- **3. ROYALWOOD -** Five unplaced efforts, the most recent over 1400m at Saint-Cloud on May 13th in a Class 2 handicap. Races off a good racing weight having dropped in the handicap. Dangerous to overlook
- **4. TIME SIGNATURE -** Unplaced last time, won before that on August 21st in a handicap at Dieppe. Not seen since September and has fitness to prove

- **4. TOPGEAR -** Won his last two runs, the latter over 1400m at Newmarket by 5L in the Challenge Stakes Group 2, on October 11th, and over track and trip before that on September 15th in a Group 3 race. Player
