C1 - PRIX LE BIG BOSS - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Mounted - EUR € 30,000

1. **HULK DU SABLIER** - Unreliable and finished 8th in class E at Lyon La Soie over 2050m on 17 January. Capable of an upset on best form
2. **DEE GODFATHER** - In very good form and was a winner at Eskilstuna over 2140m on 14 December. Big player on first run back French soil
3. **JEEK D'ACADIE** - Consistent and was third in class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2825m on 8 January. Can get involved with the finish
4. **ILLUSTRE DE CHENOU** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in class G at Agen-le-Passage over 2625m on 11 January. Needs to do more to score
5. **ILLUSION DU VAL** - Not reliable and finished 6th in class F at Lyon La Soie over 2050m on 10 December. May need to do more to beat these rivals
6. **JIM JULRY** - Much improved last run when runner-up in class E at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 7 December. Can earn some more money
7. **LEROY BOKO** - In good shape and was runner-up at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 26 December. Has done well on French soil so far and can go one place better
8. **IDEAL DE BANNES** - Did not show his best when 7th in class E at Vichy over 2950m on 25 June. Capable of doing better and might play a minor role
9. **GIPSY THORIS** - Off form and was unplaced in a Claimer over this course and distance on 18 January. Needs major improvement to win
10. **JOKER DU HAMEL** - Unreliable and finished fifth in class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2825m on 23 December. Reverts to barefoot and has a place chance
11. **ANOTHER CREATION** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in class D at this track over 2650m on 18 January. Others are much preferred
12. **FOREVER DE PAME** - Not reliable and was unplaced in class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 27 December. Capable of doing better but others make more appeal
13. **IAGO ROSE** - Remains in good shape and was runner-up in class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 11 December. Can be competitive once again
14. **IMPERIAL KEY** - Successful in class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 11 December. Effective under the saddle and remains barefoot. Can follow up
15. **FOX TROT CERISE** - Battling to find best form and finished 9th in class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 13 December. Needs to find a few lengths to score

Summary: A very competitive opening event. IMPERIAL KEY (14) is very effective under the saddle. He was a good winner at Marseille-Vivaux over this distance last month and can follow up, so gets a narrow vote. LEROY BOKO (7) remains in very good form and will not go down without challenging for top honours. DEE GODFATHER (2) has some solid wins of late and would not be a surprise winner. IAGO ROSE (13) is also in good shape and is another to consider.

C2 - PRIX D'HIVER - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. MIDORIYA DU BOURG** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class A at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 15 November. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 2. MAUZIN DE CROUAY** - Unreliable and finished 8th in class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 29 November. Tries barefoot and could be a threat
- 3. MISTA GUILLERVILLE** - Successful in a class E at Lyon La Soie over 2700m on 10 January. Looked good that day and is capable of doubling up
- 4. MANOLITA** - Not reliable and finished 7th in class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 16 January. Remains barefoot and is not out of it
- 5. MARUDA** - Unreliable and was third in class A at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 15 November. Returns from a break but has a place chance
- 6. MAGELLAN FOR CLARA** - Did not show his best when 6th in class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 16 January. Might need to do more to beat these rivals
- 7. MOULU JIHEM** - Did not show his best when 6th in class B at Vichy over 2800m on 19 June. Quite capable of contesting the finish
- 8. MADRILENE** - Not reliable and finished 9th in a class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 24 December. Tries barefoot and can bounce back to score
- 9. MODE VANILLE** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in class A at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 15 November. Might need this run returning from a break
- 10. MY LOVE GIO** - Disqualified in class B at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 22 October. Not easy to trust but can earn some money returning from a break

Summary: A very open race. MADRILENE (8) is barefoot for the very first time and was a good winner on her penultimate start, so could score with improvement expected. MISTA GUILLERVILLE (3) won well at Lyon-La Soie last time and could follow up if in the same mood. MANOLITA (4) is not reliable but looks capable of getting into the mix on best form. MOULU JIHEM (7) is clearly better than his last run would suggest and can be a lively danger this time around.

