R1 VINCENNES [L-H]

**C1 - PRIX DE VILLECRESNES - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class E - Harness - EUR
€ 49,000**

- 1. KIRA BO FACE** - Finished ahead of KINASSE DE VIVOIN (3) both at Vincennes and Angers before being prepped at home last week. Is forced to start on the inside but returns to racing barefoot and looks a major player
- 2. TOSCANA SOUTHWIND** - Made a fine comeback at Cagnes before being eliminated when competitive at Lyon-Parilly on 8 April. Breaks on the front row, sports a new configuration, and can get a look in if Benjamin Rochard manages to keep her trotting
- 3. KINASSE DE VIVOIN** - Put in a fine finish in a Class E under these conditions on 21 March despite being forced out of position. Surprisingly performant when being conditioned at Angers early this month and from the 3 slot can impose
- 4. JILIKA DU MESLE** - Has demonstrated decent condition in last 2 starts. Has placed in 1 of 2 over track and trip, ran 2nd on sole start with Mathieu Mottier, and from the 4 slot is easy to recommend for a first-5 payout
- 5. CUBA DEL DUOMO** - Handy Italian mare making first Vincennes appearance for over 2 years and appears to be out of her depth
- 6. JINA FOUTEAU** - Has merit but has looked rather ordinary for a number of months and is unlikely to create an upset
- 7. KYNTE FLUSH** - Complicated mare but has a particular appreciation for these conditions. Is clearly in competition-mode following her Angers conditioner, and will be dangerous if Alexandre Abrivard manages to keep her focused
- 8. KARVINA D'ELA** - 5th behind KIRA BO FACE (1) in a Class E over course and distance on 21 March, then ran 2nd in a 2850m Class E here a fortnight ago. Breaks wide but is on the front row and unlikely to be far off the mark
- 9. ELEONORA GRIF** - Courageous but unthreatening 5th in a 2875m Enghien Class D last week. Tends to go well under these conditions but is being aimed too high this time
- 10. ELEGANZA AV** - Lost her way in September and has since picked up where she left off, and can be confidently ruled out
- 11. KELLE HAUFOR** - Has just once failed to deliver in 5 starts over course and distance, most recently 2nd in a Class C 3 weeks ago. Has pulled a 2nd-line number but is plainly close to her best and should not be underestimated
- 12. KARLA DE BANVILLE** - Returns to a track she likes after a promising re-entry at Tours earlier in the month. Matthieu Abrivard would have appreciated a better draw but still looks competitive for some minor honours
- 13. ELTYME** - Undeniably useful but has failed to deliver in last 2 starts. Reverts to a previous formula but still has too much to do

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14. NICE STEEL - Capable nordic element that failed to deliver on sole start over the distance here. Has little going for her this time and can be passed over

15. ELLEN RIPLEY - Disappointing 6th of 8 finishers in a 2875m Enghien Class D, on French debut, last week. Has been handed a rough draw and is unlikely to spice things up

16. EDIMA - Unexceptional mare that has done nothing of note since returning to competition and with shoes fitted has no possible chance

Summary: Very unlucky here last month before being given a change of scenery at Angers, KINASSE DE VIVOIN (3) returns to racing barefoot and can more than make amends if Franck Nivard keeps her out of trouble. KIRA BO FACE (1) finished ahead of her on both occasions and she too will be barefoot following a freshener. KYNTE FLUSH (7) is not the easiest of horses to use but she is proven at a superior level and is shod to preference. Breaking just to her outside, KARVINA D'ELA (8) is close to winning another and has already been successful with her driver.

