# C1 - PRIX DE L'HIPPODROME DE REIMS - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class G Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 6,000

- 1. JAGUAR OPAJELO Has really struggled of late and finished 10th in Class G at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 21 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **2. INDIANA DI PALBA -** Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Grenade-sur-Garonne on 21 December. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- **3. IDEO HUNAUDIERES -** In good form and finished 3rd in a Class G at Pornichet-La Baule over 2725m on 31 October. Races without shoes and can win
- **4. JAMELIN** Has only been modest of late and finished 8th in Class F at Nantes over 3000m on 1 December. Might play a minor role at best
- **5. JARDIN DE MAHEY -** Holding form and finished 4th in a Class F over this course and distance on 16 December. Clearly not out of it back in this division
- **6. JAD DES ELIES -** Disqualified 7 times in a row, the latest at this track on 8 December. Hard to trust and others are much preferred

- **1. ITALIQUE DU CLOS -** A winner of two of last four starts, the latest a Class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 18 November. Should be right there at the finish
- 2. IVAN DU JAYLE Unreliable but was runner-up in Class E at this track over 2650m on 16 December. Can go one place better
- **3. JEANBLANC DUEM -** Threatening to win and was runner-up in Class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 4 December. Can be competitive once again
- **4. IVARUN** Disqualified in Class E at Argentan on 14 December. Very consistent before that and can be a threat to these rivals if smart
- **5. I SANTO DUSSAC -** Unreliable and finished 6th in a Class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 4 December. Capable of an upset on best form
- **6. JAVA DU CHERISAY -** Has disqualification issues and faulted at Vincennes on 26 November. Not easy to trust but does have a place chance when smart

- **2. MARQUIS MARANDAIS -** Victorious in Class E at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 19 December. Capable of playing a minor role if repeating this level of form
- **3. MANZANA ERA -** Only modest of late and finished 9th in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 13 December. Needs to do plenty more to beat these rivals
- **4. MINA DE BASSIERE -** Disqualified at Grenade-sur-Garonne on 15 August. Very consistent before that but could need this run returning from a break
- **5. MAX DU POMMEREUX -** Not reliable and finished 6th in Class D at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 30 November. Might play a minor role at best
- **6. MIYA DE JOUDES -** Threatening another win and was runner-up in Class D at Caen over 2200m on 19 October. Should be very competitive again

- **2. LUMIERE DU CHENE -** Uneliable and finished 8th in Class D at Vincennes over 2175m on 13 December. Can get into the mix of things when in the right mood
- **3. LE MAGICIEN** Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in Class D at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 3 November. More is needed to win this race
- **4. LEXINGTON DANICA -** Did not show his best when 6th in Class D at Vincennes over 2175m on 12 December. Won twice in the provinces before that and can bounce back to score
- **5. LOULOU DES OUBEAUX** Only modest of late and finished 8th in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 3 December. Races without shoes and could challenge for top honors
- **6. LESTANCIA BELLA** Disappointing last run when 6th in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 4 December. In good form before that and can contest the finish

- **3. KURLING ATOUT -** Has only been modest of late and fnished 8th in Class F at Eauze over 3050m on 27 July. Returns from a break and should need this run
- **4. KALOGERO SI -** Did not show his best when 6th in a Class F at Vincennes over 2700m on 9 December. Capable of earning some minor money
- **5. KAISER DU CHATELET** A winner of a Class F mounted race at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 14 December. Better under the saddle and others make more appeal
- **6. KATANGA DE BLARY** In good form and finished 3rd in Class F at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 30 November. Should contest the finish

HARLEY DELTO (8) looks to have targeted this race and has claims of winning.

- **3. GRANTCHESTER -** Uneliable and finished 7th in Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 5 December. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 4. HA YES MAX Finished 6th in a claimer over this track and trip on 8 December. Generally modest and needs to do a lot more to win this race
- **5. HORACE D'ARTHENAY -** Unreliable and finished 5th in Class E at Graignes over 2725m on 12 December. Is capable of a surprise on best form
