CHELSEA RIVER fluffed her lines last time but did finish 3rd over this track and trip previously, so could make amends if reproducing that form with the blinkers now removed. Respect Ridgemont debutantes FLY BY and WHOA WHOA WHOA.

CAPTAIN PERSIA was a close-up 3rd over track and trip recently, so could build on that to make his presence felt too. Crawford-trained newcomers SILVANO'S DASHER and SOLAR POWER are well bred and also warrant respect.

FLEETING has a bit to find on CRUIZIN CALIFORNIA but is improving and, on the evidence of her last start, should enjoy going this trip. NTINGA and DUNNEBALL appear best of the rest.

GIMMIE A STAR caught the eye on debut in KZN and could have a bright future - expect big improvement. FOREVER BILL may have needed his last start and is another who could show more. SAGE KING and TOZZETTI are well bred with scope for improvement.

IT'S ABOUT TIME and TRIP OF FORTUNE are progressive sorts with bright futures and should make their presence felt. NIGHT RULER and CAPTAIN'S KNOT aren't without chances either.

**PREVIEW:** IRISH TRACTOR has got his act together recently, winning 3 of his last 4 starts - going up 12 points in the ratings as a result. He won over 1400m last time out and, on the evidence of that victory, should enjoy a return to 1600m so could follow up. Top-weight ARCTIC DRIFT has held his own in stronger company of late and should do so again in this grade from pole position. KNIGHTS TEMPLAR and THE SECOND WAVE renew rivalry and could pose more of a threat - the latter is 1.5kg better off for a recent 0,75-length defeat. DESTIN and LION'S HEAD are capable sorts who could make their presence felt.