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C2 - PRIX SIRONE - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 49,000

- 1. CANTAB AS** - Moderate trotter starting for first time since late-January. Is barefoot for the occasion but has no love for these conditions and can be passed over
- 2. VINCI NICE** - Kicked the season off successfully at Jägersro but well-beaten in next 2 starts and is not about to spring any surprises
- 3. KLINGER (NOR)** - Opened his French account on 8 April when tenaciously winning a Lyon-Parilly Class E. Benefits from a terrific draw, races barefoot this time, and has a decent chance of picking up a cheque
- 4. INTREPIDE TURGOT** - Starts for the first time at Vincennes since 2021. Sports modified shoeing for the occasion but would be preferred barefoot
- 5. JOPLIN DES CROUAS** - Delicate trotter that has placed just once in 7 starts this year and, even from the 5 slot, will struggle to make his mark
- 6. MAX OCCAGNES** - Is considerably better than recent results would suggest. Will be fully-fit by now and can figure prominently, but stablemate KENNEDY FRANCE (7) will not be easy to oppose
- 7. KENNEDY FRANCE** - Like a horse transformed since early-February, most recently failing to secure the hat-trick when 2nd in a Class E under these conditions on 20 March, but looks better than most here and can make this his own
- 8. EMPIRE AS** - Useful on a good day, and needs to reassure, but is reunited with Jean-Michel Bazire who will be expecting to set the record straight
- 9. ERNESTO ROC** - Has done nothing of note in 3 starts since returning from his winter break and can be confidently ruled out
- 10. REDBULL PELLINI** - Has hardly put a foot wrong in last 5 starts, latterly 2nd in a Pontchateau Class E earlier in the month, and even though forced to break from 2nd line, should still be good enough to finish in the mix
- 11. ERES DORIAL MAIL** - Showed improvement when 5th in a Class C under these conditions 3 weeks ago. Has ground to make up but will not be available at 123-1 this time
- 12. DOMENIK JET** - Ran good 3rd from a poor draw, on French debut, in a 2500m Reims Class E on 5 April. Faces a tougher test here but with Benjamin Rochard in the bike should not disappoint. Place chance
- 13. DUMA NEH D'ASTI** - Unremarkable transalpine raider that has placed just once in 6 Vincennes starts. Is shod for the occasion and will not be troubling the judge
- 14. OH CEAN** - Has yet to impress since coming to France but should nevertheless be at peak fitness by now. Not ideally-drawn but will have been specifically prepared for this and should not be overlooked
- 15. JACQUES MEARAS** - Sent for a rest after failing to deliver at Vincennes late last season. Has pulled a rough number and will have nothing to contribute
- 16. DEVIL OP** - Useful in both codes but has not raced for 2.5 months and the draw only compounds matters

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Summary: Clearly back at the top of his game, and runner-up under these conditions last month, KENNEDY FRANCE (7) breaks from the front row and is in with a realistic shout of trotting his way back into the winners' circle. Marginally better-drawn, MAX OCCAGNES (6) has 3 runs under his belt since the break and it will not be long before he gets back in the game. EMPIRE AS (8) has been oddly lacklustre this term but has been reconfigured and, with JMB in the bike, could pleasantly surprise. DOMENIK JET (12) defied his odds at Reims earlier in the month and even in spite of an unfavourable draw, still looks competitively well in.

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C3 - PRIX HUBERTA - 2850m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 59,000

1. JAZZ D'OURVILLE - In the frame in 3 of last 4 starts, latterly missing out by little to JAPAROV LIRE (10), in a Class D under these conditions on 20 March. Is plainly close to his race and will not be far from the action at the business end of the race

2. JAMAIS - Took little time coming to hand this term, latterly dominating a 2725m Graignes Class F on 12 April. Has no references over 2850m of the main track but in present shape is easy to like for a first-5 cheque

3. JAZZ DE PADD - Has done everything asked of him so far this season. Is barefoot following his Cordemais conditioner and looks a serious proposition once more

4. JOYEUX DU LANDRET - No slouch on a good day, and has won under these conditions. Sports modified shoeing for the occasion but others still easier to back

5. JUNON DE LOU - In the frame in 3 of last 4 starts, latterly 2nd in a Cherbourg Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Is unlikely to set off any fireworks but should nevertheless hold her own

