C1 - PRIX DE LA GARE DES INVALIDES - 2875m (a2m) - Class F Amateur Drivers Race - Harness - EUR € 12,000

- **1. HORACE DU VIVIER -** In the frame in 3 of last 4, latterly 2nd of 13 in a 2850m Vincennes amateurs Class F 9 days ago, and from the front row should take all the beating
- **2. GODZILLA VICI -** last of 12 finishers in a 2825m Durtal Class F last Sunday. Very disappointing all season and can be confidently ruled out
- **3. HACKER D'ERI -** Unraced since running 2nd of 10 over 2350m in Avenches 2 months ago. Comes here fresh, starts in front, and is back at Enghien with a good hand to play
- **4. GODSEND -** Pleasant 6th of 16 in a 2450m Agon amateurs Class H last weekend. Has solid amateur references but still needs to raise his game
- **5. IPSOS DANOVER -** Yet to get into his stride this term, latterly sanctioned in a 2900m Amiens Class F on 7 June. Benefits from an excellent entry on the front line though and should not be overlooked
- **6. EUDES DE L'AUNAY -** Returns to the amateur division after finishing 8th of 14 in a 2450m Caen Class E 10 days ago and others easier to back
- **7. GOHAKI -** Made the frame in 2 of last 3, most recently 2nd of 10 in a 2850m Vincennes amateurs Class F on 3 June. Has never failed to deliver here and must be considered a contender
- **8. HEAGLE ONE -** Sanctioned in a 2750m Class F at La Capelle in early-May and under these conditions has no realistic chance
- **9. HILDA DU THYRAL -** Back to a category she adores after coming 8th of 12 in a 2950m Class E at Saint-Malo earlier this month. Won under these conditions last time here and has a reasonable chance of repeating
- **10. FIGARO GEMA -** Disappointing so far this term, most recently sanctioned in a 3450m Agon Class E last Sunday, but won this race last year. Reconfigured for the occasion and must be respected

Summary: An excellent servant in the amateur division, and starting on the front row, HORACE DU VIVIER (1) is less fond of Enghien than he is of Vincennes, but in current form is very hard to ignore. 25m worse off, HILDA DU THYRAL (9) was oddly out of sorts at Saint-Malo but has otherwise been firing on all cylinders and boasts an impeccable amateur record. GOHAKI (7) appreciates Enghien, thrives at this level, and is clearly close to his race. Seldom disappointing in this class, HACKER D'ERI (3) is barefoot for his return to France and must be taken seriously.

- 2. MAZERATI PAJJ Sanctioned in a 2275m Nantes Class E on 2 June. Is not devoid of ability but others still easier to trust
- **3. MILADY MADRIK** Made it 2 straight claiming victories when successful over 2700m at Graignes on 14 June. In marginally better company this time but still looks a serious proposition
- **4. MAFIA DU BAS BOSQ -** 4th of 6 finishers in a 2550m Reims Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Has no left-handed references and cannot be considered a priority
- **5. MARIA DE VALNY -** Encouraged twice in the provinces before running 5th of 10 to MYRTILLE MARBOULA (13) in a 2100m Vincennes claimer on 10 June. Would have finished closer had she stayed in stride and must not be ignored
- **6. MASSILIO BLOND -** Sprang something of a surprise when 2nd of 14 to MILADY MADRIK (3) in a 2700m Graignes claimer 12 days ago although a repeat seems most improbable
- **7. MARELLA DALEO -** Imposed at Le Mont-Saint-Michel late-April but sanctioned in a Class D over course and distance a month ago. Alexandre Abrivard in the bike this time but others still preferred
- **8. MY DESTINY QUEEN -** Won a brace of provincial claimers before finishing last but one in race of reference and others preferred
- **9. MYSTERE DE PLAY -** Failed to pull off the 3-timer when 3rd of 14 to MILADY MADRIK (3) in a 2700m Graignes claimer 12 days ago. In marginally better company this time but is still competitive for a place in the frame

In cracking form over recent months, MYSTERE DE PLAY (9) ran 3rd to her last time and is easy to like for a place on the podium.

- 2. MY DARLING DU RIS Good 2nd at Nantes before losing her action in a 2850m Vincennes Class D last week, but will not be far off the mark if Guillaume Martin keeps her focused
- **3. MADONE DES RACQUES -** Failed to confirm Amiens victory when 4th of 11 in a 2200m Caen Class D late last month. Has no left-handed credentials but has been handed a fine draw and should not be written off
- **4. MAVISTA -** 4th of 9 on re-entry in a 2725m Lisieux Class C 2.5 weeks ago. Will have progressed for the race and from the 4-spot could well lose her maiden tag
- **5. MISSLADY DU VICLAU -** Unraced since getting off the mark in a 2700m Graignes Class E on 9 June. Steps up in category but is ideally-positioned to win a race of this nature
- **6. MISS JENILOU -** 7th of 15 behind MARQUISE GRIFF (7) in a 2200m Vincennes Class D on 10 June. Placed here last summer but still appears to have too much to do

- **4. LISTEN VIP -** 3rd of 11, a place behind LA TERRE DU BANNEY (11), in a 2700m Class E at La Capelle 11 days ago. Sports hind pads this time but must not be ruled out
- **5. LUTECE PLANCHETTE -** Looked decidedly ordinary when last of 11 behind LADY DUCALE (10) in a 2150m Class E here on 14 June and must first reaffirm
- **6. LASKOVA -** Oddly lacklustre last of 11 behind LADY DUCALE (10) in a 2150m Class E here on 14 June. Has otherwise been in fine shape and will be expected to redeem herself

