

**C1 - PRIX DE L'HIPPODROME DES BRUYERES - 2850m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR €
24,000**

- 1. KRUG LOVER** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in class F at Nantes over 3000m on 7 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 2. JOKER DE VOUEDE** - Disqualified in claimer at Vincennes over 2100m on 9 January. Remains barefoot but others make more appeal
- 3. JURITI** - Disqualified in a class F mounted race at Carentan over 2875m on 19 July. Reverts to barefoot but is returning from a break
- 4. KUNZITE D'EM** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 22 November. Not easy to trust and could need this run
- 5. JULLIAN DADDY** - Disqualified in class G at this track over 2150m on 21 January. Remains barefoot and did win his penultimate start. Not out of it
- 6. KISS ME DU LIVET** - Holding form and was fourth in class E at Argentan over 2875m on 10 January. Remains barefoot and has a place chance
- 7. KIT ANGOT** - Only moderate of late and finished 9th in class A at Le Croise-Laroche over 2825m on 8 November. Should need this run returning from a break
- 8. JIVE BOY** - Very consistent and finished third in class G at this track over 2150m on 21 January. Can be competitive once again
- 9. KOPA D'ARC** - Did not show his best when 9th in class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 30 October. In good form before that and is not out of it
- 10. IBIZA DE CONNEE** - Unreliable and finished fifth in a class E mounted race at Pontchateau over 2800m on 21 December. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 11. JOADIE WIND** - Returned to form and was third in class E at Vincennes over 2175m on 30 December. Should be right there at the finish
- 12. KAISER DES GRANGES** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in class C at Vincennes over 2850m on 15 January. Capable of winning a race of this nature

Summary: A tough start to the meeting. KAISER DES GRANGES (12) seemed to run better than his finishing position suggested at Vincennes and can win a race like this. JOADIE WIND (11) remains in very good shape and would not be a surprise winner. JULLIAN DADDY (5) is best judged on his penultimate start, where he was a winner, so is not out of it. JIVE BOY (8) is not an easy horse to win with but is consistent and can make the frame again.

C2 - PRIX GERARD PORTOIS - 2850m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 24,000

1. KISS ME TO LIVE - Disqualified in class E at Argentan over 2875m on 10 January. Tries barefoot and could play a minor role

2. KALA DES RACQUES - Did not show her best when 8th in class F at Vincennes over 2700m on 24 December. Capable of doing better and has a place chance

3. KUEEN - Only modest of late and finished 8th in a class F mounted race at Vincennes over 2175m on 24 December. Reverts to barefoot but others make more appeal

4. KASIMIR DU BOIS - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in class E at Chartres over 2825m on 3 November. Needs to find a few lengths to win

5. KALYPSO DREAM - Unreliable but was third in class F at Argentan over 2875m on 17 January. Remains barefoot but is on a long losing run

6. KASHMIR PRESTANCE - Unreliable and finished fifth at Mons over 2840m on 8 January. Hard to trust and needs to do more to beat these rivals

7. KEZIO PEJI - Only modest of late and finished fifth in a class E mounted race at Le Mans over 2950m on 15 December.. More is needed to beat these rivals

8. KLIF DE LA MITRIE - Unreliable and finished 9th in class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 4 January. Capable of a surprise on best form

9. KASHKAI - Fourth in a class E at Chateaubriant over 3000m on 5 January. Remains barefoot and can get a look in

10. KEPI DEL - Disqualified in class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 19 January. Battling to find best form and others are preferred

11. KALINKA DU BREUIL - Succesful in a class E at Argentan over 2875m on 10 January. In good form and is capable of following up

12. KATINKA COTON - A winner in a class F at Argentan over 2875m on 17 January. Remains barefoot and should be given some consideration

13. KRONA VIKING - Not reliable but was fifth in class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 26 November. Can be competitive in this line-up

14. KANELLE STAR - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in class D at Vincennes over 2175m on 4 January. Hard to trust and others are preferred

15. KRONO DU TRIO - In good form and was runner-up in class E at Chateaubriant over 3000m on 5 January. Can go one place better

16. KOCKTAIL WOOD - Disqualified in class D at Vincennes over 2175m on 3 January. Remains barefoot and could be a threat if smart

