J LORDI has improved of late and should be involved in the finish. ROCKING IN RIO has only been modest so far but returns from a break and having been gelded can make dramatic improvement. AMERICAN GEM does seem better on the grass but can earn some money in a race of this nature. AMERICAN PETAL is better than her last run and can make the frame.

LADY MAJESTIC put in a career best performance last time out and might do even better this time.

BLACKBERRY BREEZE is usually competitive and clearly not out of it. HOODWINKED did his best work late last time out and could be ready for a winning turn. GLOBAL DRUMBEAT and SIXTYZERO receive weight from their rivals and might be dangerous.

CHARLIE MALONE and HOSPICES DE BEAUNE are also capable of getting into the mix.

PREVIEW: THIS OR THAT impressed in her debut win. She did not show the same level of form trying the Polytrack but could recoup losses. MYSTICAL BUTTERFLY is well drawn this time so a better run can be expected. MOSCOW MISS needed her last run and can bounce back to be a real threat to these rivals. WALK RIGHT IN won last time out and could have more to offer. DRACHENFUTTER makes a local debut and could be a danger. WHIRLYBIRD and VOORSMAAKIE are two others to consider.
