**C1 - PRIX D'ENTREVAUX - 2925m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR €
35,000**

- 1. IGGY FAFA** - Has only been modest of late and was 12th in class E at this track over 2700m on 31 January. Returns barefoot and can get involved with the finish
- 2. IROISE QUESNOT** - Off form and was 9th in class E at this track over 2700m on 31 January. Needs to do a lot more to beat these rivals
- 3. INFLUENCE JULRY** - Unreliable but was 3rd in class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 11 February. Capable of earning some more money
- 4. I LOVE JOSSELYN** - Did not show his best when 12th in class E at Vincennes over 2850m on 13 January. Returns barefoot and can bounce back to score
- 5. IQUEM** - Did not show his best when 7th in class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 22 January. In good form before that and is not out of it
- 6. ILLICO DE BOUTEAU** - Has disqualification issues but finished 4th at Vincennes over 2100m on 1 February. Victorious back in December and is capable of an upset
- 7. ISOLEE DU BOUILLON** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in class C over this course and distance on 2 January. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 8. IDEAL DELADOU** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 11 February. Others make mre appeal
- 9. IF YOU CAN** - Not reliable but was 4th in class D at this course over 2150m on 31 January. Could play a minor role when smart
- 10. INCAHUASI** - Disqualified in class D at this track over 2700m on 12 February. Victorious back in January when barefoot and can win again

Summary: I LOVE JOSSELYN (4) is best when barefoot, so his last run is safely ignored. He does very well at this track and can take out this opening event. IGGY FAFA (1) is not as reliable as the selection when barefoot, but he does race without shoes this time and can challenge for top honours. IQUEM (5) did not run badly at Vincennes last month and was in better form before that, so is not out of it. INCAHUASI (10) is unreliable but is another to consider.

- 1. JARDIN DU ROI** - Has only been modest of late and finished tenth in Class D at Nates over 3000m on 13 February. Does best when barefoot and could contest the finish
- 2. JUST D'HERIPRE** - Holding form and finished third in Class E at this track over 2150m on 7 February. Can get into the mix of things once again
- 3. JO DE CAZOULENE** - Has only been moderate of late and finished 6th in Class G at this track over 2150m on 10 February. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 4. JOAO DE VANDEL** - Finished 7th in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 10 December.. Battling to find best form and others male more appeal
- 5. JAKADI DE VAUVILLE** - Showed soem improvement when 4th in Class F at Marseille-Vivau over 2650m on 13 February. Has disqualification issues but can earn some money
- 6. JAIKA DES FANES** - Did not show her best when 8th in Class F over this course and distance on 17 February. . Capable of doing better and is not out of it
- 7. JAZZIE DE BERLES** - Unreliable and finished 6th in Class E at this track over 2925m on 23 January. Has a place chance on best form
- 8. JOYEUSE MAB** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in Class F at Marseille-Vivau over 2650m on 13 February. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 9. JANA D'ARMOR** - In good shape and finished third in Class E at Nantes over 3000m on 25 January. On a long losing run but can eaarn some minor money
- 10. JOYAUX DU CHENE** - Holding form and finished fourth in Class E at this track over 2925m on 12 February. Not barefoot this time and others are preferred
- 11. JOSE DU CHERISAY** - Bounced back with a Class G victory over this course and distance on 31 January. Can follow up with more success
- 12. JASMIN DE COEUR** - Disqualified last time out over this course and distance on 31 January. Unreliable and needs to find a few lengths to win
- 13. JADA MOKO** - Unreliable but did finish fourth in Class E at Marseille-Vivau over 2650m on 13 February. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 14. JIRENZO** - Not reliable but did run third in Class E at this track over 2925m on 20 February. Can be a threat once again
- 15. JOLIE MOME CHIC** - Not reliable but did finish fourth in Class E at this track over 2925m on 23 January. Might play a minor role at very best

Summary: a=A competitive-looking race. JOSE DU CHERISAY (11) gets the vote to score on the back of a dominant win over this track and trip last month. He can score again. JARDIN DU ROI (1) does best when barefoot and can fight out the finish once again. JUST D'HERIPRE (2) is consistent and should be competitive again. JAIKA DES FANES (6) is better than her last run would suggest and can make the frame.

