# C1 - PRIX VICTOR GREGORIS - 2550m (a1m1/2) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- **1. MITSY DU NOYER -** Third in a class F at Agon-Coutainville over 2200m on 17 August. A consistent sort who is seldom far off them
- **2. MADGIK SAUTREUIL -** A winner in a class E at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2125m on 15 August. Plainly in fine form and warrants attention
- **3. MARIUS DE FEUGERES -** A runner-up in a class E at Vichy over 2150m on 2 August. It is smart when competitive and is not out of it if applied
- **4. MELBA DU PADOUENG -** A runner-up in a class D at Biarritz over 2950m on 24 July. Better in the last two efforts when focused, and can play a minor role
- **5. MY DREAM DES MONTS -** A runner-up in a class D at Castillonnes over 2450m on 27 April. Will probably need the run back and is best watched
- **6. MOISSON DE LA COTE -** Third in a class C at Castéra-Verduzan over 2800m on 18 August. Capable of contesting for minor money
- **7. MERRY CHRISTMAS** A winner in a class E at Villereal over 2450m on 16 August. Leading claims to follow up and will have supporters
- **8. MOOREA DE SAUSSEAU -** A winner in a class D at Toulouse over 2750m on 6 June. Looking to complete a hat-trick, but is returning from a break, and fitness must be taken on trust

**Summary:** A small field but a competitive race. MERRY CHRISTMAS (7) is on the upgrade and was a good winner at Villereal earlier this month. He can follow up. MOOREA DE SAUSSEAU (8) has won her last two starts and must be respected. MADGIK SAUTREUIL (2) is improving and has scored in two of his last three starts, so another win would not be a surprise. MITSY DU NOYER (1) has yet to get off the mark but is consistent and cannot be ruled out.

- **1. LAIKA DU LEARD -** Fifth in a class E at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 27 July. Capable of a strong finish and warrants attention
- **2. LAISSEZ PASSER -** Fifth in a class E at Castéra-Verduzan over 2800m on 11 August. Seldom far off them and must not be overlooked
- **3. LORKY RED** Disqualified in a class E at Langon over 2800m on 29 July. Reverts to barefoot, as was the case when winning the penultimate, and if smart is not out of it
- **4. LOULOU'S TEAM -** Ran 10th in a class E at Castéra-Verduzan over 2800m on 11 August. Reverts to barefoot. Others are preferred
- **5. LILAS DU MELEUC -** Fourth in a class E at Castéra-Verduzan over 2800m on 11 August. Remains barefoot. Some improvement in the latest
- **6. LE GRAND AMOUR -** A winner in a class E at Cabourg over 2050m on 8 August. A previous track winner who can come out on top and will have supporters

- **2. JASMIN BLEU -** A winner in a class F at Gabarret over 2550m on 28 July. Remains barefoot. In with a decent shout to follow up
- **3. JEU ROYAL -** Disqualified in a class F at Fleurance over 2600m on 17 August. Others are much preferred in this line-up
- **4. JIRELLA DU LOISIR** Third in a class F at Luxé over 2700m on 2 August. Capable of playing a minor role in the finish at best
- **5. JEUNE PRODIGE -** A runner-up in a class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 21 June. Reverts to barefoot and looks hard to oppose. Will have many supporters

- **2. JUPITER PLANCHETTE -** Disqualified in a class F at Chateaubriant over 2400m on 8 August. Remains barefoot. Already a winner on this track, and if applied, should play a leading role
- **3. IDOLE DE LA COTE -** Third in a class H at Miramont-de-Guyenne over 2700m on 15 August. Remains barefoot. Some improvement in the latest, and might play a minor role
- **4. IANINA DES BORDES -** Finished 6th in a Harness class H at Gémozac over 2700m on 3 August. Has a shoeing configuration change, but needs to improve
- **5. INCUDINE -** Unplaced in a Harness class H at Gémozac over 2600m on 15 August. A shoeing change, but others are preferred

- **3. ICARE BRILLOUARD -** Only modest of late and was 7th in class E at Castera-Verduzan over 2800m on 11 August. Capable of better and has a place chance
- **4. HANNIBAL CARNOIS -** Victorious in Class G at Castera-Verduzan over 2800m on 11 August. Unreliable but keeps that shoe arrangement and is not out of it
- **5. IAGO CAYENNAIS -** Unreliable but was runner-up in class E at Castera-Verduzan over 2800m on 11 August. Remains barefoot and can make the frame
