

R3 NANCY [R-H]

C1 - PRIX DU SAGITTAIRE - 2600m (a1m1/2) - Class G - Mounted - EUR € 18,000

- 1. LIBERTY BLUE** - Disqualified in six of last seven starts, including last time out in a class E mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 22 June. Hard to trust but is capable of scoring when smart
- 2. MEC DES RACQUES** - Disqualified in a class F mounted race at Chartres over 2800m on 17 June. Yet to win a race but has a place chance on best form
- 3. MOONLIGHT ATOUT** - Disqualified in a class E harness race at Amiens over 2400m on 8 June. Victorious in April and could be a threat trying a mounted race
- 4. MARIUS DU CLOS** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class E at Vichy over 2950m on 13 June. Victorious in November and can score when smart
- 5. MAURANE DU CLOS** - Only modest of late and finished 5th in a class E mounted race at Cholet over 2800m on 9 June. Might play a minor role
- 6. MILLENIUM JIEL** - Victorious in a class E mounted race at Rouen-Maquenchy over 2850m on 26 January. Unreliable but is capable of scoring if fit enough
- 7. MISS VITARDERIE** - In good form and was 4th in a class E mounted race at Amiens over 2400m on 11 June. Fit and should contest the finish
- 8. LUIDGI DES EPINES** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class F mounted race at Le Touquet over 2600m on 20 June. Has major disqualification issues and others make more appeal
- 9. LADIVA DE PARIS** - Showed some improvement when 5th in a class F mounted race at Reims over 2550m on 15 April. On a long losing streak but might play a minor role

Summary: MILLENIUM JIEL (6) produced a dominant display at Mauquenchy last time out and, if maintaining the same rhythm, looks the one to beat. MISS VITARDERIE (7) has shown plenty of promise in this discipline and should be involved at the finish. MARIUS DU CLOS (4) has the form to feature but needs to bounce back after two below-par efforts this season. MOONLIGHT ATOUT (3) could improve significantly now switching to mounted racing.

**C2 - PRIX ASSOCIATION DES COURSES DE REIMS/CHALONS-EN-CHAMPAGNE - 2600m (a1m1/2) -
Class F - Harness - EUR € 17,000**

- 1. NADJIM KALOUMA** - A three-year-old colt by Charly du Noyer out of Ella Kalouma who is making his debut. His mother won once in 29 starts. Can score
- 2. NEWSTAR OF LOVE** - A three-year-old filly by Real de Lou out of Source of Love who is making her debut. Her Dam never won after three starts. Could need this experience
- 3. NYMPHE DU PASSAGE** - A three-year-old filly by A Love of Hauffer out of Highless of Passage who is making her debut. Her mother won 3 of 31 starts. Might play a minor role
- 4. NANTIS DU CHATAULT** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class D at Vincennes over 2200m on 9 June. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 5. NUIT DE FOLIE** - Showed some improvement when 3rd in class F at Strassbourg over 2150m on 7 June. Can be competitive once again
- 6. NOSTRA STAR** - Not reliable and was 7th in class F at Reims over 2550m on 6 June. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 7. NEW D'ORLY** - Not reliable and was 5th in class D at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 10 June. Capable of an upset in this line-up
- 8. NOVA JOSSELYN** - Disqualified in class F at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 24 May. Had some good form before that and could bounce back to score if smart
- 9. NO QUARTER** - Disqualified in class E at Saint-Galmier over 2000m on 21 November. Victorious before that and can score if fit enough after a break
- 10. NATACHA HEUVELLAND** - Victorious on debut in class G at Bihorel-les-Rouen over 2500m on 14 May. Won well that day and could be capable of doubling up

Summary: An eye-catching qualifier, NADJIM KALOUMA (1) looks to have been well prepared for his debut and gets the nod to score. NO QUARTER (9), a winner on debut, is worth another chance and rates a leading danger. NATACHA HEUVELLAND (10) scored with plenty in hand in her first public outing and clearly has the scope to go higher. NOVA JOSSELYN (8), from a powerful yard, will be out to make amends for the last start disqualification.

