- **1. KAFE GOURMAND AA -** In good form and was victorious last time out in a Conditions hurdle race at Agen-Le Passage over 3600m on 31 March. Can follow up if in the same mood
- **2. VIRTUOSE AA -** Unreliable and was 13th in a handicap chase at Compiegne over 3900m on 24 March. Capable of better and could contest the finish
- **3. KASTLE DE LAGARDE AA -** Yet to win a race and 8th last time out in a Conditions chase at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 4200m on 5 April. Capable of earning some money
- **4. SHAKRIMA AA -** Returned from a break in good form and finished third in a Condition hurdle at Pau over 3500m on 31 January. Has a winning chance
- **5. LOKI DE LA BRUNIE AA -** Showed vast improvement when third in a Conditions chase at Montluçon Néris-les-Bains over 3500m on 30 March. Might play a minor role
- **6. LUGANO AA -** Finished third in a Conditions hurdle at Agen-Le Passage over 3600m on 31 March. Should contest the finish
- **7. SHERKARA AA -** Showed improvement when runner-up in a Conditions hurdle at Agen-Le Passage over 3600m on 31 March. Be right there at the finish
- **8. LORA DE LA BRUNIE AA -** Has run well in both starts and was fourth last time out in a Conditions hurdle at Agen-Le Passage over 3600m on 31 March. Not out of it
- **9. ISEULT DU PACS AA -** Returns from a break but did run well when third in a Conditions hurdle at Mont-de-Marsan over 3600m on 8 December. Can earn some money

Summary: SHAKRIMA AA (4) finished strongly when third at Pau in January. She should be fitter for that run and looks the one to beat. - 2. MOMINA Has not been disgraced in both starts and finished third last time out in a Conditions race at Mont-de-Marsan over this distance on 23 March. Can contest the finish
- **3. INTISAR DE MONLAU -** Finished 7th last time out in a Group 1 at Saint-Cloud over this distance on 4 October. A winner of her first two starts and can bounce back to score returning from a break
- **4. AL RASHA -** Not disgraced when 5th in a Group 2 over this course and distance on 30 August. Can be competitive in this line-up
- **5. ALHAAN -** Returned from a break and was victorious in a Conditions race at Mont-de-Marsan over 2000m on 23 March. Fit and can follow up

- **2. VALSE DU NORD -** Yet to win a race and was unplaced last time out in a Conditions chase at Mont-de-Marsan on 13 April. Could earn some minor money
- **3. MAVERICK LADY -** Yet to win a race and was 5th last time out in a claiming chase at Fontainebleau over 2600m on 3 December. More is needed to win this race
- **4. DIODAM -** Returned from a break and was a winner last time out in a Conditions hurdle at Moulins over 2800m on 9 March. Can complete a hat-trick
- **5. DEMON VERT -** Yet to win a race and was unplaced last time out in a Conditions hurdle at Toulouse over 3900m on 19 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win

Summary: KARA DIAMOND (11) returned from a lengthy break and fell last time out at Pau, but she showed plenty of promise over the smaller obstacles and should make a bold bid. DIODAM (4) is progressive and bids for a hat-trick after two solid wins—he commands plenty of respect. BEAUBOURG (6) finished runner-up on his return and is not without a chance. ROSE ROUGE (1) is another who's knocking on the door.

- **3. MUKATEL AL SHAHANIA -** Not disgraced whn 5th in a Group 1 at Saint-Cloud over 2000m on 4 October. Capable of making the frame returning from a break
- **4. MONEER -** Victorious last time out in a Conditions race at this track over 1900m on 2 April. Fit and should contest the finish

- **3. VERTIGO POMPADOUR AA -** A runner-up in a Conditions race at Toulouse over 2400m on 17 November. A consistent sort who can be involved in the finish
- **4. FENG SHUI DU PECOS AA -** A runner-up in a Conditions race at Tarbes over 2300m on 6 April. Improved second effort and will be fitter

- **4. THE BLACK SKY -** Fourth in a Claimer at Fontainebleau over 2000m on 1 April. Others make more appeal in this line-up
