

# THURSDAY, 25/09/25

## C1 - PRIX DE LA FEDERATION DES COURSES DU SUD-OUEST - 1900m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 2 - Flat - EUR € 20,100

**1. DOURIANN** - In good form and was runner-up in a Conditions race at Lyon-Parilly over 2200m on 16 September. Should be a threat to these rivals

**2. QUARTIER MAITRE** - In good shape and was runnerup in a Claimer at Dax over 2300m on 23 July. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

**3. TOIMY SON** - Showed improvement and was third in a Conditions race at Clairefontaine-Deauville over 1800m on 15 August. Can contest the finish again

**4. VERITABLE** - A winner of claimer at this track over 2000m on 6 September. Tougher task this time but might play a minor role

**5. HARPER'S FERRY** - Did not show his best when unplaced in a Listed race at Ascot over 1600m on 30 April. Returns from a break and can make the frame

**6. CARMELITO** - Has not been at his best this year and finished 8th in a handicap at Deauville over 1600m on 10 August. Big chance on best form

**7. VA S'Y MIX** - Has some fair form and was fifth in a handicap at Mont-de-Marsan over 2000m on 10 September. Could earn some minor money

**8. ALPHABIA** - Likes this course and was runner-up in a handicap at this track over 1600m on 6 September. Tougher task but has a place chance

**Summary:** CARMELITO (6) won a Group 3 last year. He has not been at his best this season, but on his best form he is well weighted to win this race easily and looks a confident choice. TOIMY SON (3) appears to be returning to his best and should challenge for top honours. HARPER'S FERRY (5) returns from a break but showed promise last year. DOURIANN (1) is fit and in good form, so he is another who could get involved in the finish.

## C2 - PRIX DE L'ORDRE INTERNATIONAL DES ANYSETIERS - 1900m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Maiden - Flat - EUR € 21,000

- 1. REVE DU FRAISSE** - Finished 9th on debut in a Conditions race at Marseille-Borely over 1700m on 4 September. Capable of improvement and might play a minor role
- 2. MOUSTIQUE** - Showed improvement when third in a Conditions race at this track over 1800m on 6 September. Can be competitive yet again
- 3. SARI MAN** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a claimer at Toulouse over 1600m on 3 September. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 4. BEDAIO** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in a Conditions race at this track over 1800m on 6 September. Might play a minor role
- 5. LIGHT L'AUDRIELLE** - Improving and ran well when third in a Conditions race at Tarbes over 1500m on 30 August. Tries further but should contest the finish
- 6. VALPOVO** - Finished 9th on debut in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 1400m on 3 June. Likely to improve this distance and is not out of it
- 7. CIAO NENE** - Knocking very hard at the door and was runner-up in a Conditions race at this track over 1800m on 6 September. Can go one better
- 8. ESPRONCEDA** - A two-year-old colt by Ribchester out of Nell Trent who makes his debut. His mother was unraced. Watch the betting
- 9. DADDY MOON** - A two-year-old gelding by Smooth Daddy out of Worlds Apart who makes his debut. His Dam was unraced. Watch the betting

**Summary:** CIAO NENE (7) is threatening to win a race and could do so this time. This course and distance suit him well. LIGHT L'AUDRIELLE (5) is improving and may appreciate this longer trip, so must be respected. VALPOVO (6) was gelded after his debut and could show marked improvement over this longer distance. MOUSTIQUE (2) showed progress and was not far behind CIAO NENE (7) when they last met, so he can be a lively danger.

## C3 - PRIX DU HARAS DES FAUNES (PRIX VIVRE LE BASSIN) - 1900m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Maiden - Flat - EUR € 21,000