- 1. JAGUAR JENILOU** - Finished 6th in class F at this course over 2925m on 10 February. Victorious in November and has been prepared for this race. Can contest the finish
- 2. ISAAC DE SYVA** - Off form and finished 11th in Class E at this track over 2150m on 21 January when barefoot. Not this time and others make more appeal
- 3. JOCKSTRAP** - Disqualified in class E at this course over 2150m on 21 January. Has disqualification issues and others make more appeal
- 4. IMBRIN BUROIS** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in class F at this course over 2925m on 10 February. On a long losing streak and others are preferred
- 5. JOLIE SMART** - Victorious in Class G at this track over 2925m on 17 February. In good form and is capable of doubling up
- 6. JIQUEL** - Disqualified in class E at this track over 2925m on 12 February. Returns barefoot but needs to improve to beat these rivals
- 7. JET GIRL** - Returned to form and was 4th in class E at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 15 February. Can make the frame
- 8. JOJO LAPIN** - Unreliable but was fourth in class F at this track over 2925m on 10 February. Victorious back in January cannot be ruled out from scoring
- 9. INES D'HERMES** - Unreliable and finished 6th in class F over this course and distance on 17 February. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 10. JOKER DE BELLOU** - Showed some improvement and was 5th in class F at this track over 2700m on 17 February. Remains barefoot might need to find a few lengths to score
- 11. IVAN D'URZY** - In good form and was runner-up in class F at Marseille-Vivauz over 2650m on 4 December. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 12. ICARE DU POMMEREUX** - Finished 6th in class E at this course over 2150m on 10 February. Has major disqualification issues and is best watched for now
- 13. JOURUNTOME** - Consistent and was runner-up in class F over this course and distance on 17 February. Can go one place better
- 14. JACK DU CEBE** - Did not show his best when unplaced in in Class E at Argentan over 2825m on 6 February. Capable of better and has a place chance
- 15. JUPITER MADRIK** - Disqualified in class E at Graignes over 2725m on 2 February. Not easy to trust but is capable of earning some money
- 16. JINGALO BABEL** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class E at this course over 2925m on 12 February. Successful back in October and might play a minor role

Summary: JOURUNTOME (13) is threatening to win and this race looks an ideal opportunity for him to hit the target. JAGUAR JENILOU (1) has been prepared for this race and must be respected for that. JOLIE SMART (5) is in good form and was a solid winner at this track, so may well follow up. JET GIRL (7) is not as reliable as some of her competitors, but she is barefoot and quite capable of getting involved in the finish.

- 1. LASKO DES FORGES** - Finished 4th in class C at this track over 2150m on 12 February. Victorious back in February when barefoot and can contest the finish
- 2. KOCKTAIL LOVE** - Off form and finished 9th in class F over this track and trip on 3 February. Has major disqualification issues and others make more appeal
- 3. KOH I NOOR** - Unreliable and finished 9th in class D at Angers over 2350m on 15 January. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 4. KERNO** - Did not show his best when 7th in class D at Toulouse over 2150m on 19 February. Might play a minor role at very best
- 5. KISS ME JULRY** - Keeps hitting the crossbar and was runner-up in class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 19 January. Can be very competitive once again
- 6. KONRAD DE CORDAY** - Not disgraced when 5th in class F at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 25 January. Returns barefoot and has some nice victories before that. Must be respected for that
- 7. LUCIFERMORNINGSTAR** - 7th in class D at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 25 January. Unreliable and others are preferred
- 8. LEDZEP** - Successful in Class C at this track over 2150m on 12 February when barefoot. Has shown improvement and can double up
- 9. LYNYRD SKYNYRD** - Disqualified in class F over this track and trip on 10 February. Unlucky that day. Hard to trust but quite capable of scoring when smart
- 10. LIVANTO KALOUMA** - In good form and finished 3rd in class C over this course and distance on 23 January. Remains barefoot and should fight out the finish
- 11. KRIS MARTIN** - Not reliable and was 5th in class E over this track and trip on 12 February. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 12. KIMBA DU NOYER** - Unreliable and finished 3rd in class B over this course and distance on 17 February. Remains barefoot and has a place chance
- 13. LET ME SIXTY ONE** - Finished 9th in class B over this track and trip on 17 February. Victorious back in November but needs to improve to score

LEDZEP (8) was victorious over the shorter distance at this course on his latest start and is not out of it. KONRAD DE CORDAY (6) is barefoot and capable of bouncing back to score.

