- 1. KASPIENNE Well beaten 9th in a class G at Amiens over 2400m on 26 April. Others are much preferred in this line-up
- 2. KATIA DE BRUCOM Finished 6th in a class F at La Capelle over 1800m on 15 June. Others make more appeal in this line-up
- **3. KAMILA DES MONTS -** Unplaced in a class F at this track over 2700m on 28 April. Remains barefoot. Probably best watched for now
- **4. KANZA DE NAVARY -** Disqualified in a class F at Châlons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 25 May.Must be wise to have a chance
- **5. KASSIOPEE** A runner-up in a class E at Lisieux over 2725m on 8 June. Remains barefoot. When applied is competitive and can go close if wise
- **6. KISS ME MENCOURT -** Disqualified in a class G at Strasbourg over 2800m on 15 June. If applied can play a role in the finish
- **7. KASSIE DANOVER -** Finished 7th in a class E at Chartres over 2825m on 18 June. Others are much preferred in this line-up

- **5. KINGSTON SAUTREUIL** Disqualified in a Mounted class G at Arras over 2900m on 9 June. Must be wise to have a chance in this line-up

- **4. JAVA DES AUGERIES -** Finished 8th in a class E at Caen over 2450m on 31 May. A strong finisher who can earn some minor money
- **5. JOHANNA DE BRETT -** Finished 6th in a class F at Strasbourg over 2825m on 15 June. Remains barefoot. Others make more appeal

- **3. KEN FERFAY -** A runner-up in a class D at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 23 February. Remains barefoot. Holding form and is not out of it
- **4. JUGEMENT D'AVE -** Fourth in a class D at Vincennes over 2175m on 7 June. In good form and can be competitive again in this field
- **5. KANAKA DE BUSSET -** Finished 9th in a class C at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 23 May. Reverts to barefoot and can play a role in the finish

- **3. JUNO DAY -** Finished 6th in a Class D over 2550m at Reims on 1 June. He arrives with a potent team in this sort of event and should go close
- **4. JUSTE DE MELLERAY -** Disqualified in a Class H over 2700m at Avranches on 15 June. His previous form is decent so do not ignore. Padded shoes up front this time
- **5. JIOSCO DES CHASSES -** Won a Class F over 2850m at Laon on 8 June. He is in top form and looks likely to double up this time
- **6. JOHN DOE -** Unplaced in a Class F over 3200m at Saint-Omer on 1 June. Needed his comeback run last time and if ready should run well
- **7. JACARTO DE HOUELLE -** Ran 2nd in a Class F over 2950m at Saint-Melo on 9 June. He is rarely far off the winners and he should be in the places
- **8. JAG DE ROZEVIC -** Ran 4th in a Class F over 3150m at Abbeville on 1 June. Has some decent form and could run into the places. Will race with padded shoes in front

- **3. MELIUS AVIS -** Ran 4th in a Class D over 2700m at this course on 25 May. He has been ultraconsistent in his three starts and with experience at this course he looks the main danger
- **4. MAJOR DU RUISSEAU -** Won a Class F over 2750m at La Capelle on 25 May. On the basis of that impressive victory he has to have a winning chance
- **5. MICHELANGELO ZEN -** Finished 3rd in a Class D over 2150 at Mauquenchy on 5 June. He seems better over shorter but has been running well enough to place
- **6. MURPHY DU PONCELET -** Ran 2nd in a Class D over 2750m at La Capelle on 4 May. He followed up a good win with another decent effort and appears to have a lot more to offer
- **7. MYRIADE D'ORION -** Finished 8th in a Class D over 2200m at Vincennes on 10 June. Will need to repeat his third last race to have a chance

**Summary:** MURPHY DU PONCELET (6) followed up an encouraging victory with a decent second place and he looks to have quite a bright future. Based on his last impressive victory, MAJOR DU RUISSEAU (4) has to have a winning chance. If the race is run to suit MICHELANGELO ZEN (5) must have place prospects.

- 2. LABEL MARANCOURT Disqualified in a Class F over 2825m at this course on 25 June. Will need to show more. Races with shoes in front
- **3. LEONARD PEEL -** Won a Class F over 2600m at Chalons-En-Champagne on 8 June. That was a great win on the grass and he looks ready to move up to the next level
- **4. LOZANO -** Disqualified in a Class F over 2700m at this track on 2 June. He ran above his rating and is coming to form. Races fully shod
- **5. LOOK D'AVRIL -** Ran 3rd in a Class F over 2825m at this course on 25 June. Showed vast improvement and would have a chance if continuing to get better
- **6. LUPIN MELOC -** Finished 2nd in a Class F over 2700m at La Capelle on 31 May. That was a very good run and a repeat would give him a chance in an open contest. Races fully shod
- **7. LEADER JIEL -** Ran 3rd in a Class F over 2825m at this course on 18 June. Not the most consistent performer but at his best he has a winning chance
- **8. LE BROK -** Disqualified in a Class F over 2400m at Amiens on 12 June. He was a bit unlucky last time and is better than that run. Shoes in front

- **4. LIZA MARCEAUX -** Won a Class F over 2700m at La Capelle on 31 May. She wasn't pushed to win that race and there looks to be a lot more in the tank
- **5. LOVELY GAZELLE -** Ran unplaced in a Class F over 2700m at this track on 2 June. Recent form has been poor and will race fully shod this time
- **6. LIAISON MESLOISE -** Ran unplaced in a Class F over 2200m at Caen on 25 March, That was her first race after a layoff and may have needed the run. Padded shoes in front
- **7. LOLITA DE LANDEMER -** Finished unplaced in a Class F over 3175m at Abbeville on 11 May. Form does not give one much confidence
- **8. LA MAGIE DU PERSIL -** Ran 9th in a Class F over 2400m at Amiens on 12 June. Will race unshod this time and should make her presence felt