- 1. LOVATREE PARIS** - Holding form and was third in a claimer at Toulouse over 1600m on 3 September. Can be involved with the finish once again
- 2. TOUCH IN THE NIGHT** - Unplaced on debut in a Conditions race at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1600m on 8 September. Capable of improvement but others make more appeal
- 3. LA ALMADIA** - Improving and finished third in a Conditions race at Tarbes over 1500m on 30 August. Can be competitive once again
- 4. YAGGERA** - Knocking very loudly at the door and was runner-up in a Conditions race at Tarbes over 1500m on 30 August. Tries further but should be right there at the finish
- 5. RANAVALONA** - Has run well in both her starts and was third in a Conditions race at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 9 September. Big chance in this line-up
- 6. DIVA CHIQUITA** - Not disgraced when fifth on debut in a Conditions race at Tarbes over 1500m on 30 August. Capable of improvement and might play a minor role
- 7. NEBULEUSE'K** - A two-year-old filly by Cloth Of Stars out of Ribolla who makes her debut. Her mother only raced once and was unplaced
- 8. FREJULFE** - A two-year-old filly by Flintshire out of Filira who makes her debut. Her mother only ran once and was unplaced
- 9. TYKA** - A two-year-old filly by Victor Ludorum out of Triptyka who makes her debut. Her Dam won once in 11 starts. Watch the betting

**Summary:** RANAVALONA (5) was not disgraced when third at Lyon-Parilly earlier this month and should make a bold bid to beat these rivals. YAGGERA (4) is threatening to win a race and has some solid recent runner-up efforts, though she goes further this time. LA ALMADIA (3) also tries a longer trip but can be very competitive here. LOVATREE PARIS (1) is consistent and looks capable of making the frame.

**C4 - PRIX HARAS DES GRANGES - 1600m (a1m) - TURF - Maiden - Flat -  
EUR € 15,600**

- 1. LACHOP** - Has struggled of late and was a well beaten 9th in a Conditions race at Mont-de-Marsan over 1400m on 1 July. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 2. SOUND OF SILENCE** - Showed some improvement and was third in a claimer at Mont-de-Marsan over 1200m on 12 April. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 3. AQUITAIN** - Much improved last run when runner-up in a Conditions race at this track over 1800m on 6 September. Can go one better
- 4. ALTIMUS** - Did not show much when 9th on debut in a Conditions race at this track over 1800m on 6 September. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 5. LUCKY D'ID** - Has struggled of late and finished 10th in a handicap at this track over 1900m on 29 August. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 6. DREAM INDEX** - Disappointing last run when unplaced in a handicap at Deauville over 1600m on 19 August. Did better in his penultimate start and can be a threat
- 7. DESTROYING ANGEL** - Finished 6th on debut in a Conditions race at this track over 1800m on 6 September. Capable of improvement but others make more appeal
- 8. MARQUES** - Did not show her best when 7th in a Conditions race at Tarbes over 1500m on 5 June. Very consistent before that and can bounce back to score
- 9. ROSES AND DREAM** - Did not show her best when a well beaten 9th in a handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 1600m on 3 September. Capable of better and could play a minor role
- 10. CAVATINA** - Holding form and finished fourth in a handicap at Tarbes over 1500m on 12 May. Returns from a break but has claims
- 11. AVANT NOUS** - Not disgraced when fourth in a Conditions race at Angers over 1600m on 11 September. Might play a minor role
- 12. ONE TOMORROW** - A three-year-old filly by Twirling Candy out of Awesome One who makes her debut. Her mother was unraced. Watch the betting

**Summary:** A weak but competitive-looking race. MARQUES (8) did not show her best at Tarbes in June. She is capable of much better and gets a narrow vote to score. CAVATINA (10) returns from a break but was improving previously and would not be a surprise winner. AQUITAIN (3) showed progress on his second start and has course experience, so must be respected. DREAM INDEX (6) struggled last time out but is better judged on a good penultimate run.

**C5 - PRIX LOUTAFETE BASSIN - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Class 3 - Flat - EUR  
€ 13,700**

- 1. NORDESTE** - Unreliable and finished 9th in a claimer at this track over 2000m on 6 September. Did win a handicap before that and is capable of an upset
- 2. WE RIDE THE WORLD** - Returned to best when a winner in a Conditions race at Cavillon over 1600m on 6 September. Can double up
- 3. MANGAKEN** - Holding form and was finished fourth in a handicap at Dax over 1400m on 13 September. Can be competitive in this line-up
- 4. GALI LODGE** - Has struggled of late and was a well beaten 10th in a claimer at this track over 1400m on 6 June. Capable of better but others are preferred
- 5. REVE DE VALLARSA** - Only modest and was 9th in a handicap at this track over 1600m on 6 September. Capable of better and has a place chance
- 6. THE BIG BOARD** - Unreliable and was unplaced at Baden-Baden over 1400m on 6 September. She did win her penultimate start and can be a threat
- 7. KUMITE** - Very unreliable and was unplaced in a handicap at Deauville over 1600m on 10 August. Capable of contesting the finish when in the right mood
- 8. WILD CITY** - Disappointing form of late and finished 8th in a Conditions race at Deauville over 1400m on 24 August. Place chance on best form
- 9. BAYAMOON** - Only modest this year and was fifth in a Conditions race at this track over 1600m on 29 August. Did better last year and is not out of it
- 10. ECLAIRE LA VIE** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a handicap at this track over 1600m on 6 September. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 11. TIFFANYLI** - Unreliable form of late and was unplaced in a handicap at this track over 1600m on 6 September. Capable of earning some minor money

