C1 - PRIX DE BEZIERS - 2950m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 24,000

- 1. LORD FAFA** - A winner of a class G at this track over 2325m on 13 March. Victorious in his 21st start and is capable of earning some money
- 2. LOLITA DE LORIOL** - Showed some improvement when fourth in a class F at this track over 2750m on 13 March. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 3. LOKY DE JIEL** - Returned from a lengthy break when 9th in a class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 2 January. Fitter this time and could be a threat for Julien Foin
- 4. LOAIME JIJI** - A winner of a class E mounted race at Agen-le-Passage over 2625m on 9 February. Better in that discipline and others make more appeal
- 5. LUPIN DES SOURCES** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a class E at Agen-le-Passage over 2625m on 3 March. Has a place chance on best form
- 6. LOOKING FOREXPRESS** - In good shape and finished third in a class E at Agen-le-Passage over 2625m on 3 March. Remains barefoot and could earn some money
- 7. LORD DU GILET** - Has only been modest this year and finished 9th in a class E at Agen-le-Passage over 2625m on 3 March. Needs major improvement to win
- 8. LEWIS DE BLARY** - Disqualified in a class E at Agen-le-Passage over 2625m on 3 March. Unreliable but is quite capable of contesting the finish
- 9. LABEL MESS** - Very consistent and was a runner-up in a class D at Lyon La Soie over 2700m on 9 March. Remains barefoot and should be a lively danger
- 10. LIKELY DU PADOUENG** - On a long losing run but was runner-up in a class D at Agen-le-Passage over 2625m on 17 January. Could play a minor role
- 11. LORKY RED** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class C over this course and distance on 19 February. Remains barefoot and is clearly not out of it
- 12. LEMON CURD** - A winner of his last two starts, the latest in a class E at Castillonnes over 2450m on 8 March. Remains barefoot and can complete a hat-trick
- 13. LINADA BELLA** - Battling to regain best form and finished 8th in a class E at Agen-le-Passage over 2625m on 3 March. Needs to do more to score

Summary: LEMON CURD (12) is highly rated and is coming off two impressive wins. He should take out this opening event. LOKY DE JIEL (3) is talented but has only raced once since 2024. He remains a danger, though. LEWIS DE BLARY (8) is not reliable but he is quite capable of getting into the mix of things in a race of this nature. LORKY RED (11) was not disgraced over this course and distance last month and can do even better this time around.

21,000**

- 1. LOOPING DE MA** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest in a claimer at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2875m on 14 March. Probably best watched for now
- 2. LESCOUBIAC** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a Claimer at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 15 March. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 3. LUZ JELOCA** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class F at Agen-le-Passage over 2625m on 1 March. Remains barefoot and could score if staying in stride
- 4. LEONIDAS DE GUELLE** - Disqualified in a class F at this track over 2750m on 20 March. Fitter this time but does need major improvement to score
- 5. LITTLE DREAM D'ERI** - Disqualified in a class G at this track over 2325m on 13 March. Yet to win a race and is struggling so others are preferred
- 6. LOVE YOU DRALIAM** - Has yet to win a race but was fourth in a class G at this track over 2325m on 13 March. Might play a minor role at very best
- 7. LORD OF WOOD** - Successful in a class E at this track over 2750m on 30 January. Has major disqualification issues but can score when smart
- 8. LANCELOT BOCAIN** - In good form and was fourth in a class F at Auch over 2800m on 8 March. Reverts to barefoot and has a place chance in this line-up
- 9. LOS ALAMOS** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class E at this track over 2750m on 30 January. Remains barefoot and should contest the finish
- 10. LEWIS D'EVRON** - In good shape and finished third in a class E at this track over 2750m on 30 January. Should be competitive once again
- 11. L'AMI DE LANCOUR** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a class E at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 15 March. Reverts to barefoot but more is needed to beat these rivals
- 12. LUTTEUR DU RIEU** - Did not show his best when 9th in a class E at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 14 February. Does well with this shoeing and is a lively danger

Summary: LUZ JELOCA (3) finished strongly and was runner-up before being disqualified last time out. He can make amends for that if smart this time. LUTTEUR DU RIEU (12) is best judged on his form with this shoeing and can fight out the finish. LOS ALAMOS (9) has done enough of late to hold claims of winning a race of this nature. LEWIS D'EVRON (10) remains in good shape and should contest the finish yet again.

