C1 - PRIX NUNKY - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 41,000

- 1. LIBERATA** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class E at vichy over 2950m on 10 May. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 2. LAURENCE MADRIK** - Not reliable but finished fourth in Class E at Angers over 2125m on 28 January. Could need this run returning from a break
- 3. LOTTA ROSIE** - In good shape and finished fourth in Class E at Avignon over 2650m on 14 May. On a long losing run but has claims in this line-up for Eric Raffin
- 4. LILYROSE WIND** - Showed some improvement when fourth in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 11 June. Might play a minor role at very best
- 5. LAMTARA BUISSONAY** - Victorious last time out in Class E at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 30 May. Has improved of late and cannot be ruled out
- 6. LUCRECE DE CORDAY** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 11 June. Capable of contesting the finish once again
- 7. LUNE LUMALO** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in Class D at Amiens over 2400m on 8 June. Has won a couple of times with this shoeing and must be respected for that
- 8. LIPINSKA** - Remains in very good shape and was runner-up in Class E at Le Mans over 2950m on 21 May. Should be right there at the finish once again
- 9. LIBERTY HEROLD** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class D at Amiens over 2400m on 8 June. Quite capable of earning some more money
- 10. LARAFLE PASMARICK** - Very consistent and finished third in Class E at Reims over 2550m on 31 May. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 11. LA BOISBONNIERE** - Disqualified last time out in Class D at Amiens over 2400m on 8 June. Capable of earning some money when staying in stride
- 12. LA MISS ROYALE** - Disqualified five times in a row, the latest at Laval over 2850m on 11 June. Can be a threat if staying in stride

Summary: LOTTA ROSIE (3) has not added to her debut success at Saint-Galmier in January 2024, but she looks capable of putting that right here. With the significant assistance of Eric Raffin in the sulky, she is taken to come out on top. Main dangers include LUNE LUMALO (7), who boasts an excellent record when racing in this shoeing configuration, and LUCRECE DE CORDAY (6) who comes in the race in fine form and warrants plenty of respect. LA MISS ROYALE (12) should be sharper for her recent return to action and rates another leading contender.

C2 - PRIX SAPIENTIA - 2875m (a2m) - Class D - Mounted - EUR € 46,000

- 1. LUTHER** - Has really struggled this year and was unplaced in a harness race at Savigny-sur-Braye over 3500m on 7 June. Needs major improvement to score
- 2. LE TRESOR KRAAILO** - Not reliable and was disqualified last time out in a Class F mounted race at Nancy over 2600m on 29 May. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 3. LIBERTY DELO** - Has only been modest of late and finished 8th in a Class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2175m on 26 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 4. LA GARBO** - Successful last time out in a Class E mounted race at Nantes over 2275m on 1 June. Not reliable but quite capable of doubling up
- 5. LICAR SOMOLLI** - Off form and finished 9th in a Class D harness race at Laval over 2850m on 3 June. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 6. LEON DE LA COURBE** - In good shape and was third in a Class E mounted race at Vire over 2800m on 18 May. Can earn some minor money at best
- 7. LEDORIKA** - Knocking very hard at the door and was runner-up in a Class D mounted race at Graignes over 2700m on 28 April. Can go one place better
- 8. LERWICK PERRINE** - Consistent of late and finished third in a Class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 21 April. Can earn some more money
- 9. LUCERO TEJY** - Not reliable and finished 8th in a Class D at laval over 2850m on 3 June. Capable of being a real threat back in a mounted race
- 10. L'AS DE COEUR** - In good form and was runner-up in a Class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2175m on 26 May. Should contest the finish if smart

Summary: LEDORIKA (7) has been knocking firmly on the door in recent starts and, with continued application, looks ready to gain a deserved success. She gets the nod ahead of LUCERO TEJY (9), who returns to the mounted code with Eric Raffin taking over in the saddle, a notable booking. L'AS DE COEUR (10) appears to have returned to his best form and commands respect, while recent winner LA GARBO (4) arrives full of confidence and cannot be overlooked.

