

# MONDAY, 23/03/26

## C1 - PRIX DES PAYS DE LOIRE - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. LOBELIE DE GODREL** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a class F at this track over 2700m on 7 March. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 2. LACOUMA** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in a class F at Amiens over 2400m on 21 February. Capable of doing better but others make more appeal
- 3. LUDMILLA HAUFOR** - Did not show her best when 6th in class F over this course and distance on 7 March. Remains barefoot and can be competitive in this line-up
- 4. LITTLE STAR JIEL** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, including in a class D at Enghien over 2875m on 11 March. Capable of an upset if staying on the trot
- 5. LUTECE** - Needed the last run when 9th in a class F at this track over 2700m on 7 March. Remains barefoot and is capable of an upset if staying on the trot
- 6. LADY BELL** - Not reliable but was fourth in a class E at Reims over 2550m on 1 March. Should be competitive if staying in stride
- 7. LARAFALE PASMARICK** - Holding form and was fourth in class F over this track and trip on 7 March. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish
- 8. LARISSA DU VIVIER** - Three wins in her six starts and was runner-up in class D at Cabourg over 2750m on 25 October. Returns from a break but can score if fit enough
- 9. LIRYA DE REVE D'OR** - Faulted in a class E at Graignes over 2700m on 22 February. Has run well this course and distance and has a place chance
- 10. LADY SAINT CHARLES** - Finished unplaced in a class F at Reims over 2550m on 23 November. Returns from a break and could need this run

**Summary:** LARISSA DU VIVIER (8) returns from a break but she is talented and can beat these rivals if fit enough. LARAFALE PASMARICK (7) has held her form well; she is fit and should be right there at the finish once again. LUDMILLA HAUFOR (3) is clearly better than what she showed over this course and distance earlier this month and can be competitive this time around. LADY BELL (6) has disqualification issues but is not out of it.

C2 - PRIX DES HAUTS DE FRANCE - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. **LINDIR** - Victorious in a class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 8 March. Remains barefoot and in good form. Can follow up
2. **L'AMIRAL CHATAULT** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in a class E at this track over 2700m on 23 February. Reverts to barefoot and could earn some money
3. **LIVE ON** - Not disgraced when fifth at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 7 March. Remains barefoot but is not reliable. Can earn some money
4. **LORD BLACKWOOD** - Consistent this year and was third in a class F at Lisieux over 2675m on 14 March. Can get involved with the finish once again
5. **LOTS OF LOVE** - Finished 9th in a class F at Lisieux over 2675m on 14 March. Capable of doing better and can score in a race of this nature
6. **LEOLIO** - Finished fourth in a class E at Vincennes over 2175m on 27 February. Capable of playing a minor role
7. **LARIMAR** - Returned to form and was runner-up in a class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 9 March. Has major disqualification issues but is capable of making the frame when smart
8. **LOVE ET CASH RENKA** - Faulted last time out in a class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 3 January. Has won with this shoeing before and is not out of it
9. **LEONARD** - Only modest this year and finished 8th in a class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 9 March. Reverts to barefoot but others are preferred
10. **LOYAL DU CHENE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class D at La Capelle over 2750m on 8 May. Returns from a lengthy break and should need this run
11. **LOZANO** - Needed the last run when fifth in a class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 9 March. Tries barefoot and could be the surprise package of the race
12. **LE VENT DU HOULET** - In good shape and was third in a class F mounted race t Chartres over 2800m on 1 March. Better in that discipline and others are preferred
13. **LE GOLDEN PHYT'S** - Disqualified in a class F at Loudeac over 2875m on 15 March. Remains barefoot and could be a threat if smart
14. **L'AMI LUC** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class E at Bernay over 2800m on 31 August. Consistent but is likely to need this run returning from a break
15. **LUTIN DU VAUTOUR** - Disqualified in a class F at Nimes over 2750m on 11 November. Could need this run returning from a break
16. **LUTIN DE LA BESVRE** - Returned from a break and was third in a class E at Reims over 2550m on 1 March. Has disqualification issues but does have a place chance

**Summary:** A very open race. LOTS OF LOVE (5) has not been showing his best form lately, but he is quite capable of winning against these rivals. LE GOLDEN PHYT'S (13) needed his last run when faulting and remains barefoot. He can contest the finish if showing his best form. LINDIR (1) can follow up on a good last win. LORD BLACKWOOD (4) has been very competitive this year and is also capable of shining brightly.