6. IMOKO JIBELAU - Has looked decidedly ordinary so far this term and even with 4 pads fitted is unlikely to make any impact

7. HEAD OF STATE - Fine trotter with an excellent win-rate. Is barefoot for first start since last August, has never raced over 2850m here, but hails from a good home and should not be overlooked

8. HURIEL LUDOIS - Back under harness after a pair of monte fresheners this month, but in this company will have too much to do

9. JANKO HAUFOR - Occasionally misfires but has otherwise been in cracking form since November. Was beaten only by a very good horse in a 2150m Enghien Class D on 6 March, and has the wherewithal to get his nose in front this time

10. JAPAROV LIRE - Ran 2nd at Caen before lifting a Class D over course and distance on 20 March. Mathieu Mottier stays faithful and has a reasonable chance of confirming

11. IVRIG VIKING - Put 4 straight eliminations behind him to come surprise 3rd in a Class D over track and trip a fortnight ago. A repeat, however, seems improbable

12. INSTINCT SAINT BAR - Won at Laval before coming 2nd in a Toulouse Class C on 3 April. Has been reconfigured, benefits from a terrific engagement, and is unlikely to let the side down

Summary: Winner over course and distance to get 2026 off on the right note, JANKO HAUFOR (9) was unable to deliver next time, but he reassured across town in early-March, has had time to get back in shape, and can win this. Damien Bonne will still be mindful of front-row-starter JAZZ DE PADD (3) who has been excellent when barefoot this term, and JAPAROV LIRE (10) who most recently held off the better-placed JAZZ D'OURVILLE (1) to secure a Class D over course and distance.

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C4 - PRIX MAGINUS - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class A - Harness - EUR € 62,000

- 1. MARQUIS DU CHENE** - Improving sort moving back up in category after running 4th in a Class C over course and distance a fortnight ago. Is not about to paint the town red but can nevertheless make first 5
- 2. MONTEQUILLO** - Out of the picture in 2 starts so far this term, but should be fully-fit by now and can play a small role
- 3. MAD OF YOU** - Has not been seen out since coming 5th in a Class A over track and trip on 25 January. Shoes fitted this time and not a concern
- 4. MALUMA D'ANGIS** - Seldom disappoints when he can keep his action together. Ran 4th behind MOONWALK D'HERIPRE (6) in a Class A over course and distance on 21 March, and with Alexandre Abrivard reining will have his supporters
- 5. MACHIAVEL BOURBON** - Serious future prospect that has been very hard to fault. Will have a lot of work behind him and, clearly in race-mode, can win this if kept out of harm's way
- 6. MOONWALK D'HERIPRE** - Can prove a handful but otherwise has talent in spades. Has imposed 4 times when full-shod, including under these conditions, and will be no shrinking violet. Place chance
- 7. MUSCLE DREAM** - Has enjoyed quite the transformation since beginning to race in current configuration. Excels for Mathieu Mottier and looks main danger to MACHIAVEL BOURBON (5)
- 8. MARQUETY DE BAILLY** - Flattering 5th, a place behind MIRAKALU MANAZIF (11), in a 2850m Class A here on 4 April, and is unlikely to influence the outcome
- 9. MARZIPAN** - Capable colt starting for the first time since last August and will not be given a hard race
- 10. MILAN** - Raced and placed at this level to kick off 2026, and most recently won a 2100m claimer here. Clearly has merit but in this company is unlikely to spring any surprises
- 11. MIRAKALU MANAZIF** - Quality individual that has yet to fully-adapt to his new configuration, but is plainly on the right path, and has the wherewithal to finish in the mix
- 12. MISTRAL DU GOUTIER** - Regularly asked to take on too much and has not been seen out since Christmas Day. Races barefoot for the first time but is simply not up to the task
- 13. MOUFFETARD** - Quickly eliminated in a Gr.3 before losing his action again, this time when clearly in shape. Front shoes back on this time and, if focused, can contest a place on the podium