17,500**

- 1. LEYLI DE LA VALLEE** - Disqualified in class E at Lyon La Soie over 2700m on 10 January. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 2. LADY D'ALEX** - Has struggled of late and was 10th in class E at Lyon La Soie over 2050m on 10 December. Needs major improvement to win
- 3. LOST** - Disqualified in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 28 September. Remains barefoot and can earn some money when smart
- 4. LIBERO DE LOU** - Showed improvement when fourth in a class F mounted race at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 4 January. Reverts to barefoot and can be a threat
- 5. LOVA DE BOURGOGNE** - Unreliable and finished third in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2100m on 13 December. Might earn some minor money
- 6. LOUNA LA TRIGALE** - Consistent and was third in class E at Lyon La Soie over 2700m on 19 January. Can earn some more money
- 7. L'OCEAN** - Unreliable and finished 7th in class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 18 January. Has a place chance on best form
- 8. LUTIN DU JOUR** - Has improved of late and was fourth in class D at Lyon La Soie over 2050m on 17 January. Capable of making the frame
- 9. LEVE TOI** - Disqualified in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2100m on 13 December. In good form before that and can contest the finish
- 10. LOCAPO DU BOCAGE** - Off form and was unplaced in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2100m on 13 December. Others are much preferred
- 11. LUCKY BENOIT** - In good form and finished third in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 30 November. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish
- 12. LIBERIAN GIRL** - Successful in a claimer at this track over 2675m on 30 August. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 13. LAPON DE BERTRANGE** - Did not show his best when unplaced in class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 29 December. Capable of doing better and is not out of it
- 14. L'INDIEN PEARL** - Disqualified in class F at Toulouse over 2325m on 3 January. In good form before that and can bounce back to score

Summary: An interesting race. L'INDIEN PEARL (14) needed his last run and should strip fitter this time. He can bounce back to beat these rivals if in the right mood. LUCKY BENOIT (11) remains in good form and can challenge for top honours again. LUTIN DU JOUR (8) has shown improvement and drops in class here, so should be in the thick of things. LAPON DE BERTRANGE (13) is quite capable of winning a race of this nature and has to be considered too.

Harness - EUR € 30,000**

- 1. HADES JULRY** - Has struggled of late and was 10th in class E at Lyon La Soie over 2700m on 10 January. Needs major improvement to win
- 2. IDAGANI POINT ONE** - Finished unplaced in class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 27 December. Might play a minor role at very best
- 3. HELLO BOY DU PIC** - Not reliable and finished 7th in class D at this track over 2650m on 18 January. Needs to do more to score
- 4. JOBALASKO BLEU** - Disqualified in class E at Lyon La Soie over 2700m on 19 January. Reverts to barefoot but is hard to trust and others are preferred
- 5. HODRIGO EVER** - Did not show his best when 10th in class F at Lyon La Soie over 2700m on 10 December. Capable of doing better but others are preferred
- 6. KANDIE D'ORCO** - Has struggled of late and finished 10th in class C at Vincennes over 2100m on 21 November. Remains barefoot and could play a minor role
- 7. RUGER** - Unreliable and finished 10th in a class E at Vincennes over 2850m on 13 January. Reverts to barefoot and is not out of it on best form
- 8. JOB DES LOUANGES** - Disappointing last run when 9th in a class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 13 December. Did better before that and can make the frame
- 9. GRANIT PACO** - Disqualified in class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 January. Reverts to barefoot and is capable of an upset
- 10. IMPACT CASTELETS** - A winner of a claimer at this track over 2650m on 18 January. Remains barefoot but more is needed to win this race
- 11. ISSU DES LOYAUX** - Not reliable and finished 8th in class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 29 October. Remains barefoot and is not out of it
- 12. JANDICE STAR** - Not disgraced when fifth in class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 17 December. Remains barefoot and has claims in this line-up
- 13. KING DRY** - Not reliable and finished 6th in class E at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 17 January. Remains barefoot and can get involved with the finish
- 14. BOMBER MAN** - Holding form and finished fourth at Montegiorgio over 2500m on 31 December. Reverts to barefoot but this is a tougher race

Summary: JANDICE STAR (12) was not disgraced in her recent runs in better races than this and is capable of winning a contest of this nature. KING DRY (13) was only modest a week ago but should be a real threat taking a slight drop in grade. RUGER (7) races without shoes this time, so expect a much better performance. JOB DES LOUANGES (8) is clearly better than his last run would suggest and is another capable of shining brightly.

