PREVIEW: CAPTAIN CLEVER ran some fair races in KwaZulu-Natal. He should do well on local debut trying blinkers for the first time. PLAYMAKER did not show much on debut but does have Richard Fourie aboard so could improve. PIPE DE ORO has not finished off his races so it is of no surprise that blinkers have been reached for but he did not shine with this equipment earlier in his career. STAND UP is threatening to win a race and can do so if given a soft lead this time. RIVER FERN is better than the last run would suggest and could be a threat.

ROYAL MERMAID was unreliable in KwaZulu-Natal but will probably like this shorter distance and could be a threat on local debut. GENOVEFA and OCEAN FLAME are capable of vast improvement on their local debuts. ELUSIVE BOMBA is improving and would not be a surprise winner.

GEORGE HANDEL is at the top of his game but does run earlier in the week so that run will need to be looked at. LOTUS ISLAND and ROLL OF THE DICE could also be included.

PRINCE ANTONIO and MANEKI NEKO have both shown a liking for the Polytrack and hold claims. ICE CAP and KING'S SAILOR are both capable of earning some minor money.
