- **1. FEDE AS -** Unraced since coming last of 9 in a Gr.2 over 2175m here on 7 January and appears to have no realistic chance
- **2. LARA DU GOUTIER -** Fine filly that always gives her best, most recently missing out on losing her maiden status in a 2850m Class B here on 28 February. Aimed higher this time though and others preferred
- **3. LAMIE DU MESNIL -** Good, consistent filly that came a close 2nd in a Class A under these conditions on 10 February. Takes on some tougher elements this time but can at least hold her own
- **4. LIZA JOSSELYN -** Classy filly that flew up in a Class A over course and distance late last month and has every chance of extending her win-rate to 80%
- **5. LOTTA BOURBON -** Won a Class A here late-December before coming 6th of 14 in Gr.3 Prix Roquépine over course and distance on 27 January. Won her only start for Eric Raffin and drops in class with legitimate ambition
- **6. LUNA NOVA GWEN -** Talented filly making her first appearance since trotting last of 7 in Gr.2 Prix Une de Mai over track and trip mid-December. 4 pads fitted for re-entry and, although not a priority, should still acquit herself honourably
- **7. LIZY JOSSELYN -** 3rd to LIZA JOSSELYN (4) in a Class A over course and distance on 25 February. Still has ground to make up but, with form maintained, can trot her way into the money
- **8. LAYLA -** Valiant 2nd to the untouchable LIZA JOSSELYN (4) in a Class A over course and distance on 25 February, having made up considerable ground, and again looks the main threat

Summary: A host of fine fillies here but a clear preference nonetheless goes to LIZA JOSSELYN (4) who ran away with a Class A here late last month and, barring force majeure, should have this in the bag. LAYLA (8) finished a tenacious runner-up to her that day and looks the best of her adversaries, although LOTTA BOURBON (5), who beat the Abrivard's horse last December, will not be far from the action if race-fit. Third to the favourite last time out, LIZY JOSSELYN (7) will generate more interest this time around.

- **2. HANDSOME BOY -** Sanctioned, for 3rd time in a row, in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class F on Monday and will not be easy to trust
- **3. ICARE DU LEARD -** Still had something to give when sanctioned in a Class A over course and distance on 23 February. Shod differently and has a realistic chance of making up for his recent blip
- **4. INDICE DELADOU -** Surprise 4th behind ICARE DU LEARD (3) in a 2200m Vincennes Class D on 13 February but a repeat seems highly unlikely
- **5. HARDI CROWN -** 2nd, with some good fortune, on monté debut 11 days ago in a 2875m Enghien Class D, but will still need to raise his game
- **6. HEURISTIQUE -** Back at the top of her game with 2 straight course-and-distance wins, most recently with authority in a Class C under similar conditions on 20 February. Thrives over 2700m here and will take some beating
- **7. HUIS CLOS (SWE) -** Tricky but talented type that lost his action on re-entry 3 weeks ago in a 2175m Class D here. Will have come on for the run and, with application, can trot his way into the frame
- **8. ISOCRATE D'ELA -** Consistent sort that could well have won a 2850m Laval Class E on 29 February had he not faulted late. Has never delivered over the main track at this level but, in current condition, can change that

- 3. CELESTE BREED Failed to live up to expectations when 12th in a Class D under these conditions on 28 February. Bites off more than she can chew and can be ruled out
- **4. ILIADE (SWE) -** Finished a one-paced 7th of 15 in a similar event late last month. Takes on some even better horses this time and can be passed over
- **5. CINDERELLA JET -** Courageous but never-dangerous 8th in the race of reference and will need to show marked improvement
- **6. LA SASSICAIA -** Showed improvement when 5th in a 2200m Caen Class D on 11 March. Has placed just once in 3 starts here, races unshod behind this time, and not an obvious choice
- **7. BUENA SUERTE BI -** 6th on re-entry, following a long absence, over 2140m at Färjestad on 12 February. Is confirmed here but stays shod and best to wait
- **8. CANADIAN KRONOS -** Honest type that just missed out on 3rd in the 18 February race of reference. Has not won since last summer but form is not in doubt and she is thoroughly capable of picking up a place cheque
- 9. IXORA Valiant 2nd of 11 in a 2150m Enghien Class D 11 days ago. Sports modified configuration this time and must not be underestimated
- **10. IRIS DES CHAMPS -** Has struggled this year, latterly coming 8th of 16 in a 2875m Enghien Class E 2 weeks ago. Gets another chance racing without front shoes but still no more than a minor place prospect
- 11. ICAMORA DE HOUELLE Good dual-discipline mare that finished a 15/1 2nd to IS MAGIC HAUFOR (15) in the race of reference. Is close to her race and can apply the pressure on ISLAND LOVE (12)