17. KANDEL DE BEYLEV - Showed improvement when fifth in class F at Cordemais over 2825m on 14 January. Has claims in what is an open race

18. KRUGER DU NORD - Unreliable and finished 9th in class F at Cordemais over 2825m on 14 January. Not easy to trust but is capable of winning

Summary: Another very difficult race to find the winner. KANDEL DE BEYLEV (17) has had two runs back, so could be nearing a peak performance and a possible winning turn. KRUGER DU NORD (18) is unreliable but has been prepared for this race, so must be respected for that. KRONO DU TRIO (15) remains in good form and can get involved with the finish again. KOCKTAIL WOOD (16) faulted last time out but is another that could score if staying in stride.

C3 - PRIX PARIS TURF - 2850m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. LA BARAKA** - Disqualified in class F at this track over 2150m on 21 January. Capable of doing better and has a place chance
- 2. LACOUMA** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in class E at Vincennes over 2175m on 6 January. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 3. LOVE SHACK** - Not reliable and finished 6th in class E at Graignes over 2725m on 12 December. Tries barefoot and get into the mix of things
- 4. LUPIN DU BOURG** - Did not show his best when 8th in Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 5 December. Races without shoes and is not out of it
- 5. L'AMI DANOVER** - Disqualified in a class F at Nantes over 3000m on 7 December. Remains barefoot but is hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 6. LUCKY WIND** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 15 November. Could need this run returning from a break
- 7. LUCHADOR** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class E over this track and trip on 12 January. Not easy to trust but can make the frame when smart
- 8. LUCKY STAR JIEL** - Disqualified in class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 17 December. Not easy to trust but is capable of scoring when in the right mood
- 9. LIANGA** - Very unreliable and was unplaced in class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 4 January. Capable of a surprise when smart
- 10. LINGUIST D'HERIPRE** - Battling to find best form and finished 6th in class E at this track over 2850m on 12 January. Needs to do more to win
- 11. LILOU D'ATOUT** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 13 January. Better under the saddle and others are preferred
- 12. LASCAR PILE** - Has struggled of late and finished 9th in a class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 6 January. Remains barefoot and could threaten if at best
- 13. LORENZO GEDE** - Not disgraced when fifth in class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 6 January. Quite capable of winning in this line-up

Summary: LORENZO GEDE (13) has run some fair races at Vincennes of late and should make a bold bid at beating these rivals. LASCAR PILE (12) has struggled of late but is clearly capable of doing better and can be a threat to these rivals if back on song. LOVE SHACK (3) races without shoes for the very first time, so expect a much better performance. LUPIN DU BOURG (4) is better than his last run and will be barefoot so could be ready to strike.

C4 - PRIX HIPPOMAT - 2850m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. MEETIC DE BEAULIEU** - Disqualified in a class E at Vichy over 2800m on 20 September. Has major disqualification issues and is returning from a break. Others are preferred
- 2. MAO DU PARC** - Not disgraced when fifth in class F at Agon-Coutainville over 2200m on 25 August. Returns from a break and should need this run
- 3. MAESTRO DE PAGERIE** - Not reliable but was fifth in class F at Argentan over 2875m on 17 January. Tries barefoot and has a place chance
- 4. MAX DU CAMPDOS** - Disqualified in class E at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 15 December. Unreliable but is capable of earning some minor money
- 5. MAMBO DU MIREL** - Consistent so far and was a winner of a class E at Les Andelys over 2525m on 15 June. Could need this run returning from a break
- 6. MONZON DU CHATELET** - In good form and was third in class F at Cordemais over 2825m on 14 January. Should be right there at the finish once again
- 7. MILORD DU LORAULT** - Unreliable but was runner-up in class F over this course and distance on 12 January. Can go one place better
- 8. MAESTRO DE CORDAY** - Disqualified in class E at Argentan over 2800m on 23 December. Has disqualification issues but can make the frame when smart
- 9. MOMO DES CARREAUX** - In good shape and finished fourth in class E at Vincennes over 2850m on 24 December. Can get involved with the finish
- 10. METEORE ETOILE** - Not reliable and finished fifth in class E at Vincennes over 2850m on 24 December. Capable of doing better and is not out of it
- 11. MISTER D'AVOINES** - Disqualified in class E at Vincennes over 2850m on 6 January. Remains barefoot and is capable of bouncing back to win

Summary: MISTER D'AVOINES (11) was unlucky not to earn money for his connections last time out at Vincennes. If smart this time, he could win this race. METEORE ETOILE (10) has not been too reliable but does have claims of winning this very open-looking race. MOMO DES CARREAUX (9) is usually very competitive in this division and can get into the thick of things once again. MONZON DU CHATELET (6) is also in very good form and should be right there at the finish as well.

