

C1 - PRIX AUSONE - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class G Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 6,000

1. **JOUR DE JUIN** - Finished 7th in a Class G over 3000m at Nantes on 19 January. Won his two races prior to his last run and will be looking to get back on a winning track
2. **INSTAR** - A reasonable 4th in a Class G over 2650m Grenade on 22 December. Takes on stronger and will need to find more
3. **JADIS DAIRPET** - Disqualified in a Class F over 2550m at Beaumont De Lamagne on 19 December. Will need to up his game but he is capable of gaining a place
4. **IDEO HUNAUDIERES** - A decent 2nd in a Class G over 2650m at this course on 26 December. Will have a lot more to do this time but will be racing fully shod this time
5. **JERSEY ISLAND** - Unplaced in a Class F over 2725m at Graignes on 11 January. That was her first run back from a 217-day layoff so there could be some improvement this time
6. **JADE GERBEHAYE** - Disqualified in a Class F over 2650m at Agen on 10 November. She will race without shoes behind this time but she did win using that configuration in July. She has a lot going for her
7. **GALAXIE LIMOUSINE** - Finished downfield in a Class G over 2675m at this course on 22 December. Recent form has not been great
8. **JOYEUSE DE LAVANCE** - Ran 5th in a Class E over 2575m at Agen on 17 January. She is in decent form and although up in class, she must have a place chance
9. **HARKONNEN** - Unplaced in a Class E over 2400m at Montauban on 28 December. Rarely far off the leading contenders and could be competitive at this level. Will race with padded shoes in front

Summary: She might have made a mistake in her last race but JADE GERBEHAYE (6) is in good form, particularly at the amateur level in which she won so impressively last October. She is undoubtedly the runner they all have to beat. JOUR DE JUIN (1) has his issues but if he behaves he looks to be the main threat. After that the race looks quite open and JOYEUSE DE LAVANCE (8) is probably next best while HARKONNEN (9) should run well.

C2 - PRIX DES AMIS DU CHEVAL - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Mounted - EUR € 30,000

- 1. IRISH SONG** - A poor 9th in a Class E over 2550m at this course on 4 January. Form has been poor and looks unlikely to feature
- 2. JEUNE PRODIGE** - Looked good when 2nd in a Class E over 2575m at Agen on 17 January. Ran a promising 4th in his debut under the saddle in October and could show further improvement
- 3. JADE VENESI** - Finished 2nd in a Class F over 2750m at Cabourg on 2 January. Has been runner-up in two starts at this course and should do well again. Will race fully shod
- 4. HEPICETOU** - Ran 4th in a Class E over 2650m at Marseille-Vivaux on 18 January. Has some ability and ran well after a 138-day break last time.
- 5. IMHOTEP BUROIS** - Unplaced in a Class E over 2675m at this track on 16 December. While not the most consistent of runners, he is really good if in the mood and must be considered. Will race unshod
- 6. GALIBOT DE L'ISOP** - Finished 5th in a Class E over 2475m at Villereal on 6 September. He comes back from a layoff and tries his luck in this discipline
- 7. JIMINY CRICKET** - An excellent 2nd in a Class D over 3125m at Angers on 1 October. Has good form in this discipline but is returning from a break. Will have shoes on all four feet
- 8. JAG MAHCATH** - Disqualified in a Class H over 2175m at Vincennes on 18 January. His strongest form is in mounted trotting and he can get back into the winner's enclosure. Will race fully shod
- 9. IDEAL DE RIVRAY** - A promising 4th in a Class B over 2625m at Agen on 17 January. That was his first run for a new trainer and although that was a harness race, he could run into a place. Will race with padded shoes on all four feet
- 10. HASARD** - Unplaced in a Class B over 2625m at Agen on 17 January. Has a lot more to do to be competitive in this line-up

Summary: JAG MAHCATH (8) is always a runner to consider at this level when contesting mounted trotting events and despite making a mistake last time looks the one to beat. His biggest rival is likely to be JIMINY CRICKET (7) who has excellent form racing under the saddle but all will depend on his fitness in his first run since 1 October. JADE VENESI (3) has a good record at this course while JEUNE PRODIGE (2) has a big chance to run a place.