- 1. JOIE DE BERTRANGE** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in a class F over this track and distance on 13 March. Remains barefoot but more is needed to score
- 2. JOG JELOCA** - Did not show his best when 9th in a class F at Vire over 2800m on 1 March. Has a good record with this shoeing and can score
- 3. JET DE LA FERME** - Unreliable but was a good third in a class F over this track and trip on 13 March. Can be competitive once again
- 4. IANINA DES BORDES** - Battling to regain best form and was 10th in a class F at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 3 March. Needs to do a lot more to beat these rivals
- 5. HERMES D'AIROU** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a class F at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 3 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 6. IBIS D'OR** - Consistent and was fourth in a class F over this course and distance on 13 March. Might play a minor role
- 7. JOLISSIME ELDE** - Consistent of late and was third in a class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 19 February. Can contest the finish once again
- 8. ISEA D'HOULBEC** - Has struggled of late and finished 10th in a class F at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 3 March. Reverts to barefoot but others make more appeal
- 9. ICARIOS GEMINI** - Needed the last run when 6th in a class F over this course and distance on 13 March. Capable of improvement and is not out of it
- 10. JAVA DE CAPONET** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 7 March. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 11. JALNA DU PALAIS** - Has needed both her starts this year and was unplaced in a class F over this track and trip on 13 March. Could make the frame
- 12. JAVANAISE DE FARS** - Consistent of late and finished fourth in a class F at Agen-le-Passage over 2625m on 23 March. Might play a minor role
- 13. IQUITO DU LEARD** - Unreliable but was fourth in a class G at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 18 March. Remains barefoot and is capable of an upset when smart
- 14. JUNO ELLIS** - Not reliable but was fourth in a class G at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 22 February. Might need to do more to beat these rivals
- 15. JONAGOLD** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a class E at Lyon La Soie over 2050m on 9 March. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 16. ICARE DE LA BASLE** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a class F over this course and distance on 13 March. Has won at this track and could be the surprise package of the race

Summary: An open looking race. JOG JELOCA (2) is clearly better than his last run would suggest. He has a good record with this shoeing arrangement and can bounce back to score. JET DE LA FERME (3) was good over this course and distance last time out but is not reliable. JOLISSIME ELDE (7) is consistent and she is capable of shining brightly once again. ICARIOS GEMINI (9) will strip fitter this time and has claims at scoring.

- 1. HAROLD SAUTONNE** - Has struggled of late and finished 9th in a class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 10 February. Needs to find a few length to win
- 2. IDEAL DELADOU** - Battling to regain best form and finished 9th in a class E at Cavaillon over 2600m on 1 March. Reverts to barefoot but others make more appeal
- 3. ILTON DE BELLANDE** - Consistent and finished fourth in a class D at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 4 November. Remains barefoot and could make the frame if fit enough after a break
- 4. INCROYABLE BLACK** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a class C at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 7 March. Reverts to barefoot and could earn some money at this track
- 5. HAKIM DES CHAMPS** - Successful in a class E at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 17 January. Has a good record barefoot and can follow up
- 6. IBIS DE CHAHAINS** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 26 December. Reverts to barefoot but others make more appeal
- 7. HORN** - In good form this year and was runner-up in a class E at Agen-le-Passage over 2050m on 3 March. Reverts to barefoot and can be a threat yet again
- 8. IENISSE DE BARBRAY** - Unreliable and finished 10th in a class F at Machecoul over 2700m on 15 March. Reverts to barefoot and could contest the finish
- 9. HEURE BLEUE** - Disqualified in a class E at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 14 February. Not easy to trust but does well with this shoeing and must be respected in this line-up
- 10. GALVESTON** - A barefoot winner in a class E at Lyon La Soie over 2700m on 18 February. Remains barefoot and has a place chance
- 11. ILTON CASH** - Not disgraced when fourth in a class C at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 7 March. Might play a minor role
- 12. IZAYA DE COUSSERAT** - Victorious in a class F at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 1 March. Keeps that shoeing and can earn some money
- 13. GRANITA DES BOIS** - Finished fourth in a class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 8 February. Might earn some minor money at very best
- 14. GAVROCHE DU GADE** - Showed some improvement when third in a class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 7 March. Remains barefoot but more is needed to score
- 15. HA YES MAX** - Finished 7th in a class D mounted race at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 7 March. Remains barefoot and others are preferred
- 16. HERMES DELUSS** - Not disgraced when fourth in a class E at Cordemais over 2825m on 23 November. Remains barefoot but could need this run returning from a break

Summary: HAKIM DES CHAMPS (5) was a solid winner last time out at Agen-le-Passage and has a good record when racing without shoes. He returns from a short break but does get the vote to score. IENISSE DE BARBRAY (8) is unreliable but will be barefoot for this performance and must be respected for that. HEURE BLEUE (9) has a good record with this shoeing arrangement but is not easy to trust. ILTON DE BELLANDE (3) returns from a break but is consistent and could shine.

