## R3 CAEN [R-H]

### C1 - PRIX DE BEAUMONT-EN-AUGE - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class F Amateur Riders - Harness - EUR € 19,000

- 1. KREIZ DE PRAT GUEN** - Went off the boil last autumn and has picked up where he left off. Is barefoot on this occasion but others still easier to back
- 2. KAMA D'EM** - Quality element making first appearance since May 2025. Is clearly in conditioning-mode and can be ignored
- 3. KALINE DE LA COUR** - No slouch on a good day and has form under these conditions. Benefits from a good draw but at this level will have her work cut out
- 4. KIRENE FLASH** - Secured victory at Amiens before coming 3rd at Vire 3 weeks ago. Enjoys the plum spot in front, is reunited with Pierre Courval who won with her that day, and from the 4 slot is easy to fancy for the win
- 5. KINGSTON DU BOURG** - Seldom gets his nose in front but has had the benefit of 2 conditioners. Appreciates the Caen profile and is well-placed to give this a good go. Place prospect
- 6. KENACHA** - Honest mare that consistently gives her best. Is new to the venue though and in this company will struggle to make her mark
- 7. KAISER TURGOT** - In the frame in 3 of last 4, latterly 2nd in a Vire Class F early this month. Goes well in the day's configuration and his place is on the podium
- 8. KUTARA MICHE** - Serious mare that won under these conditions last September. Is barefoot for her first target of the year, and steps up in category, but is still unlikely to be too far off the mark
- 9. KELLY D'ERABLE** - Has looked decidedly ordinary for some time and even though having placed last time here, still looks a rank outsider
- 10. KRONOS DE TROIS** - Goes barefoot for the first time this season but is out of his depth here and can be confidently passed over
- 11. KARO DAIRPET** - Has turned a corner lately with 2 straight places, but races shod this time and best to keep one's powder dry
- 12. KNOX JENILOU** - Made short work of a 2600m Lyon-Parilly Class F on 14 April. Starts on second row but, with form maintained, can repeat
- 13. KIWI DE LAVRIGNAIE** - Won smartly at Laval before being eliminated in a Bordeaux Class F 12 days ago. Is difficult to fault when barefoot and focused though and cannot be discounted
- 14. KRAC BOREAL** - Lost his way after imposing at Mauquenchy in late-January. Is not ideally-placed either and others preferred
- 15. KOBRA JENILOU** - Just twice out of first 3 in 13 career starts. Returns to racing shod after dominating a Lisieux Class D a month back, and in spite of a tough draw, still looks a respectable first-5 chance

**16. KAPORAL GAME** - Useful dual-discipline trotter that has hardly put a foot wrong this year. Has yet to deliver at Caen but in present shape is difficult to ignore

**Summary:** Terrifically-engaged at the limit of earnings, KIRENE FLASH (4) returns to Caen at the top of her game and, barefoot for the occasion, will be a tough nut to crack. Less-favourably-drawn but impressive winner in Lyon mid-month on just his 2nd start for Nicolas Bazire, KNOX JENILOU (12) looks the principal danger. KAISER TURGOT (7) has been knocking at the door and won his only start over course and distance. Shod to preference for his first objective of the spring, KINGSTON DU BOURG (5) has pulled a good number and has never failed to fire at Caen.