**C3 - PX JEANOT LAMAISON-PX HIPPO VILLEREAL - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness -
EUR € 18,000**

- 1. MAC TYSON** - Disqualified in a Class G over 2650m at this course on 18 January. That was his first run after a 78-day break. Will race unshod in front
- 2. MOLITA** - Did well to run 2nd in a Class E over 2700m at Lyon A La Soie on 26 October. That was her first run for a new trainer and was achieved without shoes. Using the same configuration she should be right there
- 3. MILORD DU CORTA** - Ran 3rd in a Class G over 2650m at this track on 26 January. That was his first run for his new trainer
- 4. MENELAS DE CORBERY** - Unplaced in a Class G over 2350m at Angers on 8 December. That was his first run back in 196 days but will need to find a lot more
- 5. MON GRAND PRE** - Finished 6th in a Class F over 2725m at Grenade on 21 December. Races unshod this time and there could be massive improvement
- 6. MUST MAJYC** - A disappointing 9th in a Class F over 2150m at Toulouse on 9 January. Will need to up his game to feature
- 7. MON REVE** - Won a Class G over 2825m at Cordemais on 14 December. He has only run twice and looks a horse to follow.
- 8. MISTER JENILOU** - Disqualified in a Class F over 2675m at this track on 4 January. Will race fully shod this time and won his penultimate start wearing shoes on all four feet.
- 9. MILORD MARANDAIS** - Disqualified in a Class F over 2150m at Toulouse on 9 January. Has been disqualified in six of his last seven starts but can play a role if he can keep his mind on the job. Racing unshod behind
- 10. MISSIONDARCHE** - An excellent 2nd in a Class G over 2875m at Argentan on 10 January. That was her first run following a 125-day break and she now looks ready to win
- 11. MOOREA BOND** - Disqualified in a Class E over 2725m at Grenade on 14 December. She can take advantage of being perfectly positioned at the earnings ceiling

Summary: MISSIONDARCHE (10) came back well from a lengthy break to finish runner-up. She should improve on that performance with driver Théo Briand this time and can notch up her first victory. MOLITA (2) could provide the biggest threat after a decent 2nd last time and will enjoy the right-handed track. Lightly raced MON REVE (7) has a win and a 4th in his last two starts and could have more to offer. MON GRAND PRE (5) could show more racing barefoot this time.

C4 - PRIX OURASI - 2550m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 23,000

1. **MAGGIOTTA** - Finished 5th in a Class D over 2700m at Vincennes on 19 January. Has a lot to do make any impact on this field
2. **MISSILE DE TAGOR** - Finished 5th in a Class D over 2700m at Vincennes on 19 January. Been disappointing of late and will need to regain his best form
3. **MARAVILLA DU METZ** - A respectable 5th in a Class D over 2975m at Toulouse on 22 January. Has the speed and ability to be competitive. Will race fully shod this time
4. **MOURILLON** - Disqualified in a Class D over 2100m at Vincennes on 6 December. Won three in a row before a break and looks ready to return to best form
5. **MOOREA** - An excellent 2nd in a Class D over 2150m at Toulouse on 9 January. Talented filly who will be a massive contender if she keeps her mind on the task
6. **MIYA DE JOUDES** - Won a Class D over 2550m at this course on 26 December. Proven at this track and in top form, she has to be respected
7. **MAESTRO DE JOUDES** - Disqualified in a Class D over 2150m at Toulouse on 9 January. Has had the same issue in his last three runs so will need to get that right
8. **MICHEL MARTIN** - A mediocre 8th in a Class B over 2625m at Chatelaillon-La Rochelle on 28 July. Coming back from a six-month break so fitness could an issue
9. **MELICIANO** - A reasonable 6th in a Class E over 2100m at Vincennes on 1 January. Has ability on his day and needs to be considered

Summary: MOURILLON (4) started his career in style, notching up three successive victories before having a lengthy 119-day break. His comeback has been slow but now having his third run back, should be at his peak. Dropping in class he should be hard to beat. MOOREA (5) is another in good form currently along with MIYA DE JOUDES (6) and they have to be respected. MARAVILLA DU METZ (3) has the ability to challenge the top contenders.

