# C1 - PRIX ZOSMA - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class C Race - Harness - EUR € 53.000

- **1. HEARTBEAT THUNDER -** Makes French debut after running 3rd of 12 over 2140m at Hagmyren on 22 September. Forced to start on the rail but has considerable class and must not be underestimated
- **2. JINGLE LOVER -** Pleased at Enghien before finishing 8th of 11, behind JOKER DES CHALIERS (8), in a 2700m Class C here on 20 September, and will need to raise his game
- **3. JACKMAN -** Tough trotter that ran 9th of 14, on comeback, in a 2600m Cherbourg Class B a month ago. Shoes on again and others preferred
- **4. JACQUARD** Good dual-discipline sort that finished last of 14, on comeback, in a 2600m Cherbourg Class B a month ago. Is still in conditioning mode and best to hold off
- **5. JUNKIE (SWE) -** Last but one, when preparing for this, in a 2875m Enghien Class B on 30 September. Has won under these conditions and from the 5-spot can play a leading role
- **6. DESTINY DI POGGIO -** 2nd of 12 in a Class D over course and distance on 29 September. Stays unshod behind but still looks good enough to win this
- **7. JUNON DE LOU -** 2nd of 13 in a 2700m Class C here on 22 September. Has placed just once in 5 under these conditions and chances limited
- **8. JOKER DES CHALIERS -** Gave a good account on re-entry late last month when 5th of 11 in a 2700m Class C here. Will have progressed for the run and returns to his distance of preference with a realistic chance of imposing
- **9. DANA EK -** Serious mare making first start for new trainer after winning over 1640m at Mantorp late last month. Breaks wide but excels over these shorter trips and can play a role
- **10. DIE HARD (ITY) -** Surprise 2nd of 9 finishers, on re-entry, in a Class D under these conditions late last month. Takes on a decent bunch here but with form maintained should not disappoint
- **11. DAYTONA DI CECCO -** Sprang a 111/1 surprise when winning a 2875m Enghien Class D on 9 October. On back line and a repeat seems most improbable
- **12. SANDOKAN (SWE) -** Makes first start south of the nordics after running 4th of 12 over 2140m at Solvalla a fortnight ago. Receives a David Thomain drive and can get a look-in if he successfully navigates the start
- **13. DOROTY DEL SAURO -** Sanctioned in both since coming to France, most recently a 2875m Enghien Class D earlier in the month. Shoes on and no threat
- **14. DE GAULLE GRIF -** Comes here fresh after having run 2nd of 14 in a Class D over course and distance late-August. Is unbeaten with Yoann Lebourgeois who will be eager to put on another good show

**15. JASMIN DHELPA -** Not the most dependable but came in a pleasant 5th of 9 in a 2700m Class B here mid-month. Handed a tough draw but has been entrusted to Eric Raffin for first time and will have his chances of finishing in the mix

**Summary:** An exceptional Italian import, DESTINY DI POGGIO (6) missed out by little over course and distance late last month, on just her second start back, and looks the one to beat this time. JMB will still be keeping a keen eye on the reconfigured JOKER DES CHALIERS (8) who has won 3 of 4 under these conditions, and the less-favourably-drawn DE GAULLE GRIF (14) who thrives over these shorter trips. JUNKIE (SWE) (5) may not be to everyone's taste but she has been prepared for this, goes barefoot, and the draw will only work to her advantage.

