# C1 - PRIX PAUL DELANOE - 2850m (a2m) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 24,000

- **1. KADO SURPRISE -** Won 2 from 3 before running 3rd of 7 finishers in a 2850m Class F at Maure-de-Bretagne a month back. Is clearly close to his best and will be no soft touch
- **2. KALL ME CENSERIE** 8th of 14 in a 2700m Vincennes Class E on 8 April. Cannot be considered a priority but the engagement of Matthieu Abrivard will do his prospects no disservice
- **3. KING DE CHANLECY -** Returns to a track he appreciates after being sanctioned in a 2700m Vincennes Class E earlier in the month. Takes on a tough bunch of horses though and is unlikely to rock the boat
- **4. KELMONDO BOY -** Won a 3200m Vannes Class F on re-entry 11 days ago. Steps back up in category, with morale intact, and is not incapable of bringing home the bacon
- **5. KOKO MARBOULA -** Disappointing so far this term, latterly sanctioned in a 3250m Saumur Class F on 30 March, and will struggle to make his presence felt
- **6. KING TURGOT -** Sanctioned on return to competition in a 2875m Argentan Class E on 19 March. Is never far from faulting and is no great fan of Laval, but can surprise and should not be ruled out
- **7. KILOU -** Pleased on Caen comeback before faulting in a 2875m Argentan Class E on 19 March. Has merit but may just be taking on too much
- **8. KEOPS DES HAUBOIS -** Last but one, on re-entry, in a 2150m Enghien Class E a week ago. Is patently better than that, likes Laval, and if focused will take all the beating
- **9. KLARCK DE VANDEL -** Last of 12 when being prepared for this in a 2150m Enghien Class E a week ago. Is confirmed in the category and barefoot this time is not to be underestimated

**Summary:** Sent for a spell after running 2nd under these conditions, KEOPS DES HAUBOIS (8) lost all chance at the start on re-entry but is plainly a horse of significant ability and Anthony Dollion can be justifiably confident of setting the record straight. He will nonetheless be watching out for KELMONDO BOY (4) who made a victorious return to the track, and KADO SURPRISE (1) who has returned to racing left-handed with ample success. KLARCK DE VANDEL (9) is plainly better than recent numbers would suggest and is back barefoot with a good hand to play.

# C2 - PRIX THIERRY DENUAULT - 2850m (a2m) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 27,000

- **1. JOYAU DE MORTREE -** Last but one in a 2625m Cherbourg monte Class G on Monday and backs up shod and with no possible chance
- 2. INCISIF VAUCEEN Lost his action in a 2800m Cholet Class E on Monday. Hind shoes off for first time but others still preferred
- **3. JINA DE L'ORMERIE -** 7th of 16 in a 2825m Cordemais Class E on 30 March. Is new to the venue and unlikely to make much impact
- **4. ISKO D'IQUAINE -** Useful trotter making first appearance since being sanctioned in a 3000m Nantes Class F mid-January, but is going to need the race
- **5. JOCKEY -** Made it 2 on the trot when comfortably winning a 2825m Class F at Le Croise-Laroche late last month. Competitively-shod this time and can bring the fight to JANE CASH (13)
- **6. JAZZY FLIGNY -** Sanctioned when well-supported in a 3125m Angers Class F 2 weeks ago. Eric Raffin in the bike and warrants considerable respect
- **7. ITALIQUE DU CLOS -** Just failed to pull off the hat-trick early last month when 2nd of 18 in a 2675m Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel. Steps up in category and returns to racing left-handed, but still looks capable of getting in on the action
- **8. ICONE DU GARDEN -** 7th of 18 in a 3125m Angers Class E on 22 March. Is being aimed too high this time and can be passed over
- **9. JOIE D'AMOUR -** Returned to winning ways 10 days ago when easily securing a 2150m Argentan amateurs Class G. Takes on a better lot this time but is in sufficiently good form to make first 5
- **10. JASMINE DE JYR -** Showed improvement at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne earlier in the month when 3rd of 15 in a 2675m Class F. Gets on well with her driver and should not be overlooked
- **11. JASMIN PHIL -** Back under harness after finishing 6th of 9 in a 2875m Enghien monte Class E a week ago. Barefoot this time but still not a priority
- **12. JOCDOR -** Starts for first time since October 2023. Still being conditioned and poses no danger
- **13. JANE CASH -** In the frame in 2 of last 3, most recently 2nd of 16 in a 2875m Class E at Meslay-du-Maine on 18 March. Shod as she was when 2nd here last summer and has a realistic chance of opening her 2025 account
- **14. IZAAC D'HAVAROCHE -** 3rd over course and distance in an amateurs event prior to faulting in a 2100m Vincennes amateurs Class G on 8 April, and others easier to trust
- **15. JERICHO DU RIB -** 10th of 11 finishers behind JOCKEY (5) in a Class E over course and distance, on re-entry, mid-February. Has not been seen since but if close to fit, can put on a good show
- **16. JAMAICA DE LOU -** Close 3rd behind JANE CASH (13) at Meslay before coming 3rd of 18 in a 2450m Caen Class E in late-March. Is plainly on the boil and will be competitive for a spot on the podium