C5 - PRIX DE CAHORS - 2950m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. LEANA DU CHATELET - Probably needed her only start of the year when 8th in a claimer at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 15 March. Fitter now but does need to find a few lengths to score

2. LAITUE DE QUERAY - Disqualified in both her starts this year, the latest being over this course and distance on 7 February. Struggling to win but can play a minor role when staying in stride

3. LA KIFFANCE MIL - Disqualified last time out at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 1 March. Does well when barefoot and could earn some money this time around

4. LASKA TURGOT - Unreliable and finished tenth in a Class E mounted race over this course and distance on 17 October. Returns from a break and could need this run

5. LOVELY GAZELLE - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at this track over 2325m on 3 January. Hard to trust and others make more appeal

6. LITTLE QUEEN JISCE - Returned from a break and finished 6th in Class G at this track over 2325m on 13 March. Fitter this time but does need to improve to win

7. L'ETOILE MASCAR - Yet to win a race but did finish third in Class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 1 February. Capable of making the frame again

8. LILI D'EVAILLES - Faulted last time out at Saint-Brieuc over 2575m on 15 February. Yet to win a race but can be a threat to these rivals

9. LICORNE QUICK - Did not show her best when 7th in Class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 1 March. Capable of doing better and is not out of it

10. LUZ DES CHARENTES - Unreliable and finished tenth in Class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 22 March. Barefoot this time and has a place chance in this line-up

11. LOUISE D'ERPION - Returned to form with a victory in Class F at this track over 2750m on 13 March. Keeps that shoeing and might just follow up

12. LEGENDE SEVEN - Disqualified in three of her last four starts, including last time out at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 20 February. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal

13. LUCRECE - Did not show her best when 7th in Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 17 December. Did better at this track before that when barefoot and races without shoes again. Can go close

14. LIBERTINE DE FRECA - Not disgraced when fifth in Class F at Auch over 2800m on 8 March. Has some disqualification issues but can contest the finish when smart

15. LISON DES GLENAN - A winner of her last two starts, both in mounted races, the latest in Class F at Vire over 2800m on 1 March. Better in that discipline but can play a minor role

Summary: A very competitive looking race. LIBERTINE DE FRECA (14) was not disgraced at Auch earlier this month. That effort suggested she is edging back towards her best but she does come with disqualification issues. LILI D'EVAILLES (8) arrives for this after a fault and she has yet to win a race but she is also capable of contesting the finish. LUCRECE (13) and LOUISE D'ERPION (11) have both done well at this track and would not be surprise winners.

C6 - PRIX DE LOURDES - 2950m (a2m) - Class G Amateur Riders - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. KUEEN KEP** - Probably needed her only run of the year when 7th in Class F at Auch over 2800m on 8 March. Fitter this time but does need to find a few lengths to score
- 2. KOURANE LA CHENAIE** - Has only been modest this year and finished 6th in a Class F mounted race at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 26 February. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 3. JOYEUX DES SOURCES** - Finished 12th in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 15 November. Returns from a break and needs major improvement to win
- 4. KEEPYOURSELFALIVE** - Clearly needed her comeback run when 12th in Class H at Saumur over 3250m on 22 February. Barefoot this time and is capable of scoring
- 5. JOYAU WINNER** - Not reliable and finished 11th in Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 8 February. On a long losing run and others make more appeal
- 6. KASH DE TAGOR** - Finished tenth in Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 8 February 2025. Returns from a lengthy break and is likely to need this run
- 7. KOKONUT BAINDOR** - Unreliable again this year and was tenth in Class F over this course and distance on 27 February. Barefoot this time and could earn some minor money
- 8. KINGKARL** - Faulted last time out at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 12 March. Capable of making the frame when staying on the trot
- 9. JAVADA DU MONT** - Not reliable and finished 6th in Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 22 December. Returns from a break but is not out of it
- 10. KANSAS QUICK** - Unreliable but did run well when runner-up in Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 7 March. Can go one place better
- 11. JASMIN BLEU** - In good shape and was runner-up in Class G over this course and distance on 20 March. Can get involved in the finish once again
- 12. JADESKA** - On a very long losing run but did finish third in Class F at Amiens over 2400m on 21 February. Might play a minor role at best
- 13. JOSIO DU POMMEREUX** - Faulted last time out over this track and trip on 20 March. Has been in good form this year and can earn some money if wise
- 14. KEEP COOL** - Not reliable but did run well when third in Class D at this track over 2150m on 19 February. Can contest the finish

She is likely to strip much fitter this time, and the switch to racing barefoot indicates she could be ready to score. The biggest danger may come from KANSAS QUICK (10) who showed a return to form at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat earlier this month. She remains capable of winning a race of this nature. JASMIN BLEU (11) and KEEP COOL (14) have both done enough of late to be dangers.