**C2 - PRIX DE PERRIERS - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Mounted - EUR €  
18,500**

- 1. NELSON DE BANVILLE** - Qualified unexceptionally under harness last September. Hails from a good home though and with Alexandre Abrivard in the irons must not be underestimated
- 2. NIRVANA DE VANDEL** - Qualified unremarkably here last October. Guillaume Martin in the saddle for debut but is still not a priority
- 3. NITBY** - Returns to the code after a change of scenery at Lisieux recently but can expect to have few takers
- 4. NO LIMIT** - Courageous but unthreatening 4th behind NOORHA D'IQUAINE (15) in a Class E under these conditions on 25 March, and is unlikely to shake things up
- 5. NARAGONAISE** - Has yet to show any particular flair for the game and has little to contribute
- 6. NATCHELLO GLYCINES** - Makes monte bow after a solid debut in the other discipline. Top jockey in the saddle and looks main threat to NOVA D'URZY (7)
- 7. NOVA D'URZY** - Lightly-raced filly taking first competitive monte steps. Has a lot going for her here and will be well-backed to win this
- 8. NEW ORLEANS WIND** - Turns her hand to the ridden code after running 3rd on debut in a 2800m Pontchateau Class E a fortnight ago. Oscar Placier in charge this time and can be confident of picking up a cheque
- 9. NEPTUNE D'AUVRECY** - Placed in 1 of 2 monte starts before the break. Has a harness conditioner under his belt but is being aimed too high this time
- 10. NEW LIFE** - Eliminated on monte debut in a Class E over course and distance a month ago. Showed her form though and, on good behaviour, can contest the finish
- 11. NOZAKA DU CLOS** - 2nd on career debut in a 2950m Saint-Malo Class F earlier in the month, but is in better company this time and chances limited
- 12. NARCISSE TURGOT** - Eliminated in both monte starts to date but his potential is not in question. Benjamin Rochard aboard this time and can go close if he keeps his charge applied
- 13. NICO DU CEDRE** - Has taken well to his new vocation, most recently 3rd in a Class E over course and distance on 30 March. Will be pitted against some good fillies this time but could nevertheless pick up some minor honours
- 14. NYAKA** - Switches code for first time following 3 straight sanctions, but will first need to reaffirm
- 15. NOORHA D'IQUAINE** - Ran 2nd over course and distance a month back, but eliminated at Reims next time and others easier to support
- 16. NIGHT FOR YOU** - Sent for a spell after being eliminated on monte debut on 5 February. Has been afforded ample time to recalibrate and has a decent chance of finishing in the mix

**Summary:** Respectable in both harness starts last month, the nicely-bred NOVA D'URZY (7) sports 4 pads for her monte debut, and with Mathieu Mottier in the irons will be expected to furnish a big performance. NATCHELLO GLYCINES (6) switches code after debuting well under harness last month and Paul Ploquin gets the nod. Eliminated under these conditions on her monte debut a month back, NEW LIFE (10) nevertheless gave an encouraging account and Alexis Collette will be eager to put things right. Plainly talented, but also clearly spirited, NARCISSE TURGOT (12) will be no soft touch if Benjamin Rochard keeps him focused.

**C3 - PRIX DE CARPIQUET - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR €  
21,000**

**1. NEIGE DES LANDES** - Ran pleasant 3rd at Ranés earlier in the month but in this category will have little to offer

**2. NOBEL DU RIB** - Ran 3rd to a pair of very good colts who have since confirmed, on debut, in a Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel on 8 March. Will have progressed for the race and can go closer this time

**3. NUSCH NOVA** - Unexceptional filly that has placed just once in 4 starts and is not about to trouble the judge

**4. NOUBA DU CABARET** - Unthreatening 4th of 6 finishers in a Graignes Class F 3 weeks ago. Faces a tougher lot this time and is unlikely to cause an upset

**5. NOT ALLOWED** - Did everything asked of her on debut early this month when close 2nd in a Cherbourg Class F. Looked thoroughly professional that day and it will not be long before she loses her maiden tag

**6. NOUMEA DES YVETS** - Entrusted to Mathieu Mottier after making modest comeback on turf 2 weeks ago and is unlikely to spice things up

**7. NEUILLY DE PLAY** - Back under harness after being eliminated in a monte Class E here a month ago. Showed form though and cannot be ruled out

**8. NELSON MELODY** - Takes a notable step up in category after winning a Ranés Class G on debut early this month and while unlikely to repeat, will sport front pads and should nevertheless acquit himself competitively