**Summary:** A tough nut to crack when unshod, JANE CASH (13) returns to a successful formula, at a track she appreciates, and may just have the edge over JOCKEY (5) who sports front pads for his hat-trick bid. Wonderfully-entered at the limit of earnings, and plainly in shape, JAMAICA DE LOU (16) has been similarly-shod and is unlikely to disappoint. JERICHO DU RIB (15) has a race under his belt and, if applied, can figure prominently.

# C3 - PRIX JEAN MARY - 2850m (a2m) - Class D Amateur Riders Race - Mounted - EUR € 31,000

- **1. HEROS JARZEEN -** Flattering 5th of 6 here last month prior to faulting in a 2700m Meral amateurs harness Class H 2.5 weeks ago, and has no realistic chance
- **2. IMAGINE GIRL -** Returns to the code after being sanctioned in a 3200m Vannes harness Class F 11 days ago. Shoes on this time and others easier to back
- 3. ELOGE DE LARA 2nd of 10, on first start since the break, in a 2550m in an amateurs Class H at Gournay-en-Bray a month ago, but a repeat seems improbable
- **4. ZANZA FRANK -** 3rd of 10 to IDEAL DU NOYER (10) in a 2550m Reims Class D a fortnight ago, on first start since October. Will have cone on for the race and must be considered a contender
- **5. IGNACE GUENESERIE -** Last of 6 in a 2175m Vincennes Class D in late-February. Enjoys a good record with his partner though who will be eager to repeat last performance here in February
- **6. HERCULE DES SABLES -** Quality element making first appearance since coming 4th of 9 in a 2850m Vincennes Class D on 20 February. Shoes on for comeback and best to wait
- **7. VASTERBO IMTHEMAN -** Versatile Swede that ran 3rd of 11 in a 2700m Vincennes Class E on 22 March. Comes to Laval fresh and will be expected to contest the finish
- **8. FALAISIEN DU RIB -** Looked decidedly ordinary when 12th of 14 in a 2875m Argentan Class F 10 days ago and latest numbers do nothing to inspire confidence
- **9. GET UP BROWN -** Last but one, a place behind FALAISIEN DU RIB (8), in a 2875m Argentan Class F 10 days ago. Shoes on once more and best to hold off
- **10. IDEAL DU NOYER -** Met little opposition on re-entry when successful in a 2550m Reims Class D a fortnight ago. Will have come on for the run and a repeat is well within his capacity
- **11. ILEO PIERJI -** Oddly below-par when 7th of 11 behind VASTERBO IMTHEMAN (7) in a 2700m Vincennes Class E on 22 March. Has otherwise been in dec form and enjoys a decent chance to set things straight
- **12. HANDSOME BOY -** 4th of 9 in a 2875m Enghien Class E a week ago, on first start for 2 months. Appreciates these conditions and can again finish in the mix
- **13. GAVROCHE D'OMBLAIS -** Sanctioned early but nevertheless showed his form in a Class E over track and trip on 12 March. In this company though will have nothing to offer
- **14. FOREVER D'ARIANE -** Returns to the monte code after being sanctioned in a 3200m Fougeres Class E a month ago and can expect to have few friends in the markets
- **15. FIDELIO DU LOISIR -** Back under the saddle after finishing 9th of 11 in a 2600m Parilly harness claimer 2 weeks ago. Has yet to deliver at Laval but enjoys an excellent entry and does not make the trip just to see the sights