**Summary:** WE RIDE THE WORLD (2) broke a long losing run and picked up a confidence-boosting win. This is a tougher race, but he may well follow up. BAYAMOON (9) has not been at his best this year but is capable of getting involved in the finish. THE BIG BOARD (6) struggled at Baden-Baden but did win before that and must be respected in this line-up. KUMITE (7) is hard to trust but is another who could shine.

**C6 - PRIX HARAS DE GALOUIN - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Handicap - Flat -  
EUR € 19,200**

- 1. BARANTIN** - Has some fair form and was fifth in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1600m on 8 September. Did better earlier this year and can be a threat
- 2. FAR BEYOND** - Disappointing last run when unplaced in a handicap at Deauville over 1300m on 14 August. Capable of much better and is not out of it
- 3. DIAMANTINE** - Did not show her best when 8th in a handicap at this track over 1400m on 27 July. In good form before that and can upset
- 4. GAST A GAST** - Has only been modest of late and finished 9th in a handicap at Deauville over 1400m on 28 August. More is needed to win this race
- 5. BOEZA** - Unreliable and was third in a claimer at this track over 2000m on 6 September. Might play a minor role at best
- 6. BURNING HEART** - Did not show his best when a well beaten 10th in a Conditions race at Dax over 1400m on 13 September. Consistent before that but others make more appeal
- 7. KOHANA** - Not disgraced when fifth in a handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 1600m on 3 September. Has improved of late and has claims
- 8. SHUTTERWOOD** - In good form and was third in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1600m on 8 September. Should be right there at the finish once again
- 9. GUSTAN** - Has lost the way and was unplaced in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1600m on 8 September. More is needed to win
- 10. SALSA ROSE** - Did not show her best when a well beaten 8th in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1600m on 8 September. Capable of better and could play a minor role
- 11. BOGADO** - A winner in a handicap at this track over 1400m on 27 July. Improving and can overcome a 2.50kg penalty. Go close
- 12. JARKI** - Much improved last run and was runner-up in a Conditions race at Mont-de-Marsan over 1600m on 24 August. Could be the surprise package of the race
- 13. LA FERRETCAPIENNE** - A good third in a Conditions race at this track over 1400m on 6 September. Yet to win a race but has a place chance once again
- 14. PIC PEN** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a claimer at Castéra-Verduzan over 1700m on 5 July. Yet to win a race and others are preferred

**Summary:** A competitive handicap. KOHANA (7) was not disgraced on stable debut at Lyon-Parilly and could do a lot better this time around. FAR BEYOND (2) is not the most reliable but has run well at this track before. SHUTTERWOOD (8) is knocking on the door and could see his consistency rewarded with a winning turn. BARANTIN (1) showed better form earlier this year and is clearly not out of it in this line-up, so must be respected.