C5 - PRIX ULTRA PETITA - 2550m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. **LEKEVIN DESBOIS** - Disqualified twice in his last three starts. the latest at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2950m on 18 December. Capable of getting involved with the finish
2. **LE CARAT D'AS** - Unreliable and finished 6th in Class C at Toulouse over 2950m on 16 January. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
3. **LOUSTIC DE FLAM** - Disqualified in Class E at Nantes over 3025m on 18 January. Four good wins before that and can bounce back to score
4. **L'AMI DE LANCOUR** - Off form and finished 8th in Class E at Toulouse over 2975m on 15 January. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
5. **LARGO DE JOUDES** - Showed some improvement when third in Class E at Graignes over 2725m on 20 November. Returns from a break and could need the run
6. **LA JOCONDE** - Faulted last time out at Nantes over 3025m on 16 January. Had some fair form before that and is not out of it
7. **LEMON CURD** - Not reliable but was a good third in Class E at Toulouse over 2975m on 15 January. Can get involved with the finish
8. **LABEL TURGOT** - Much improved last run when runner-up in Class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 25 October>Returns from a break but has claims if fit enough
9. **LILAS DU MELEUC** - Not reliable and finished third in Class E at Toulouse over 2975m on 8 January. Capable of making the frame
10. **LIEVRE D'ALBRET** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in Class E at Toulouse over 2975m on 9 January. Needs to find a few lengths to win

Summary: LOUSTIC DE FLAM (3) faulted last time out at Nantes last week. He has generally been outstanding for Pierre-Louis Desauvette and could resume winning ways over this shorter distance. LEKEVIN DESBOIS (1) has disqualification issues but is capable of contesting the finish when staying in stride. LA JOCONDE (6) was in good shape before a recent disqualification and can be competitive. LEMON CURD (7) has a good record when racing without shoes and is another to consider.

C6 - PRIX OZO - 2550m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 24,000

1. **KEOPS TILLAYE** - Faulted last time out in Class E at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 200 on 3 November. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
2. **KYARA** - Unreliable and finished 5th in Class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2725m on 17 January. Capable of an upset on best form
3. **KOUSINE CARISAIE** - Disqualified three times in last five starts, the latest in Class E over this track and trip on 16 December. Might play a minor role if smart
4. **KASSAV DE FRECA** - Disqualified last time out at Toulouse over 2975m on 9 January. Very consistent when staying on the trot and has claims
5. **KALINE DE COSSE** - Victorious in Class E over this track and trip on 8 January. Quite capable of following up if in the same mood
6. **KAI LA SHA** - Returned to form and was runner-up in Class F at Graignes over 2700m on 11 January. Can go one place better
7. **KEYS** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in Class E at this track over 2660m on 8 January. Needs to find a few lengths to win
8. **KANCAENNAISE** - Showed some improvement when fourth in a Class F mounted race at Toulouse over 2325m on 15 January. Needs to find more to win
9. **KASSIOPEE DU NOYER** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class F at Argentan over 2900m on 17 January. Could earn some minor money
10. **KING DE BOUTEAU** - Did not show his best when 8th in Class D at this course over 2550m on 8 January. Capable of a surprise on best form
11. **KRISTOBAL** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in Class F at this track and trip on 18 January. Might play a minor role
12. **KAISER DE CESNY** - Unreliable but was runner-up in Class E at Argentan over 2900m on 10 January. Be right there at the finish
13. **KROONER D'ORION** - Much improved last run when runner-up in Class E at this track over 2650m on 18 January. Can go one place better
14. **KING D'EB** - Successful in Class E at Nantes over 3025m on 16 January. Not reliable but might well follow up in this line-up

Summary: A very open-looking race. KAI LA SHA (6) comes here in good shape and got close to scoring at Graignes, so gets a narrow vote to go one better. KASSAV DE FRECA (4) put in a rare fault at Toulouse but is usually very competitive and should be right there. KAISER DE CESNY (12) is not reliable but can contest the finish. KALINE DE COSSE (5) was a solid winner at this track last time out and is quite capable of doubling up.