**Summary:** As consistent as they come when racing barefoot, IDEAL DU NOYER (10) comfortably imposed on re-entry at Reims and even racing with 4 pads for the first time still looks good enough to double up. That said, VASTERBO IMTHEMAN (7) has taken to the discipline like a fish to swimming and makes his Laval debut with a lot to offer. The same can be said of Italian import ZANZA FRANK (4) who ran 3rd to Marc Sassier's horse on his own return to competition. Consistently in the thick of things when applied, HANDSOME BOY (12) has previously imposed here with hind shoes off and is easy to recommend for a place on the podium.

- **1. INDY DARK -** 9th of 16 on return to competition 3 weeks ago in a 3100m Angers Gr.3. Is still being conditioned and best to hold off
- 2. GENET DE BOITRON 11th of 14 behind HUNT (10) in a 2400m Amiens Class D 2.5 weeks ago. Went off the boil last autumn and can be disregarded
- **3. INDIGO PIERJI -** Endured all sorts of woes when 6th of 14 behind HUNT (10) in a 2400m Amiens Class D 2.5 weeks ago. Form is not in question and with his trainer back in the bike, should logically make amends and can impose
- **4. HERMES LUDOIS -** 10th of 14 behind HUNT (10) in a 2400m Amiens Class D 2.5 weeks ago. Stays shod this time and can be confidently passed over
- **5. GALLAGHER WIND -** Unseen since being sanctioned in a 2850m Vincennes monte Class D mid-December and can expect to have few friends
- **6. IMOKO JIBELAU -** Sanctioned, on first start since the break, in a 2800m Pontchateau Class D last week. Stays shod and best to wait
- **7. FRANKLIN DE MESLAY -** Has not been seen out since finishing last but one in a 2850m Vincennes Class C last August and will need the run
- **8. FILOU SMILING -** 8th of 18 behind GRAND SOURIRE (13) in a 2625m Cherbourg Class D earlier in the month. Barefoot as he was when placing here in early-March and should not be ruled out
- **9. HOLD UP RANAIS -** Good 3rd of 11 in a 2150m Enghien Class D early last month. Comes here fresh, sports modified shoeing, and will be expected to play an active role
- **10. HUNT -** Good 2nd of 14 in a 2400m Amiens Class D 2.5 weeks ago. Has yet to be bested at Laval and Florian Desmigneux will be keen to keep that fact relevant
- **11. FELICITA D'ECOUVES -** Unthreatening 7th of 12 in a 2325m Toulouse Class B a fortnight ago. Has never shown much liking for Laval conditions though and chances appear slim
- **12. GOLDEN GRACE -** Sanctioned in a 2250m Enghien monte Class C a month back. Should not be too hastily-judged, has form here, and will not be far off the mark if focused
- **13. GRAND SOURIRE -** Gave a reassuringly good account when 2nd of 18 in a 2625m Cherbourg Class D earlier in the month. Has shown a liking for these conditions and will not be going home empty-handed
- **14. GLYCINA BELLA -** 13th of 16, on return to competition, in a 2800m Pontchâteau Class D last week. Appreciates these conditions and racing barefoot will only enhance her already good prospects
- **15. INFERNA DE HOUELLE -** Fine servant making first start since finishing last but one in a 2700m Vincennes Class B in early-February. Shoes fitted and no threat this time
- **16. HINDEN -** Distant last of 15 in a 2100m Vincennes Class C on 5 April and despite a good entry, and racing barefoot, has no possible chance

**Summary:** A course-and-distance winner two months ago, HUNT (10) did not miss out by much at Amiens next time and will be expected to leave Laval 3 for 3. INDIGO PIERJI (3) was unlucky behind him that day but nevertheless showed his form and will be no pushover if Matthieu Abrivard keeps him focused. GLYCINA BELLA (14) has never let the side down when barefoot here and is not about to start. HOLD UP RANAIS (9) has taken little time getting back in shape and placed on lone appearance in the day's configuration.

