Race 1 - PRIX SEM- PRIX DES ERABLES - 2650m WALK-UP F72 HCP Harness. Purse EUR €20,000.

- 1. **HOPE COGLAIS** Easily accounted for last time at the first run of the campaign when 13L from the winner in 14th at Lyon-la-Soie. Facing a tough assignment this time around.
- 2. **HARRY MONTAVAL** Continued some plain form when a poor 12th at Lyon-la-Soie nine days ago. Not keen.
- 3. **GAG DE KACY** Was last produced when eighth at Jullianges six months ago. This run will do him the world of good.
- 4. **HAPPY COGLAIS** Form average and it has been eight runs since the last win. Last start finished fifth at this track. Form not inspiring.
- 5. **HALL BLACK DREAM** Racing very well this season, last start scoring at Grenade-sur-G by 2.8L. Top chance again.
- 6. **HALL TOP** Has had three runs this time in and struggled, the latest when 11th at this track. Others preferred.
- 7. **HALTO MESSI** Didn't do a lot when resuming last start, finishing sixth at this track and beaten 5.4L. Solid prospect with that run under the belt.
- 8. **HUNTER DE LA COTE** First up since finishing seventh at Chartres 12 weeks ago. Consider despite the layoff.
- 9. **HULK DU SABLIER** Disqualified last start at this track. Forgive the latest run. Well placed to make amends.
- 10. **HOUSTON JUSTICE** Last raced at Marseille Vivaux on January 31 when he was disqualified. Put a line through that latest run.
- 11. **HELLO VRAC** Registered a minor placing two starts back then a win a month ago by 0.4L at Marseille Vivaux. In form and should feature in the finish again.
- 12. **HERON DE JULLOU** May need the outing following a spell of four months. Last raced when seventh at this track.
- 13. **HIANT DU VAL** Won two back at this track then couldn't repeat the dose last time out when fourth at Vincennes, beaten 2.6L. Well-placed in this contest. Strong contender.
- 14. **HESTUR DE BELLEN** Racing well without winning, making it two minor placings in a row last start when third at Lyon-la-Soie, beaten 3.3L. Looks hard to beat.
- 15. **HELLO BOY DU PIC** Was mediocre when 5.8L away in ninth most recently at his first run back from a break at Lyon-la-Soie. Capable of testing this line up.
- 16. HAKA Disqualified last start at Lyon-la-Soie. Put a line through the latest run. Top pick if at his best.

Summary: HESTUR DE BELLEN (14) finished third behind two subsequent winners at Lyon-la-Soie (Class E) on his first outing barefoot before filling the same spot over the same course and distance nine days ago. Leading hope back at this venue (two wins from three starts). HALL BLACK DREAM (5) score by 3L in this class at Grenade and cannot be discounted. HOUSTON JUSTICE (10) won a Class F at Marseille-Vivaux in November and needs including with an excellent strike-rate barefoot. HAKA (16) would hold claims on his Class F walk-up win at Lyon-la-Soie on penultimate outing.

- 1. **EL PARDO** Has been out of the winner's circle for a long while. Missed out two starts back then was a distant sixth last start at Lyon-la-Soie. Wait until the form picks up.
- 2. FUNKY D'ALB Finished 6.6L back in fourth at his latest appearance at Vincennes. Can make amends.
- 3. **ECKMUHL JACK** Has been struggling of late, most recently finishing seventh at Cagnes-sur-Mer. Rates highly on best form and can bounce back.
- 4. HURELLA Is a last-start winner by 1.7L at Cagnes-sur-Mer. Sure to be in the finish again.
- 5. **HINDEN** Has been out of the winner's circle for a long while. Finished seventh last time out at Vincennes, 5.6L from the winner. Can do a lot better in this suitable contest.
- 6. **HORACE DU GOUTIER** Failed to raise backers' hopes when resuming last start, finishing 12th at Vincennes and beaten 11L. Open to sharp improvement.