**9. NIKYSTAR D'AUVRECY** - 3rd over course and distance on 2 March but twice failed to confirm. Sports 4 pads this time but still not a priority

**10. NANTUS D'AVIGNERE** - Not altogether at his ease when 6th in a Class E under these conditions a month back. Paul Ploquin at the helm this time and is easy to like for a first-5 cheque

**11. NOT A BAD DEAL** - Has done little of note since imposing at Mons on seasonal bow, and latest Mauquenchy performance inspires little confidence

**12. NEW STAR WIND** - Made amends for Vire elimination when 2nd of 14 in an Ecommoy Class F on 6 April. Trainer back in the bike and can trot her way onto the podium provided she keeps her action together

**13. NINA ROSE** - Comfortably won a 2950m Saint-Malo Class F on 4 April, first time out. Trainer hands over the reins to a top pilot and the double looks well within her reach

**14. NACRE JADOR** - Wonderfully-engaged here but would have better prospects at a lower level

**Summary:** Winner on her debut at Saint-Malo 3 weeks ago, the nicely-engaged NINA ROSE (13) will be reined by Yoann Lebourgeois this time, will sport front pads for the occasion, and is easy to like for the win. NOBEL DU RIB (2) though caught the eye at Le Mont-Saint-Michel last month, first time out, and looks competitively well in. As for NOT ALLOWED (5), she was just headed at Cherbourg on her own career bow and will have come on for the run. In the frame in 2 of her last 3 starts, NEW STAR WIND (12) returns to a hard surface with a good hand to play.

**C4 - PRIX DE MESLAY - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Mounted - EUR €  
24,000**

- 1. LUNA BELLA BROUETS** - Modest mare starting for the first time since November and even though barefoot will have nothing to bring to the table
- 2. LINAROSA** - Has been disappointing in both codes for some time and in this company has no possible chance
- 3. LEDA SAINT LATUIN** - Ran 3rd at Laval before failing to deliver at Meslay-du-Maine earlier in the month. Sports modified shoeing and is not incapable of bouncing back
- 4. LOVE ME JIVE** - Has shown improvement over recent weeks and has been reconfigured. Takes on a more exalted lot this time but still cannot be ruled out
- 5. LOVA DE FROMENTEL** - Gave a good account when 2nd in a Vire Class F 3 weeks ago. Seldom disappoints for Antonin Andre and can figure prominently
- 6. LAURENTINA TURGOT** - Has yet to show any particular flair for the code. Is unraced since November and will have nothing to contribute
- 7. LATINA DE TILOU** - Not without merit but is as complicated as they come and others easier to trust
- 8. LOLITA DU MIREL** - Has placed just once in 5 monte starts and current form does little to inspire confidence
- 9. LICORNE DE LA JOIE** - Sports a fresh configuration for return to the venue. Is confirmed here and excels with Alexis Collette. Place prospect
- 10. LAQUILA WOOD** - Never far from faulting but has bags of ability. Will be barefoot for the first time under the saddle and the engagement of Benjamin Rochard may be just the ticket
- 11. LEA D'HOULBEC** - Ran 3rd under the saddle at Elbeuf before being conditioned in the other code. Has never disappointed under the saddle and is unlikely to start now. Place chance
- 12. LUCIA DU CHATELET** - Made a modest monte debut at Meslay-du-Maine earlier in the month and is thoroughly out of her depth
- 13. LADY DE GREZ** - Quality mare that seldom lets the side down in the monte discipline. Has never left Caen empty-handed and will not this time either. Claim

**Summary:** Back under the saddle after enjoying a change of scenery in the other code, LADY DE GREZ (13) is forced to incur a 25m handicap, but has previously won here and can do so again. She will still meet opposition from the better-placed and barefoot LAQUILA WOOD (10) who will be dangerous if Benjamin Rochard keeps her trotting, and LICORNE DE LA JOIE (9) who has been reconfigured for her first real test of the year. Ideally-engaged on the front row, LEA D'HOULBEC (11) is hard to knock in this branch of the business and will be barefoot as she was when successful at Le Mont-Saint-Michel early last month.

