DECEPTION PASS and EIGER SANCTION have the means to make their presence felt too.

LEAD THE CHARGE has benefitted from the application of cheekpieces so warrants respect, as does progressive 3yo QUICKFREEZE with the his cheekpieces refitted.

**PREVIEW:** Consistent WINDS OF GRACE was well-backed last time and acquitted herself well in a stronger race over 1450m. A repeat of that effort in this grade off an unchanged mark could suffice. Stablemate WINTER VOICE is a frontrunner and could be dangerous over this shorter trip under a 1.5kg claimer. ONCEINABLUEMOON and MASTER'S ROSE had excuses last time and are capable of better. Both could have a say in the outcome if bouncing back to earlier form. FIERY FROLIC caught the eye when a fast finisher (not beaten far) over 1160m last time so shouldn't be underestimated over this extended trip.
