## R4 ENGHEN [L-H]

**C1 - PRIX DU PONT ALEXANDRE III - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class E Race -  
Harness - EUR € 41,000**

- 1. KHITARA** - Has struggled of late and finished 11th last time out in Class E at Reims over 2550m on 2 March. Capable of an upset on best form
- 2. KASANE DU BISET** - Holding form and finished fourth last time out in Class E at Graignes over 2725m on 16 March. Quite capable of making the frame
- 3. KELLE EAU** - Has improved of late and was runner-up in this class at Laval over 2650m on 6 March. Clearly not out of it
- 4. KOURSE MAGIC** - Disqualified last time out at Laval on 6 March. In good form before that and can bounce back to score
- 5. KASSIOPEE DREAM** - Threatening to win and was runner-up last time out in Class E at Caen over 2200m on 6 March. Can go one better
- 6. KALINKA MOYA** - Has struggled of late and finished 12th last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 17 February. Needs major improvement to win
- 7. KUNZITE D'EM** - Disqualified last time out at Vincennes on 7 February. Hard to trust but is capable of popping up in a place when in the right mood
- 8. KALINKA SOMOLLI** - Disqualified in her last three starts, with the latest being at Vincennes on 28 February. Capable of playing a minor role when wise
- 9. KARA DE PIERREPONT** - Has been struggling for some time now and finished tenth last time out in Class F at Caen over 2200m on 17 March. Unlikely to win
- 10. KALINKA DU GREMAT** - On a long losing run but did show improvement when fourth last time out in Class D at Laval over 2650m on 6 March. Might earn some minor money
- 11. KRISTA DE KERYANN** - Returned from a break and was victorious in this division at Cordemais over 2825m on 28 February. Can follow up

**Summary:** Denied a clear run last time, KOURSE MAGIC (4) is primed to set the record straight. Back with Mathieu Mottier, who guided her to her last victory, she has a favorable draw and should be in the thick of things. KASSIOPEE DREAM (5) arrives in top form and is well-placed behind the car-start. She can to go close. KRISTA DE KERYANN (11) is a reliable contender in this grade and won't be far away. KHITARA (1) is not without a chance if things go her way.

## C2 - PRIX DU PONT DU CARROUSEL - 2875m (a2m) - Class D Race - Mounted - EUR € 46,000

- 1. JUPITER DE VAL** - Unreliable but was a good third in a Class E Mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 13 March. Capable of scoring in this line-up
- 2. JIHERE DU PORET** - In good shape and was third in a Class F Mounted race over this course and distance on 11 March. Should be competitive again
- 3. JOURNEY** - Finished 6th last time out in a Class E harness race at Vincennes over 2700m on 30 November. Could need this run returning from a break
- 4. KUSAERI** - Unreliable and finished 11th in a Class E harness race at this track over 2150m on 7 March. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 5. KAPORAL VISASIS** - Only 7th in a Class D harness race at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 27 February. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 6. DEE GODFATHER** - Has struggled this year and was 11th in a Class E Mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 28 February. Capable of better but others are preferred
- 7. JOTT DU BOCAGE** - Has struggled of late and finished 9th last time out in a Class E Mounted race at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 3 March. Needs major improvement to win
- 8. JINGLE DES BROUETS** - Unreliable but did run well when third in a Class E Mounted race at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 27 February. Can earn some more money
- 9. CONRADS PALLE** - In good form and was third last time out in a Mounted race at Solvalla over 1640m on 19 February. Has a winning chance
- 10. JAZZ PETTEVINIERE** - Has major disqualification issues but was runner-up in a Class F Mounted race over this track and trip on 11 March. Can go one better if wise again
- 11. MERCEDES STAR** - Did not show his best when barefoot and 9th in a Class D Mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 22 December. Remains barefoot and could play a minor role
- 12. KING DE PLAY** - Disqualified last time out at Cagnes-sur-Mer on 18 February. was in good form before that and is capable of making the frame
- 13. JAVRILLON** - On a very long losing run but is in good form and finished third last time out in a Class E Mounted race at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 3 March. Not out of it

**Summary:** CONRADS PALLE (9) was a promising third on debut under the saddle in Scandinavia and can be given plenty of consideration on his first start on French soil. JAZZ PETTEVINIERE (10) posted a reassuring effort over the course & distance last time out and is highly respected. JAVRILLON (13) is in great form and finds here an ideal entry at 175 Euros from the threshold. JUPITER DE VAL (1) posted a promising effort on re-entry at Caen and is another one with a live chance.