- 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. KOMANIA D'ABY** - Not reliable and finished 9th in class F at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 14 November. Capable of a surprise
- 2. KEEN DE MAHEY** - Disqualified in class F at Carpentras over 2650m on 4 October. Not easy to trust and could need this run returning from a break
- 3. KIYOHADA DE NAPPES** - Victorious in a class F at Cavaillon over 2600m on 30 August. Returns from a break but does have the ability to win if fit enough
- 4. KATHARINA DE MAI** - Much improved last run when third in class E at Lyon La Soie over 2700m on 10 January. Can be competitive once again
- 5. KOETANE D'AVRIL** - Not disgraced when fifth in class E at Lyon La Soie over 2700m on 10 January. Reverts to barefoot and could score this time around
- 6. KALINE DU CORTA** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in class E at Lyon La Soie over 2700m on 10 January. Reverts to barefoot and might play a minor role
- 7. KELLY DE CERISY** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in class F at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 8 November. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 8. KYRIELLE D'ALBRET** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 8 January. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 9. KIM BLUE** - Unreliable and finished 7th in class E at Lyon La Soie over 2700m on 11 November. Needs to do more to score
- 10. KISS THE MOON** - Showed some improvement when fourth in class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 16 January. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish
- 11. KOPALINE DE CHENOU** - Unplaced in class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 10 December. Capable of doing better and is not out of it

Summary: KOETANE D'AVRIL (5) did win for this driver at this track in November and looks the one to be with for Theo Briand back in the kart. KIYOHADA DE NAPPES (3) has not been seen since August but does have ability and is capable of winning if fit enough. KISS THE MOON (10) has shown improvement of late and can get involved with the finish once again. KATHARINA DE MAI (4) was an excellent finisher last time out and must be given some respect in this line-up.

Harness - EUR € 23,000**

- 1. L'ILE DU TRIEUX** - Unreliable and was disqualified last time out in Class E over this course and distance on 18 January. Others make more appeal
- 2. LEADER CATZ** - In good shape and was third in Class D at Lyon-La Soie over 2050m on 17 January. Can be competitive once again
- 3. LABEL MESS** - A winner of two of his last three starts, including in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2725m on 11 November. Can score again
- 4. LOU D'ECHAL** - In good shape and was runner-up in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2725m on 11 November. Might play a minor role
- 5. LUPIN DE BEAFOUR** - Unreliable and finished 6th in Class E at Toulouse over 2975m on 15 January. Did win his penultimate start and has a place chance
- 6. LEADER OAKS** - Faulted last time out at Vincennes over 2700m on 17 December. Hard to trust and others are preferred this time
- 7. LOVE ME DE CERISY** - Faulted last time out in a Class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 26 November. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 8. LILY CARNOIS** - Unreliable and finished 7th in Class E at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 8 November. Might play a minor role at very best
- 9. LORKY RED** - A barefoot winner last time out in Class E at Toulouse over 2975m on 15 January. Not fully barefoot this time but is not out of it
- 10. LA PRIMAVERA** - A winner of her last two starts, the latest in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2725m on 11 November. Can complete a hat-trick
- 11. LIBERTY DU MORTIER** - Not reliable and finished 5th in Class D at Lyon-La Soie over 2050m on 17 January. More is needed to beat these rivals

Summary: LA PRIMAVERA (10) returns from a short break but has been very good of late. She won some nice races last year and generally runs well fresh, so gets the vote to score. LORKY RED (9) impressed with a solid barefoot win at Toulouse but is not fully unshod this time around. He remains hard to rule out. LABEL MESS (3) also comes in the race on the back of some solid performances and would not be a surprise winner. LEADER CATZ (2) is another in good form and can contest the finish.