Summary: Impressive winner of a Class A under these conditions on New Year's Eve only to be subsequently disqualified, MACHIAVEL BOURBON (5) is competitively-shod for the first time and Jean-Philippe Monclin will be expecting him to get straight down to business. Stablemate MOONWALK D'HERIPRE (6) beat MUSCLE DREAM (7) here on 21 March, but the former races shod this time and may yet see the roles reversed. Wonderfully-engaged at the limit of earnings, the talented MOUFFETARD (13) has been a bit of a handful lately but has been re-shod and must not be underestimated.

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**C5 - PRIX RENE PALYART - ETRIER 4 ANS Q1 - 2175m (a1m1/4) - -
Mounted - EUR € 120,000**

1. MINILADY DE CHOC - Unremarkable filly facing a very tough task after having failed to deliver at Mauquenchy and can be confidently disregarded

2. MARIEVA DE LOU - Has taken her game to a new level this year, and has form under these conditions. At this level, however, will have too much to do

3. MIRATISSIME - Goes barefoot for first time but looks out of her league and will have few friends

4. MESSI PASS - Has 2 runs under his belt following a lengthy layoff. Completely missed the break on recent return to the code, and Paul Ploquin will be eager to put things right

5. MALICE CAILLERIE - Complicated but talented filly that stormed up in a 2700m Class B on re-entry here early this month. Faces a tougher test this time but will be similarly-shod and Eric Raffin stays faithful

6. MILOR DE LA VALLEE - Capable trotter but has yet to get into his stride this season. Sports front pads for the first time, should appreciate the shorter trip, and can start to get back in the game

7. MASINA DE TILLARD - Unluckily eliminated in a 2850m Class A here 3 weeks ago when preparing for this. Is first-time barefoot, has thrived with Mathieu Mottier, and can give MHUM FLYNG (12) something to think about

8. MUNHOA VEDAQUAISE - Progressive filly that won 3 straight before being eliminated in a 2700m Class A here 2 weeks ago. Form is not in question though and will have her chances if she stays in stride

9. MANITAS DE TRUCHON - Won Gr.2 Prix Raoul Ballière over course and distance last November but has not been as sharp since and will need to raise her game

10. MATIGNON - Stayed on well to come 3rd in 2850m Gr.3 Prix Louis le Bourg in early-February, before disappointing in a 2700m Class A here a fortnight back. Front pads back on and cannot be discounted

11. MISS DES BESACES - Seldom gets her nose in front but seldom disappoints either and recent 4th place in Gr.1 Prix des Centaures did not go unnoticed. First 5

12. MHUM FLYNG - Occasionally loses focus but is a high-class colt otherwise. Has not been seen out since early-February but has nothing to prove under these conditions and will be tough to beat if Alexandre Abrivard keeps him trotting

Summary: Winner of a Gr.3 to get 2026 off to a positive start, MHUM FLYNG (12) followed up with a dominant Gr.2 Prix de Pardieu success. Sent for a rest after being eliminated in the Gr.2 Prix Louis le Bourg, he returns fresh to a distance he appreciates and, with application, can wrap this up. That said, MASINA DE TILLARD (7) returns to a discipline she has shown significant flair for and, first-time barefoot, will be no soft touch. MUNHOA VEDAQUAISE (8) has never been tested at this level but has no issue with the trip and Benjamin Rochard can be justifiably confident. Reliability may not be her strong suit but MALICE CAILLERIE (5) easily won a Class B on her recent return to competition, and has earned the right to race in this class.

