- **4. JANNAH PEARL -** Placed in all 3 appearances, twice 2nd. Runner-up over 2800m at Compiegne on 11 October and looks ready to open her account
- **5. WALKABOVE -** Twice 3rd in 3 starts, including over 2000m at Saint-Cloud on 20 September in a well-composed field. Candidate for success

Summary: JANNAH PEARL (4), runner-up in 2 of 3 appearances, has already shown her aptitude/efficiency on heavy ground and she is ideally placed to open her account. WALKABOVE (5), whose last-start 3rd at Saint-Cloud was encouraging, is the biggest threat to the selection, though supplemented newcomer GANAVA (7) shouldn't be underestimated, given her pedigree to excel on deep/heavy ground. KOWALSKI (1) completes the shortlist.

- 3. MISS OXFORD Unplaced in 3 starts across the Channel but made an encouraging reappearance/debut on French soil when 3rd over 1600m at Chantilly on 26 September. Keep safe
- **4. SIYOUNI FLASH -** Regally bred late-starter who caught the eye when a promising debut 2nd over 1600m at Chantilly on 26 September. Should have more to offer
- **5. OASINA -** Experienced 9-start maiden with sound references/form credentials, albeit without a victory. Finished 3rd over 1650m at Amiens on 29 September not taken lightly
- **6. THEOTOKOS -** Donjuan Triumphant filly owned and trained by Walter Delalande who has engaged Hugo Journiac to ride this newcomer

Summary: SIYOUNI FLASH (4) caught the eye when finishing 2nd on her belated debut at Chantilly over 1600m and needn't improve a great deal to go one better with that experience to count on. SALVA MEA (2) has flattered to deceive but boasts the form and experience to pose a threat. MISS OXFORD (3) made an encouraging start on French soil and, with any improvement, should play a leading role in a field of this ilk. Consistent OASINA (5) is another with legitimate podium aspirations.

- **2. SHOWPOWER -** Supplemented for this race after finishing 2nd in first-time blinkers over 1600m in a Toulouse claimer on 25 September. Keep safe b
- **3. MOUNT VERNON -** Has regained form and momentum in 2 comeback outings after a lengthy layoff. Won a 1300m claimer at Saint-Cloud on 9 September
- **4. LA BELLE POETE -** Won a 1200m Class 1 conditions race on heavy ground early this year and added to her tally in a 1200m claimer at Mont-de-Marsan on 14 September. Not hastily condemned for her Chantilly 7th on 1 October

- **3. LOVELY ANGEL -** Experienced hard-knocker with sound references/form credentials in handicaps. Didn't go unnoticed when finishing 5th in a 1400n conditions race at Saint-Cloud on 10 October
- **4. KILFRUSH MEMORIES -** Has been waited with for deep/heavy ground on which he thrives won consecutive starts on heavy ground in March. Not hastily condemned for finishing 10th on PSF over 150m at Deauville on 8 August

- **3. MY DESERT QUEEN -** Yet to find the frame in 7 (unplaced) appearances and unlikely to trouble the judge here after finishing 14th in a 1600m turf handicap at Deauville on 6 August
- **4. KAMAKURA ONE -** Showed early promise last year, finishing 2nd three times and 3rd twice in her first 5 starts. Hasnt been since finishing 9th over 2000m at Toulouse on 19 June

Summary: SOME SKYE (2) sets the standard and has already proven herself on deep/heavy ground. She ought to take advantage of this drop in class by belatedly opening her account in these calmer waters. WINDBURN (5) has the form and experience to pose a threat, while LORIA (6) would've gained plenty from her pleasing introduction and she should improve to make her presence felt too. Newcomer SAVE THE SEA (8) isn't taken lightly.

- **3. GARDE COTE -** Absent since finishing an improved/reassuring 4th in a 2400m Saint-Cloud handicap on 5 October. Not taken lightly
- **4. CLICCLIC PANPANPAN -** Courageously opened her account with a last-start win in a 2800m Saint-Cloud handicap on 4 October. A 2,5kg penalty is unlikely to prevent another bold bid

- **3. HYGROVE BEC -** Last-start winner of a 1600m handicap at Le Mans on 16 October penalised 2,5kg for that victory. She remains competitive off her revised mark, especially with Mickaël Barzalona engaged

- **11. GOFAST -** Battling 21-start maiden soundly beaten in 4 consecutive recent outings, the latest (14th) in an 1800m PSF handicap at Chantilly on 26 Spetember

- **3. PREWITT -** Consistent performer with sound references/form credentials, including a last-start victory over 1800m at Dieppe on 27 August. Respected on his reappearance under a mere 0,5kg penalty
