C1 - PRIX DE GRETZ - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Mounted - EUR € 33,000

- **1. NEMORINO LEMAN** A two-year-old gelding by Doberman out of Egerie Leman who is making his debut. His Dam never ran. Others are preferred
- **2. NICE DREAM MESLOIS -** Disqualified in all four of his starts so far, the latest in a Class E harness race at Le Croise-Laroche over 2825m on 27 October. Can improve trying a mounted race
- **3. NORGUSSON ATALANTE -** Has only been modest so far and finished 7th in a Class D mounted race over this course and distance on 9 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **4. NYTRO GO ON -** Has only been modest so far and finished 6th in a Class D mounted race over this course and distance on 9 December. More is needed to win
- **5. NECTAR DE BOMO -** Unreliable and finished unplaced in a Class D mounted race over this track and trip on 9 December. Capable of doing better but others are preferred
- **6. NEWCASH DE PHYT'S -** Not disgraced when fourth in a Class D mounted race over this track and trip on 9 December. Can contest the finish once again
- **7. NAUTILIO BELLO -** Showed vast improvement when third in a Class D mounted race over this course and distance on 9 December. Has disqualification issues but does also have a winning chance
- **8. NIMBUS DE L'AVRE -** Disqualified last time out over this track and trip on 9 December. Did run better than position shows that day and also won well on debut. Big chance
- **9. NEWTON ELLIS -** Has some fair form and finished 5th in a Class D harness race at this track over 2850m on 10 November. Can be a threat trying a mounted race

Summary: NIMBUS DE L'AVRE (8) faulted in a race where a number of these rivals meet again. He ran well after that mistake and can bounce back with a victory this time around. NAUTILIO BELLO (7) showed improvement when third in that race and should be a threat once again. NEWCASH DE PHYT'S (6) was not disgraced over this track and trip last time out and should be right there at the finish. - **2. MEDEE DU CONROY -** Has struggled of late and finished 9th in Class D over this course and distance on 7 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **3. MIRABELLE DE LARRE -** Yet to win a race and was unplaced in Class D over this track and trip on 7 December. Capable of earning some minor money
- **4. MISS DISCO** Not reliable but was also not disgraced when 5th in Class D over this track and trip on 7 December. Can contest the finish
- **5. MAGGY JENILOU** Disqualified in three of last four starts, the latest in Class D over this track and trip on 7 December. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- **6. MAGIQUE HAUFOR -** Victorious last time out in Class E at this track over 2700m on 5 December. Has disqualification issues but can follow up if in the same mood
- 7. MENTHE FRAICHE Unreliable and finished 6th in Class D at this track over 2850m on 25 November. Has a place chance on best form
- 8. MAMOUNIA SEVEN Did not show her best when 7th in Class C at this track over 2700m on 19 December. Better this distance and will be a threat
- **9. MARVA CALENDES -** A bit of a disappointment when only 7th in Class D over this course and distance on 7 December. Needed the run and is capable of better here
- **10. MY CHARMING -** Showed some improvement when a winner in Class E at this track over 2200m on 10 December. Up in grade but worth a good look in

Summary: A very competitive-looking race. MAGIQUE HAUFOR (6) has disqualification issues but is also quite capable of following up and winning again after a solid success at this track at the beginning of the month. MAMOUNIA SEVEN (8) is better over this distance and can contest the finish this time. MISS DISCO (4) is unreliable but was not disgraced over this course and distance last time out and can be a threat. MARVA CALENDES (9) is another capable of contesting the finish on her best form.

- 2. IRIS INTENSE Disqualified four times in a row, the latest in Class D over this track and trip on 19 December. Capable of earning some money when smart
- **3. COSMICO POLARE -** Remains in good shape and finished fourth in Class D at Reims over 2500m on 19 October. Can be competitive once again
- **4. INSIDE MAN -** Has struggled of late and was 9th in Class E at Reims over 2550m on 7 December. Needs major improvement to be involved
- 5. SANGRIA PELLINI Did not show her best when unplaced in Class D over this course and distance on 10 December. Yet to win a race but can make the frame
- **6. ISLA (GER)** Usually competitive in Germany and was 5th over 1900m at Berlin-Mariendorf on 23 November. Barefoot and can contest the finish
- **7. CANTAB AS -** Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class C over this track and trip on 3 December. Capable of being competitive in this line-up
- **8. CONDOR BAR -** Finished 5th in Class E at Enghien over 2875m on 8 March 2024. Likely to need this run and others make more appeal
- **9. INDICE DU CAIEU** On a long losing run and finished 6th in Class D over this track and trip on 19 December. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **10. VINCI NICE** Disqualified last time out in Class F at reims over 2500m on 19 October. Needs to raise his game in order to win
- **11. DARLINGTON FAME -** Much improved last run when runner-up in Class D at this track over 2850m on 4 December. Can go one better despite the drop in trip
- **12. EDIMA** Has struggled of late and finished 9th at Rome over 1640m on 6 October. Top-connections but needs to find a few lengths to win

Summary: DARLINGTON FAME (11) showed improvement and ran a cracker at this course at the beginning of the month. She can go one place better over this distance. ISLA (GER) (6) is barefoot for her debut on French soil and could be a lively danger. CANTAB AS (7) has only been modest of late but is capable of winning a race in this division. IN RACE LORRAINE (1) picked up a confidence-boosting win at Le Croisé-Laroche and is another who can shine.