**C5 - PRIX DE SAINT-MANVIEU - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR  
€ 21,000**

- 1. MARIE LOU DE LARRE** - Put in quite the performance at Agen early this month when successful in a Class F. Forced to break on the inside here and is unlikely to create an upset
- 2. MELINE DU VIVIER** - Quality filly that outclassed the opposition in a 2450m Class E here on 30 March. Excels with Yoann Lebourgeois and should be able to wrap this up
- 3. MILADY DREAM** - Given an easy re-entry at Meslay-du-Maine earlier in the month, will be competitively-shod for the first time, but failed to deliver here last autumn and others preferred
- 4. MELOPE DU GOUTIER** - Lost her maiden status in good order at Cherbourg early this month and, ideally-placed behind the car, David Thomain will be keen to prove it was no flash in the pan
- 5. MAMACITA** - Didn't miss a beat at Cordemais when running out a commanding winner of a 2825m Class E 10 days ago, on her first start since September, and when barefoot for the first time. Chance
- 6. MAMAMIA DES ARRIS** - Has returned from her winter break in cracking shape, most recently winning unopposed in a Pontchateau Class F late last month. Steps up in category but is nicely-positioned on the front line and can make first 5
- 7. MOANA DE WALLIS** - Acquitted herself well after being eliminated on re-entry at La Capelle last weekend. Benjamin Rochard in the bike this time and from the front row will not be far off the mark
- 8. MINDIE DES PRES** - Is plainly capable but eliminated in all 3 starts this term. It is only a matter of time though before she gets back in the game. One to watch
- 9. MINNEAPOLIS** - Not the easiest of horses to use but has buckets of ability. Was eliminated in Lyon recently but presents solid clockwise form, and will be no pushover if Mathieu Mottier keeps her focused
- 10. MADONA DE VILLABON** - Takes first steps for new handler after having won a Gournay-en-Bray claimer a month back. Has pulled a rough number and can be passed over
- 11. MOYA SPORT** - Eliminated in all 4 starts to date. Makes first appearance since October and even though barefoot, is unlikely to create much interest
- 12. MONA VILI** - Gave a good account on comeback in a Nancy Class F on 28 March. Is competitively-shod for the first time, with Alexis Collette in the bike and, despite a second-row-draw, can nevertheless get a look in
- 13. MI CASA** - Made amends for comeback elimination when victorious in a 2400m Amiens Class F 2 weeks ago. Faces a much tougher test this time and chances appear limited
- 14. MELLY STAR** - Unremarkable filly that appears to have lost her way and will have nothing to offer
- 15. MADISHA JOSSELYN** - Non partante
- 16. MILONGA PLANCHETTE** - Last of 7 in a 2200m Class E here on 19 March and once again has no realistic chance

**17. MAGIC ALOUETTE** - Held her own nicely to run 3rd in a Mauquenchy Class F 9 days ago, but has little going for her this time and will have few friends

**Summary:** Like a horse reborn since starting to race barefoot, MELINE DU VIVIER (2) stormed up here late last month and should again take all the beating. MELOPE DU GOUTIER (4) has similarly turned a corner and recently got off the mark for David Thomain. MAMACITA (5) was dynamic at Cordemais mid-month and has a lot more to give. Benjamin Rochard takes over on MOANA DE WALLIS (7) who should not be far from the action if she stays in stride. MINNEAPOLIS (9) goes right-handed in a bid to end her unruly streak and being reunited with Mathieu Mottier will do her prospects no disservice.