C7 - PRIX BEATNICK II - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 23,000

1. **LAISSEZ PASSER** - Faulted last time out in Class E over this course and distance on 8 January. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
2. **LORD DU GILET** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in Class F at Agen-La Garenne over 2650m on 11 January. Needs to do more to score
3. **LOTTA SUEDOISE** - Disqualified in Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 27 December. In good form before that and can bounce back to score
4. **LIMBOURGOIS** - Only moderate of late and finished 7th in Class D at Agen-La Garenne over 2625m on 17 January. Can be a threat on best form
5. **L'AS DE CAZOULENE** - Off form and finished 9th in a Class E mounted race over this track and trip on 8 January. Others make more appeal
6. **LUMIERE BLUE** - Very consistent and was runner-up in Class E at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2700m on 26 October. returns from a break but is not out of it
7. **LAZIO BUROIS** - In good shape and finished third in Class E at Nimes over 2775m on 16 November. Could earn some more money
8. **LAMIE QUICK** - Unreliable and finished 8th in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 13 December. Capable of an upset on best form
9. **LOTHBROCK** - Disqualified in his last four starts, the latest in Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2926m on 11 January. Hard to trust but can make the frame when wise
10. **LOOK AT ME LULU** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class E at Pontchateau over 2800m on 21 December. Capable of contesting the finish

Summary: A very tricky race and anything is possible. LORD DU GILET (2) faulted last time out at Vincennes but did win her penultimate start. Théo Briand will give her every opportunity to score again. LIMBOURGOIS (4) and LOOK AT ME LULU (10) have both struggled of late but are capable of winning a race of this nature. LOTHBROCK (9) is very hard to trust but is quite capable of getting involved with the finish if staying in stride.

C8 - PRIX DE CENON - PRIX RFM - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 39,000

1. **KIVALA RENARDIER** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class E at Vincennes over 2850m on 10 January. Remains barefoot and is not out of it
2. **LORENZO BOKO** - Showed improvement when third in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 8 January. Has a place chance in this line-up
3. **KISS ME AGAIN** - Victorious in Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 28 December Has a good record with this shoeing and can follow up
4. **GENTLEMAN PIYA** - Off form and was unplaced in a claimer at Vincennes over 2850m on 14 January. More is needed to win this race
5. **ICEBREAKER PELLINI** - Clearly needed the run when 9th in Class E at Vincennes over 2850m on 13 January. Remains barefoot and capable of winning
6. **GLOBAL CONCEPT** - Not disgraced when 6th in Class E at Vincennes over 2850m on 13 January. Fitter this time and can contest the finish
7. **JOJOBA DE QUERAY** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class B at Agen-La Garenne over 2625m on 17 January. Not easy to trust but is also capable of scoring
8. **GEGE DE FROMENTEL** - Battling to find best form and was 9th in Class C at Toulouse over 2150m on 16 May. Returns from a break and others are preferred
9. **GENEROUS CHARM** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class B at Agen-La Garenne over 2650m on 17 January. More is needed to score
10. **ICARE DU BERYL** - Not reliable and finished 8th in Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 17 January. Had some fair form before that and can make the frame
11. **CANTO DEI VENTI** - Successful in Class D over this course and distance on 22 December. Quite capable of following up in this line-up
12. **GAZ D'OCCAGNES** - Unreliable and finished 6th in Class B at Vincennes over 2100m on 11 January. Might play a minor role at very best
13. **HAMONET DE CHOISEL** - Unreliable and was disqualified in Class B at Vincennes over 2100m on 11 January. Not easy to trust but can earn some money when smart

Summary: A very competitive-looking lucky last race. The foreign horses could dominate the finish. ICEBREAKER PELLINI (5) and GLOBAL CONCEPT (6) go right-handed this time around but both have ability and are capable of scoring. ICEBREAKER PELLINI (5) might be the better of the two on this occasion. KIVALA RENARDIER (1) has only been modest of late but is capable of winning a race of this nature. KISS ME AGAIN (3) remains in very good shape and would not be a surprise