Summary: The recent outing of HORACE DU GOUTIER (6) is easily ignored given he raced in shoes and in the context of things he didn't shape badly when twelfth in the G3 Prix de Rouen. The six-year-old showed some solid form in Group company last season and holds a brilliant record in this shoeing combination (five wins from seven starts). Selected to remain unbeaten behind the mobile. HURELLA (4) is pretty prolific around this grade and looms a major threat following a Class D walk-up win at Cagnes-sur-Mer. The drop in standard should aid HINDEN (5) and FUNKY D'ALB (2) looks an each-way candidate.

- 3. **HERMANDA MAT** Last raced at this track on February 12 when she was disqualified. Prefer to see her perform well before recommending.
- 4. **HARPIE GIBUS** Has been struggling of late, most recently finishing fourth at Lyon-la-Soie. Can do much better.
- 5. **HAUTE D'ORTIGE** Was disqualified last start at Lyon-la-Soie on January 15. Prefer to see her perform well before recommending.
- 6. **HUGOLINE** Didn't do a lot when resuming last start, finishing sixth at Lyon-la-Soie and beaten 4L. Will come on from that run and is a strong winning hope.
- 7. **HEPONA D'UN JOUR** Not a threat last start when tenth first-up at Lyon-la-Soie, beaten 7.3L. Facing a tough assignment this time around.

Summary: GRAINE D'URZY (11) finished a sound second in a Class E walk-up at Marseille-Vivaux last outing. Strong claims eased a grade with a new shoeing combination tried. Market support for HOUPETTE ROSE (13) would be interesting given she won a similar course and distance walk-up in November. DQ last-time-out but remains of interest. GALAXIE DU LOISIR (16) is proven at this track and could be in the mix if building on a decent Class E fourth at Lyon-la-Soie last month. Each-way claims go the way of HUGOLINE (6).

- 3. **IRONIE DU RABUTIN** Easily accounted for last time when 5.3L from the winner in fourth at Lyon-la-Soie. This looks a far sterner task.
- 4. **ICE SCOTT** Last raced at this track on February 12 when he was disqualified. Prefer to see him perform well before recommending.
- 5. **IDEAL WIC** Finished third at Lyon-la-Soie last start after he missed the placings but wasn't far away two back at Toulouse. Winning claims.
- 6. IRA STAR Not a threat last start when 13th first-up at this track, beaten 18L. Not keen on her chances.

- 1. **JUKE BOX LOVE** Much better effort last time when he broke his maiden by 0.4L at Lyon-la-Soie. Fitter for two runs back and expected to go well again.
- 2. JAVA DE NERET Finished 3.7L back in seventh at her latest outing at this track. This looks far too tough.
- 3. **JOKAI** Improved last start and broke through for his maiden win at Lyon-la-Soie. Can go back-to-back.
- 4. **JUDYRA BOISSIERE** Missed the placings last start but was only beaten 2.1L when fifth at this track. Cannot enthuse.
- 5. **JACK SPARCK** Finished third at Lyon-la-Soie last start after he missed the top-three but wasn't disgraced two back at Lyon-la-Soie. Sure to be thereabouts.
- 6. **JUST BEAUTIFUL** Turned in a fair performance when fourth at her first run back from a spell at Lyon-la-Soie last start. Expect a much better run this time.

Could take this rise in standard in his stride. JOB DES LOUANGES (11) won a Class C course and distance walk-up last October. Player on that form and goes well with shoes on all four. JEDI DES BROUETS (12) would have to be respected on his Class B walk-up second here two starts ago. Open to improvement with a new shoeing combination tried. JUST BEAUTIFUL (6) won both starts as a three-year-old and remains unexposed in this company.

KISS BOY (3) would likely be in the mix if building on a sound Lyon-la-Soie third in this class eighteen days ago and KENTUCKY EXPRESS (7) rounds out the shortlist.

- 4. **FED DU PATURAL** Was not a factor when resuming last start, finishing tenth at Agen and beaten 13L. Can improve enough to play a big role.