## C7 - PRIX HARAS DES PETITS CHAMPS - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 14,400

- 1. LOUP DU PYLA** - Yet to win a race but did show improvement when fourth in a handicap at Tarbes over 2100m on 30 August. Can get into the mix of things
- 2. AGAMEMNON** - Showed improvement when runner-up in a conditions race at Dax over 2100m on 13 September. Could be a threat in this line-up
- 3. THE MAGIC MAN** - Unreliable and was 7th in a handicap at this track over 2400m on 6 September. Capable of earning some money
- 4. CHARM KING** - Has not won for some time now but is in good form and finished third in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1600m on 8 September. Should contest the finish
- 5. ASSIER** - Has improved of late and was not disgraced when 5th in a conditions race at Dax over 2100m on 13 September. Did win a handicap before that and could make the frame
- 6. MEARAS STYLE** - Only modest of late and was 5th in a handicap at this track over 2400m on 6 September. Distance suits and can play a minor role
- 7. SUPER CUTE** - Has struggled of late and finished 11th in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1600m on 8 September. Capable of a surprise on best form
- 8. TOROSENTADO** - Has shown improvement of late and was 4th in a conditions race at Royan La Palmyre over 2300m on 20 September. Tougher task in this line-up
- 9. ROYAL ETINCELLE** - Has shown improvement of late and was runner-up in a handicap at Tarbes over 2100m on 30 August. Can go one better this time
- 10. PEDROZIO** - Unreliable of late and finished 8th in a handicap at this track over 2400m on 6 September. Hard to trust but might play a minor role
- 11. GARMi** - In good shape and finished 4th in a handicap at Niort over 1400m on 14 September. Better at that distance but has claims
- 12. LUNDO** - More than a year since last win but is in fair form and finished 4th in a handicap at Tarbes over 2100m on 30 August. Can get involved in the finish again
- 13. AMORETTI** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in a handicap at this course over 2400m on 6 September. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 14. RIGHTEOUS LOVE** - Showed some improvement when 6th in a conditions race at Dax over 2100m on 13 September. More is needed to win this race

**Summary:** CHARM KING (4) has not won for some time but always gives his best. He is suited to this course and distance and gets a narrow vote to score. GARMi (11) struggled when last seen over a similar trip but has been doing well over shorter distances and must be respected on that form. AGAMEMNON (2) showed improvement at Dax and could go one better. LOUP DU PYLA (1) has yet to win a race but did show progress last time and could do even better.

## C8 - PRIX JAMES, GABY ET CHARLEY CROCKETT - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 16,300

- 1. OASIS BAY** - Showed some improvement when third in a handicap at Craon over 2200m on 6 September. Capable of contesting the finish once again
- 2. DAYSANIYA** - Unreliable of late and finished 6th in a conditions race at Saint-Cloud over this distance on 2 September. Did win a handicap before that and is not out of it
- 3. VILLAIRES** - Has been fair of late and finished 5th in a handicap at San Sebastián over 1200m on 5 September. Has struggled over a similar distance and others are preferred
- 4. TZARINSKA** - Battling to find best form and finished 10th in a handicap at Tarbes over 2100m on 30 August. Needs to find a few lengths to win this race
- 5. RIZZICHOP** - Finished 12th in a handicap at this track over 1800m on 5 August in his only start this year. Fitter this time but needs major improvement to win
- 6. HAUTE GAMME** - On a very long losing run and finished 6th in a claimer at Dax over 2100m on 21 September. Needs to do more to win this race
- 7. UNAMUNO** - Did not show his best when 10th in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1600m on 8 September. Did win a handicap before that at this track and has claims
- 8. AFRICAN GREY** - Has really struggled this year and finished 14th in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1600m on 8 September. Others are much preferred
- 9. LADY DARKA** - Improving and was runner-up in a conditions race at Mont-de-Marsan over 2000m on 10 September. Can be a threat on handicap debut
- 10. STARECTO** - On a very long losing run and finished 8th in a handicap at Dax over 3000m on 13 September. Needs to find a few lengths to win this race
- 11. DAZZLE AT DAWN** - Battling to find best form and finished 7th in a handicap at Tarbes over 2100m on 30 August. Might play a minor role at very best
- 12. SORIANE** - Knocking at the door and was runner-up in a handicap at Tarbes over 2100m on 30 August. Can go one better in this line-up
- 13. LANCEUR D'ALERTE** - Disappointing form of late and was 11th in a handicap at Tarbes over 2100m on 30 August. Capable of better but others make more appeal
- 14. ULTRASOUND** - Holding form and finished third in a handicap at this track over 2400m on 16 June. Clearly capable of winning off this handicap mark

**Summary:** OASIS BAY (1) hinted at a winning turn when finishing a good third earlier this month. This is a very open lucky last race. UNAMUNO (7) is best judged on his good penultimate start win at this course in August and must be respected for that effort. DAYSANIYA (2) also won her penultimate start and should be a threat to these rivals. SORIANE (12) is in good shape, and with her last win coming at this course, she must be considered a possible winner.