C3 - PRIX IRENE - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 40,000

- 1. MALDRIC D'ECHAL** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 30 April. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 2. MAFIOSO DREAM** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class D at Vincennes over 2175m on 29 May. Quite capable of making the frame
- 3. MISTRAL POURPRIX** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in Class E over this course and distance on 23 May. Can go one place better
- 4. MAZAR DE VANDEL** - Not reliable but did finish fourth in Class D at Vincennes over 2175m on 29 May. Might play a minor role at very best
- 5. MISTER CARNOIS** - Finished third last time out in a Class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 20 January. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 6. MANY DREAMS** - Usually competitive and finished third in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 9 June. Should fight out the finish once again
- 7. MAGIC FACE** - Finished fifth last time out in Class B at Châtelailon-La Rochelle over 2625m on 28 July. Returns from a break but can earn some money if fit enough
- 8. MAJOR MESLOIS** - Has needed both runs this year, the latest when tenth in Class D at Vire over 2800m on 18 March. Could need this run as well and others are preferred
- 9. MIRADOR PLANCHETTE** - Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Ecommoy over 2750m on 31 May. Capable of an upset on best form
- 10. MAGNUM** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest at Vincennes on 9 June. Capable of scoring if staying on the trot
- 11. MARCUS BERRY** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 9 June. Better this distance and is not out of it
- 12. MISTER FRIPOUILLE** - Unreliable and was fourth in Class D at Lisieux over 2725m on 7 June. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

Summary: MISTRAL POURPRIX (3) caught the eye in no uncertain terms over this course last time and looks capable of going one better if reproducing that level of performance. He is preferred to MAGNUM (10), who is best forgiven his latest effort and is well worth another chance. MANY DREAMS (6) is fitted with this shoeing arrangement for the first time, which could unlock further improvement. MARCUS BERRY (11) is better than his recent form figures suggest and would not be a surprise winner if bouncing back.

C4 - PRIX ECHO - 2875m (a2m) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 46,000

- 1. NOLIO DU BARBEY** - Only modest of late and finished 9th in Class B at Vincennes over 2175m on 2 June. Needs major improvement to score
- 2. NELSON JENILOU** - Disqualified last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 16 June. Hard to trust but is capable of scoring when smart
- 3. NOMAN'S POINT** - Disqualified last time out at cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 7 March. Returns from a break but can be a lively danger if fit enough
- 4. NAVAKI PLANCHETTE** - Successful twice in last three starts, the latest in Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 8 June. Tougher task this time and others are preferred
- 5. NINJA DU PLESSIS** - Unreliable but did finish fourth in Class C at Lisieux over 2725m on 7 June. Capable of earning some more money
- 6. NICOU CHAK** - Disqualified last time out at Vichy over 2950m on 10 June. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 7. NETEYAM** - Consistent and finished third in Class D at Vincennes over 2200m on 9 June. Can get involved with the finish yet again
- 8. NOVIALO** - Not disgraced when fourth in Class D at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 23 May. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 9. NEWTON TUILERIE** - Successful last time out in Class D at Laval over 2850m on 3 June. Improving and looks capable of doubling up
- 10. NOTHING COMPARES** - Remains in very good form and was runner-up in Class D at Vincennes over 2200m on 9 June. Can go one place better

Summary: A highly competitive contest in which several runners have realistic claims. NOTHING COMPARES (10) was arguably an unlucky loser at Vincennes last time, having been denied the opportunity to make his challenge earlier. With a smoother passage, he can make amends. Recent winner NEWTON TUILERIE (9) commands plenty of respect after his latest success. NETEYAM (7) should be thereabouts once again despite having finished behind the selection last time. NELSON JENILOU (2) has the ability to play a major role provided he remains disciplined throughout.

