# C1 - PRIX DE L'AMITIE - 3000m (a2m) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 24,000

- **1. HECTOR DES CAMBRES -** His last win was in 2022 and he was tenth last time out in Class G at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 10 May. Barefoot this time but others are preferred
- **2. HEVA MALEX -** Unreliable and was 8th last time out in Class E at Granville over 3125m on 19 May. Does win every now and then over shorter but is barefoot and could upset
- **3. HATOUT DE CONNEE -** Has struggled twice this year and was 9th last time out in Class G at Challans over 2900m on 28 April. Needs major improvement to win
- **4. HISTOIRE D'ELLE -** Has really struggled this year and was 11th last time out in Class F at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 19 May. Others are much preferred
- **5. HELMA DU COURTILS -** Unreliable and was 9th last time out in Class E at Nantes over this distance on 9 May. Did win her penultimate start and she is capable of being a threat
- **6. GENIE D'ATTAQUE -** Disappointing form of late and was 8th last time out in Class G at Montauban over 2400m on 9 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **7. GAGNANT RUSH -** Very unreliable and was 8th last time out in Class H at Le Grand-Fougeray over 2750m on 9 May. Won his penultimate start but he does appear better over that shorter distance
- **8. HURLEVENT -** In good form of late and has won two Mounted races this year, with the latest being in Class F at Cholet over 2800m on 14 May. Not as good these days in harness races but is not out of it
- **9. HERAKLION DESBOIS -** Has struggled this year and was 7th last time out in Class F at Le Mans over 2950m on 8 May. Needs to do more to win this race
- **10. HIDALGO DE VARENNE -** Has disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at Nantes on 9 May. Capable of a surprise when wise
- **11. HISTOIRE DU LUPIN -** Her last win was in 2022 but she is in good form and was fourth last time out in Class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2600m on 16 May. Deserves respect in this line-up
- **12. HEUREUSE DE VIVRE -** In fair form and was 5th last time out in Class F at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 19 May. Can contest the finish
- **13. GAMAY DES CROUAS -** Struggled in his only start of this year when unplaced in Class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2600m on 16 May. Likely to need another run and others are preferred
- **14. HERA WIND -** Back to her best and is hat-trick-seeking after some nice wins, with the latest being in Class F at Elbeuf over 2750m on 8 May. Big chance

**Summary:** HERA WIND (14) is back to her best and has a big chance of completing a hat-trick. HEUREUSE DE VIVRE (12) has only been fair of late but an improved run could be on the cards. HISTOIRE DU LUPIN (11) is in good form but is also on a long losing run. HURLEVENT (8) has won two Mounted races this year and could not be a surprise winner of a harness race.

- **1. HUMEUR LA RAVELLE -** Won her penultimate start but she has struggled in her other runs this year and was 6th last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Cholet over 2800m on 14 May. Others are preferred
- **2. HUMOUR D'HAUFOR -** Unreliable but he was victorious last time out in Class F at Le Mans over 2950m on 8 May. Capable of following up if in the same mood
- **3. HELIOS DJEMA -** At the top of his game this year with back-to-back wins, with the latest being in Class E at Caen over 2450m on 22 April. Deserves respect in this line-up
- **4. FURY D'EVEL -** On a very long losing run but was not disgraced when fourth last time out in Class G at Châtelaillon-La Rochelle over 2625m on 12 May. Might play a minor role
- **5. GOODWOOD SPORT -** Has struggled this year so far and was tenth last time out in Class H at Valognes over 2500m on 9 May. Others are much preferred
- **6. GARD -** Very unreliable but was not disgraced when runner-up last time out in Class E at Loudéac over 2850m on 11 May. Can finish in the money
- **7. GAVOTTE DU PRATEL** Unreliable and was third last time out in Class F at Vichy over 2150m on 6 May. Capable of making the frame
- **8. GIRL DE L'ETOILE -** Only moderate form this year and was 7th last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Cholet over 2800m on 14 May. Others are preferred

- **11. FIRST DES CHARRONS -** Unreliable again this year and was 9th last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 15 May. Capable of better and can bounce back to score
- **12. HUDSON VEDAQUAIS -** Has been struggling for some time now and was disqualified last time out at Caen on 13 May. Best watched for now
- **13. HERO SIBEY -** Returned from a break in fine form and has won twice, with the latest being in Class E at Tours over 2800m on 14 April. Can complete the hat-trick
- **14. DROP DE L'ITON -** Has lost his way and was well beaten last time out in Class E at Lignières over 2825m on 14 April. Needs major improvement to win

**Summary:** HERO SIBEY (13) has been very good of late, winning twice and has every chance of completing the treble. HEXODE DE FELLIERE (9) is knocking hard on the door with some promising runner-up performances and should fight out the finish once again. FIRST DES CHARRONS (11) is unreliable but is also capable of getting into the mix of things. HELIOS DJEMA (3) is in good form and deserves the utmost respect.