**C6 - PRIX DE BOLBEC - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Mounted - EUR €  
24,000**

- 1. LEADER D'ANGELY** - Unseen since running 2nd in a Meslay-du-Maine Class F last November. Is barefoot for return but others easier to back
- 2. LABEL PIYA** - Has ability but eliminated more often than not. Has never delivered racing right-handed and is not about to start now
- 3. LUCKY CARNOIS** - Modest individual making monte bow after being eliminated on re-entry late last month and appears to have no realistic chance
- 4. LOL DESBOIS** - No slouch on a good day and recently ran 2nd in a Nort-sur-Erdre Class F 2 weeks ago. Front pads fitted this time but still not a priority
- 5. LORD ON WAY** - Returns to the code after having reassured in a Nancy harness Class F last Sunday, but still has more to find
- 6. LOS PACOS** - Unbeaten in last 3 starts, most recently making short work of his comeback run on turf at Tours earlier in the month. Breaks in front with champion jockey in the saddle, and can expect to receive the lion's share of support
- 7. LUMIO FALL** - Ran 4th of 15 on re-entry in a 2800m Vire Class F 3 weeks ago. Continues to race barefoot and from the first line can challenge for a place in the picture
- 8. LATINO DE CANCHY** - Returns to the code after disappointing under harness at Lisieux. Has yet to make his mark under the saddle but is well in on the front line here and is unlikely to go home empty-handed
- 9. LEADER DU RIB** - Enjoyed a productive run of form last summer but is far from that condition today. Shoes back on and not an obvious choice
- 10. LOVE ME DO MESLOIS** - Returns to the code after a pair of harness conditioners. Is never far from faulting, and incurs the handicap, but can still bring the fight to LOS PACOS (6)
- 11. LORD SUN DRALIAM** - Makes monte debut after thoroughly disappointing on return from his spell. Reverts to a previous formula but looks a minor place chance at best
- 12. LANCELOT DE BEYLEV** - Dependability not his strong suit but is at his best when barefoot and will be no pushover if his jockey keeps him out of trouble
- 13. LYNX D'URZY** - Has just the one win to his name but consistently gives his best. Is unraced since placing at Vincennes on 20 January but will be barefoot with Benjamin Rochard aboard and can finish close
- 14. LEON DU CLOS** - It took almost 2 years but returned to winning ways earlier this month in a Meslay-du-Maine Class E. On back row this time and although yet to deliver here, is still not to be overlooked
- 15. L'ARTISTE ZEN** - Gave a good account at Beaumont-de-Lomagne late last month before being eliminated in Toulouse a fortnight ago, and others easier to trust

**Summary:** After a difficult start to his career, LOS PACOS (6) came good with a double to end 2025. He picked up at Tours on his recent comeback where he left off, will be reconfigured, and with Mathieu Mottier reining looks the obvious choice. LOVE ME DO MESLOIS (10) is 25m worse off but is barefoot for his return to the discipline and will not go down easily. LANCELOT DE BEYLEV (12) failed to confirm his Saint-Galmier victory at Beaumont but is barefoot following his harness freshener and has a decent chance of making the frame. LUMIO FALL (7), in contrast, starts on the front row and previous Caen performances bode well for his chances.

C7 - PRIX DE LIVAROT - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR €  
21,000