- **2. MANDELA SEVEN -** Remains in good shape and finished fourth in Class A at this track over 2175m on 20 December. Has solid claims in a open race
- 3. MAN IN LOVE Not disgraced when 5th in Class E over this course and distance on 4 December. Fitter this time and can be a live threat
- **4. MELKIOR DE BAILLY -** Has struggled of late and was unplaced in Class D at this track over 2200m on 3 December. Needs major improvement to win
- **5. MONTENEGRO** Disqualified in four of his last five starts, including last time out at this course over 2200m on 3 December. Does win when staying in stride so must be respected for that
- **6. MAGELLANO SUN -** Did not show his best when 7th in Class D at this track over 2200m on 3 December. Has a place chance in this line-up
- **7. MATISSE DU PONT -** Not reliable but was runner-up in a Class E mounted race at this track over 2200m on 12 December. Better under the saddle and others are preferred
- **8. MILLESIME STAR** Unreliable and finished unplaced in Class D over this track and trip on 12 December. Needs to do more to win this race
- 9. MADMAX JEF In good shape and finished third in Class E over this track and trip on 3 December. Capable of making the frame
- **10. MALICIOSO -** Showed some iimprovement when runner-up in Class D at Cabourg over 2050m on 15 October. Could need this run returning from a short break

- **2. DEMIDOFF CLA -** Has struggled of late and was 11th in Class D at this course over 2100m on 28 November. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **3. DANILO SPRITZ -** Victorious in his last two starts, the latest Class E at Milan over 1600m on 14 December. Can complete a hat-trick
- **4. DOMINGO BAR -** Has struggled of late and finished 10th in class C at this course over 2850m on 20 October. On a long losing streak and others make more appeal
- **5. MISTER JUPITER -** Finished 3rd in class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2875m on 14 June. Has shown promise and runs with a light shoeing. Can spring a surprise on return from a break
- **6. DAUPHIN JOYEUSE -** Consistent in Italy and was victorious last time out at Milan over 2120m on 14 December. Can be competitive in this line-up
- **7. DALI'DEL RONCO -** Off form and finished 11th in Class D at this track over 2175m on 16 November. Has major disqualification issues and is best watched for now
- **8. JUST VERY NICE -** Not reliable but was 3rd in class F at Cabourg over 2725m on 16 December. Has a place chance in this line-up
- **9. JUMBO JACK -** Has struggled of late and finished 12th in class F at Cabourg over 2725m on 23 October. Capable of an upset on best form

Summary: A tricky race and anything is possible. Christoffer Eriksson has got a good turn out of HIGH FIVE D.K. (12) and he can score on his debut on French soil. MERCEDES STAR (11) indicated his well being with a win in Germany in October and is another one who should play a leading role. FIORANO (13) was not disgraced at this course last month and can do a lot better. DAUPHIN JOYEUSE (6) brings solid Italian form to this race and is another to consider.

- 3. DIABEL Disqualified in her latest start, in Class D over this course and distance on 19 December. Knows how to win and can be a threat if smart
- **4. IDOLA -** Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class C over this course and distance on 13 December. Others make more appeal
- 5. IDOLE D'OURVILLE Very consistent of late and was third in Class D at this course over 2100m on 10 December. Can be involved in the finish
- **6. IENA D'ORGERES -** Knocking very hard at the door and was runner-up in Class D at this course over 2100m on 10 December. Should be competitive once again
- **7. JASMINE DE VAU -** Continues to improve and was victorious in Class D over this track and trip on 8 November. Can add another win to her tally

DIABEL (3) faulted last time out but has ability and can be a lively danger to these rivals. IDOLE D'OURVILLE (5) is usually competitive in this class of event and can get into the mix once again.

- **2. MISS MATTERS -** Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Solvalla over 2140m on 2 November. Tries a mounted race, well spoken and is capable of winning
- **3. MODE DU VALLON -** Has only been modest of late and finished 5th in a Class C harness race over this course and distance on 19 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **4. MY BLACK CADENCE** Showed some improvement and finished fourth in a Class D mounted race over this course and distance on 17 December. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **5. MISS BLACK BERRY -** Not reliable but did run well when third in a Class B harness race over this course and distance on 1 December. Capable of scoring if staying in stride
- **6. MIRATISSIME** Has struggled of late and finished 9th in a Group 1 mounted race over this track and trip on 14 December. Others make more appeal

- **3. KING KONG SMILE -** Has some fair form and finished 4th in class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 10 December. Remains barefoot and can earn some more money
- **4. KAID FORTUNA -** Has struggled of late and finished 10th in class E at this track over 2100m on 9 December. Needs to do plenty more to win this race
- **5. KARAT COOL -** Did bot show his best when 7th in class E at Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 17 August. Victorious in July but is likely to need this run returning from a break
- **6. KEEPSAKE MOSSA** Unreliable but was runner-up in class E at this course over 2700m on 29 November. Can be a threat to these rivals