### C2 - PRIX URANIE - 2175m (a1m1/4) - Gr2 Race - Harness - EUR € 120,000

- **1. LAMATTA -** Disqualified, but nevertheless showed her form, in a 2100m Class B here a fortnight ago. In this category though, has no possible chance
- **2. LOUVE DE REVE D'OR -** Useful sort that finished 7th of 11, having faulted, in a 2600m Cherbourg Class B a month ago. Has never been tested at this level and even with Eric Raffin in the bike is not about to shake things up
- **3. LOVE LETTER -** Ran 4th in Prix Annick Dreux before defying her 95/1 to run 4th in Criterium. Unlikely to improve on that but can still make first 5
- **4. LUSH LIFE -** Tricky filly that showed her talent when 3rd to LIZA JOSSELYN (9) in 2700m Gr.2 Prix Annick Dreux here late-August, and will not be sent out at 67/1 this time
- **5. LUNA NOVA GWEN -** Has placed once in this rank but disappointing 8th of 10, behind LONDON (7), in a 2700m Gr.3 here on 29 September, and will need to find more
- **6. LET ME SHINE GIO -** Disappointing for some months, latterly 8th of 10 in a 2450m Caen monté Gr.1 a fortnight ago, and can be passed over
- **7. LONDON -** 2nd of 10 in Gr.3 Prix des Troyes over track and trip late last month. Mathieu Mottier back in the wagon and should figure prominently if he keeps her trotting
- **8. LA JOYEUSE WICZ -** Gr.1-winning filly that was sanctioned, on re-entry, in a 2800m Rambouillet Class B on 6 October. Front pads fitted but others still preferred
- **9. LIZA JOSSELYN -** Terrific filly that made short work of Prix Annick Dreux before being sanctioned in Criterium under these conditions mid-September. Shoes back on and, if focused, can make this her own
- **10. LOUISIANE DE BOMO -** Ran 5th of 12, behind LOTTA BOURBON (11), in Criterium des 3 Ans over course and distance last month. Was in cracking shape that day and, with form maintained, could pleasantly surprise
- **11. LOTTA BOURBON -** Has done battle with LIZA JOSSELYN (9) in last 3, beating her once, and latterly 3rd of 12 in Criterium des 3 Ans. In similar form is not incapable of beating her again

**Summary:** Sanctioned when she appeared not to be at her ease in the Gr.1 Critérium des 3 Ans, LIZA JOSSELYN (9) returns to racing shod and, with application, should have the measure of the classy LOTTA BOURBON (11) whom she beat in the Gr.2 Prix Annick Dreux in late-August. LOUISIANE DE BOMO (10) would have finished closer in the Criterium had she been afforded a run, and Benjamin Rochard will be eager to set the record straight. LONDON (7) may not always be the luckiest of fillies but she ran 2nd in a Gr.3 here late last month and must be considered a contender.

# C3 - PRIX JUNO - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 59,000

- **1. FOKKER DE BAILLY -** Sanctioned in a 2825m Chartres Class E last week. Has no love for 2100m on the main track and can be passed over
- **2. HAS DE COEUR -** 6th of 12 in a 2700m Class D here 3 weeks ago. Is considerably better than that, enjoys a front-row break, and can win his first race since May 2023
- **3. FIRST LADY BLEUE -** Has done little of note for some time, latterly 6th of 14 in a 2800m Castéra-Verduzan Class E mid-month, and can be ruled out
- **4. FAKIR DE GESVRES -** Sanctioned, when unsupported, in a 2875m Enghien monté Class D last week, and will have nothing to offer
- **5. GAMINE DE RIBEAU -** 5th of 13 in a 2300m Borely Class E 2 weeks ago. Imposed over track and trip last month, and even though drawn well, can expect to find this a stiff test
- **6. GAROU DU CHENE -** Sanctioned after a minor incident in a 2850m Class D here late last month. Has not been the most fortunate recently, but given the chance can trot his way into the frame
- **7. FUNKY BERRY -** Barring a Beaumont blip has been lurking for some time, latterly 2nd of 11 in a 2625m Alencon Class E on 6 October, and being partnered by Jean-Philippe Monclin will do his prospects no disservice
- **8. FERGIE HIGHLAND -** Pleasantly surprising 4th of 13 in a 2850m Class D here on 27 September, but a repeat seems improbable
- **9. HERMES EXPRESS -** 9th of 12, behind HAS DE COEUR (2), in a 2700m Class D here 3 weeks ago. Has never been tested under 2350m but Eric Raffin maintains faith and can win this if he successfully navigates the start
- **10. HARCOUEL -** 5th of 11, behind HAS DE COEUR (2), in a 2500m Reims Class E mid-September. Has placed just once in 6 starts over track and trip and others easier to back
- **11. HACIENDA** Disqualified following some poor luck in a 2400m Amiens Class D on 21 September. Form is not in question and can go close if François Lecanu keeps her out of trouble
- **12. GLORIOSO BELLO -** Defied his odds to run 4th of 13 in a 2450m Caen Class C a fortnight ago. Solid in last 2 starts over course and distance but, in this category, will struggle to make his mark
- **13. GIANA DE MARZY -** 2nd to GAMINE DE RIBEAU (5) here before coming 6th of 12, a place behind HACIENDA (11), in a Class D over course and distance on 14 October. Races barefoot but the draw will do her no favours
- **14. HOTEL MYSTIC -** 4th of 11 in a 2700m Class D at La Capelle on 6 September. Has been knocking at the door for some time and, despite the draw, can still make first 5
- **15. HESCORT LOVE -** Won over 2200m at Caen before being sanctioned, when full of running in a 2875m Enghien monté Class D mid-month. Barefoot for the occasion but will first need to negate the draw. Minor place chance