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C6 - PRIX ENIF - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 40,000

- 1. MAGIC DE VAUVILLE** - Has yet to get off the mark but has gone close more than once. Would have contested the finish at Laval had he not hesitated, and can turn the tables on MEPHISTONS DIDJEAP (4) who imposed that day
- 2. MOTS BLEUS** - Got off the mark with ease 12 days ago in a Graignes Class E. Is in better company this time though and unlikely to spice things up
- 3. MISTER FRIPOUILLE** - Faces first target of the season following a pair of modest return runs, but will be barefoot this time and is not incapable of playing a small part
- 4. MEPHISTONS DIDJEAP** - Opened his 2026 account at Laval on 28 March but looked rather ordinary here next time. Mathieu Mottier in the bike on this occasion and should be taken seriously
- 5. MILLE MERCIS** - Faces first objective of the year after 2 return conditioners. Gets to race competitively-shod this time and Jean-Philippe Dubois can be confident of a competitive run
- 6. MIC DUNDEE** - Fine gelding that has won 4 of 5 starts, most recently a Rambouillet Class F late last month. Faces a stiffer test this time but has been re-shod and must be respected
- 7. MONTANA KALOUMA** - Made up for comeback elimination with a commanding Lisieux Class E victory on 26 March. Has buckets of untapped potential and a repeat performance is not out of the question
- 8. MARTIN DOL** - Quality individual that would have remained unbeaten this year had he not been eliminated here 2 weeks ago. Is plainly in rude health and looks set to take all the beating
- 9. MEC D'ERCOURT** - Put 2 straight eliminations behind her when 4th in a Class E under these conditions a week ago. Takes on a better bunch this time and chances appear limited
- 10. MAESTRO CASH** - Encouraged on comeback at Enghien but was trounced 2 weeks ago when 11th of 12 in a 2100m Class D here, and can expect to have few takers
- 11. MISTER FOURCADE** - Modest individual making first appearance since early-February and has no realistic chance
- 12. MAGIK DE PIERRAIS** - Pleased in both starts so far this year and should be fit by now. Is ideally-entered and Eric Raffin will be keen to prove a point

Summary: Winner of his first 2 starts this year, MARTIN DOL (8) would have secured the hat-trick had he not been harshly eliminated here 2 weeks ago. He reverts to his previous formula and Benjamin Rochard will be determined to set the record straight. Fourth that day, the well-engaged MAGIK DE PIERRAIS (12) will be barefoot for the first time and could well contest the finish. Lightly-raced but a talent all the same, MONTANA KALOUMA (7) vies to complement his recent Lisieux romp and will be legitimately well-supported. MILLE MERCIS (5) has a pair of runs in him following the winter break and with hind shoes off for the first time is easy to like for a place in the frame.

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**C7 - PRIX LOUIS FORCINAL - ETRIER 5 ANS Q1 - 2850m (a2m) - -
Mounted - EUR € 120,000**

- 1. LUDMILA DETE** - Impressive last summer but has not been as sharp since. Showed improvement late last month but insufficient to be considered a concern
- 2. LAIKA DES MARES** - Unexceptional mare with no place in this field and can be confidently dismissed
- 3. LITTLELOU MATIDY** - 3rd to LYRIC (6) on comeback here 3 weeks ago, but has a lot of ground to make up and is unlikely to cause an upset
- 4. LOUSTIC DELAURIERE** - Bounced back from Bordeaux elimination with 2nd in a 2850m Lyon-Parilly Class D late last month. Takes first competitive monte steps and hopes are legitimately high for a big performance
- 5. LASKA DU LEVANT** - Never far from faulting but reassuring 2nd in a 2700m Class C here 10 days ago. Has placed at Gr.2 level and even though shod this time still represents a respectable first-5 chance
- 6. LYRIC** - Barring the occasional elimination seldom disappoints. Flew up in a 2200m Class D over the short course earlier this month. At this level, is unlikely to repeat but can nevertheless play a small role
- 7. LAMBADA DU GOUTIER** - Won a 2700m Class B here on 31 March before losing her action, when full of running, in a 2700m Class A here 2 weeks ago. Sports 4 pads this time but still warrants respect
- 8. LARA DU LERRE** - Impressive winner of a 2700m Class A here 2 weeks ago. Dependability not her strong suit but, with application, can double her money
- 9. LAKANA DE FELLIERE** - Consistently performant mare that goes well when fresh. Won over course and distance last October and has every chance of giving LARA DU LERRE (8) a run for her money