C5 - PRIX SPEED TROTTING - 2850m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. MERRY STAR** - Has some fair form and finished fourth at Mons over 2300m on 22 January. Probably needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 2. MATINA D'ORLY** - Battling to find best form and finished 8th in class F at Nantes over 3000m on 12 June. Returns from a break and others are preferred
- 3. MAMZELLE DU HOULET** - Unreliable and finished 9th in a class E mounted race at Enghien over 2250m on 9 October. Tries barefoot and could earn some money
- 4. MA JOLIE JIEL** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in class F at Amiens over 2400m on 13 November. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 5. MAMMA MIA DE LOU** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class E at Vincennes over 2850m on 25 December. Tries barefoot and is capable of scoring if smart
- 6. MANON BLONDE** - In good shape and was fourth in a claimer at Vincennes over 2875m on 19 December. Remains barefoot and could be competitive again
- 7. MILAZZIA** - Disqualified in a class E mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 13 January. Consistent before that and has a place chance
- 8. MIMI CHARMEUSE** - A winner of two of her last three starts, including in class F at Graignes over 2725m on 30 December. Can follow up
- 9. MILADY DE REUX** - Showed improvement and finished third in class E at Enghien over 2150m on 30 July. Returns from a break and is not out of it if fit enough
- 10. MAMZELLE DREAM** - Unreliable but was third in class E at Le Mans over 2200m on 15 December. Tries barefoot and can make the frame

Summary: MIMI CHARMEUSE (8) continues to improve and should be a big runner yet again. She was an easy winner at Graignes and sets the standard for the race. MAMMA MIA DE LOU (5) has the ability and will race without shoes. She does, however, have some disqualification issues. MANON BLONDE (6) is in good shape and can be competitive yet again. MILADY DE REUX (9) returns from a break but was improving before it and is capable of making the frame if fit enough.

C6 - PRIX DE BUCHY - 2850m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 17,000

- 1. NO LIMIT SAUTREUIL** - A three-year-old filly by Hooker Berry out of Amazone du Parc who is making her debut. Her mother did not win a race after 13 starts. Others make more appeal
- 2. NINA DU COJEUL** - Did not show much when 8th on debut in class F at Cabourg over 2750m on 6 December. Others are preferred
- 3. NORDIC GIRL** - Disqualified in a class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2200m on 19 January. Very hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 4. NUANCE DU HOULET** - Finished 8th on debut in class F at La Capelle over 2000m on 11 November. Returns from a short break and could need this run
- 5. NOUCHKA ROYALE** - Showed some improvement when 6th in a class F at Graignes over 2700m on 11 January. Needs to do more to win this race
- 6. NUT AND MONEY** - Only modest so far and finished 6th in a class E at Graignes over 2700m on 12 December. Needs to do more to win
- 7. NINA SIMONE** - Only modest so far and finished 6th in class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 5 December. Should be a lot more competitive this time around
- 8. NEED YOU AGAIN** - Much improved last run when runner-up in class F at Angers over 2425m on 11 January. Clearly not out of it
- 9. NIGHT SHADOW** - Much improved last run when runner-up in a claimer at Reims over 2550m on 7 December. Tougher task this time and has disqualification issues
- 10. NASHIRA RUSCINO** - Showed some improvement when third in class F at Argentan over 2875m on 17 January. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 11. NYMPHADORA TONKS** - Has run well in both starts and was runner-up in class F at Graignes over 2700m on 11 January. Can go one place better
- 12. NAKOA D'OURVILLE** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in class F at Argentan over 2875m on 17 January. Can be competitive once again
- 13. NAGODA** - Holding form and finished third in a class F mounted race at Argentan over 2875m on 17 January. Could earn some minor money
- 14. NALA LEALMANI** - Showed improvement when runner-up in class F at Cordemais over 2150m on 4 January. Be right there at the finish

Summary: A very interesting race. NYMPHADORA TONKS (11) was a bit unlucky not to win at Graignes and can certainly go one better over this longer trip. NALA LEALMANI (14) showed improvement when splitting some colts last time out and will not remain in the maiden ranks for too much longer. NEED YOU AGAIN (8) is improving, was outsprinted last time out, and should prefer this distance. NINA SIMONE (7) is likely to improve after two runs at Vincennes and is another to consider.