**16. HERMES D'ECROVILLE -** Was on a fine run of form before finishing an atypical 11th of 12, behind HAS DE COEUR (2), in a 2700m Class D here 3 weeks ago. Thrives over this distance and will not be far from the action if Matthias Legros positions him early

**Summary:** Not the luckiest here early this month, HAS DE COEUR (2) returns to conditions he adores, breaks from the 2-spot, and can set the record straight. HERMES EXPRESS (9) ran out of steam that day following some questionable tactics but Eric Raffin will be keen to make amends. GAROU DU CHENE (6) showed his form before being sanctioned here late last month, sports a new configuration, and can redeem himself. HACIENDA (11) was denied a run at Amiens but is barefoot as she was when 5th here mid-September, and must be respected.

# C4 - PRIX PIERRE VAN TROYEN - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Gr3 Race - Harness - EUR € 80,000

- **1. JOLIE STAR -** 9th of 12 in a 2875m Enghien Class B on 30 September, and in present shape will have nothing to offer
- **2. JOLIE SURPRISE -** Quality element that is still being conditioned after finishing 7th of 16 in a 2800m Rambouillet Class B earlier this month, and can be ruled out
- **3. JINGLE DU PONT -** Gets a 4th conditioner after his break, latterly finishing 13th of 16 in a 2800m Chartres Class B last week, and can be passed over
- **4. KHAL'S FELLA -** 5th in Prix Gaston Brunet before coming 5th of 12, a place behind KEEN WINNER (8), in 2850m Gr.1 Criterium des 4 Ans here on 14 September. 77/1 will not be available this time but still a minor place chance at best
- **5. KELLE BEAUTE -** Ran 2nd in a Gr.2 over course and distance before faulting in Criterium des 4 Ans. Shoes on this time and best to wait
- **6. KARLA DE MAI -** Back under harness after faulting in a 2175m Vincennes monté Gr.1 late last month. Has other priorities and can be ruled out
- **7. KATAKI DE WALLIS -** Made short work of Prix Gaston Brunet before running 11th of 12, after numerous false starts, in Criterium des 4 Ans. If he gets off on the right foot, the race should be his for the taking
- **8. KEEN WINNER -** Won a 2175m Gr.2 here before outclassing many colts, coming 4th of 12 finishers in 2850m Gr.1 Criterium des 4 Ans here on 14 September. Takes on better this time but has earned the right to race and place here
- **9. KATINKA DU MOUCHEL -** Tricky character than ran 3rd to KEEN WINNER (8) in Prix Paul Leguerney before faulting in Criterium des 5 Ans mid-September. Just hind shoes off this time and is a potential spoiler
- **10. JUST A MIDI -** More than made up for Prix Jockey performance when 5th of 15, a place behind JANGO VICI (15), in 3000m Criterium des 5 Ans here on 14 September, and looks a more serious proposition this time around
- **11. KABAKA DE GUEZ -** Finished last but one in a 2950m Toulouse Class B on 27 September, on 2nd start for JMB. Eric Raffin reining on this occasion and it is only a question of time before she delivers
- **12. KIARA DE VANDEL -** Pulled off quite the coup a fortnight ago, running 2nd of 8 in a 2100m Gr.1 here. Unlikely to repeat but can still make first 5, and will not be available at 94/1 on this occasion
- **13. JEEGHA PRIDE -** Has not been seen out since faulting in a 3000m Vincennes monté Gr.1 late June. Just front pads fitted and will need the run
- **14. JOUMBA DE GUEZ -** Complicated but talented mare that was sanctioned in a 2700m monté Gr.2 here a fortnight ago. Has references under harness too and, sporting a new configuration, will be no easy touch if she stays in stride
- **15. JANGO VICI -** 5th of 15 in 3000m Gr.1 Criterium des 5 Ans mid-September. Takes a notable step down in category and should be able to give KATAKI DE WALLIS (7) a run for his money