# C5 - PRIX GASTON ROUSSEL - 2850m (a2m) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- **1. LITTLEBOY DE PLANY -** Sanctioned on re-entry in a 2800m Tours Class F on 13 April and would be preferred under the saddle
- **2. LORD DE LA NOE -** Made it 2 on the trot when winning a 2500m Reims Class F on 20 March. Steps up in category but has earned his place here and although unlikely to pull off the hat-trick, can still play a prominent part
- **3. LE BIEF -** Honest type that ran 4th of 16 in a 2350m Angers Class E a fortnight ago. Is arguably better racing clockwise but is plainly in form and has a decent chance of making first 5
- **4. LIPTON DU VIVIER -** Imposed at Mauquenchy on comeback before being sanctioned in a Class E over track and trip on 29 March. Is plainly a colt for the future and will be expected to redeem himself
- **5. LEON DE L'AUNAY -** Encouraging 4th of 13 in a 2725m Graignes Class E earlier this month. Takes on a better lot this time though and is unlikely to shake things up
- **6. LOVE DE CERIZE -** Impressive despite losing his action in a Class E over course and distance late-March. Has already imposed under these conditions and, on good behaviour, can confirm
- **7. LION DU HOULBET -** Classy, and unbeaten, type making first appearance since completing the hat-trick in a Class E over course and distance last September. Is better than many here but will not be given a hard race
- **8. LEADER DE HOUELLE -** Ran 2nd over 2650m here before making short work of a 2850m Class F at Maure-de-Bretagne a month ago, and a similar performance would see him win this
- **9. LYNX GRIFF -** 6th of 13 behind LEON DE L'AUNAY (5) in a 2725m Graignes Class E on comeback earlier this month. Has already imposed here, sports a fresh configuration, and can pick up a cheque
- **10. LOVING DREAM -** Starts for first time since running 6th of 16 in a 3000m Nantes Class E late-January. Shoes on and will need the race
- **11. L'AMIRAL SACHA -** 2nd on re-entry 3 weeks ago before inheriting (a deserved) success in a 2800m Chartres Class F 10 days later. Goes well for Benjamin Rochard and will be expected to challenge for a place on the podium

**Summary:** LEADER DE HOUELLE (8) has done nothing but improve since returning to competition, thrashed the opposition last time out, and has a realistic chance of repeating. Loïc Guinoiseau will still be keeping a watchful eye on the complicated LOVE DE CERIZE (6) who could well have won here late last month had he kept trotting, and LIPTON DU VIVIER (4) who, even though shod, can still give this a good go. A model of consistency, L'AMIRAL SACHA (11) enjoys a fine engagement and despite the hike in category still looks a leading protagonist.

