### C1 - PRIX OLYMPE DE GOUGES - 2550m (a1m1/2) - Class G Amateur Drivers Race - Harness - EUR € 6,000

- **1. IRUN -** Disqualified in his latest start, which was at Monpazier on 4 May. Has struggled of late and needs major improvement to win
- **2. ICARE ELJI -** Has major disqualification issues and faulted at Castelsarrasin on 4 May. Capable of playing a minor role when in the right mood
- **3. HASARD DES VENTES -** Unreliable but was fourth in Class H at Castelsarrasin over 2375m on 4 May. Might play a minor role in this line-up if he can repeat this effort
- **4. ISLEY GRIFF -** Finished 12th in Class H at Castelsarrasin over 2375m on 4 May. Battling to find his best form and others are much preferred
- **5. HOPLA DE MORGE -** Returned from a break and was 11th in Class H at Monzapier on 4 May. Needs major improvement to win this race. Best to ignore
- **6. IONIS BOCAIN -** Disqualified in his last three starts, with the latest being at Toulouse on 9 May. Unshod on all four feet and capable of scoring if wise
- **7. IRACLE DES TITHAIS -** Has struggled of late and was 11th in Class H at Castelsarrasin over 2375m on 4 May. Capable of an upset if finding his best form
- **8. INOUK LOULOU -** Has only been modest of late and was 7th in Class H at Monzapier over 3125m on 4 May. Well placed on the front line and can surprise
- **9. IDEAL DE CALVETI -** Disqualified in his last two starts, the latest at Toulouse on 9 May. Has won with this shoe combination and is capable of an upset
- **10. IDDIR D'ANTEE -** Unreliable and finished 11th in Class G at Vichy over 2950m on 17 May. He did win his penultimate start and is barefoot today so could play a role
- **11. HALFAC BILOU -** Unreliable and was 5th in a claimer at Angoulême over 2775m on 19 May. Needs to do a lot more to beat these rivals
- **12. HORIZON PELSA -** Has struggled this year and was tenth in Class G at Cholet over 2825m on 1 May. Unlikely to pose a threat
- **13. IMPACT BLACK -** Disappointing form of late and finished 8th in Class E at Monflanquin over 2500m on 11 May. Capable of better and has a winning chance
- **14. GAELINE SERVINOISE -** Has really struggled of late and was 9th in Class G at Toulouse over 2950m on 9 May. Needs major improvement to win
- **15. IRIS DES YOLAIS -** Has really struggled this year and was 8th in Class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 16 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **16. GENTLEMAN SMART** Showed good improvement when third in Class G over this track and trip on 30 April. Well entered and can contest the finish

**Summary:** IONIS BOCAIN (6) may not be the most consistent trotter, but he certainly doesn't lack talent and races unshod on all four feet this time. He gets the nod over IMPACT BLACK (13), who reunites with Thomas Marlin—a partnership that has enjoyed notable success in the not-too-distant past. GENTLEMAN SMART (16) is very well placed in the race and deserves consideration. While IDDIR D'ANTEE (10) has shown better form under the saddle, but he cannot be ruled out in this harness division.

- **1. MER AGITEE -** Has shown promise in both starts and was victorious in Class C at Toulouse over 2950m on 31 January. Returns from a break but can win if fit
- **2. MOISSON DE LA COTE -** Unreliable and finished 6th in Class C at Royan-Atlantique over 2475m on 4 May. Did better at this track before that and has a place chance
- **3. MILLER DU VIVIER -** A winner of two of his three starts, including last time out in Class E at Graignes over 2700m on 9 May. Can follow up
- **4. MIAMI -** Yet to win a race but was runner-up in Class D at Argentan over 2150m on 12 May. Capable of contesting the finish if he can build up on this effort
- **5. MANHATTAN GABINLEA -** Finished a gale third in Class C at Vichy over 2150m on 12 May. Yet to win a race but should be very competitive once again
- **6. MAJOR CHANTEREINE -** Fluffed his lines with a disqualification last time out at Caen on 10 May. In very good form before that and can bounce back to score
- **7. MANHATTAN EMGE -** A winner of three of his last four starts, including last time out in Class C at Toulouse over 2975m on 19 February. Can score again
- **8. MAJYC FLIGHT -** Very consistent and finished fourth in Class B at Caen over 2250m on 10 May. Should be right there at the finish once again

**Summary:** MILLER DU VIVIER (3) was an impressive winner at Graignes on 9 May and, if in similar form, will be very hard to beat once again. MAJYC FLIGHT (8) is best judged on his penultimate run—a winning effort at Toulouse—and holds solid claims. MAJOR CHANTEREINE (6) caught the eye after an early sanction at Caen and should not be underestimated. MANHATTAN EMGE (7) has plenty of ability but must overcome a three-month absence.