Summary: Determined winner here a fortnight ago when reunited with Alexandre Abrivard, LARA DU LERRE (8) may not be the most reliable horse here but she has nothing to prove at this level and can bring home the bacon if she stays in stride. LAKANA DE FELLIERE (9) sports pads for her first start following the spell, won a Gr.3 last time over course and distance, and represents the main threat. LOUSTIC DELAURIERE (4) makes his monte debut with Alexis Collette in the irons and is expected to put in a good showing. LAMBADA DU GOUTIER (7) can get in on the action if Paul Ploquin manages to keep her focused.

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C8 - PRIX CLAUDIA - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 53,000

- 1. LARIANO** - Is not devoid of talent but has yet to make his mark this term and best to keep one's powder dry
- 2. LE METEQUE** - Has done nothing noteworthy since imposing over course and distance last September and can expect to have few friends
- 3. LORIGRE** - Has ample ability but stays shod for comeback and best to hold off
- 4. LIQUIDATEUR** - Tough trotter that never got a race in him after failing to line up behind the car here early this month. His talent is not in question and will be no pushover if Alexandre Abrivard gets him off on the right foot
- 5. LE TOUQUET** - Serious sort that has found his way again after a below-par start to the season. Is never far from faulting but, with application, can give L'AMOUR SUPREME (10) something to think about
- 6. LAY UP** - Won a 2100m Class D here before coming 2nd to L'AMOUR SUPREME (10) in a Class D over course and distance late last month. Boasts a fine record with Eric Raffin and should not disappoint. First 5
- 7. LE GENTLEMAN** - Made short work of his first objective of the year, winning a 2100m Class D here 2 weeks ago and is easy to recommend for a place in the picture
- 8. LAMIE DU MESNIL** - Has pleased for the most part this term but failed to make any impression in a 2100m Class C here on 4 April, and others easier to back
- 9. LINNA DE VANDEL** - 20-1 winner at Caen on 19 March prior to running 4th in a 2100m Class C here early this month. In this category though is unlikely to shake things up
- 10. L'AMOUR SUPREME** - Seldom lets the side down when competitively-shod. Comfortably won a 2700m Class D here in late-March and is eminently capable of repeating
- 11. LOYAL DU CHOQUEL** - Good, consistent element that has climbed the category-ladder in good order. Returns from his spell on a hat-trick but in this company looks more a minor place prospect
- 12. L'ATOLL** - Consistently gives a good account of himself and is as capable racing left-handed as right-. Presents excellent course-and-distance credentials and should again prove competitive when it matters
- 13. LEONARDO DE LOU** - Decent dual-discipline type racing barefoot for first target of the spring, but would have a better chance in a lesser category
- 14. L'AMIRAL GAGNANT** - Goes barefoot following a respectable 2100m Class C conditioner here earlier in the month, but will still need to find significantly more
- 15. LEOPOLD** - Left a good impression at Marseille-Borély a month ago before losing his action at Cavillon 2.5 weeks ago. Is barefoot for just 2nd time in his career, enjoys a good entry, but still cannot be considered a contender

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Summary: Thierry Duvaldestin will be particularly well-armed for this with L'AMOUR SUPREME (10) who ran out a convincing course-and-distance winner late last month, and LE TOUQUET (5) who is dynamic when focused. LE GENTLEMAN (7) failed to deliver behind the former last time out but more than made amends when victorious over 2100m here 2 weeks ago. LIQUIDATEUR (4) should not be too quickly-condemned for his last 2 appearances, returns to a volte start, and with application will not be far from the action. L'ATOLL (12) is as honest as the day is long, has form under these conditions, and is unlikely to go home empty-handed.
