BACK FROM WAR is closely matched with that rival so dangerous to discount with the benefit of her rider's 1,5kg allowance. Last-start winner PALACE DANCER remains competitive under a penalty from gate No 1, as does WARNING SOUND who is unbeaten over track and trip. Lightly raced INTO DANCING isn't taken lightly either.