- EUR € 23,000

- 1. JESSIE DU HAUTVENT** - Unreliable and finished 7th in Class G over this track and trip on 18 January. Needs to do more to score
- 2. JOURNEY** - Has really struggled of late and finished tenth in a claimer at Vincennes over 2100m on 9 January. Needs major improvement to win
- 3. JOHANNA ELEVEN** - Battling to find best form and was 8th in Class F at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 20 June. Should need this run returning from a break
- 4. JACKIE IS BACK** - Unreliable and finished 11th in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 17 January. Barefoot this time and could earn some money
- 5. JEZABELLE BEZILLAT** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Lyon-La Soie over 2050m on 17 January. Not easy to trust but does have a place chance
- 6. JUST ELGE DESBOIS** - Not reliable but did run well when third in Class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 17 January. Can make the frame
- 7. JACK REACHER** - Showed some improvement when third in Class E at Montauban over 2400m on 28 December. Can get involved with the finish
- 8. JINGLE KOP** - Remains in good form and finished third in Class E at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 7 October. Returns from a break but could earn some money
- 9. JENJOY MAYBE** - Very consistent and finished third in Class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 17 January. Should be right there at the finish
- 10. JACKASS LATIN** - Unreliable but did win in Class G at Lyon-La Soie over 2050m on 13 December. Not one to trust but cannot be ruled out
- 11. JIVAGO BLEU** - Only modest of late and finished 5th in Class G at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 30 December. More is needed to win this race
- 12. JOLISSIME ELDE** - Not reliable but was a good third in Class F at Feurs over 2100m on 15 October. Returns from a break but is capable of winning

Summary: JOLISSIME ELDE (12) returns from a break but has been prepared for this race, so could win if fit enough. JACK REACHER (7) showed improvement at Montauban and can contest the finish with further progress to offer. JUST ELGE DESBOIS (6) is unreliable but did run well at Agen-Le Passage and can be a lively danger on the back of this effort. JENJOY MAYBE (9) is very consistent and is sure to be competitive over this course and distance, so must be respected too.

- 1. KID PADDLE** - Has struggled of late and finished 10th in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 10 January. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 2. KLIC JULRY** - Unreliable and finished 6th in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 10 January. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 3. KIMCHI D'ELIOTT** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 11 January. Capable of playing a minor role
- 4. KEEP TIME** - Did not show his best when 7th in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 10 January. Races without shoes and has a place chance
- 5. KLIMT MERITE** - Has lost his way and was disqualified last time out at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 11 September. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 6. KENAVO DU BOUILLON** - Much improved of late and was victorious in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 10 January. Has disqualification issues but can follow up
- 7. KUNG FU FAMILY** - Not reliable but did run well when fourth in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 10 January. Can make the frame
- 8. KISS BOY** - Holding form and finished fourth in Class E at Toulouse over 2950m on 11 April. Returns from a break and should need this run
- 9. KONOR HIGHLAND** - Only modest of late and was 9th in Class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 10 December. Needs to do more to score
- 10. KANNABIS JELOCA** - Very consistent and was third in Class F at Vincennes over 2700m on 21 December. Should be right there at the finish once again
- 11. KANTISSIME WINNER** - Unreliable and finished 8th in Class D at Lyon-La Soie over 2050m on 19 January. Better over this distance and has a place chance
- 12. KINGSLEY** - Not easy to trust and was disqualified at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 10 December. Capable of winning when staying in stride
- 13. KADENCE MAN** - Unreliable but did run well when third in Class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 January. Can get involved with the finish when smart
- 14. KID DE LA BANIO** - Did not show his best when 8th in Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 13 January. Capable of doing better and is not out of it

Summary: A very competitive lucky last race. KANNABIS JELOCA (10) is usually very effective in this division and should make a bold bid at beating these rivals. KID DE LA BANIO (14) is better than his last run would suggest and can get into the mix of things if back on song. KADENCE MAN (13) is unreliable but should not be excluded of the equation as he could win if in the right state of mind. KENAVO DU BOUILLON (6) has disqualification issues but has also been good of late and must be considered a possible winner.
