- 1. ZAZU AA 3rd last time at Toulouse behind MOMBASA AA (4) over 2400m on April 21st. In the mix
- **2. HALDAWYSSA AA -** 2nd in the Toulouse race won by MOMBASA AA (4) over 2400m on April 21st when last seen. Hard to ignore
- **3. MADAOUA AA -** Unplaced last time, won before that over 2400m at Pau on March 24th. Can be competitive
- **4. MOMBASA AA -** Nice win last time at Toulouse over 2400m on April 21st, that was her fourth win in a row. Can be hard to beat
- **5. ELECTRIK JIM AA -** 3rd last time, won before that over 2300m at Tarbes on October 22nd. Ought to be thereabouts
- **6. ZIGOTTO AA -** Unplaced last time, won before that over 2400m at Toulouse on November 20th. Others preferred
- **7. FURIEUSE AA -** Two unplaced runs of late, 4th before that over 2400m at La Teste on June 23rd. Has work to do
- **8. KATAHNAA AA -** Three unplaced runs so far, the latter over 2550m at Gabarret on May 13th. Makes no appeal

**Summary:** MOMBASA AA (4) has won four races in a row and scored by over three lengths last time at Toulouse on April 21st beating two of her main threats that day who now reoppose. ZAZU AA (1) was third that day and HALDAWYSSA AA (2) was second, the former could be the biggest danger this time but both have ground to find on similar terms. KALIS DE LA BRUNIE AA (9) has some solid placed efforts and can not be discounted.

- **2. DEPUTY RULER -** Fair 3rd last time, won before that at La Teste on April 10th in a Class 3 handicap. Ought to be in the shake-up
- **3. ANTAIOS -** Won a Class 3 handicap last time at Bordeaux Le Bouscat over 2400m on May 16th. Has more to do in a stronger line up
- **4. THE TOP GATSBY -** Decent 3rd last time at Angers in a Class 2 race on May 4th over 2300m. Can play a lead role
- **5. FAL DARA -** Four unplaced runs this year, the latter on May 5th over 2200m at Madrid (ESP). Hard to recommend

**Summary:** SILAWI (1) has not won for a while but has some solid form in strong races. His third two runs ago in Saudi Arabia was in a stronger race than this and if emulating that run he can score. THE TOP GATSBY (4) could be the one to give the selection the most to do. She is very genuine and finds it hard to run a poor race. DEPUTY RULER (2) is also one to respect and has some consistent efforts of late.

- **1. HARRY DE LA BRUNIE AA -** 5th last time, 2nd before that at Toulouse over 2400m on November 11th. In the mix
- **2. INCROYABLE D'OC AA -** Fair 3rd last time at La Teste over 2400m on April 25th and a win before that at Toulouse in November. Contender
- **3. ANGELO DE L'ABBAYE AA -** 4th last time at la Teste over 2400m on April 25th. Not the most reliable and others rate higher
- **4. JAFAR D'ESCAR AA -** Won last time at La Teste over 2400m on April 25th and some solid efforts before that. One to pay attention too
- **5. VERTIGO POMPADOUR AA -** Unplaced last time, won the three races before that with the latter of them at Tarbes over 2300m on October 22nd. Live chance

- **3. SIYOUKING -** Unplaced on the last two runs in Listed races, won before that at Pau on January 22nd on the PSF over 1600m in a Class 2 race. Opposable
- **4. CHARLUS -** Unbeaten in three runs so far, the latest win was in a Class 1 race at Bordeaux Le Bouscat on May 4th over 1900m. Looks progressive and a live threat
- **5. SOLDIER'S GOLD -** 3rd two runs ago at Doha(QAT) in a conditions race over 1600m on February 17th. Consider

**Summary:** SIBAYAN (1) was not beaten that far in a strong Group 3 race last time at Parislongchamp in mid-April. Back down in class, he can score. - 1. NONANCOURT 3rd last time over 2100m at Toulouse in a maiden on April 8th. One to pay attention too
- **2. HOT IN FRONT -** Unplaced on the last two runs, 2nd before that over 2100m at Toulouse on his debut on March 11th. Others are more likely
- **3. FUTURE FATE -** Fair 4th last time over 2000m at Fontainebleau on April 30th. Can improve and make the frame
- **4. BLACKMOON DU MAZET -** Unplaced on the sole start so far over 2900m at Royan on May 8th in a maiden. Opposable
- **5. GO FLY -** Unplaced last time , 4th before that over 1900m on April 6th on his debut. Looks safely held
- **6. BABAKOOL -** Nice 4th last time over 2000m on April 18th, which came after a 2nd placed run on debut in March. Player

He gets the vote ahead of BOETTI (9) who has a taking profile and will be well forward for his debut. ROYAD (7) is also trained by Jean Claude Rouget and is one to watch in the betting for any support. FUTURE FATE (3) makes up the shortlist.

- **2. MEDIA STORM -** Won last time at Madrid(ESP) over 2000m on April 21st and 3rd before that in a Class 1 race at Chantilly in March. Others seem more likely
- **3. SWISS BANK -** 4th last time at this track over 1900m on April 22nd in a Class 2 handicap. Looks vulnerable
- **4. KOVROV -** Won on March 23rd over 2000m at La Teste in a Class 1 race when last seen. Hard to rule out
- **5. WATCH HIM -** Credible 5th last time at Toulouse on April 21st over 2000m. Has work to do to feature

- **3. AMADORA -** 4th last time over 2100m at Madrid(ESP) on May 2nd . Needs more to win but has place claims
- **4. BEAUTIFULL RISK -** 3rd last time in a Class 3 race over 2000m at Angouleme on April 14th. Looks vulnerable
- **5. SAILAWAYWITHME -** Good 2nd last time over 2000m on May 11th at Chantilly in a maiden. Is improving and looks ready to win

She may have the most to fear from the choice-bred newcomer GRECIAN JEWEL (7) who is from a good stable that can get one to strike on their debuts. SPERA (6) has shown enough to warrant her being on the premises. AMADORA (3) heads the remainder.

- 3. COPPER 2nd last time over 1800m in a Class 4 race on May 1st. Has outside place claims
- **4. LORDRECORD -** Has been placed over hurdles of late, 3rd on the latest flat run at Pau on December 23rd in a Class 3 handicap over 2000m. Looks vulnerable
- **5. GIFT OF THE G** Two unplaced runs of late, 3rd before that over 1400m at this track in a Class 3 handicap on March 16th. One to keep safe