C5 - PRIX ALGINA - 2250m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Mounted - EUR € 40,000

- 1. NEW DANCE** - A three-year-old filly by Royan Dream out of Belly Dance who is making her debut. Her mother won 5 of her 35 starts. Can contest the finish
- 2. NYMPHE PAJELO** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest in class D at Vincennes over 2725m on 19 May. Has major disqualification issues and is best watched for now
- 3. NACRE DU GERS** - Disqualified in class E at Laval over 2850m on 11 June. Did run well in a mounted race before that and can bounce back to score
- 4. NASTREE DU VINOIS** - Disqualified in class G at Elbeuf over 2750m on 14 June. Unreliable and needs to find a few lengths to score
- 5. NOCE DE REVE** - Only modest of late and finished 5th in a class E mounted race at Segre over 2700m on 7 June. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 6. NOOR DE CHENU** - Disqualified in three of four starts so far, including last time out in class E at Vichy over 2200m on 28 May. Victorious in May and has that rider. Not out of it
- 7. NEWLIFE DE CAHOT** - Showed some improvement when 4th in class E at Cherbuorg over 2550m on 14 June. Has disqualification issues but is capable of scoring
- 8. NORMA FIRST** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out in class D at Caen over 2450m on 30 May. Victorious in April and is capable of an upset
- 9. NINON DREAM** - Has struggled of late and was 10th in a class E harness race at Caen over 2450m on 15 June. Yet to win a race and others are preferred
- 10. NYMPHE DE FLEUR** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in class E at Caen over 2450m on 15 June. Capable of doing better and has a place chance
- 11. NOCTURNE DE BUSSET** - Victorious in a class D mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 30 May. Has shown improvement and can double up if smart again

Summary: A race in which manners and reliability could prove decisive. NACRE DU GERS (3) looks well placed in this division and, with Alexandre Abrivard taking the ride, is taken to come out on top. NOCTURNE DE BUSSET (11) made a winning start in this discipline and rates a serious threat. The talented but delicate NOOR DE CHENU (6) is of interest now reunited with Jean-Yann Ricart. The unraced NEW DANCE (1) is worthy of consideration on debut and is best to be monitored in the betting.

**C6 - PRIX MARCEL GOUGEON - 2875m (a2m) - Class R Claiming Amateur Riders - Harness - EUR €
18,000**

1. **KALINA DE LAURIERE** - Did not show her best when unplaced in Class E at la capelle over 2750m on 14 June. In good form before that and can score
2. **KRONOS CAMP** - Has really struggled of late and was unplaced in class G at Thouars over 2700m on 25 May. Capable of much better but is probably best watched for now
3. **KASHKAI** - Showed some improvement when 3rd in class F at Vichy over 2150m on 15 June. On a long losing run but has claims in this line-up
4. **KEZIO JOSSELYN** - Finished 8th in class F at Challons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 8 May. Has room to improve at this level and is not out of it
5. **KULTA** - Disqualified in a claimer at Graignes over 2700m on 13 May. Unreliable but is capable of playing a minor role
6. **KHEOPS SAINT CLAIR** - Has struggled of late and was 10th in a claimer at Vincennes over 2100m on 2 June. Unreliable but might play a minor role
7. **KINNAIRD** - Needed the last run when unplaced in class G at Argentan over 2150m on 13 April. Makes little appeal
8. **KADOR JOSSELYN** - In good shape and was runner up in a claimer at Vincennes over 2100m on 2 June. Can go one place better
9. **KEROS DES BAUX** - Unreliable and finished 8th in class E at Feurs over 2850m 12 June. Victorious back in January and can be a lively danger

Summary: KASHKAI (3) has managed just one victory, recorded in March 2024, but this first venture into claiming company could provide the ideal opportunity to return to winning ways. He is taken to make the most of this drop in grade. The main threats may come from KEZIO JOSSELYN (4) and KEROS DES BAUX (9), both of whom make their first appearances in this category and have the ability to play leading roles if adapting well to the new conditions. KADOR JOSSELYN (8) arrives in good form and also warrants serious consideration, having the profile of a runner capable of capitalizing should the principals fail to deliver.