The principal threat will be expected to hail from Prix Gacilly 2nd, ICAMORA DE HOUELLE (11) who won over course and distance earlier in the year, 3rd-placed IXORA (9) who races barefoot for just the second time in her career, and next in, CANADIAN KRONOS (8), who has placed at Gr.3 level already this year and who should again figure prominently.

- 3. FOUGUE DU DOLLAR Last of 15, on comeback, in a 2850m Laval Class A 10 days ago and will not be ruffling any feathers
- **4. EPSOM D'HERFRAIE -** Unbeaten in 2 Cagnes starts this year, latterly with authority in a 2925m Gr.3 a month ago. Faces a stiffer test this time but can still hold his own. First 5 chance
- **5. GAMAY DE L'ITON -** Imposed impressively on re-entry 2 weeks ago in a 2825m Class D at Le Croisé-Laroche and, with form maintained, will be no pushover
- **6. IDEAL LIGNERIES -** Has struggled with form since the turn of the year, most recently finishing 10th in the race of reference. Returns to racing unshod behind but others still preferred
- **7. FIGARO DE LARRE -** Finished 1 from last in a 2450m Caen Class D when shod for comeback a fortnight ago. Last of 12 in 2023 edition and unlikely to show much improvement on that
- **8. HAPPY VALLEY -** Came in 7th of 11 behind HORSY DREAM (14) in the race of reference. 8th in the 2023 edition but still represents an interesting outside chance
- **9. GASPAR DE BRION -** Has not been seen out since enduring a bad trip in Gr.3 Prix du Luxembourg over 2100m here on 27 January. Shoes off for comeback and best to wait
- **10. USAIN TOLL -** Pleased on his return to France when 4th in the race of reference. Unlucky 3rd in this race 12 months ago, adores Vincennes, and is not to be overlooked
- **11. GASPAR D'ANGIS -** Courageous 5th behind HORSY DREAM (14) in Prix du Plateau de Gravelle earlier this month. Has nothing to prove under these conditions, as he showed in Gr.2 GNT final, and is not to be underestimated
- **12. ERIC THE EEL -** Did not displease when 7th to EMERAUDE DE BAIS (16) in Gr.1 Critérium de Vitesse over 1609m at Cagnes 2 weeks ago. Has otherwise been in fine form and is never far off causing an upset
- 13. ECHO DE CHANLECY 6th, behind FAKIR DU LORAULT (15), in a 2200m Caen Class D mid-month and will struggle to attract much support

Franck Nivard can still expect to feel the heat from HORSY DREAM (14) who has hind shoes off following his excellent Prix du Plateau de Gravelle performance. A place behind him that day, DESIDERIO D'ESI (2) is proven at at the highest level and should again figure prominently, although he may first have to give way to GAMAY DE L'ITON (5) who was remarkable on his recent provincial re-entry.

- 2. HANIKA DU LUPIN Came close to completing the double when 2nd in a 2850m Laval Class E 10 days ago. Clearly back at the top of her game, starts in front, and could finally open her Vincennes account
- **3. GAMELIA DU LUPIN -** Decent 4th of 12 in a 2850m Maure-de-Bretagne Class E on 11 February. Always gives her best but no fireworks anticipated on Vincennes debut
- **4. HARENA DE MARZY -** Reverts to a proven configuration after faulting in a 2800m Cholet Class F on 25 February. Takes on a tougher bunch this time and not an obvious choice
- **5. HISTORY MAJYC -** Returned to the winners' circle a month ago when outclassing the opposition in a 2100m Vincennes Class E. Benefits from a front-line break but, at this level, will struggle to confirm
- **6. HAUTENTICA -** Hardy mare that was given an easy comeback 3 weeks ago when 9th of 18 in a 2825m Vire Class F. Barefoot this time but others still preferred