C7 - PRIX TIDALIUM PELO - 2850m (a2m) - Class E - Mounted - EUR € 21,000

- 1. MILORD DE CALI** - Has struggled so far and was unplaced in a class G harness race at this track over 2150m on 30 November. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 2. MY SPIRIT ERA** - Showed improvement when fourth in a class F mounted race at Graignes over 2700m on 11 January. Can earn some more money
- 3. MILLENIUM JIEL** - Disqualified in five of six starts so far, the latest in a class E mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 14 January. Capable of winning when smart
- 4. MOGADOR** - Only modest f late and finished 6th in a class E harness race at Angers over 2350m on 15 January. Tries a mounted race and has a place chance
- 5. MARGARITA** - Disqualified in three of five starts so far a class F at Nantes over 2275m on 16 January. Has the ability and can be a real threat if staying on the trot
- 6. MORNING SUN** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class E mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 4 November. Not out of it if staying on the trot
- 7. MILORD DREAM** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class E mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 28 December. Tries barefoot and can contest the finish
- 8. MISSION IMPOSSIBLE** - Unreliable and finished fourth in a class E mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 13 January. Capable of getting involved with the finish

Summary: MILLENIUM JIEL (3) is clearly very hard to trust but does have plenty of ability. He was disqualified after an enquiry last time out and could make amends if staying on the trot this time around. MARGARITA (5) is clearly talented but also comes with disqualification issues. She will be a threat to these rivals if applied. MILORD DREAM (7) will be racing without shoes this time around and did chase home MILLENIUM JIEL (3) at Cabourg, so must be respected for that. MISSION IMPOSSIBLE (8) is not reliable but does have scope for improvement and could make the frame.

C8 - PRIX LEVASSEUR RECEPTIONS - 2850m (a2m) - Class G Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 6,000

- 1. JETHRO DE NILREM** - Disqualified in a class E mounted race at Saint-Brieuc over 3150m on 5 December. Battling to regain form and needs major improvement to win
- 2. JUST FOR YOU PIYA** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class E mounted race at Neuille-Pont-Pierre over 3025m on 3 August. Returns from a break and others are preferred
- 3. JOKAI DES ROIS** - Unplaced at Mons over 2840m on 4 January. Remains barefoot and had some fair form before that but others make more appeal
- 4. JUMP WITH ME** - Successful in a class F at Argentan over 2875m on 17 January. Very unreliable but cannot be ruled from scoring again
- 5. JACKPOT D'AXEL** - Unreliable and was unplaced in class F at Cabourg over 2750m on 8 December. Might play a minor role at very best
- 6. HEROINE RINGEAT** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in class G over this track and trip on 2 December. Very hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 7. GYPSIE MAGIQUE** - Disqualified in a class G over this course and distance on 12 January. Unreliable but is capable of playing a minor role
- 8. JULIANA DES LUCAS** - Holding form and was not disgraced when fifth in class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 4 January. Big chance in this line-up
- 9. ILLICO DES BROUETS** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in class F at Vincennes over 2850m on 10 January. Has a place chance on best form
- 10. JOURNAIO DU ROI** - Disqualified in class F at Graignes over 2700m on 11 January. Has major disqualification issues but is capable of winning when smart
- 11. JACKSON HILL** - Very consistent and was third in class E at Vincennes over 2850m on 24 December. Should contest the finish

Summary: JULIANA DES LUCAS (8) remains in good form and does look the one to be with in this competitive lucky last race. JUMP WITH ME (4) won a good race at Argentan but has proven to be very unreliable. JACKSON HILL (11) is usually right there at the finish and can get involved with the finish yet again. He is a difficult horse to win with, however. JOURNAIO DU ROI (10) is very hard to trust but does win races when staying on the trot, so must be considered a possible