- **1. KLIF DE LA MITRIE -** Disappointing form of late and was disqualified last time out at Caen on 18 May. Capable of better and could win
- **2. KING EVOLUTION -** In good form this year and was runner-up last time out in Class F at Le Neubourg over 3000m on 20 May. Better over further but could earn some money
- **3. KRAC BRENUS -** More than a year since last win and was 11th last time out in Class E at Chartres over 2800m on 8 May. Best watched for now
- **4. KAMARO -** Unreliable and was 8th last time out in Class F at Méral over 2700m on 12 May. Capable of earning some money when in the mood
- **5. KENNEDY TEXAN -** Has disqualification issues but did run well when third last time out in Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 10 May. Might place
- **6. KRIS KROSS -** Disappointing last run when unplaced in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 26 September. Likely to need this run returning from a break

- **12. KHAZIM -** Holding his form and was fourth last time out in Class F at Laon over 2850m on 12 May. Could play a minor role
- **13. KETBERNY -** Unreliable but did run well when third last time out in Class F at Jallais over 2975m on 5 May. Place chance

- **1. JINA FOUTEAU -** Knocking hard on the door and was runner-up last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 23 April. Not out of it
- **2. JERICHO VEDAQUAIS -** Holding his form well and was fourth last time out in Class D at La Capelle over 2700m on 5 May. Capable of making the frame again
- **3. ISLAND GIS -** Unreliable of late and was 6th last time out in Class F at Ecommoy over 2750m on 18 May. Capable of better but others are preferred
- **4. JAGERBOMB -** Very good when unshod and was runner-up last time out in Class E at Angers over 3125m on 11 April. Can go one better this time
- **5. JENARO DJEMA -** Has already won four times this year and was third last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 10 May. Can contest the finish once again

- **3. KOH LANTA -** Disappointing last run when 12th in Class E at Vincennes over 2175m on 23 December. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- **4. KOURGA DE LOU -** Unreliable but did run well when third last time out in Class E at Vichy over 2950m on 12 May. Can play a minor role
- **5. KELLA DU DONJON -** Unreliable but did run well when third last time out in Class F at Châtelaillon-La Rochelle over 2500m on 12 May. Can contest the finish
- **6. KYRIA BELLA -** Fluffed her lines with a disqualification last time out at Vincennes on 27 January. Can bounce back to be a threat

- **3. JESSYLONA -** Struggling of late and was 6th last time out in Class E at Bernay over 2800m on 12 May. More is needed to win this race
- **4. JACINTHE DES BOIS -** Disappointing last run when 7th last time out in Class F at Jullouville-les-Pins over 2700m on 9 May. Capable of making the frame
- **5. JEWEL D'AUCHY -** In good form of late and was fourth last time out in Class F at Savigny-sur-Braye over 2525m on 9 May. Place chance in this line-up
- **6. JOYEUX DE BOLERO -** Unreliable this year and was third last time out in Class E at Ecommoy over 2750m on 18 May. Could play a minor role

- **3. LILOU DE GUOZ -** Did all that was asked of her on debut winning in Class F at Tours over 2200m on 14 April. Can follow up
- **4. LOUNA D'ESTIEU -** Has yet to win after 20 starts and was disqualified last time out at Cholet on 14 May. Others are much preferred
- **5. LAZULITE GEDE -** A runner-up in two of three starts, with the latest being in Class G at Thouars over 2700m on 9 May. Not out of it
- **6. LA BOHEME VRIE -** Did not show much on debut when tenth in Class F at Laval over 2850m on 17 May. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- **7. LATINUS AVIS -** Has disqualification issues but did run well last time out when third in Class G at Fougères over 3200m on 8 May. Not out of it
- **8. LAUREL -** Showed improvement to win his second start, a Class G at Loudéac over 2225m on 21 April. Has a winning chance

**Summary:** A competitive lucky last race with the smallest field of the meeting. LIKABLE DE LOU (2) was disqualified last time out but is better judged on his good debut performance. LILOU DE GUOZ (3) won on debut and deserves respect for that win. LATINUS AVIS (7) is not easy to trust but did run well last time out. LAUREL (8) is improving and could follow up on a solid last win.