- **3. GO FAST DE VAINS -** Encouraging 4th of 16 in a 2700m Avranches Class H mid-month. Has merit though and can get a look-in if he stays in stride
- **4. GOWEN CHALEONNAIS -** Back in the claiming category after coming 7th of 10 in a 2100m Vincennes amateurs Class F a fortnight ago and others easier to back
- **5. GOOD FRIEND -** Sanctioned, on return to competition, in a 3150m Mamers Class F on 9 June. Won a Bordeaux claimer last winter but cannot be considered a priority this time
- **6. ITRO -** Returned to winning ways 2.5 weeks ago when securing a claimer over 2575m at Gournay-en-Bray. In better company this time and with Christophe Martens in the bike is very easy to like for a minor place cheque
- **7. HENRY DE TROUVILLE -** Last but one in a 2850m Vincennes amateurs Class F last week. Has been a write-off so far this year and will have few, if any, friends in the markets
- **8. HOMMAGE DE LARRE -** Modest individual that ran 9th of 10 in an 1800m Class E at La Capelle mid-month and even in this category has no possible chance
- **9. HOPE -** Excellent winner of a 2525m Cavaillon Class F on 17 June. Enjoys a front-row start, has won twice at Enghien, and has every chance of adding another success to his tally

Summary: Winner at Vincennes on his only start at this level, GALLAGHER WIND (16) goes barefoot for the first time since and with application can impose. He will still feel the heat from FEUX VERTS (15) who is shod as he was when winning a Class D here last summer, and frontrow starter and 2-time Enghien winner HOPE (9) who was victorious in the provinces just last week. Terrifically entered on the front line, at ease in the claiming division, and reconfigured for the occasion, IRON MIJACK (11) must be considered a major player.

- **3. HEADLINE FAC -** Has not put a foot out of line since February, most recently 2nd of 8 finishers in a Class D over course and distance on 24 May, and will be competitive for the win

Summary: Highly-impressive since returning to the discipline last summer, MADE OF STARS (6) put in an excellent performance in his Caen re-entry 10 days ago and is in with a realistic chance of making his Enghien debut a successful one. Mehdi Lelievre will nevertheless be mindful of the in-form HEADLINE FAC (3) who ran a good 2nd under these conditions a month ago, and HUMOUR FESTIF (7) who has excelled under the saddle this term. - **2. KRONOS D'ERPION -** Reassuring 4th of 15 in a 2800m Rambouillet Class E on 2 May. Comes here fresh, placed last time at the venue, but still not a priority
- **3. KNOW EVER -** Secured 2 on the trot before faulting in a 2100m Vincennes Class E mid-May. Won his only start with Pierre-Yves Verva reining and breaking from the 3-spot will only work in his favour. Chance
- **4. KAP NORMAND -** Courageous 6th of 15 behind KISS COOL MIJACK (5), in a 2100m Vincennes Class E on 13 June. Will not be sent out at 87/1 this time but will not be as competitive either
- **5. KISS COOL MIJACK -** Made up for lacklustre Graignes run when 2nd of 15 in a 2100m Vincennes Class E on 13 June. Well-positioned behind the car and can impose this time
- **6. KAZAAL -** Fine servant moving up the category-ladder after comfortably winning a 2700m Graignes Class E on 23 May. Breaks on the front line and although untried here still looks a player
- **7. KILLER ANGOT -** Ran 2nd at Graignes before finishing 7th of 11 in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E 3 weeks ago, and others preferred
- **8. KATSUKI -** Produced a tenacious performance to win a 2350m Angers Class E on 10 June. Starts wide in front but can play an important role if Gabi Gelormini keeps him trotting
- **9. KING HEUVELLAND -** Tricky type returning to France after winning over 2600m at Victoria Park mid-month. Takes on a better lot this time and the draw will do him no favours

- **3. JOYAU DE MORTREE -** Has enjoyed a decent run of form this season, most recently 3rd of 6 finishers in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class G 3 weeks ago. In better company but is still worth monitoring
- **4. JOKER DU MIDI -** 11th of 14 when preparing for this in a 3000m Marseille-Borely harness Class F conditioner last week. Is plainly in shape and Oscar Placier will be justifiably confident of a big run
- **5. INDIGO GEDE -** Has been off the boil all year, latterly sanctioned in a 2625m Saint-Pierre-la-Cour last Saturday, and is not about to shake things up
- **6. JESOLO -** Unable to confirm Cherbourg performance when sanctioned in a 2650m Alencon Class G on 11 May. Form is not in question though and with application can set the record straight
- 7. ISIS DU LEARD Failed to confirm Chartres effort when unusually 7th of 12 to JUBLA VIKING (9) in a 2450m Caen Class E a fortnight ago. Pads on all 4 again and will be expected to make amends
- **8. INDULGENTE -** Takes to monte code for first time after finishing last of 11 in a 2450m Caen harness Class F a week ago. Hind shoes off for first time, with Pierre-Yves Verva in the irons, and could pleasantly surprise
- **9. JUBLA VIKING -** Sanctioned when going well at Mauquenchy but redeemed herself when comfortably winning a 2450m Caen Class E on 11 June, and can double up if Alexis Collette keeps her focused

Summary: Nicely-entered at the limit of earnings, JUBLA VIKING (9) put on quite the show at Caen earlier in the month and, barefoot for her Enghien debut, looks thoroughly capable of confirming. Alexis Collette will still be keeping an eye on the in-form JESOLO (6) who should not be condemned for his recent sanction, and JOKER DU MIDI (4) who returns to Paris shod to preference. Useful over these shorter trips, ISIS DU LEARD (7) is worth retaining.