C7 - PRIX ISTRIA - 2250m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Mounted - EUR € 40,000

1. NOMADE DU KAIROS - A three-year-old gelding by Magnificent Rodney out of Queen Mary Belle who is making his debut. His Dam was unraced in France. Others are preferred

2. NOOKER DREAM - Disqualified in three of four starts, the latest in class G at Elbeuf over 2750m on 14 June. Capable of making the frame if staying in stride

3. NEW DEAL DU ROEN - Unreliable but was 3rd in class E at Reims over 2550m on 26 June. Has shown improvement and is clearly not out of it

4. NAME IS DAIRPET - Not reliable and finished 7th in class C at Vincennes over 2850m on 2 June. Might play a minor role at very best

5. NEWTON DU GRENY - Disqualified in three of four starts so far, the latest in class E at Reims over 2550m on 6 June. Victorious back in May and could upset if smart

6. NEW HOPE DE COUZAN - Victorious in class E at Vichy over 2200m on 28 May. Has shown improvement and can contest the finish once again

7. NINO D'AMOUR - Victorious in a class E mounted race at Segre over 2700m on 7 June. Has shown promise and is capable of doubling up

8. NARCO AS - In good form and finished 3rd in class D at Laval over 2850m on 3 June. Victorious in April and can beat these rivals

Summary: A useful performer in harness races, NARCO AS (8) looks particularly well treated here and could make a winning start under the saddle. Given the quality he has shown in the other discipline, this appears an excellent opportunity to make an immediate impact. The chief threat may come from NEW HOPE DE COUZAN (6), who arrives on the back of a recent success at Vichy. NINO D'AMOUR (7) remains open to further improvement and is expected to take another step forward. NEW DEAL DU ROEN (3) returns to a plated shoeing configuration and is capable of upsetting the principals if everything falls into place.

C8 - PRIX GARUMNA - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class F Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 12,000

- 1. JEALOUS GIRL** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in class F at Vincennes over 2100m on 12 June. Keeps that shoeing and can go one better this time
- 2. IL MIO** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in class F at La Capelle over 1800m on 14 June. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 3. KLARCK DE VANDEL** - Not disgraced when 5th in class G at Vincennes over 2100m on 9 June. Has disqualification issues but is capable of getting into the mix of things
- 4. IVES DES GLENAN** - Victorious in class F at Loudeac over 2850m on 30 May. In good shape and could contest then finish once again
- 5. HERCULE DE BEA** - Showed some improvement when 5th in class E at La Capelle over 2750m on 14 June. On a long losing streak and others are preferred
- 6. JUPITER DU PERCHE** - Did not show his best when 7th in class F at Vincennes over 2100m on 12 June. capable of doing better and has a place chance
- 7. IVAJALE** - Has only been fair of late and was 5th in class F at Vincennes over 2100m on 19 May. Can earn some more money
- 8. KAISER RIVER** - Finished 6th in class F at Vincennes over 2700m on 19 June. Victorious in June and should be a real threat to these rivals
- 9. JOKER D'AMARO** - Returned to form and was runner-up in class G at Vincennes over 2100m on 9 June. Should be competitive once again

Summary: JEALOUS GIRL (1) caught the eye with a strong late effort at Vincennes last time and now returns to a track where she has won twice from just three appearances. Faced with an appealing opportunity, she looks the one to beat. KAISER RIVER (8) makes his first start at this level and is entrusted to Barbara Guenet, a booking that commands respect. JOKER D'AMARO (9) is another major player, having developed a highly effective partnership with Emilie Duperche. KLARCK DE VANDEL (3) is better judged on his earlier form and is worth another chance.