## C3 - PRIX DU PONT D'IENA - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 41,000

- 1. KALYPSO DE THIERRE** - Remains in good form and was third last time out in Class E at Laval over 2650m on 6 March. Can contest the finish again
- 2. KANSAS BONBON** - Not disgraced when 5th last time out in Class E at Graignes over 2725m on 16 March. Has a place chance
- 3. KINGDOM DE CHENU** - Unreliable but did run well when third in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 17 March. Might play a minor role when smart
- 4. KAISER TURGOT** - In good form this year and was runner-up in Class E at this track over 2850m on 11 March. Has a winning chance
- 5. KING OF RACE** - Disappointing form of late and was 7th in Class F at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 18 March. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 6. KOZMIC BLUES** - Disqualified last time out at Graignes on 16 March. Is always capable of popping up in a place when in the right mood
- 7. KLEMS DE JAVIE** - On a long losing run but was runner-up last time out in Class E at Graignes over 2725m on 16 March. Could make the frame
- 8. KINGMAN DELO** - In good form and was runner-up last time out in Class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 8 March. Barefoot and can go one better
- 9. KIRIO DE REUX** - Not easy to trust but was barefoot and third in Class E at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 3 March. Can make the frame when smart
- 10. KENDALL** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced last time out in Class E at Graignes over 2725m on 16 March. Others are much preferred
- 11. KAID FORTUNA** - On a very long losing run but was runner-up last time out in Class F at Chartres over 3300m on 16 March. Better that distance and others make more appeal
- 12. KAIROUAN GLAM** - A good winner last time out in Class E at Cordemais over 2825m on 28 February. His disqualification issues but is capable of following up

**Summary:** KINGMAN DELO (8) is a very reliable performer in this division and looks a solid winning proposition but he will have to overcome his poor draw on the outside of the front row. KAIROUAN GLAM (12) is a delicate trotter but can win a race like this if he is in the mood. KALYPSO DE THIERRE (1) tries a new shoeing feature and could pop-up at a nice price. KLEMS DE JAVIE (7) finished in front of the selection at Laval on 15 February and is not out of it.

## C4 - PRIX DU PONT DE GRENELLE - 2250m (a1m1/2) - Class C Race - Mounted - EUR € 68,000

- 1. KATE BALDWIN** - Much improved this year and finished a hat-trick by taking out a Class D Mounted race at Vincennes over 2175m on 28 February. Can be competitive again
- 2. JOY ALISSA** - Disappointing form of late and was 13th last time out in a Class D harness race at Vincennes over 2100m on 26 February. Capable of better and is not out of it
- 3. IT'S MY DREAM** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Class B Mounted race at this track over 2875m on 18 March. Likes this track and could surprise
- 4. GET UP DES PLAINES** - Battling to regain best form and finished 5th in a Class D harness race at Laval over 2850m on 27 February. Needs to do a bit more to win
- 5. ISOCRATE D'ELA** - Consistent under the saddle and was a Class E winner last time out at Laval over 2850m on 12 March. Remains barefoot and can make the frame
- 6. ALONE (SWE)** - On a very long losing run and finished 8th last time out in a Class E Mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 12 March. Needs major improvement to win
- 7. HOTKATISSIME** - Holding form and was not disgraced when fourth in a Class E Mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 12 March. Might make the frame at best
- 8. IMPERIAL COGLAIS** - In very good form and was not disgraced when fourth in a Group 3 Mounted race at Vincennes over 2175m on 16 February. Be right there at the finish once again
- 9. GOLDEN GRACE** - Very unreliable and was 7th last time out in a Class D harness at this track over 2150m on 7 March. Others make more appeal
- 10. GLADIATOR BOY** - Unreliable of late and finished 7th in a Class C Mounted race at Vincennes over 2850m on 21 February on 21 February. His last win was in 2023 but is capable of earning some money
- 11. HURRICANE WAY** - Disqualified last time out at at this track on 7 March. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 12. IVANOF** - Holding form and finished third in a Class A harness race at Laval over 2850m on 12 March. Might play a minor role
- 13. ILLENC DES BOSC** - Remains barefoot and was a good third last time out in a Class C Mounted race at Vincennes over 2175m on 19 January. Has a winning chance

**Summary:** A winner on his only previous start at this venue, ILLENC DES BOSC (13) hails from a powerful yard and gets the nod in this wide-open contest. JOY ALISSA (2) produced some solid efforts at Vincennes over the winter and can go close if in similar form. IMPERIAL COGLAIS (8) has been freshened up after a fruitful winter campaign and should be in the mix. KATE BALDWIN (1) is better than ever and warrants serious consideration.

**C5 - PRIX DE L'ISERE - 2875m (a2m) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR €  
35,000**

- 1. LYUBOV** - Yet to win a race and was 8th in Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 21 November. Could need this run returning from a break
- 2. LAURIANE DU RIED** - Hard to trust and has been disqualified in her last two starts, with the latest being at Meslay-du-Maine on 18 March. Others are preferred
- 3. LIBERTY FRECA** - Has struggled this year and was tenth in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 12 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 4. LILYROSE WIND** - In good shape and was runner-up in Class F at Caen over 2200m on 6 March. Likes that track and trip but is not out of it
- 5. LADY PETTEVINIERE** - Has major disqualification issues and finished 8th last time out in Class E at Caen over 2450m on 13 March. Needs major improvement to win
- 6. LESDY MAGODA** - Yet to win a race but was not disgraced when third in Class E at Caen over 2450m on 13 March. Capable of making the frame
- 7. LUMIERE DE BAILLE** - Returned to form and was runner-up in Class E at Vincennes over 2200m when barefoot on 18 February. Remains barefoot and can go one better
- 8. LUCKY LADY D'AMOUR** - Unreliable but was not disgraced when fourth in Class E at Caen over 2450m on 13 March. Might play a minor role
- 9. L'ATHENIA BELLA** - Very consistent so far and was victorious last time out in Class E at Nantes over 2275m on 14 February. Should contest the finish again
- 10. LOMBARDINA** - A barefoot winner last time out in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 28 February. Remains barefoot and can follow up
- 11. LOTTA ROSIE** - Has improved since going barefoot and was fourth last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 14 February. Can play a minor role