- **3. I CAN DREAM** Monté horse making first appearance since trotting 8th of 14 on re-entry in a Gr.3 over track and trip late-November and will have other priorities
- **4. CASH BANK BIGI -** Faulted in last 3 starts, most recently a Class B over course and distance on 1 March. Has merit but in current shape is not easy to like
- **5. HAVE A DREAM -** Going well when sanctioned under similar conditions 3 weeks ago. Not the most reliable but has solid references in elevated company and should be good enough to pick up some first-5 prizemoney

- **4. KWARTZ SIBEY -** Missed out by little in a 2175m Class C here on 11 February. Barefoot as he steps up in class and, although an improving type, he cannot be considered a priority
- **5. KEPI DU HOME** Sanctioned when never threatening in Gr.3 Prix Franck Anne 3 weeks ago. Has not come on as hoped and, even though fitted with a new configuration, is not about to shake things up

- 2. DONNER AMOUR Has taken well to Vincennes conditions when barefoot. Untried over 2850m here, and steps up in class, but is still worth keeping an eye on
- 3. DIE HARD (ITY) Pleasantly surprised when 5th, a place behind DAMASCO EFFESSE (1), in a Class E over 2700m here on 25 February but will struggle to leave his mark on this occasion
- **4. JIBI DU FRUITIER** Honest mare that came 4th to JAZZMAN DEBAILLEUL (14) in the race of reference, despite not being entirely at his ease. David Thomain takes over the reins and will give him his usually competitive drive
- **5. YAHOO DIAMANT -** Returns to Paris after coming 4th in a Gelsenkirchen prep over 2000m a fortnight ago. Appreciates Vincennes and the Eric Raffin-factor will only help his cause
- **6. JIGSAW PUZZLE -** Modest 7th of 8 in a 2925m Cagnes Class F. Yet to recapture last summer's form and represents no more than a minor place chance
- 7. JAMAICA D'AURCY Quality mare that was sanctioned in the race of reference. Shoes on this time and best to keep one's powder dry
- **8. JAZZ DE PERVENCHE -** Made little impact when 7th to JEWEL DE BANVILLE (16) in a similar event on 9 February and racing shod does him no favours
- 9. JABALPUR Looked one race shy when 5th to JAZZMAN DEBAILLEUL (14) here earlier in the month. Will have come on since and will be more competitive this time around
- 10. JULIANA DE RETZ 4th of 5, on comeback, in a 2700m monté Class A here a month back. Here for reasons of conditioning and no threat
- 11. JASMIN PRECIEUX Courageous runner-up to JAZZMAN DEBAILLEUL (14) in a Class B over 2700m here on 1 March. Paul Ploguin back in the wagon and, if still on the boil, can again make the frame
- 12. JOCONDE SIBEY Has not been seen out since securing the hat-trick in a 2700m Class B here on 20 January. Shoes on this time though and best to wait
- 13. JAGUAR DU GOUTIER Unraced since finishing 8th of 9 in a 2700m Gr.3 here 2 months ago. Shoes on and can be ruled out
- **14. JAZZMAN DEBAILLEUL -** Comfortable winner of a 2700m Vincennes Class B early this month, making it 3 from 4, and is eminently capable of pulling off the 3-timer
- 15. JINGLE DELO Reassured somewhat when 5th of 12 in a 2450m Caen Class B on 11 March. Front shoes off this time but others still easier to trust
- **16. JEWEL DE BANVILLE -** Won over course and distance before being sanctioned in a 2700m monté Class A here a month ago. Unlikely to pick up where he left off under harness, but can still pick up some prizemoney
- **Summary:** JAZZMAN DEBAILLEUL (14) has enjoyed a whirlwind of success since starting to race in his current configuration and will again be a tough nut to crack. JASMIN PRECIEUX (11) produced quite the performance to run second to him here earlier in the month and will not be available at 78/1 this time around. A disappointing 5th on that occasion, JABALPUR (9) has had time to get back in shape and should prove a decent first-3 contender. YAHOO DIAMANT (5) has yet to disappoint here, goes barefoot for the occasion, and gets the services of the champion driver.
