SANTA MARIA had previously got the better of that rival too but is also 2kg worse off. Stablemate AMANZIMTOTI confirmed the promise of her debut 2nd when beating older horses last time. She is likely to improve stepped up in trip, so must be included. QUICK BREEZE wasn't disgraced in an Eastern Cape feature and could also play a role.

FUSILLADE is improving and could have say too, while LAMI JEAN remains unexposed and open to improvement over the extra - respect. SONIC BURST, SNOW DRAGON and NOOSA PRINCESS have claims too.