**Summary:** LUMIERE DE BAILLE (7) goes unshod and finds here a great spot to resume winning ways. In case she fails to run up to expectations, the best alternative for success is the very useful LOMBARDINA (10), who goes barefoot too for the occasion. LILYROSE WIND (4) boasts solid form in this division and is another one with a live chance. L'ATHENIA BELLA (9) has done little wrong since her debut race and can get a look in.

1. **JAMIROQUAI** - In good form of late and was runner-up in this division at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 4 March. Be right there at the finish yet again
2. **JACK FOULONIERE** - Unplaced last time out in Class E at Caen over 2200m on 6 March. Capable of popping up in a place
3. **JASPE** - Did not show his best when 11th last time out in Class E at Caen over 2200m on 6 March. Can be a threat dropped to a claimer
4. **JARFALLA QUICK** - Disqualified last time out at Cagnes-sur-Mer on 4 March. In good form before that and has a winning chance
5. **JOULYO VITA** - Disqualified last time out at Vincennes on 12 February. Capable of making the frame on best form
6. **JABADAO** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in a claimer at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 16 March. Not out of it
7. **JUAN CARLOS GIFONT** - On a long losing run and finished 8th last time out in Class E at this track over 2765m on 14 March. Can win a race like this
8. **JAGUAR DU GITE** - Victorious last time out in a claimer at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2875m on 15 March. Can follow up this shorter distance
9. **KIRA DE CAHOT** - Disappointing form this year and finished 9th in Class D at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 17 February. Could be the surprise package of the race
10. **JOLIE FLEUR OR** - Has some fair form and was not disgraced when 5th last time out in Class F at Toulouse over 2950m on 7 March. Might play a minor role
11. **KALIKA DU RIS** - Disqualified last time out at Cagnes-sur-Mer on 26 February. Needs to find a few lengths to win this race
12. **JIPSY ROYALE** - Disqualified last time out at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne on 2 march. Capable of better but others make more appeal
13. **JACOVIA MADRIK** - Unreliable and finished 12th in Class G at Chartres over 2825m on 16 March. Capable of better but others are preferred
14. **JORADE DAIRPET** - Needed the last run when 9th in Class F at Châtelailon-La Rochelle over 2625m on 9 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win
15. **JOSIO DU POMMEREUX** - Unreliable and finished 7th last time out in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 3 March. Has a place chance on best form

**Summary:** UAN CARLOS GIFONT (7) has competed at a higher level and can make a big impact on his claiming race debut. JARFALLA QUICK (4) showed plenty of ability last year, and while she may not be fully tuned up yet, dismissing her would be a risk. JASPE (3) drops back into a winnable contest and should be in the mix. The in-form JAMIROQUAI (1) makes his first start for a new yard and is worth a second look.

- 1. LA CHENEVIERE** - Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at this track on 7 March. Hard to trust but is capable of a surprise when wise
- 2. LOTUS PAULOIS** - Yet to win a race and finished 8th last time out in a Class D Mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 17 February. Others make more appeal
- 3. LOTUS DES SABLES** - Yet to win a race but was runner-up last time out in a Class E Mounted race over this track and trip on 7 March. Has a place chance
- 4. LOUSTIC** - Very consistent and was third last time out in a Class D Mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 17 February. Can contest the finish yet again
- 5. LUSSABEAU** - Yet to win a race and finished 7th last time out in a Class C Mounted race over this track and trip on 14 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 6. LYNX ATOUT** - Has some fair form and was not disgraced when 5th in a Class C Mounted race over this course and distance on 14 March. Capable of earning some money

- 2. HILTON BERRY** - Has lost the way and was 12th in Class G at Graignes over 2700m on 23 February. Others are much preferred
- 3. GASBY DU MESNIL** - Disqualified in his last two starts, with the latest being at Bihorel-lès-Rouen on 9 March. Strips fitter and capable of a surprise
- 4. JARDIN DU ROI** - Returned to form with a Class F win at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 3 March. Remains barefoot and can follow up
- 5. GOLF** - Disqualified last time out at Agen-Le Passage on 2 March. Likely to need some runs to get to peak fitness and others make more appeal
- 6. HEIKO VANCEEN** - Unreliable but did not run too badly when 5th in Class F over this track and trip on 14 March. Could play a minor role
- 7. HALAFOLY ROBSEN** - Unreliable but was not disgraced when fourth in Class F at Caen over 2450m on 17 March. Can contest the finish when in the right mood