**C3 - PRIX DE LA FEDERATION DES COURSES DE L'EST - 2600m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR €
17,000**

1. **MIAMI DES RACQUES** - Disqualified in both starts, the latest in class G at Saint-Omer over 2625m on 31 May. Makes little appeal
2. **MONA CROWN** - Has improved of late and was runner-up in class G at Strassbourg over 2750m on 7 June. Can go one place better
3. **MAMZELLE D'ARBAZ** - Not disgraced when 5th in class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 31 July. Returns from a break and could need this run
4. **MEYLLINE LESAC** - Not reliable and finished 6th in class F at Bernay-en-Braye over 2550m on 25 May. Might play a minor role at very best
5. **MAMOUNIA D'ECHAL** - Victorious in class H at Villedieu-les-Poeles over 2800m on 14 June. Has shown improvement in form and can double the lead. Contest the win
6. **MIA DE CHENU** - Finished 8th in class H at Elbeuf over 2750m on 17 May. Has yet to win a race and others are much preferred
7. **MISS FINE** - Yet to win a race but was 3rd in class F at Reims over 2550m on 6 June. Clearly is not out of it in this line-up
8. **MADY DU POMMEREUX** - Off form and was 9th in class f at Le Croise La Rocha over 2700m on 1 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score
9. **MAITIKA D'HERIPRE** - Victorious in class F at Hyeres over 2650m on 20 July. Has disqualification issues but is capable of doubling up
10. **MANGALYA** - Not reliable but was 3rd in class E at Caen over 2200m on 18 June. Quite capable of making the frame
11. **MADISON DE MAHEY** - In good shape and was 3rd in class E at Amiens over 2400m on 8 June. Can get into the mix of things once again

Summary: MAITIKA D'HERIPRE (9) makes her return from a lengthy break but comes from a shrewd yard and, if keeping her action together, could make a winning comeback. MAMOUNIA D'ECHAL (5) has clearly turned a corner, as shown by her recent success, and now steps up in class with justified ambition. From the second row, MADISON DE MAHEY (11) should not be underestimated after improving when racing without shoes, and the same applies to MANGALYA (10), who also holds solid claims.

C4 - PRIX DE LA FORET DE HAYE - 2600m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 17,000

- 1. MAN IN THE MIRROR** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a Class H at Elbeuf over 2750m on 14 June. Capable of earning some minor money
- 2. MELO DU LOCHEUR** - Has only been modest so far and finished 5th in a Class F at Les Andelys over 2525m on 21 June. Might need to do more to beat these rivals
- 3. MAGNUM ROYAL** - Successful in a Class G at this track over 2000m on 9 November. Returns from a break but can score if fit enough
- 4. MAN O WAR** - Victorious twice in a row, the latest in a Class H at Villedieu-les-Poêles over 2800m on 14 June. Can complete the treble
- 5. MINOS DES RACQUES** - Disqualified at Châlons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 8 May. Battling to find best form and others make more appeal
- 6. MAESTRO DE FERFAY** - Not reliable and finished 8th in a Class F at Amiens over 2900m on 11 June. Might play a minor role at very best
- 7. MANDARINO FLEURY** - Holding form and finished 4th in a Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 8 June. Can be competitive once again
- 8. MILO DE NAPPES** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 8 June. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 9. MERGINIO** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in a Class F at Laon over 2850m on 7 June. Can go one place better

Summary: MAGNUM ROYAL (3) has not been seen since making a winning debut on this track last year but could still come out on top if ready to roll. MAN O WAR (4), a winner on his return to these shores, looks the main threat. MANDARINO FLEURY (7) has solid form to his name and, despite an initial handicap, is capable of making the frame. MERGINIO (9), partnered by Christophe Martens and once again racing barefoot, could confirm his return to form.