**Summary:** Winner of the Gr.2 Prix Gaston Brunet over course and distance late-August, before disappointing in the Gr.1 Critérium des 4 Ans, the reconfigured KATAKI DE WALLIS (7) should be able to win this if Gabi Gelormini keeps him focused at the start. That being said, JANGO VICI (15) benefits from a superb entry and, given current form, will be no pushover. A place behind him in the Critérium des 5 Ans, at 126/1, JUST A MIDI (10) must be taken more seriously this time. KEEN WINNER (8) won the Gr.2 Prix Paul Leguerney before running 4th in the Critérium des 4 Ans and takes on her elders with modified shoeing and a good hand to play.

- **1. L'AS DE COEUR -** Sanctioned in a 2450m Caen monté Gr.1 a fortnight ago. Has no place here and can be written off
- **2. LAGNU MAG -** In the frame in last 3, most recently 3rd of 10 to LITTLE BROWN (5) in a Gr.3 over course and distance late last month. 4 pads fitted but will still struggle to repeat
- 3. LOGAN JIEL Sanctioned in a 2825m Chartres Class B last week. Hind pads on this time but still has more to find
- **4. LUCKY JACKSON -** Honest colt that ran 4th in Prix Jacques de Vauloge before coming 7th of 12 in Criterium. Cannot be considered a priority but, in similar form, can make first 5
- **5. LITTLE BROWN -** Failed to fire in Criterium but reassuring winner of a Gr.3 over course and distance late last month and should not be underestimated
- **6. LARGO DE CASTELLE -** Won a valuable sales Gr.3 over track and trip late-August before racing better in Criterium than his 9th place would suggest. 4th of 9 when prepping for this in a 2700m Graignes Class B 12 days ago. Attention
- **7. LOULOU DE MYE -** Held off LOMBOK JIEL (9) to win a 2700m Gr.2 here late-August but was out of sorts when 10th of 12 in Criterium. Has had time to recalibrate, sports a revised formula, and looks the main threat to Matthieu Abrivard's charge
- **8. LUCIANO MENUET -** Could have finished closer than 4th of 12, behind LOMBOK JIEL (9), in Criterium des 3 Ans mid-September had he not encountered traffic problems, but can more than make amends if Yoann Lebourgeois keeps him out of trouble
- **9. LOMBOK JIEL -** High-class colt that ran 2nd to the exceptional Lovino Bello in Gr.1 Criterium des 3 Ans over course and distance mid-September. Is plainly the standout here and will be expected to impose

**Summary:** An excellent campaigner that missed out by little in the Gr.1 Criterium des 3 Ans, and in the absence of that day's winner, LOMBOK JIEL (9) sports hind pads this time and has an excellent chance of returning to victorious ways. Leading the opposition is the reconfigured LOULOU DE MYE (7) who beat him in the Gr.2 Prix Jacques de Vauloge late-August, and the talented but somewhat erratic LUCIANO MENUET (8) who was rather unlucky in the Criterium.

