Race 1 - PRIX MITSOUKO III - 3600m STPLE. Purse EUR €59,000.

- 1. JARDIN D'ARTHEL Won by 4 lengths in a steeplechase (3900m) at Pau. Top hope.
- 2. **JUNGLE SEA** Second two runs back in a steeplechase (3900m) at Pau before finishing third in a steeplechase (3450m) at Compiegne latest. Obvious chance.
- 3. **JOKER DE MAI** Scored by 19 lengths in a steeplechase (3600m) at Saint Brieuc recently. Upped in standard.
- 4. **JALZAN** Finished third beaten 4 lengths in a hurdle (3400m) at Angers. Might find this a bit too tough.
- 5. **JOIKA D'HERODIERE** Fair fourth in a steeplechase (3450m) at Compiegne. Each-way chance with added fitness.
- 6. JUST A CASTLE Unseated rider recently in a steeplechase (3900m) at Pau. More needed.

Summary: JARDIN D'ARTHEL (1) made an impressive start to his chasing career when beating JUNGLE SEA (2) by 4L at Pau last month. The former looks up to remaining unbeaten over the larger obstacles while the latter can feature having since finished a decent third in a Class Two chase at Compiegne. JOIKA D'HERODIERE (5) finished fourth in that Compiegne event and cannot be ruled out for a leading yard while the wide-margin Saint-Brieuc (Chase) winner JOKER DE MAI (3) is noted up in standard.

- 1. **THELEME** Top-class six-year-old who looked as good as ever when winning the G1 Prix Serge Landon Grand Prix d'Automne (4800m) here in November. Leading hope.
- 2. **HERMES BAIE** Ten from nineteen over hurdles and finished a sound third behind II Est Français in the G3 Prix Juigne at this venue three weeks ago. Player.
- 3. **IL EST FRANCAIS** Unbeaten five-year-old who looks like an exciting prospect. Impressive 8L winner of the G1 Prix Renaud du Vivier (Grande Course de Haies des 4 Ans) last year and returned to action with a snug success in the G3 Prix Juigne here. Top hope.
- 4. GOA LIL Fourth behind a trio of these in the G3 Prix Juigne here. More needed.
- 5. KAPTEEN Runner-up to II Est Francais in the G3 Prix Juigne three weeks ago. Place claims.
- 6. **FOLSOM PRISON** Fair fourth in the G2 Prix Leon Olry Roederer hurdle at this venue in December. Could sneak into the frame on best form.
- 7. SPIRIT OF THE MOON Held fifth behind a handful of these in the G3 Prix Juigne. Opposed.

Summary: Multiple G1 winner THELEME (1) is not likely to go down without a fight and looked good when landing the G1 Prix Serge Landon - Grand Prix d'Automne by 5L here in November. However the new kid on the block IL EST FRANCAIS (3) brings a fierce reputation and last year's facile G1 Prix Renaud du Vivier (Grande Course de Haies des 4 Ans) winner can remain unbeaten. He always looked to be doing enough when winning the G3 Prix Juigne at this venue on reappearance and should take a step forward with that outing under his belt. HERMES BAIE (2) finished third in that event and cannot be dismissed while the runner-up KAPTEEN (5) looks to hold place claims once more.

Race 3 - PRIX GENERAL DE ROUGEMONT - 3600m HCP HDLE. Purse EUR €110,000.

- 1. LOU FAST Finished fourth in a Listed handicap hurdle (3600m) at this track. Leading hope.
- 2. **THEAMOI** Fell in a Listed handicap hurdle (3600m) at Compiegne. Not dismissed on best form.
- 3. **JIM DU CHENET** Second in a Listed handicap hurdle (3500m) at Cagnes-sur-Mer beaten 3 lengths. One to note.
- 4. **FRENCH EXIT** Sixth in a Listed handicap hurdle (3600m) at this track. Won a similar event earlier in the season.
- 5. SWEET DAVID Seventh in a steeplechase (3700m) at Angers last time. Could place.
- 6. AO NANG Fifth in a Listed handicap hurdle (3600m) at this track latest. Not ruled out.
- 7. IL DIAVOLO Finished a modest sixth in a steeplechase (3450m) at Compiegne last start. Risky.
- 8. J'Al LA COTE Won a hurdle (3700m) at Bordeaux by a head latest. May feature.
- 9. **ROI K'ALIN** Returned from a spell last start with a modest ninth in a Listed handicap hurdle (3600m) at this track. Looks tested in this line-up.
- 10. **HILL OF BAMBOO** Resumed after a 111-day spell last start with a strong third in a Listed handicap hurdle (3600m) at this track. Strips fitter and needs respect.
- 11. **OCASTLE DES MOTTES** Finished fourth when fresh from a spell last start in a hurdle (3600m) at this track. Place hope.
- 12. BARON ZANZI Pulled-up in a hurdle (3500m) at Pau. Others preferred.
- 13. **LE ROI DAVID** Unfancied in the betting but returned from a 121-day spell on March 5 with a sound second in a Listed handicap hurdle (3600m) at this track beaten 3 lengths. Cannot be ignored.

