- **1. CHARMING CAT -** Ran 2nd in a Claimer at Salon Provence on 15 May. Goes a little further this time and has racing experience
- **2. OSHIA -** Won a Conditional Handicap over 1200m at Marseille Borely on 2 May. Win was full of merit and can repeat this time
- **3. BALTA -** Finished 6th in an event for unraced horses at Bordeaux Le Bouscat on 5 May. Will need to show improvement
- **4. GO MAN -** Finished 7th in an event for unraced horses over 1000m at Marseille Borely on 19 March. Will need to improve
- **5. SICILIANO -** Beautifully bred colt by Time Test out of a Frankel mare and trained by Patrice Cottier. One to watch
- **6. ASTREA -** Ran 2nd in a Conditional Handicap over 1200m at Marseille Borely on 2 May. Looks held by OSHIA (2)
- **7. SPARKS OF LOVE -** Finished 3rd in a Conditional Handicap over 1200m at Marseille Borely on 2 May. Held by others on last run
- **8. EXQUISE ITALIENNE -** Irish-bred filly by Romanised out of Chipololata and trained by Jerome Reynier. Watch the betting
- **9. AMAZING GRACE -** By new sire and top sprinter A'ali and trained by Mme Manon Scandella-Lacaille. Should be quite speedy

**Summary:** This is quite an interesting race with some well-bred first-timers. However, there was a lot to like about the manner in which OSHIA (2) won her last race and she can do so again. ASTREA (6) finished 2.5 lengths behind her and should also be competitive in this. SICILIANO (5) is a beautifully bred colt out of a Frankel mare and comes from a top stable so could make a winning debut. CHARMING CAT (1) has the most racing experience which could tell in a race of this nature.

- **2. BLACK BOSS -** Ran 4th in a Maiden over 2000m at Marseille Borely on 9 May. Goes over further on this occasion and needs to raise his game
- **3. TANFEPAS -** Ran 7th in a Handicap over 2600m at Marseille Borely on 2 May. Will need to improve to feature in this
- **4. DREAM IN BROOKE -** Finished 2nd in a Maiden over 2400m at Salon Provence on 15 May. She has improved with each run and will enjoy the distance
- **5. BLANCHE SACREE -** Ran 3rd in a Handicap over 2600m at Marseille Borely on 2 May. She has a good draw and has proven stamina
- **6. STORM STAR -** Ran 2nd in a Maiden over 2200m at Cavaillon on 26 April. That effort was quite impressive she should improve further

- **3. CLEOD'OR -** Won a Handicap over 2100m at Marseille Borely on 2 May. Loves this course but at the weights will battle in this event
- **4. LOU MAN -** Ran 2nd in a Handicap over 2000m at Salon Provence on 17 April. An experienced runner and could place in this field
- **5. BOBBYMURPHY -** Finished 3rd in a Handicap over 1600m at Lyon Parilly on 8 May. In good form but will need to overcome the widest draw

- **4. RESOLUTION -** Ran 2nd in a Claimer over 2100m at Marseille Borely on 9 May. Runs well at this course and could contest the places
- **5. MOKKA LATTE -** Finished 7th in a Maiden over 2400m at Saint Cloud on 25 March. Drops in distance and that may suit
- **6. BERLINETTA -** Ran 7th in a Handicap over 1700m at Marseille Borely on 2 May. She was well beaten at this track last time