- **2. HORACIO DE CERISY -** Reassuring 2nd of 11 in a 2900m Amiens Class F 3 weeks ago. Starts in front and with Eric Raffin in the bike, is unlikely to disappoint
- **3. EL VALEROSO -** Reassuring 3rd of 9 in a 2800m Chartres Class E last week but in this company will have no prospect of making his presence felt
- **4. GREAT KILLS -** 8th of 11 in a 2650m Laon Class F on 13 October. Has been out of sorts but races barefoot for the occasion, with Yoann Lebourgeois reining, and is not to be overlooked
- **5. GALWAY DU VIVIER -** Unexceptional trotter that finished 8th of 11 in a 2150m Enghien amateurs Class E last week. Barefoot for the occasion but can still be written off
- **6. GALANTE DE TILLARD -** Made the frame at Les Sables-d'Olonne before finishing a lacklustre 9th of 13 in a 2875m Enghien Class D on 9 October, and others easier to back
- **7. GRAHIKA -** Showed her form despite being sanctioned in a 2875m Enghien Class D on 9 October. Starts in front and with application can impose
- **8. GAMIN DU LERRE -** Honest type that ran 4th of 14 in a 2700m Segré Class F on 29 September. Enjoys a good entry on front line but still looks out of his depth
- **9. HERMES LUDOIS -** Got back in the game at Meslay-du-Maine earlier this month when 3rd of 15 in a 2875m Class E. Incurs the penalty again but still looks a solid first-5 chance
- **10. GARDE A VOUS -** 9th of 16, behind GAMIN DE MAHEY (13), in a 2450m Caen Class D a fortnight ago. Races barefoot this time but has not done enough recently to be considered a player
- **11. GOLD D'ECROVILLE -** Sanctioned, when unsupported, in a 2150m Enghien Class D late last month. Just front pads fitted and even with Gabi Gelormini in the bike this time is unlikely to cause an upset
- **12. HONEY KING -** Tough, consistent trotter that came 4th of 13 in a 2150m Enghien Class D 3.5 weeks ago. Has references under these conditions and, even from back line, looks dangerous
- **13. GAMIN DE MAHEY -** 3rd of 16 in a 2450m Caen Class D a fortnight ago. In the frame in 2 of 3 under these conditions and should be good enough to finish close again
- **14. EL PASO D'OCCAGNES -** Races barefoot after coming 5th of 14 in a 2875m Enghien claimer 11 days ago, but can still be confidently disregarded
- **15. EQUEJUELO -** Showed improvement when 6th of 12 in a 2875m Enghien Class D 2.5 weeks ago, but is unlikely to repeat
- **16. FILOU DE LARRE -** 4th of 7 in a competitive Class C over course and distance on 22 September. In less-exalted company this time and can make a big splash. Attention

**Summary:** Talented but never far from faulting, GRAHIKA (7) finds herself nicely-placed on the front row, is shod as she was when winning at Mauquenchy and, if focused, can prevail. She will however face significant opposition from second-line starters HONEY KING (12) who is barefoot following a good Enghien performance, finishing ahead of GAMIN DE MAHEY (13) who subsequently went on to go closer at Caen. On the back row, but superbly-engaged, FILOU DE LARRE (16) drops in category and looks a serious proposition.

- **2. JEZABELLE BIE -** Distant 3rd of 5 finishers, behind JEROBOAM D'ERABLE (8), in Gr.2 Prix Edmond Henry over track and trip a fortnight ago. Is not devoid of ability and, with some luck in running, can pick up a cheque
- **3. JOY FOR US -** Sanctioned in a Class C over course and distance mid-month, on 2nd start back, but others still easier to trust
- **4. JAMAICA PHEDO -** Won 3 of last 4, latterly a 2875m Enghien Class D in good order a fortnight ago. Takes a big step up in category but has won 4 of 6 with Eric Raffin and, sporting 4 pads for first time, must be respected
- **5. JAGUAR DU GOUTIER -** Modest element that faulted, on comeback, in a 2700m Class B over course and distance 3 weeks ago and is out of his depth
- **6. JUNON DU LEARD -** Back under the saddle after finishing last but one in a harness Class B over course and distance late-September. Sports her 'monté' configuration but in current form is hard to make a case

- **12. ERMES EFFESSE** Disappointing since coming to France, latterly last but one behind KAKO GASCOGNE (5) in a 2175m Class C here on 20 September, and will have nothing to contribute
- **13. RAGAZZA DU CHENE -** Sanctioned in late-September race of reference. Tends to show more at home and, even with hind shoes off, will have too much to do
- **14. EMIRO CLEMAR -** Surprise 5th of 9, a place behind KOZIELLO DE LOU (1), in a Class D under these conditions late last month. Will not be available at 90/1 this time but is unlikely to be as competitive either
- **15. EMILY LP -** Last but one, behind KASH LADY (2), in a Class D over course and distance on 29 September, and looks to need another run
- **16. ERICA JET -** Sanctioned after tiring in a Class D over course and distance late last month. Not short of ability but looks to have her work cut out this time

**Summary:** As inclement as the wind but a filly of significant capacity, KASH LADY (2) won over course and distance late last month, on her first start for Pierre Belloche, and barefoot for the first time, is in with a realistic shout of confirming. KIWI DE TREMONT (4) drops marginally in category, has never disappointed under these conditions, reverts to racing with front pads, and is well-placed to apply the pressure. Shod to preference this time, KEVISAN (8) has never been beaten over 2100m here and has already won twice for David Thomain. KAMIKAZE DU CAMPUS (6) came into himself over the summer, thrives at Vincennes, and takes on 2100m here with legitimate ambition.