C3 - PRIX DE NORMANDIE - 2825m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. **KOLCANI JEEP** - Not reliable and was unplaced in a class F over this course and distance on 23 February. Reverts to barefoot but others are preferred
2. **JOVIAL DE ROCK** - Off form and finished 8th in class E mounted race at Graignes over 2700m on 30 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win
3. **KOCO PEEL** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class G at Reims over 2550m on 19 March. Very hard to trust but can play a minor role when smart
4. **KOBE BEJI** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in a class G at Amiens over 2900m on 15 March. Reverts to barefoot and could earn some money when smart
5. **JACKPOT DE GAPI** - Finished 10th in a class F at Carentan over 2850m on 6 July. Likely to need this run returning from a break
6. **JAZZ DU HOULET** - Disqualified in a class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 8 March. Remains barefoot and could be the surprise package of the race on best form
7. **KASHMIR PRESTANCE** - Showed improvement when runner-up in a class F over this course and distance on 23 February. Unreliable but has to be considered a possible winner
8. **JEWEL D'ARGENT** - In good shape and finished fourth in a class G at Amiens over 2400m on 15 March. Could earn some more money
9. **KOMAN** - Finished fourth in a class E at Caen over 2200m on 5 March. Remains barefoot and can earn some more money
10. **KAP NORMAND** - Finished fifth in a class E mounted race at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 2 December. Returns from a break and could need this run
11. **KEL PRESTANCE** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest in a class C at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 4 August. Should need this run returning from a break
12. **KATSUKI** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class F at Chartres over 2825m on 15 March. Remains barefoot and can bounce back to score if smart
13. **KERRO DE HOUELLE** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 26 February. Can be competitive once again
14. **JAZZ JENILOU** - Not reliable but was fourth in a class F over this course and distance on 23 February. Has a place chance in this line-up
15. **KARTER LEWIS** - Finished 10th in a class E over this track and trip on 2 March. Reverts to barefoot and can contest the finish ,fitter this time
16. **JET DE CANVILLE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class G at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 16 March. Not easy to trust and others are preferred

**Summary:** An open race. KATSUKI (12) has had a couple of faults of late but is better than that and can win a race of this nature, so gets the vote to score. KARTER LEWIS (15) clearly needed his last run and is without shoes this time around, so can strike back. KERRO DE HOUELLE (13) has not been disgraced of late and is likely to be competitive once again. KASHMIR PRESTANCE (7) is unreliable but does have claims over this track and trip.

C4 - PRIX DE L'OCCITANIE - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 27,000

1. **JASMIN DU NORD** - Has some fairr form and finished fifth in a class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 21 January. Races without shoes and has claims at scoring
2. **HERCULE DE BEA** - Needed the last run when 8th in a class F at Amiens over 2900m on 15 March. Fitter this time and is capable of playing a minor role
3. **GAMIN DE COKTAIL** - Has needed both runs this year and was 10th in a class G at Enghien over 2875m on 17 March. Remains barefoot and is capable of earning some money
4. **JUNIOR ANGELE** - Not reliable and finished 8th in a class F at Reims over 2550m on 14 March. Remains barefoot and was a good winner before that. Not out of it
5. **JUPITER MADRIK** - Not reliable but was runner-up in a class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 8 March. Reverts to barefoot and can go one place better
6. **JACK DU CEBE** - Knocking loudly at the door and was runner-up in a class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 25 February. Should contest the finish
7. **HECTOR DU MINON** - Unplaced in a class G at Enghien over 2875m on 17 March. Probably needed that run but has major disqualification issues and others are preferred
8. **IDOLE STAR** - Unplaced in a class E mounted race at Cabourg over 2750m on 8 December. Returns from a break and could need this run
9. **IN AMERICA** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest in a class G at Reims over 2500m on 14 March. Remains barefoot but others are preferred
10. **JACKPOT JOMUNA** - Unplaced in a class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 17 November. Returns from a break and could need this run
11. **ICARE DES FORGES** - A winner of a class E at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 7 September. Only raced twice last year and could need this run returning from a break
12. **INDUCTIF** - In good shape and was fourth in a class G at Vincennes over 2850m on 20 February. Not out of it in this line-up
13. **JUBY DE BAILLY** - Unplaced in a Claimer at Vincennes over 2700m on 16 February. Remains barefoot but has yet to win a race
14. **IVO SIVED** - Needed the only run this year when unplaced in a class E over this track and trip on 7 March. Fitter this time but others are preferred
15. **IL MIO** - Fit and finished fourth in a claimer at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2875m on 14 March. Might play a minor role at very best
16. **I FEEL PRETTY** - Off form and finished 9th over this course and distance on 2 March. Needs to do a lot more to beat these rivals

**Summary:** JUPITER MADRIK (5) does not always show his best side but he was good without winning at La Capelle earlier this month and could be ready for a winning turn. He does have disqualification issues, though. JACK DU CEBE (6) has hit the crossbar twice in his last three starts and will be a threat once again. JASMIN DU NORD (1) is barefoot this time and can score. JUNIOR ANGELE (4) is best judged on a good penultimate start victory and has to be considered a possible winner.

