class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 26 January. Should fight out the finish

Summary: MISS DU RABUTIN (9) is knocking very loudly at the door. She looks the one to side with over this course and distance. MISS DE REUX (7) did all that was asked of her when winning, but that was back in September. She needs to show she is fit enough to double up. MISSION DU CHOQUEL (4) is threatening to improve and can get into the mix of things. MISSIONDARCHE (11) has form that should also make her a challenger for top honours.

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C7 - PRIX DES BOURGEONS - 2825m (a2m) - Class F Amateur Riders - Mounted - EUR € 19,000

- 1. KERRIADARCHE** - Finished 6th at Mons over 2275m on 4 November. Reverts to barefoot but does need to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 2. KRACOTTE GIRL** - Showed some improvement when fifth in class E at Laval over 2850m on 4 February. Can do even better this time around
- 3. LAMIRAL D'ERABLE** - Much improved last run when third in a class E harness race at Nantes over 3000m on 13 February. Very hard to trust but can score back in a mounted race
- 4. LOTUS PAULOIS** - Disqualified in a class F harness at this track over 2700m on 11 February. Remains barefoot but needs to find a few lengths to win
- 5. LUTHER** - Has disqualification issues and faulted in a class E harness race at Pontchateau over 2800m on 15 February. Not easy to trust but should be a threat under the saddle
- 6. LUSSABEAU** - Has struggled of late and was 10th in a harness claimer at Vincennes over 2850m on 28 October. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 7. KITA DU RIB** - Unreliable and was unplaced in a class F harness at Vincennes over 2700m on 11 February. Best judged on a good penultimate start performance and is not out of it
- 8. KING DE LA COTE** - Unreliable but was third in a harness claimer at Vincennes over 2100m on 11 February. More is needed to win
- 9. LITTLE DRAGON** - Has struggled of late and was 10th in a class D harness race at Vincennes over 2100m on 5 February. Needs to do more to score
- 10. KILLIE EILISH** - Has not show much and finished 9th in class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 2 January. Capable of improvement and might play a minor role
- 11. KARLITO DU CAMPDOS** - Has struggled of late and finished 9th in a class F harness race at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 21 January. Reverts to barefoot but others are preferred

Summary: An interesting race. LAMIRAL D'ERABLE (3) is very hard to trust and has many disqualifications. He does, however, look the likely winner if staying in stride. LUTHER (5) is also not easy to trust but can get involved in the finish when smart. KRACOTTE GIRL (2) showed some improvement last time out and can do even better this time around. KITA DU RIB (7) did well in her penultimate start and could be a danger if repeating that level of form.

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**C8 - PRIX DES ERABLES - 2825m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR €
15,000**

1. NELSON CHARENTAIS - A three-year-old gelding by Un Charme Fou out of Foudre Charentaise who is making his debut. His Dam did not win a race after 35 starts. Can earn make the frame for Eric Raffin

2. NETSUKE - A three-year-old colt by Captain Sparrow out of Dalmatia who is making his dbut. His Dam was unraced. Might play a minor role at vest

3. NINETY ONE BOND - A three-year-old colt by Booster Winner out of Cincinnati Bond who is making his debut. His mother won 3 of her 30 starts. Can be a threat on debut

4. NO COUNTRYNESS - A three-year-old colt by Invincible Cash out of Family Business who is making his debut. Hid mother was unraced. Others make more appeal

5. NOBI BAROSSO - A three-year-old colt by Hohneck out of Hélèna Barosso who is making his debut. His mother won 2 of 30 starts. Qualified nicely at Caen and could score

6. NORD CALITY - A three-year-old colt by Dollar Macker out of Cality Sautreuil who is making his debut. His Dam won 3 of her 9 starts. Can be a danger on debut

7. NOURKIS - A three-year-old colt by Singalo out of Bella du Vivier who is making his debut. His mother won 3 of her 30 starts. Can contest the finish

8. NYSKIO SPORT - A three -year-old cold by Uzo Jossely out of Garance de Hoerdts who is making his debut. Qualified in a good time and can contest the finish.

9. NEBRASKA - Not disgraced when fourth on debut in class F at Les Sables D Olonne over 2150m on 25 July. Returns from a break and could contest the finish

10. NEOH DAIRPET - Has not shown much so far and was 9th in class C at Vincennes over 2200m on 28 October. Returns from a break and others are preferred

Summary: A very tricky lucky last race that is dominated numerically by newcomers. Two of them immediately catch the eye. NOBI BAROSSO (5) and NYSKIO SPORT (8) have both qualified in good times and would not be surprise winners. NEBRASKA (9) was not disgraced on debut and should improve on that experience this time around. The dam of NELSON CHARENTAIS (1) did not win a race, but he could make the frame on debut.