C5 - PRIX DE LA FONTAINE NEPTUNE - 2600m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 19,500

- 1. LADY DE MONGUERET** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Class E at Reims over 2500m on 25 May. Best judged on a good penultimate start and could make the frame
- 2. LADY DU CAMPUS** - Has some fair form and finished 4th in a Class H at Châlons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 14 June. Capable of playing a minor role
- 3. LIO DU MESNIL** - Unreliable and was runner-up in a Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 27 November. Could need this run returning from a break
- 4. LARISSE D'ECHAL** - Returned to form and was runner-up in a Class F at Caen over 2450m on 15 June. Has disqualification issues but is also capable of scoring
- 5. LA NUIT JE MENS** - Disqualified at Le Neubourg on 13 June. Battling to find best form and needs major improvement to score
- 6. LEXI BIRDIE** - Did not show her best when 6th in a Class F at Le Neubourg over 3000m on 13 June. Capable of better and has a place chance
- 7. L'HISTOIRE SECRETE** - Victorious in three of last four starts, including in a Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 19 June. Big chance
- 8. LARISSA DU VIVIER** - Disqualified at Alençon on 10 May. In very good form before that and can contest the finish when smart
- 9. LUDMILLA HAUFOR** - Yet to win a race and finished 6th in a Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 2 June. Needs to do a bit more to score

Summary: Trained by the in-form Romain Derieux, L'HISTOIRE SECRÈTE (7) returns from a lengthy absence but races barefoot and could prove hard to beat if ready. LARISSA DU VIVIER (8), who has plenty of ability and remains open to improvement, looks a threat. LARISSE D'ECHAL (4) is not the most consistent but caught the eye when runner-up in a strong contest at Caen and can be competitive. LADY DE MONGUERET (1) faces an easier assignment this time and could make the frame.

C6 - PRIX OZO - 2600m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 19,500

- 1. LOVELY DE TILLARD** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Strasbourg on 13 May. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 2. LOIR BOURBON** - Did not show his best when 7th in a Class E at Chartres over 2825m on 17 June. In good form before that and should be competitive this time
- 3. LITTLEBIG STARDUST** - Not reliable but finished 4th in a Class F at Orléans over 3400m on 7 June. Yet to win a race and may need to find a few lengths to score
- 4. LEOLIO** - Showed some improvement when 5th in a Class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 28 May. On a long losing run but might play a minor role
- 5. LUPIN MELOC** - In good shape and was runner-up in a Class F at La Capelle over 1800m on 14 June. On a long losing run but does have a place chance
- 6. L'ARC EN CIEL** - Disqualified at Strasbourg on 13 May. Battling to find ebst form and needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 7. LISKI DE LA CRIERE** - Did not show his best when 7th in a Class D at Les Andelys over 2525m on 21 June. Capable of much betetr and could earn some money
- 8. LEADER DE CHOISEL** - Threatening to score and was runner-up at Angoulême over 2750m on 14 June. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 9. LIPTON DU NOYER** - Unreliable but was runner-up in a Class F at Le Neubourg over 3000m on 13 June. Tougher task but could make the frame
- 10. LORD SAINT MARTIN** - Not reliable but was runner-up in a Class F at Vichy over 2150m on 28 May. Has disqualification issues but can go one place better
- 11. LOTUS JIEL** - Victorious twice in a row, the latest in a Class F at Elbeuf over 2750m on 7 June. Big chance of completing the treble

Summary: mperious in his last two outings, LOTUS JIEL (11) looks to have a golden opportunity to complete a hat-trick. He may, however, face a test from LORD SAINT MARTIN (10), who is capable of putting up strong resistance on a going day. LOIR BOURBON (2) disappointed last time out but with the trainer back in the sulky, is worth another chance. LIPTON DU NOYER (9), a reassuring runner-up around ten days ago, is also not out of contention.

