- **16. ILARIA KILY -** Imposed at Senonnes-Pouance 3 weeks ago prior to running 3rd of 12 in a 2500m Reims Class F last Saturday, but in this company will have too much to do

Summary: A terrific campaigner that won in style across town earlier in the month, JANE CASH (10) may be new to Enghien but in present form has every chance of doubling up. Damien Bonne will still want to be wary of JOLYDOLE (11) who imposed on re-entry late last month, and a barefoot JEUNESSE ETERNELLE (3) who ran a good second last time. ICE HAUFOR (5) showed her form at Graignes despite being sanctioned and Yoann Lebourgeois can put things right.

- **1. KALENCIO FLAC -** Returns to France after coming 2nd of 6 over 2300m in Mons 2.5 weeks ago. Has been reconfigured for the occasion and entrusted to Franck Nivard, but others still easier to back
- **2. KISS ATOUT -** Won at La Rochelle last month before just missing out in a 2200m Caen Class C 2 weeks ago. Excels when barefoot and can add another victory to his tally
- **3. KATIM DU GOUTIER -** Has not been seen out since finishing last but one in a 2700m Vincennes Class B on 28 February. Enjoys a good draw but others still easier to support
- **4. KINGDOM KAT -** Starts for first time since finishing 6th of 7 in a 2850m Vincennes monte Class B last November and will have nothing to offer
- **5. KLASSE DE BRUZEAU -** Reverts to a previous configuration after winning a 2950m Vichy Class D on 5 May. Is confirmed here but would be preferred barefoot
- **6. KRAKEN CASTELETS -** Last but one behind KALINE DU JOUR (12) in a 2700m Vincennes Class C a month ago. Won his only start at the venue but is biting off more than he can chew
- **7. KALINA PRINCESS -** Ran 2nd at Vincennes before coming 4th of 12 in a 2850m Laval monte Class C a month ago. Boasts fine barefoot references and, well-engaged, must be taken seriously
- **8. KAISER DES GRANGES -** Did not enjoy the best of trips when last of 11 behind KALINE DU JOUR (12) in a 2700m Vincennes Class C a month ago. Won under these conditions last October and, barefoot this time, can get back in the game
- **9. KOH SAMUI -** Quality individual making first appearance since finishing last of 11 in 10 May race of reference, on first start back, and best to wait
- **10. KOQUERY DU BUISSON -** 9th of 11 finishers behind KISS ATOUT (2) in a 2200m Caen Class C 2 weeks ago. Subject of interference that day and while unlikely to have his way this time, he sports a new formula and can nevertheless finish in the money
- **11. KEITHOS DU RHIN -** 4th of 13 behind KYNTE FLUSH (14) in a 2100m Vincennes Class D on 2 May. A model of consistency this term and is unlikely to be far off the mark
- **12. KALINE DU JOUR -** Sanctioned when going well in a 2200m Caen Class C on 10 May. Won over longer here 2 months ago and, despite the draw, should not be overlooked
- **13. KUNG FU QUICK -** Won twice under harness in space of 10 days prior to coming 3rd of 13, a place behind KYNTE FLUSH (14), in a 2100m Vincennes Class D on 2 May. Not ideally-drawn but a serious proposition all the same
- **14. KYNTE FLUSH -** In the frame in last 3, most recently 2nd of 13 in a 2100m Vincennes Class D on 2 May. Enjoys good speed and despite the draw still looks main threat to KISS ATOUT (2)
- **15. KINASSE DE VIVOIN -** Encouraged at Ecommoy but failed to confirm when 7th of 11 finishers behind KISS ATOUT (2) in a 2200m Caen Class C 2 weeks ago, and is not about to trouble the judge

16. KENTUCKY SOMOLLI - Imposed at Angers prior to running 2nd of 16 to KLASSE DE BRUZEAU (5) in a 2950m Vichy Class D on 5 May. Takes on a better bunch here and the draw does him no favours

Summary: Hard to knock since starting g to race barefoot, KISS ATOUT (2) enjoys a good spot behind the car and can secure his second win of 2025. That being said, KYNTE FLUSH (14) has been going good-guns lately and her most recent Vincennes chrono was particularly impressive. Starting beside her on the 2nd row, KUNG FU QUICK (13) has looked a different horse under harness recently and won his only start under these conditions. KALINA PRINCESS (7) is forced to break wide but is excellent when barefoot and adores these shorter trips.