- 1. MBAPE DES CHARRONS** - Faulted last time out in class D at over this course and distance on 10 February. Not easy to trust but can score when staying on the trot
- 2. MOSTRA DE CHANLECY** - Unreliable but was 4th in class D over this track and trip on 7 February. Victorious back in September and can play a minor role at very best
- 3. MA COPINE FLAC** - Victorious in Class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 February. Tougher task this time but has a place chance
- 4. MAJOR GEDE** - Consistent and finished 3rd in class D over this course and distance on 10 February. Can be competitive yet again
- 5. MY LOVE DU VIVIER** - A runner- up in class D over this track and trip on 10 February. Threatening to hit the target and has claims in this line-up
- 6. MOLLY DU VALLON** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class C at this track over 2150m on 3 February. Can earn some money when staying in stride
- 7. MIGUEL DU CHERISAY** - Disqualified in class C at this track over 2150m on 3 February. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 8. MEXICAIN** - Victorious in Class E at this track over 2700m on 3 February. Improving and should be right there at the finish
- 9. MY WAY LEAGABIN** - Only modest of late and finished 5th in class C at this track over 2150m on 3 February. Might need to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 10. MOOREA** - Not disgraced when 4th in class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 26 January and cannot be ruled out from winning
- 11. MACARENA D'HOULBEC** - Consistent and finished 3rd in class C at this course over 2150m on 3 February. Can earn some more money
- 12. MAGGY JENILOU** - Victorious in Class D at this course over 2150m on 23 February. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish

Summary: MBAPE DES CHARRONS (1) does come with disqualification issues, but he is talented and capable of winning well when in the mood. A confident pick to score. MY LOVE DU VIVIER (5) has been unlucky not to score recently and will be a lively danger once again. MEXICAIN (8) is improving and comes off a confidence-boosting win, so must be respected for that. MAJOR GEDE (4) is consistent and races without shoes, so can also shine brightly.

- 1. NUBA DE PERVENCHE** - Much improved second run when runner-up in Class F at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 25 January. More is needed to bat these runners
- 2. NEWLIFE DE CAHOT** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at this track on 7 February. Hard to trust but did win when staying on the trot and can earn some money
- 3. NOLAN QUESNOT** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including at at this track on 7 February. Hard to trust and others mae more appeal
- 4. NYCIA RED** - A winner on debut, in Class F at this track over 2150m on 10 February. Tries further but is not out of it
- 5. NOTTINGHAM ROYAL** - Showed improvement when a winner in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2050m on 19 January. Tackles tough but is not out of it
- 6. NESPO** - Victorious on debut in Class E over this track and trip on 17 February. Cauppable of following up in this line-up
- 7. NOBLE PETTEVINIERE** - Knocking at the door and was runner -up in Class E over this course and distance on 17 February. Can go one place better
- 8. NEURO BELLA** - Disqualified at this track on 7 February. Has some disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 9. NARKOS DU CHATAULT** - Consistent and finished 4th in Class B over this track and trip on 12 February. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 10. NORIA DE BERTRANGE** - Disqualified at this track on 12 February. Has some fair form before that and can play a minor role when smart
- 11. NASSANDRA** - Unbeaten in two starts, the latest in Class C over this course and distance on 16 January. Can complete the hat-trick

Summary: A good race. NESPO (6) impressed on debut and it was over this course and distance, so gets the nod to follow up. NASSANDRA (11) is undefeated in two starts and both were over this track and trip. She will not go down easily. NYCIA RED (4) won on debut over a shorter distance at this track and must be respected for that success. NOBLE PETTEVINIERE (7) has hit the crossbar twice so far and is another to consider.