1. **MELISSA MATCH** - A winner of three of her five starts, including in a class F at Graignes over 2700m on 15 March. Tries barefoot and can follow up
2. **MILORD DU LORAU** - Has improved this year and was fourth in a class E at Reims over 2550m on 14 March. Capable of making the frame
3. **MIA STEJELO** - Yet to win a race and finished 7th in a class E at Vire over 2150m on 18 March. More is needed to win this race
4. **MILORD DU COJEUL** - Unplaced in a class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 12 December. Tries barefoot but is hard to trust and others are preferred
5. **MELBA DES VAUX** - Finished 8th in a class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 1 January. Returns from a short break and others make more appeal
6. **MYSTERE CERIZE** - Finished fifth in a class D over this track and trip on 27 October. Has some fair form but could need this run returning from a break
7. **MARKUS DES AGETS** - Faulted last time out in a class E mounted race at Enghien over 2875m on 6 March. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
8. **MANHATTAN JENILOU** - A barefoot winner in a class F over this track and trip on 2 March. Remains barefoot and could follow up
9. **MAITRE DU CHENE** - Unreliable and finished 10th in a class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 25 February. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
10. **MACARENA** - Just needed the run when fourth in a class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 17 January. Fitter this time and is not out of it
11. **MAKE FOR JUMP** - Victorious in a class E over this course and distance on 27 October. Returns from a break but can score if fit enough
12. **MASTER KING** - A winner of a class F over this course and distance on 7 March. Likes this track but this is a tougher race
13. **MELIUS AVIS** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a class A at this track over 2825m on 8 November. Needs to find a few lengths to win
14. **MINNEAPOLIS** - Disqualified at Pontchateau over 2800m on 6 March. Reverts to barefoot and can earn some money when smart
15. **MUSTANG DE REUX** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 29 January. More is needed to beat these rivals
16. **MIDNIGHT DU VICLAU** - Successful in a class F at this track over 2825m on 23 February. Returned from a break to score and could have more to offer

**Summary:** Many runners are in with a winning chance in this race. MELISSA MATCH (1) impressed in her win at Graignes and will be barefoot this time, so gets a narrow vote. MANHATTAN JENILOU (8) raced without shoes when scoring over this course and distance at the beginning of the month and can double up. MAKE FOR JUMP (11) won over this course and distance in October, so returns after a break but is talented. MIDNIGHT DU VICLAU (16) showed good improvement after a break and could have more to offer.

- 1. LUTIN DES RACQUES** - Finished unplaced in a class F harness race at Divonne-les-Bains over 2000m on 11 August. Likely to need this run returning from a long break
- 2. LE BOCAGE** - Finished fifth in a harness claimer at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2875m on 14 March. Can do better under the saddle and must be respected
- 3. LARGO FLIGNY** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class G mounted race at Reims over 2550m on 1 March. Capable of earning some money
- 4. LOKI DU CARMA** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class F harness race at La Capelle over 2750m on 26 October. Could be a surprise package trying a mounted race returning from a break
- 5. LUXEMBOURGEOISE** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class F mounted race at Chartres over 2800m on 1 March. Fitter and could score in a race like this
- 6. LUIDGI DES EPINES** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a class G harness race at Strasbourg over 2800m on 8 March. Has yet to win a race but might play a minor role
- 7. LALY DE CELLES** - Needed the last run when 6th in a class G mounted race at Reims over 2550m on 1 March. Reverts to barefoot and could earn some money
- 8. LOCKDOWN POWER** - Disqualified in a class E at this track over 2825m on 29 September. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 9. LABEL MARANCOURT** - Unplaced in a class F harness race over this track and trip on 24 November. Returns from a break and others are preferred
- 10. LE DIAMANT DE Jafa** - Finished 9th in a class E harness race at Laon over 2650m on 19 October. Reverts to barefoot and could be a threat back under the saddle
- 11. LABEL DADDY** - Faulted in a class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 16 March. In good form before that and has claims if smart this time around
- 12. LOOPING DE CAPONET** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in a harness claimer at Bihorel-les-Rouen over 2500m on 8 March. Remains barefoot and has a place chance
- 13. LORD** - Disqualified in a class E at Ecommoy over 2750m on 31 August. Returns from a break but can make the frame if fit
- 14. LATINA DE TILOU** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 16 March. Has major disqualification issues but can earn some money if smart
- 15. LOU DU DERBY** - Not reliable but was a runner-up in a class F Mounted race at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 16 March. Remains barefoot and can go one better

**Summary:** A very weak race and a surprise result could be on the cards. LOU DU DERBY (15) only found one a bit better last time out and could have a winning turn. LABEL DADDY (11) had some good form before a last-start fault and could be a lively danger if staying in stride. LE DIAMANT DE Jafa (10) races without shoes and could contest the finish back under the saddle. LE BOCAGE (2) was not disgraced last time out and is one of many others that have to be considered possible winners.