1. **METAVERS ERA** - Showed a liking for a mobile start at Graignes last season. Goes barefoot after a necessary return run and despite being handed the 1 slot still looks a serious player
2. **MAKAO DE REVE D'OR** - Has been most impressive to date, winning 3 of 4 this year. Should take well to Caen conditions and the Thomain clan can be justifiably confident of a big performance
3. **MYTHIQUE RENKA** - Showed promise early last year but has failed to come good, and latest performances leave a lot to be desired
4. **MUST PLEIN CHENE** - Was not disgraced when 5th to MARCO DES GACHERES (10) in a Class E over course and distance last month, but still has more to find
5. **MILLE SOUS GEKA** - Made up for Mauquenchy elimination when 3rd in an Argentan Class E earlier in the month. Is unlikely to spring a surprise but can nevertheless figure prominently
6. **MAESTRO D'IDEF** - Placed over course and distance on his comeback in early-March but has twice failed to confirm. Goes barefoot on this occasion though and will be worth monitoring
7. **MEETING MESLOIS** - Modest individual sporting a new configuration after three clinkers this term and is not about to change his ways
8. **MARQUIS D'ENFER** - Pleasant 5th in a Cherbourg Class E on 6 April, his first start for 13 months. Will have come on for the run, goes barefoot again, and can finish in the mix
9. **MANGO KALOUMA** - Has demonstrated good aptitude for racing clockwise. Put on a good show at Reims mid-month and will be entrusted to Benjamin Rochard this time. Place prospect
10. **MARCO DES GACHERES** - Put paid to many questions when easily winning a Class E over course and distance on 19 March. In marginally better company this time but still has the wherewithal to finish close
11. **MUSCARI DE RIVIERE** - Imposed at Le Mont-Saint-Michel early last month but failed to fire at Vire next time, and others easier to back
12. **MILANO SPORT** - Has not been seen out since being eliminated on debut last November and can expect to have few friends
13. **MARIUS DES TOURS** - Back under harness after a modest monte run at Tours recently. Yoann Lebourgeois reining this time though and cannot be discounted
14. **MICKEY DE CRENNES** - Respectable element but is still chasing that elusive first win. Is barefoot for first time under harness but still not a concern

**Summary:** Winner of three on the trot, MAKAO DE REVE D'OR (2) comfortably imposed at Vire earlier in the month and it is hard to envisage him being bested. David Thomain will nevertheless be wary of the promising METAVERS ERA (1) who will be barefoot for the first time going right-handed, and MARCO DES GACHERES (10) who won from pillar to post here in March. MANGO KALOUMA (9) has taken well to French conditions and is close to his race.

**C8 - PRIX DE BERNIERES - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR €  
24,000**

- 1. LEA GIBUS** - Occasionally a handful but otherwise a terrific campaigner. Has not been seen out since early-February but is barefoot for comeback and is not to be overlooked
- 2. LINGUIST D'HERIPRE** - Showed promise at 3 but missed all of 2025 and has looked a shadow of his former self since
- 3. LA GUARDIA** - Particularly disappointing in all 4 starts this year. Is new to Caen, has placed just once in 5 clockwise starts, and others easier to back
- 4. LADY DE JANEIRO** - Got straight down to business on barefoot debut, winning a Class E at Meslay-du-Maine on 9 April. Takes on a better lot this time though and represents a minor place chance at best
- 5. LILYROSE WIND** - Moderate individual that was not disgraced here in early-March but still appears to be taking on too much
- 6. LULU DES CARREAUX** - Disappointing on the whole since returning to competition. Is new to Caen and others preferred
- 7. LASCAR PILE** - Disappointing at Cherbourg when heavily-backed earlier this month. If he runs here, he has reassured his handler and must be taken seriously
- 8. LILIAN DU PARADIS** - Pleasant 5th in a 3125m Angers Class E 3.5 weeks ago, on his first start since imposing in Vichy last August. Goes barefoot this time and must be considered a player
- 9. LADY MAJOR** - Showed improvement at Vincennes a fortnight ago but will be out of her comfort zone in this field and can be dismissed
- 10. LA FOULE** - Eliminated here before flopping in a Rambouillet Class E on 29 March, and is unlikely to generate much support
- 11. LEONARDO** - Returned to winning ways at Graignes last month on his first barefoot outing. Is arguably better racing left-handed but in current condition looks a serious proposition
- 12. LOVELY MILL** - Undeniably useful but has not been seen out since October and even though barefoot is going to need the run
- 13. LELLAMIKA** - Useful mare that has picked up in 2026 where she left off last season. Has little love for Caen though and on this occasion is unlikely to influence the result
- 14. LITTLE DU RIB** - A fine servant that seldom lets the side down and appreciates these conditions. Should not be too hastily-condemned for faulting at Laval and will be justifiably well-backed here