- **1. GAILLARDE QUERAY -** Has struggled of late and finished tenth in Class E at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 4 May. Needs major improvement to win
- **2. IPSON DU VERNAY -** Disqualified in his latest start which was at Toulouse on 25 April. Disappointing recent form but is capable of winning if at his best
- **3. FLYING DEVIL -** Very unreliable but was fourth in Class E at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 4 May. Others make more appeal
- **4. JOJOBA DE QUERAY -** Disqualified last time out at Royan La Palmyre on 4 May. Was in very good form before that and can get involved with the finish once again
- **5. INDOCILE -** Disappointing recent form and was tenth in Class E at Lisieux over 2725m on 18 May. Capable of better and could play a minor role
- **6. JOKER DE CHOISEL -** A winner of his last three starts, with the latest being in Class E Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 5 May. Can complete the four-timer
- **7. JOIE DE LA COTE -** Hat-trick seeking after some solid wins, the latest in Class E at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 7 May. Leading chance once again
- **8. HELIOS D'ELA -** Has only been modest this year and was 6th in Class C at Toulouse over 2150m on 16 May. Needs to do a lot more to beat these rivals
- **9. GENEROUS CHARM -** Very consistent and finished third in Class C at Toulouse over 2150m on 16 March. Has a winning chance in this line-up
- **10. GALANT DE CAREL -** Only fair of late and finished 5th in Class C at Toulouse over 2150m on 16 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **11. HAPPYJO DE LIGNY -** Has only been modest this year and was 8th in Class B at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 16 May. Capable of improvement but others are preferred

**Summary:** JOKER DE CHOISEL (6) and JOIE DE LA COTE (7) both come into this race in top form and are difficult to split. A slight preference goes to the former though, whose most recent win at Mesaly du Maine was particularly eye-catching. Should either of the leading pair underperform, the talented IPSON DU VERNAY (2) could be a strong alternative despite his recent dip in form. GENEROUS CHARM (9) is a consistent performer and merits consideration for a place.

- **2. FILOU DE SITA -** Unreliable and finished 8th in Class C at Toulouse over 2160m on 16 May. Capable of playing a minor role when in the right mood
- **3. ICARE DU BERYL -** s A barefoot winner of his last three starts, the latest in Class E at Cavaillon over 2600m on 26 April. Remains barefoot and can complete the four-timer
- **4. GATSBY WIC -** Has really struggled of late and was unplaced in Class E at Laon over 2850m on 1 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **5. INVISIBLE SAM -** Has struggled of late and was 13th in Class D at Laval over 2850m on 16 May. Barefoot this time and can bounce back
- **6. HYDROMEL -** Has struggled of late and was 11th in Class E at this track over 2550m on 28 April. Might play a minor role at best
- **7. ENDIAN DE BANVILLE -** Has struggled all year and was tenth in Class C at Castillonnès over 2450m on 20 April. Others are much preferred

- **3. KENZA CHOISIE -** Barefoot and a winner in both starts this year, the latest in Class E over this track and trip on 20 April. Can finish off her hat-trick
- **4. KOALA DU DROPT -** Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Monflanquin on 11 May. Hard to trust but could pop up in a minor place
- **5. KUEEN KEP -** Returned to form with a good runner-up performance in Class F at Châtelaillon-La Rochelle over 2500m on 1 May. Barefoot and can go one better this time
- **6. KAHINA DE FAEL -** Very unreliable and finished 7th in Class F at this track over 2400m on 18 May. Has a place chance in this line-up

- **3. KISMIE GRIFF -** Victorious in Class E at Toulouse over 2325m on 9 May. Has disqualification issues but is capable of an upset if applied
- **4. KARESSE D'EURVAD -** Finished 13th in class E at this track over 2550m on 20 April. Unreliable and is hard to make a case for on current form
- **5. KASGAGNAT -** Victorious in Class E at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 6 April. Very consistent and should be competitive yet again