**C7 - PRIX D'AQUITAINE - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR €  
18,000**

- 1. NORTH OF GOLD** - A three-year-old gelding by Heart of Gold out of Déesse Téjy who is making his debut. His mother won 3 of her 43 starts. Monitor the betting
- 2. NO COUNTRYNESS** - Disqualified on debut in a class F at this track over 2825m on 23 February. Was unlucky on debut and could make amends if smart
- 3. NOWAK DE BUSSET** - A three-year-old colt by Hohneck out of Calamity Colmine who is making his debut. His Dam was unraced. Others make more appeal
- 4. NEVER ALONE VERTAC** - Finished fifth on debut in a class E at this track over 2825m on 27 October. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 5. NEOH DAIRPET** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, the latest a class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2225m on 16 March. Hard to trust and is best watched for now
- 6. NON STOP** - Disqualified on debut in a class F at Machecoul over 2700m on 15 March. Ran well after disqualification and has claims
- 7. NOURKIS** - Not disgraced on debut when third in a class F at this track over 2825m on 23 February. Can make the frame
- 8. NOXUS JIEL** - Showed promise when third on debut in a class F at Chartres over 2300m on 1 March. Should be involved with the finish once again
- 9. NINETY ONE BOND** - Disqualified on debut in a class F at this track over 2825m on 23 February. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- 10. NASH** - A three-year-old colt by Face Time Bourbon out of Diamantina who is making his debut. Well bred and can get into the mix of things
- 11. NORMAN HAPPY** - A three-year old gelding by Falcao de Laurma out of Happy Des Charrons who is making his debut. His Dam never raced. Monitor the betting

**Summary:** A very tricky race. NON STOP (6) showed promise on debut in that he did well after his disqualification. He could make amends if staying on the trot this time around. So too, for that matter, could NO COUNTRYNESS (2), who was leading before faulting on debut and is a real danger if smarter this time. NOXUS JIEL (8) showed promise on debut and can challenge for top honours. NASH (10) makes his debut but is well bred and is another to consider.

C8 - PRIX DE LA SOMME - 2825m (a2m) - Class F - Mounted - EUR €  
18,000

**1. MARCO DU RIB** - Disqualified in both starts so far, the latest a claimer at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 14 March. Others are preferred

**2. MICHIGAN BLUE** - Disqualified in all three starts so far, the latest a class F at Cordemais over 2825m on 4 January. Remains barefoot but is best watched for now

**3. MAGIC MAESTRO** - Disqualified in a class F at Reims over 2550m on 19 March. Has shown very little so far and others are much preferred

**4. MUST D'OLIVERIE** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a class F harness race at Auch over 2250m on 8 September. Tries barefoot but could need this run returning from a break

**5. MILLE DOLLARS** - Disqualified in a class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2175m on 14 May. Did better on debut but could need this run returning from a break

**6. MILORD DE LA FONTE** - Successful in a class F mounted race at Angers over 2425m on 28 January. Remains barefoot and can double up

**7. MY TOP GIFT** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in a harness claimer at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 14 March. More is needed to beat these rivals

**8. MARIANNE** - Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up in a class F harness race at Amiens over 2900m on 15 March. Has improved barefoot and has a place chance

**9. MALICA MADRIK** - In good shape and was fourth in a class F mounted race at Cordemais over 2825m on 8 March. Remains barefoot and is clearly not out of it

**10. MANAPANIS** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class F mounted race at Cordemais over 2825m on 8 March. Yet to win a race but can make the frame

**11. MODIG VIKING** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 16 February. Consistent and should fight out the finish again

**Summary:** MILORD DE LA FONTE (6) showed what he is capable of with a good win at Angers in January. He is a confident pick to follow up over this course and distance. MODIG VIKING (11) has not been disgraced in her performances at Vincennes and can challenge for top honours. MALICA MADRIK (9) is in good shape and should contest the finish. MANAPANIS (10) has yet to win a race but is capable of making the frame.