- 1. LESLIE DE VANDEL Ran 2nd on re-entry but failed to confirm when 9th of 12 finishers in a 3250m Saumur Class F late last month. Races first-time barefoot but others still preferred
- **2. LYNDA CASTEL -** Sanctioned early in a 2500m Reims Class F last week but nevertheless displayed her form and will be no easy touch if his trainer keeps her focused
- **3. LAMAGISTERE -** Failed to confirm Le Croisé-Laroche performance when quickly sanctioned in a 2700m Vincennes Class E last week. Eric Raffin in the bike this time and can finish in the mix if she takes to the Laval profile
- **4. LATINA DU FER -** Makes first start since being sanctioned in a 2700m Vincennes monte Class D last September. Is going to need the race
- **5. LADY DAY -** Gave a good account to run 2nd of 16 in a 2800m Tours Class F 11 days ago. Goes well for Alexandre Abrivard and has the wherewithal to spice things up
- **6. LOYALE DAIRPET -** Unraced since coming 6th of 16 in a 2150m Enghien claimer last October and is not about to spring any surprises
- **7. LILIE D'OMAHA -** Makes Laval debut after running 4th of 11 in a 2825m Cordemais Class E late last month. Clearly at the top of her game and will be expected to apply the pressure on LOLLIPOP DU CEBE (12). Chance
- **8. LADIVINA -** Pleasant 4th of 9 finishers, on re-entry, in a 2725m Graignes Class E on 13 April. Is not about to cause an upset but, competitively-shod, should nevertheless hold her own
- **9. LAQUILA WOOD -** Unraced since being sanctioned in a 2175m Vincennes Class E in early-February. Has been reconfigured for the occasion, has evident ability, and with stride in cheque is unlikely to let the side down. First 5
- **10. LADY D'IDEF -** Ran 2nd here late-February but trounced next time when last of 11 in a 2450m Caen Class E on 13 March, and can be ruled out
- **11. LAURIANE DU RIED -** Unremarkable 8th of 12 in a 2700m Vincennes Class E mid-month and will have nothing to contribute
- **12. LOLLIPOP DU CEBE -** Made up for a pair of sanctions when successful in a 2800m Pontchateau Class E last week. Is head-and-shoulders better than most here and on good behaviour can wrap this up
- **13. LOVE PROFUSION -** 9th of 15 in a 2100m Vincennes Class D mid-February. Remains shod for comeback and best to keep one's powder dry
- **14. LUDMILLA HAUFOR -** Runner-up in last 2, latterly a 2750m Class E at La Capelle 2.5 weeks ago. Is patently close to getting off the mark and must be considered a leading contender

**Summary:** She may not be the easiest of horses to handle but LOLLIPOP DU CEBE (12) showed at Pontchateau recently what she can do when focused and Benjamin Rochard will be eager to confirm Mathieu Mottier's score. Well-entered close to the threshold, LUDMILLA HAUFOR (14) is plainly close to her race and, barefoot for the first time at Laval, looks a serious proposition. Although new to the venue, LILIE D'OMAHA (7) has been transformed since starting to race barefoot and is unlikely to be far off the mark. LYNDA CASTEL (2) would have encountered little opposition at Reims had she stayed in stride and the fresh configuration may be just the ticket.

- **1. JAPHET SNOB -** Quality sort making first appearance since September 2023. Is shod for comeback and will be race-rusty
- **2. JAIN SAUTREUIL -** Quickly sanctioned in a 3125m Angers Class E 2 weeks ago and can be confidently disregarded
- **3. KANELLE DE TILLARD -** 6th of 10, on re-entry, in a 2100m Vincennes harness Class D last week. Is useful when applied, is fitted with pads this time, but still no more than a minor place chance
- **4. KEY BISCAYNE -** Honest sort that ran a solid 4th of 13 in a 2700m Graignes Class F mid-March. Unlikely to get his nose in front but can still make first 5
- **5. KANTHABELLA -** Disappointing so far this term, most recently 9th of 12 behind KOALA (12) in a 2700m Vincennes Class C last week. Out of the picture so far this term and must get her house in order
- **6. KID DES MOLLES -** 10th of 12 behind KOALA (12) in a 2700m Vincennes Class C last week and will need to pull a rabbit out of a hat
- **7. KING OF JIEL -** Raced better in a 2700m Vincennes Class C last week than his 7th of 12 behind KOALA (12) would suggest. Benjamin Rochard in the bike this time and looks a decent first-5 prospect
- **8. JACKPOT DU CHOQUEL -** Last of 7 on re-entry in a 2825m Chartres Class G 11 days ago. Barefoot this time but others still easier to like
- **9. KOBALT DU VALLON -** 3rd of 14 behind KALINA PRINCESS (10) in a 2200m Vincennes Class D 3 weeks ago. Is clearly firing on all cylinders and has a decent chance of trotting his way onto the podium
- **10. KALINA PRINCESS -** 2nd of 14 in a 2200m Vincennes Class D 3 weeks ago. Has taken to the discipline like a cat to cream and Eric Raffin would be wise to be wary. Chance
- **11. JOSS CAPELLO -** Makes first appearance since clinching a 2925m Cagnes Class D on 27 February. Stays shod but can still pick up some prizemoney
- **12. KOALA -** Quality element that ran a good 5th of 12 in a 2700m Vincennes Class C last week, on first start for 2 months. Will be race-fit and can make this his own
- **13. JOYAU DE JANZE -** 4th of 10 in a 2175m Vincennes Class E on 8 April. Seldom disappoints when focused and even in the presence of 5yo's can still make a big impact

