# C1 - PRIX DES GLAIEULS - 2875m (a2m) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- **1. LOUVE DE BAIS -** In the frame in first 2 before faulting in a 2500m Reims Class E a month ago. Showed her limits that day and will have few takers
- **2. LASER FIGHTER -** Has done nothing but improve since his March debut, latterly 2nd of 7 finishers in a 2675m Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel on 10 May, but in this category will need to find more
- **3. LUXE D'ERABLE -** Plainly capable but sanctioned in 4 of 5, most recently a 2950m Saint-Malo Class D a week ago. Showed his form that day though and will have his chances if David Thomain keeps him trotting
- **4. LA PAIX -** Got off the mark in a 2725m Méral Class G 2 weeks ago. Steps up in category and although unlikely to repeat, should still acquit herself competitively
- **5. LOVE DANCER -** 3rd of 6 finishers in a 2450m Caen Class E 3 weeks ago. Can lose focus but is plainly able and looks a respectable first-5 prospect

- **10. LAUTREC D'HERFRAIE -** Useful sort that was oddly below-par when 5th of 8 finishers in a 2675m Lisieux Class D 2 weeks ago. Will appreciate the change of scenery and looks capable of making the frame this time

**Summary:** LILIAN DU PARADIS (9) put in an excellent final kilometre at Cholet late last month; she has had time to freshen up and, in similar form, can impose. It is unlikely to be all plane sailing though, considering how well LEMBELIE VERDERIE (8) performed at Caen recently, and the untapped potential LUXE D'ERABLE (3) has yet to display. LAUTREC D'HERFRAIE (10) is a serious colt for the most part and will be expected to improve on his recent Lisieux performance.

- **1. KRILLE DU BOUILLON -** Sanctioned on re-entry but made amends when 2nd of 9 finishers in a 2750m Ecommoy Class F last weekend. Still has more to find but will have her supporters
- **2. KISS ME JIVE -** 6th of 7 finishers in a 2550m Class F at Gournay-en-Bray a week ago and can be disregarded
- **3. KAMTCHATKA -** Capricious filly but has shown potential. Unseen since being sanctioned in a 2750m Cabourg Class E last December though and best to hold off
- **4. KALIPETTE JELOCA -** Promising filly making her first appearance since trotting 3rd in a 2675m Class E at Le Mont-Saint-Michel last August, and will not be given a hard race
- **5. KEZYA -** Made the frame at Laval last month before faulting early in a 2550m Reims Class F 6 days ago. Has a good entry though and, with David Thomain at the helm, can play a leading role
- **6. KALIMERA FLASH -** 5th of 6 finishers in a 2550m Gournay-en-Bray Class F a week ago. Starts in front, with shoes off, and can finally get that maiden monkey off her back

- **3. KANTOUTSTART -** 6th of 13, behind KINDER DANOVER (5), in a 2800m Class F at Villedieules-Poëles 3 weeks ago. Is considerably better than that and with David Thomain reining, will have his chances
- **4. KOPECK DU LOUVET -** 2nd of 8 finishers in a 2825m Vire Class F on 8 May. Is barefoot for Argentan debut and has never disappointed for Mathieu Mottier. Place prospect

- **3. JUNAKA MELODY -** Lost her action on re-entry in a 2750m Class E at La Capelle earlier this month. Shoes still on and best to wait

- **10. KARAMEL JOYEUX -** Faulted in a 2700m Méral harness Class F a fortnight ago. Sanctioned in last 2 under the saddle and will have few takers
- **11. KANOIS DE LATOUR -** Failed to pull off the hat-trick when 3rd of 9 finishers in a 2450m Caen Class F one 22 April, but with a trouble-free run, can impose
- **12. KARLA D'AVENIR -** Started to get back in the game when 2nd of 8 finishers in a 2750m Class F at La Capelle 3 weeks ago and will be no pushover if Jean-Loïc Claude Dersoir keeps her trotting
- **13. KAYENNE -** Has not been seen out since finishing last of 8 in a 2875m Enghien Class E early-March. Races first time barefoot and will generate some interest

**Summary:** KALIN DU TRESOR (3) has enjoyed quite the resurgence since switching codes and, fresh for his hat-trick bid, will justifiably garner significant support. Mathieu Mottier will still want to be wary of the capable KAPORAL GAME (8) who races barefoot for the first time, and recent Graignes winner KAVIVE (6) who is not far from winning another. KANOIS DE LATOUR (11) keeps on getting better and is sure to finish in the mix.