C7 - PRIX DU MUSEE LORRAIN - 2600m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 19,500

1. **KEEP ON RUNNING** - Disqualified at Laon on 7 June. On a long losing run but is capable of earning some minor money when smart
2. **KAPRICE DE CHANJAC** - Disqualified in five of last six starts, including last time out at Laon on 7 June. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
3. **KEEP OUT** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in a Class F at Reims over 2500m on 20 June. Battling to find best form and others are preferred
4. **KRAQUITA BELLA** - Unreliable but finished 3rd at Angoulême over 2750m on 14 June. Tougher task this time but might play a minor role
5. **KEOPS DE BETTON** - Did not show his best when 7th at Angoulême over 2750m on 14 June. Capable of doing better and might earn some minor money
6. **KIRUNA DU PONCELET** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Class E at Amiens over 2900m on 8 June. A good winner of her penultimate start and can score again
7. **KASH ELEVEN** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out at Strasbourg on 7 June. Hard to trust and others are preferred
8. **KALYPSO MI AMOR** - Disqualified at this track on 25 May. Battling to find best form and needs to find a few lengths to score
9. **KAPITEN DU MELEUC** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Amiens on 8 June. Needs to do a lot more to beat these rivals
10. **KNOX JENILOU** - In good shape and was runner-up in a Class E at Toulouse over 2150m on 5 June. Not reliable but does have claims in this line-up
11. **KUZCO** - Off form and finished 8th in a Class E at Amiens over 2900m on 8 June. Has struggled this year and others make more appeal
12. **KOKA DU DOUET** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class E at La Capelle over 2750m on 19 June. Capable of better and has a place chance
13. **KISS ME DUTOLLEM** - In very good shape and finished runner-up in a Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 8 June. Can be a threat to these rivals
14. **KANSAS DE CASTELLE** - Disqualified at Amiens on 8 June. Had some good form before that and could contest the finish if smart
15. **KELOWA STARDUST** - Unreliable and finished 12th in a Class D at Le Mans over 2950m on 21 May. On a long losing run but could play a minor role
16. **KRONA VIKING** - Not disgraced when 4th in a Class E at Caen over 2450m on 10 June. Has disqualification issues but might earn some more minor money

Summary: KNOX JENILOU (10) is at the top of his game at present and, with his trainer making the trip with clear intent, looks a leading contender. KIRUNA DU PONCELET (6) is capable of a bold front-running display if allowed to dictate and rates a serious threat. KANSAS DE CASTELLE (14) has the ability for a race of this nature and is worth another chance. Tough and consistent, KISS ME DUTOLLEM (13) should also have a say.

**C8 - PRIX DE LA SOCIETE DU TROTTEUR FRANCAIS - 2600m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR €
25,000**

- 1. JOUR DES RACQUES** - Unreliable and finished 9th in a Class F at Reims over 2550m on 15 April. Capable of an upset on best form
- 2. HELLO CAUVELLIERE** - Only modest of late and finished 5th in a Class G at Arras over 2900m on 21 June. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 3. JUST BE GOOD** - Disqualified twice in last four starts, including last time at La Capelle on 19 June. Capable of bouncing back to beat these rivals
- 4. JIMIR DE GUEZ** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest at Jallais on 13 June. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 5. JAGUAR DE ROZEVIC** - Returned to form when 4th in a Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 8 June. Has disqualification issues but does have claims in this line-up
- 6. JACOTTE DE TIZE** - Unreliable but finished 3rd in a Class E at Jallais over 3000m on 13 June. Very hard to trust but can be competitive
- 7. IMITCH DU MOULIN** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out at Arras on 21 June. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 8. JOKER DE LA BRETTE** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class E at Cholet over 2800m on 9 June. Capable of making the frame on best form
- 9. ILUCE DE BEAUCAMPS** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out at Saint-Omer on 31 May. Can contest the finish when smart
- 10. HAPPY ATOUT** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a Class E at Amiens over 2900m on 11 June. Might play a minor role at very best
- 11. HIT DE JOBI** - Continues to struggle and finished 12th in a Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 3 January. Could need this run returning from a break

Summary: Preference is given to the younger runners in this very open lucky last race. JAGUAR DE ROZEVIC (5), capable of both brilliance and disappointment and gets a tentative vote. JACOTTE DE TIZÉ (6) is partnered by Gabriele Gelormini in a bid to maximise her chances. From the second line, ILUCE DE BEAUCAMPS (9) has the ability to feature prominently if maintaining stride throughout. JOKER DE LA BRETTE (8), ideally positioned on the front row, is also worthy of consideration.