**C7 - PRIX DU MAS D'AZIL - 2950m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR €
23,000**

- 1. MISSING DUEM** - A runner-up in class E at this course over 2150m on 17 October. Has been good so far but could need this run returning from a break
- 2. MOSCATO DUEM** - Consistent and finished 3rd in class D at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 15 September. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 3. MAYA DES BAUX** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 3 March. More is needed to win this race
- 4. MADISON DANICA** - Victorious in his last three starts, the latest Class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 3 March. Tries a bit further but can make it four on the trot
- 5. MONTENEGRO** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 28 February. Can make the frame if staying on the trot
- 6. MISTRAL DE LOISEL** - Yet to win a race but was runner-up in class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 9 February. Keeps that shoeing and is a danger
- 7. MAD DREAM** - Holding form and finished 4th in class E at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 20 March. Can get into the mix of things once again
- 8. MENTION GRAVE** - Showed some improvement when barefoot and runner-up in a class E mounted race at this track over 2325m on 13 March when barefoot. Not this time and others are preferred
- 9. MONEY AIMEF** - In good form and was 4th in class D at Enghien over 2875m on 10 March. Victorious back in February and can be competitive in this line-up
- 10. MINIE CAUSSANEL** - Victorious in Class E at this track over 2325m on 13 March. Victorious in two of last three starts and can win again
- 11. MAESTRO DE JOUDES** - Off form and finished 9th in class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 3 March. Is barefoot but needs to improve to beat these rivals

Summary: MADISON DANICA (4) is unbeaten this year and has won three of just four starts. He sets a clear standard for the race. MISTRAL DE LOISEL (6) has yet to win a race but is knocking at the door and must be respected for that. MONEY AIMEF (9) ran a decent race, all things considered, at Enghien and can be a threat to these rivals if she is in that mood. MONTENEGRO (5) has disqualification issues but is talented and is another to consider.

- 1. MIAMI DREAM** - Victorious in Class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 1 March. Has shown improvement but is not reliable. Capable of following up
- 2. MATARIKI** - In good form this year and was runner-up in class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 14 February. Remains barefoot and can score
- 3. MA LEA DU GUESCLIN** - Faulted in class E at this track over 2750m on 27 February. Has disqualification issues and is best watched for now
- 4. MAESTRO D'ESPACE** - Not reliable and was 7th in class E at this track over 2750m on 27 February. Did better in his penultimate start and can contest the finish
- 5. MILADY CASTELETS** - Showed some improvement when 5th in class E at this course over 2325m on 13 March. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 6. MARCOTTE D'ALBRET** - Returned from a break and finished 9th in class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 27 February. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 7. MAC VENESI** - Showed improvement and was runner-up in class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 22 March. Can go one place better
- 8. MERVEILLE DAB** - Unreliable and finished 11th in Class E at this track over 2750m on 27 February. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 9. MONA LISA STARDUST** - Successful in a claimer at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 15 March when barefoot. Tougher task this time and others are preferred
- 10. MUSE DU LOISIR** - Victorious in Class F at Auch over 2800m on 8 March. Has shown improvement but is not reliable and has disqualification issues. Others make more appeal
- 11. MAJOR DU PADOUENG** - Needed his last run when 7th in class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 17 January. Victorious at this track before that and is not out of it
- 12. MILTON BROWN** - Needed his last run when 7th in class E at Caen over 2200m on 16 March. Victorious back in June and is capable of an upset
- 13. MIRABEAU** - A runner-up in class E at this track over 2150m on 14 November. Could need this run returning from a break
- 14. MARVELOUS SPORT** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, the latest in class A at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 18 November. Returns from a break but is capable making the frame

Summary: MATARIKI (2) has improved this year since going barefoot and should make a bold bid at taking out this lucky last race. A confident pick. MAESTRO D'ESPACE (4) is better judged on his penultimate start and can contest the finish. MIAMI DREAM (1) is not reliable but she did win her latest start and is not out of it. MAC VENESI (7) ran a cracker on Sunday and is capable of going one place better this time around.