- 1. LUXY DE CRENNES** - Has some fair form and finished 3rd in Class F at Hyeres over 2650m on 8 February. Might play a minor role
- 2. KAIROS DU GOUTIER** - Unreliable and finished 7th in Class E at this track over 2150m on 7 February. Needs to do more to score
- 3. KAIROS QUICK** - Dsqalified twice in a row, the latest at Hyeres on 8 February. Capable of contesting the finish when smart
- 4. LARGO DE JOUDES** - Returned to form and finished 4th in a claimer at Vincennes over 2700m on 6 February. Consistent in this division and can score
- 5. KIKAR DE BEYLEV** - Holding form and finished 4th in a Class E at this track over 2150m on 17 February. Should be right there at the finish yet again
- 6. L'ETOILE D'URSIN** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in a Class D at this track over 2700m on 10 February. Capable of doing better and has a place chance
- 7. LINDSTEDT** - Disqualified three tims in a row, the latest at Vincennes on 30 January. Hard to trust but can score when staying in stride
- 8. KASIMODO** - Not reliable and finished 6th in Class E at this track over 2150m on 17 February. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 9. KISS THE MOON** - Not reliable and finished 6th in Class E at this track over 2150m on 3 February. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 10. LATINO TURGOT** - Finished 5th in Class E at Marseille-VivauX over 2650m on 13 February. Has only been modest of late and others make more appeal
- 11. KABRIEL** - Unreliable and finished 10th in Class E at Marseille-VivauX over 2650m on 13 February. Might play a minor role at very best

Summary: LARGO DE JOUDES (4) has a good record at this level and is clearly the one to beat. KIKAR DE BEYLEV (5) continues to hold form and can challenge for top honours this time around. KAIROS QUICK (3) has a couple of faults in a row but can contest the finish when staying on the trot. LINDSTEDT (7) does have the ability to score, but he is even harder to trust. He would not be a surprise winner, though.

- 1. EK DEL RONCO** - A winner of his last four harness races , the latest at Bologne over 2460m on 7 January. Can earn some money
- 2. JEEK D'ACADIE** - In good shape and was runner-up in a Class E harness race at this track over 2150m on 10 February. Can surprise this longer distance
- 3. KARA D'OR** - Unreliable but was runner-up in a Class C harness race over this course and distance on 3 February. Can earn some money
- 4. ENAOZ** - Victorious in a Class D mounted race over this course and distance on 8 January. Should double up with another win
- 5. JOKER DU MIDI** - Has only been modest of late and finished 8th in a Class E mounted race over this course and distance on 12 February. Others are preferred
- 6. DAMISELA** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in a Class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2850m on 9 December. Can make the frame
- 7. JAVA D'ECAJEUL** - Not reliable but finished 4th in a Class E mounted race over this track and trip on 12 February. Has a place chance
- 8. HIRO DE L'ORMERIE** - Has struggled of late and finished 10th in a Class E mounted race at Monflanquin over 2500m on 11 May. Returns from a break and others make more appeal
- 9. IMPARTIAL** - Showed some improvement when 3rd in Class E harness race at Toulouse over 2950m on 7 February. More is needed under the saddle this time
- 10. IMPERIAL KEY** - Very consistent and was runner-up in a Class E mounted race at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 January. Should be a threat again
- 11. INITIALE CASTELETS** - Has struggled of late and finished 9th in a Class D harness race at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 2 February. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 12. HEVA BLONDE** - Has improved of late and was runner-up in a Class D mounted race at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 2 February. Can be competitive once again
- 13. HAWAI RIVER** - Unreliable and finished 9th in a Class B harness race at Vincennes over 2850m on 17 February. Capable of better under the saddle and might play a minor role

Summary: An interesting lucky last race. A number of these runners are in good shape, but ENAOZ (4) does look the best of them. He was a solid winner over this track and trip last month and can take this race out as well. IMPERIAL KEY (10) is very consistent and will challenge for top honours yet again. HEVA BLONDE (12) has improved of late and is clearly not out of it. DAMISELA (6) has also done enough of late to make the frame.