Summary: LE ROI DAVID (13) took a huge step forward when runner-up in the Listed Race Prix Univers li and will likely feature with a similar effort. That said preference is for LOU FAST (1) who holds a more consistent profile. The four-year-old shaped nicely when fourth in the aforementioned event and would hold solid claims on his good second in the Listed Race Prix Fifrelet here prior. FRENCH EXIT (4) won the Listed Race Prix Fifrelet before finishing sixth behind the previously mentioned pair. One to note. HILL OF BAMBOO (10) holds form that links in with the previous runners and should go well on the back of a sound third in the course and distance Listed Race Prix Univers li. THEAMOI (2) is not dismissed.

- 3. BLACK TRACK Finished third in a 3600m hurdle at Compiegne recently. Each-way hope.

Summary: JOJO LAPIN (1) overcame inexperience to make a narrow winning debut over course and distance in October. Top hope on return to action for a notable stable. CASHBACK FORLONGE (2) won a Class Four conditions hurdle in comfortable style at Fontainebleau before going for a break. Major appeal. Cagnes-sur-Mer debut scorer NYIRI (4) cannot be ignored and ULTRA MARINO (5) should feature following back-to-back second-place finishes to subsequent scorers at Pau.

Summary: A tricky race to assess. The unexposed five-year-old INDIAN DE GASCOGNE (6) could be the one to side with having impressed when making a winning hurdling debut by 2L over course and distance. Genuine claims. The market will surely guide to DOCTEUR DE BALLON (8) chances who looks like a fascinating contender on his first start since winning the G1 Grand Steeple-Chase de Paris back in May 2021. The reappearing GALLEO CONTI (3) cannot be ignored on the ratings and HARRY (5) looks interesting on the back of a promising French debut third behind Indian de Gascogne.

- 2. **BECQUARAINBOW** Sound fourth in the Listed Race 136Eme Grande Course de Haies de Pau (Prix Max de Ginestet) hurdle at Pau. Claims back chasing.
- 3. **IRUNDO** Impressive winner in a conditions chase over course and distance before finishing sixth in the G3 Prix Morgex in December. Likely remains capable of better.
- 4. EL MARTEL 11L third in a Class One conditions chase at Pau last outing. Could place.

Summary: Smart hurdler MISTER VISION (8) made a seamless transition to chasing when taking out a Class One conditions chase over 3700m here three weeks ago. Top chance. BECQUARAINBOW (2) finished a sound fourth in the Listed Race 136Eme Grande Course de Haies de Pau (Prix Max de Ginestet) at Pau last month. Player back over fences. Four-time chase winner FUNWAY (1) can be involved back chasing following a fair runner-up effort in a conditions hurdle here. IRUNDO (3) is also considered.

ANGEL STORM (4) needs to be considered following a sound second in claiming company Fontainebleau last month. JUKIRIKO (1) should find this easier than when fifth in a Class Two conditions hurdle at this venue last start. Player on handicap debut. KANOUMA JELOIS (7) makes place appeal.

The four-year-old jumped well before quickening clear for a 10L success and is selected to remain unbeaten over fences. JAZZY SENAM (7) arrives with a similar profile following a 4L win on her first start over fences in a Class One conditions event here. Obvious chance. SPEED EMILE (2) cannot be left out of the equation after a solid third in the G2 Prix Congress at this course in November. PACIFIC ONE (6) rounds out the shortlist.