**Summary:** A hardy campaigner with nothing to prove at this level, KOALA (12) was by no means disgraced on his Vincennes comeback and, reunited with Eric Raffin who excels with him, can get straight back down to business. Excellent in all three ridden starts, and sporting 4 pads for the first time, KALINA PRINCESS (10) went close in Paris 3 weeks ago and looks the main danger. Ideally-entered, JOYAU DE JANZE (13) is always game, has solid Laval credentials, and will be shod to preference this time. A place behind Estelle Croisic's horse earlier this month, KOBALT DU VALLON (9) deserves to be rewarded with victory one of these days.

- 1. MERCURIUS Qualified in 1'19"5 at Caen last June. Market will guide
- **2. MONTICELLO -** Last of 9 behind Malium, on debut, in a 3225m Fougeres Class G a month ago, and will need to show another side
- **3. MISTER DUAL -** 3rd on debut here but sanctioned in next 2, latterly a 2625m Class E at La Rochelle last Sunday. Paul Ploquin reining this time and is not to be overlooked
- **4. MARIOLE -** Bit off more than he could chew when last but one in a 2200m Vincennes monte Class D on 8 April. Placed on lone harness start though and merits significant respect
- **5. MINUTY DU GERS -** Was unable to confirm his Royan debut effort when sanctioned in a 2200m Pontchateau Class E last week. Subsequently showed his form though and, with application, can trot off with the silverware
- **6. MONZON DU CHATELET -** Pulled-up in a 2700m Graignes Class F a month ago. Trainer back in the wagon and others preferred
- **7. MANOUCHE -** Ran 2nd of 14, at 54/1, in a 2725m Lisieux Class F 11 days ago and a similar performance would see him compete for a first-3 place
- **8. MORPHEUS DU LOISIR -** 2nd only to a good Duvaldestin horse on debut in a 2750m Class F at La Capelle on 23 March. Looks a progressive sort and can make a big splash
- 9. MAESTRO DE DUSSAC 4th in all 3 starts to date, most recently a 2675m Lisieux Class F late last month. Not a contender but will have his supporters
- **10. MOONLIGHT DANICA -** Placed in last 2, most recently 3rd of 7 finishers in a 2200m Tours Class F 11 days ago. Not a priority but could still get a look-in
- **11. MALIUM -** 4th on debut here before coming 2nd of 13 in a 3225m Fougeres Class G a month ago. Appears to have considerable potential and Anthony Barrier will be eager to prove the point
- **12. MASSILIO BLOND -** Won a Le Mans claimer before finishing last of 8 behind MAJESTIC DU KLAU (13) in a 2725m Graignes Class E earlier in the month, and already looks out of his depth
- **13. MAJESTIC DU KLAU -** Placed at Challans before running 6th of 8 finishers in a 2725m Graignes Class E earlier in the month. Matthieu Abrivard at the helm this time but still no more than a minor place chance

**Summary:** After leaving a fine impression on his debut, MINUTY DU GERS (5) lost his action just 10 days later, but plainly displayed his form and can win this if he keeps his mind on the game. Beaten only by a very good horse first time out, MORPHEUS DU LOISIR (8) comes to a track he should appreciate and it would be no surprise were he to lose his maiden status. MALIUM (11) made significant improvement at Fougeres last month and benefits from already have raced here. MANOUCHE (7) confirmed his good qualification when placing at Lisieux first time out and deserves to be taken seriously.
